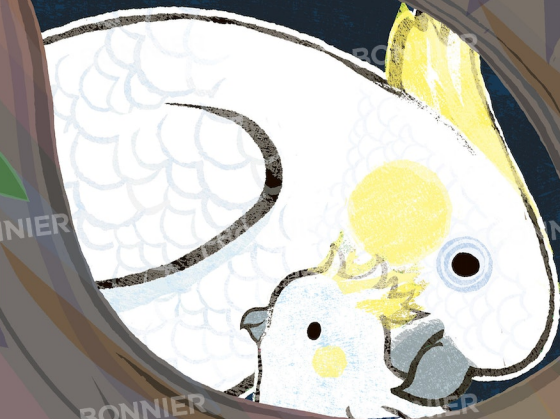



SPREAD YOUR WINGS

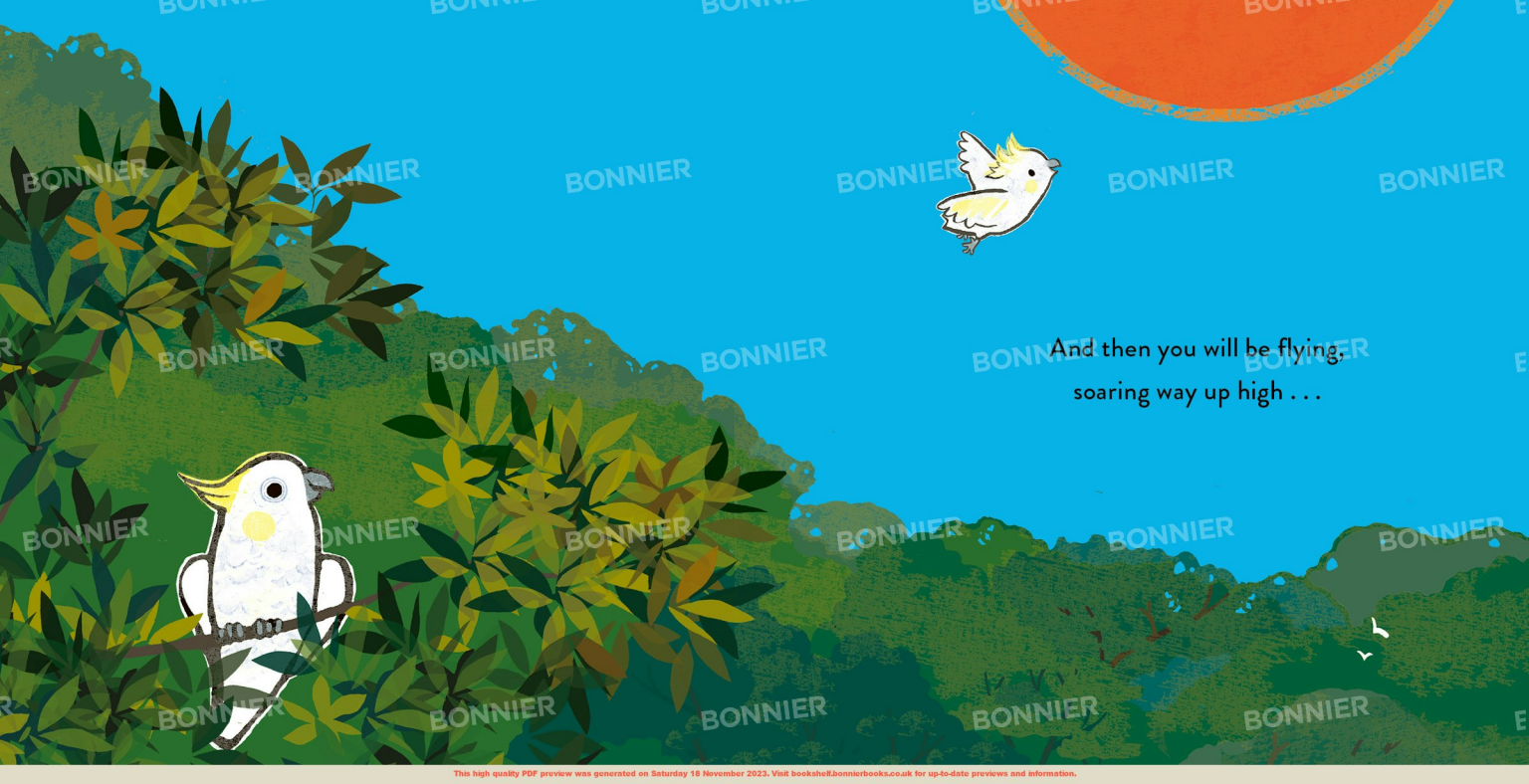
Safely tucked beneath my wing

in the wild blue sky.



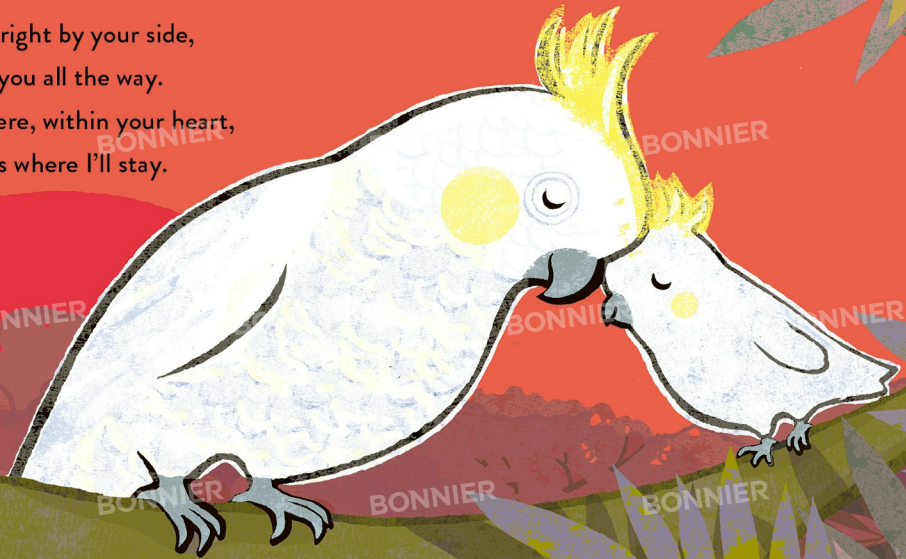


The world may seem a scary place
when you're far from home.

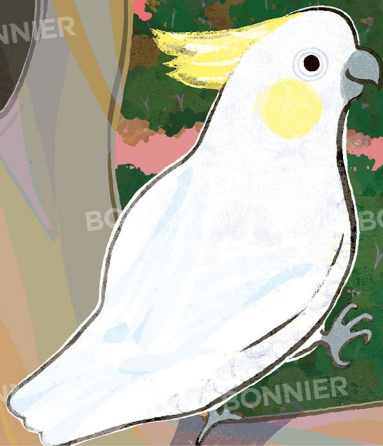


But anywhere you go, my love,
