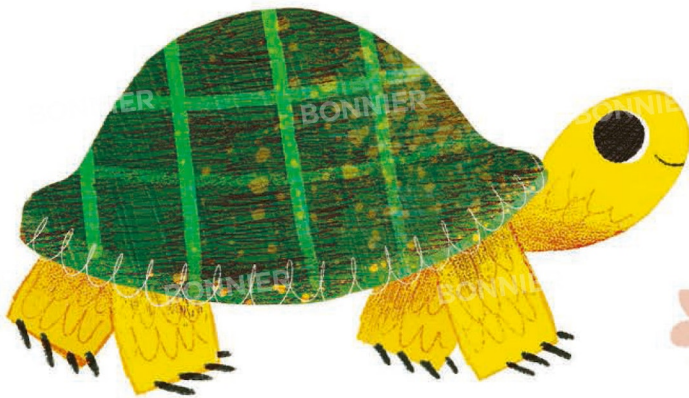

a simply **brilliant** day.”

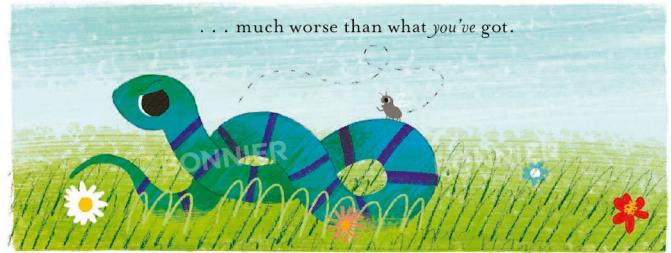




"But wait, what's this? I climbed up high

can make a bad day great!"

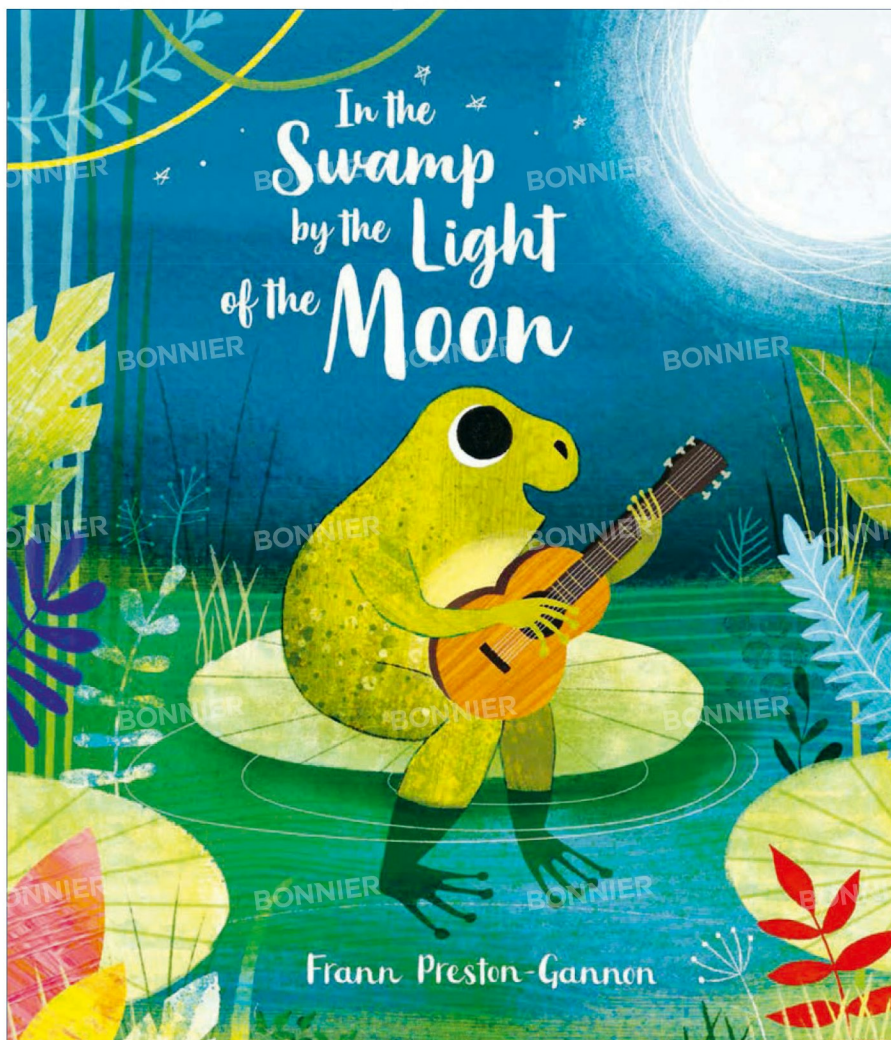
