MRS BEAR!



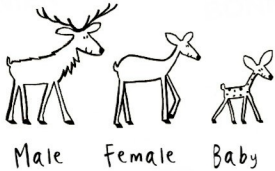

HERBIVORE

Rabbits are **AMAZING** jumpers. They can leap up to a metre high!

Foxes are **NOCTURNAL**. That means they sleep in the day and wake up at night.



Baby foxes are born in underground **DENS**.



Now meet Bear. She weighs as much as eight grown ups and is the **BIGGEST** animal in the forest.

OMNIVORE



Her favourite food is FISH!

She has BIG, SHARP claws.

Say hello to the Beaver family.
They use logs and sticks to build
their home called a lodge.



Beavers teach their
babies how to build, too.

Beavers also build
DAMS to block rivers
and make lakes.

They have LONG sharp

OMNIVORE

Mice use
their whiskers to
find their way in
the dark.

Look out! Here comes Owl. He's looking
for his favourite dinner... Mouse!

CARNIVORE

(This means he
only eats meat.)

Owls hunt by
SOUND rather
than sight.

They grab prey
in their long,
SHARP talons.



Owls have round faces like a satellite dish to collect sounds.



They can turn their heads right around to look **BACKWARDS!**

Owls usually live inside **TREE** hollows.

OMNIVORE

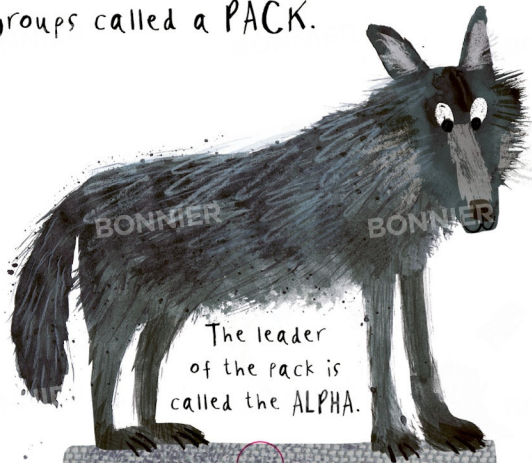
Squirrels eat nuts, berries, mushrooms, roots and bark.

and Mrs Bat!

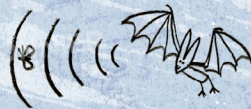
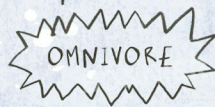


Some bats are so light they
