




























Beneath the eaves, the tiny traveller shakes the miles from its wings . . .

and waits for its young to hatch.




Briefly helpless . . .

They already know the paths through the pathless sky.




 $A_{\rm nd}$  when the time comes they gather with the flock, sensing the shift in the turning air. They have promised the summer to elsewhere.

But they have deserts to cross




and seas to span and wild winds to ride . . .
