gardener do?

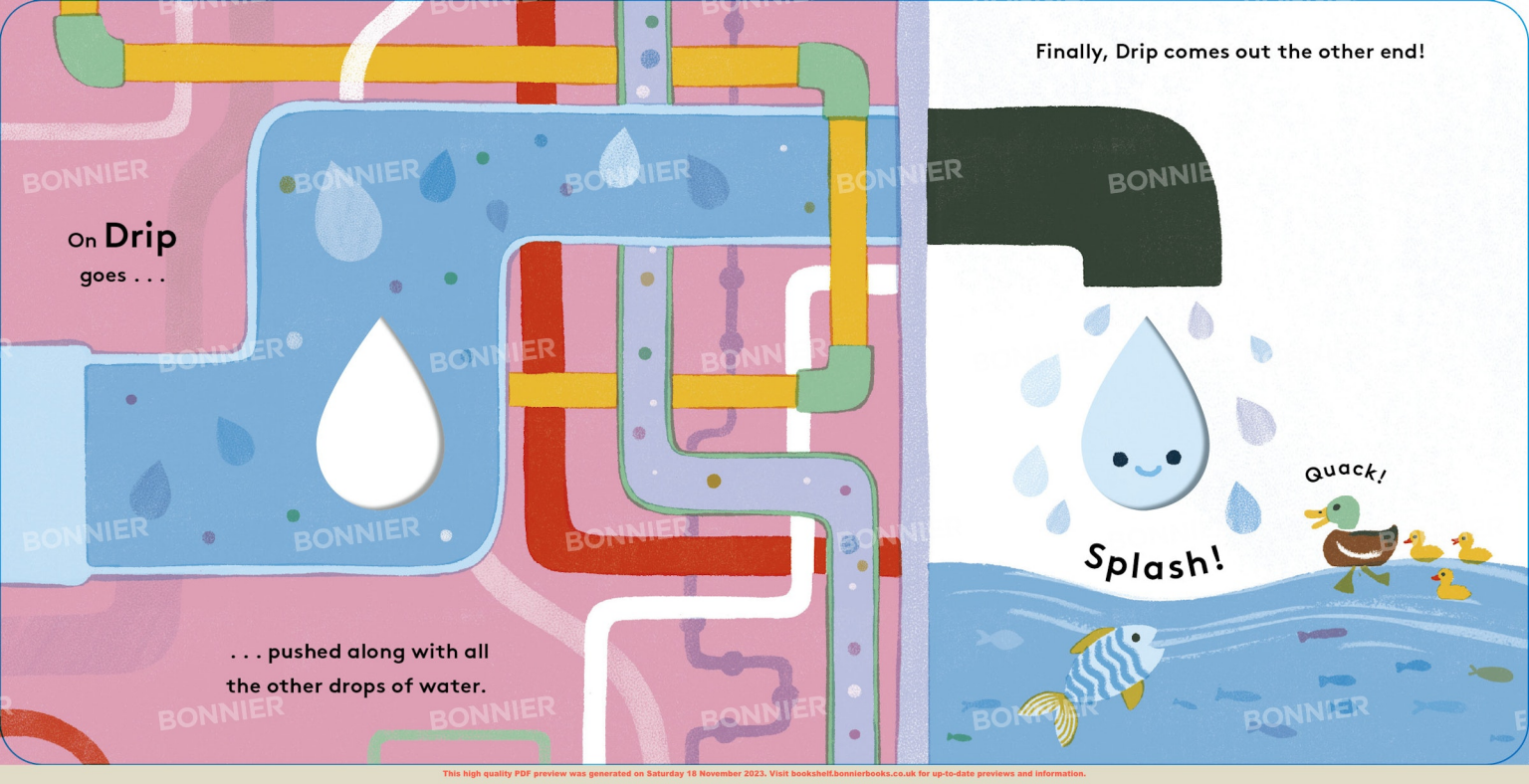


All of a sudden,

TO THE SEA



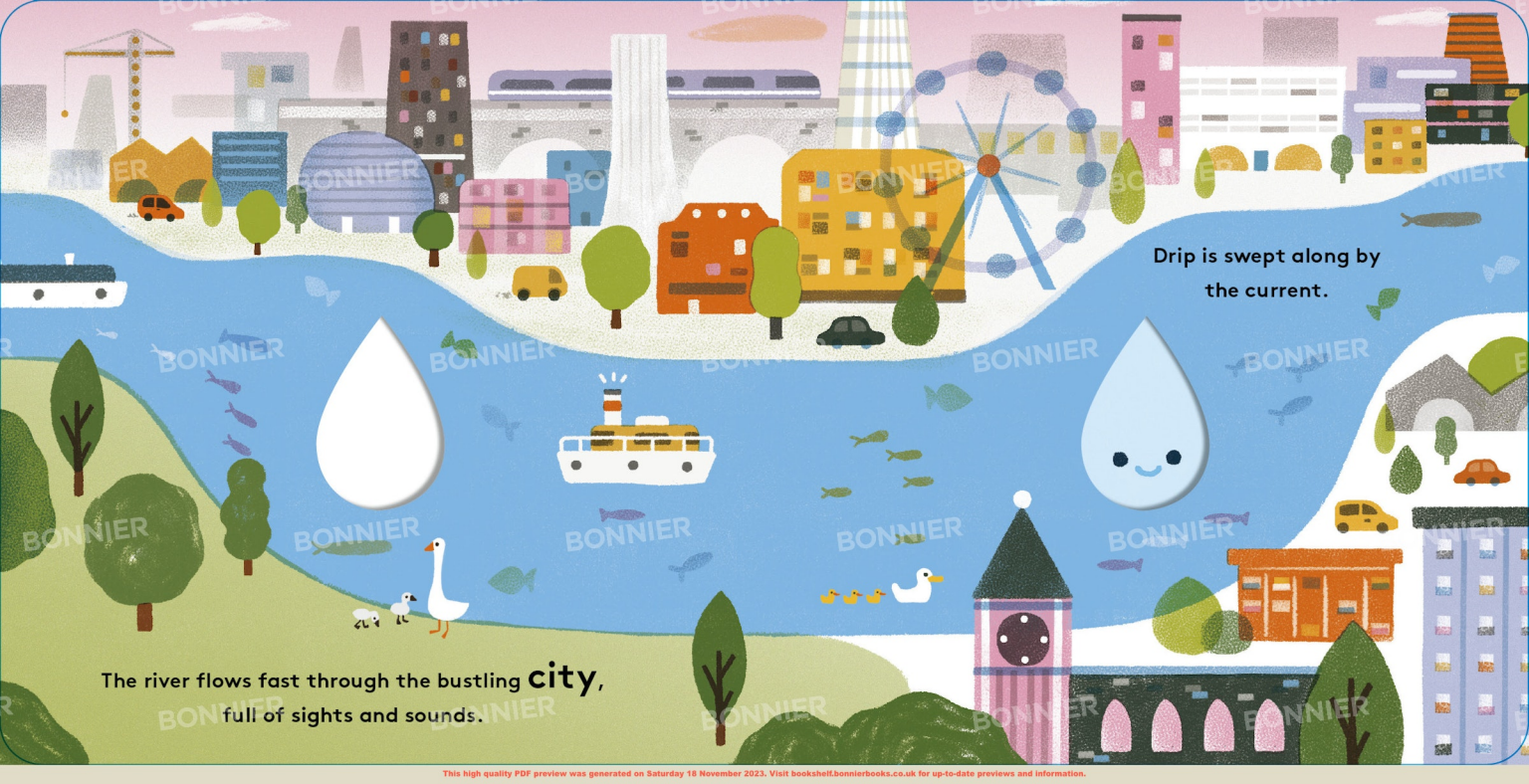
Finally, Drip comes out the other end!

Quack!

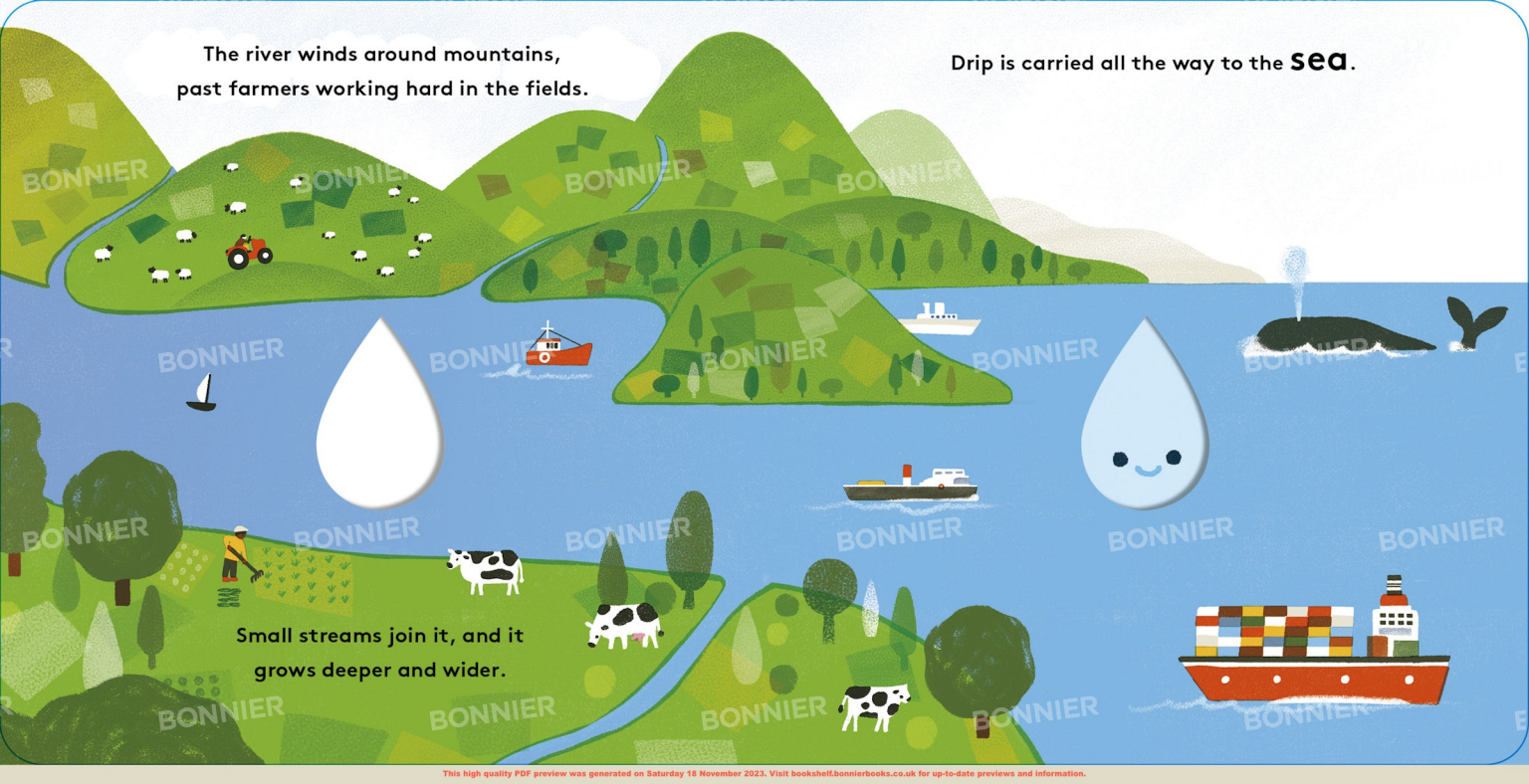


The river flows fast through the bustling **city**,

Drip is carried all the way to the **sea**.



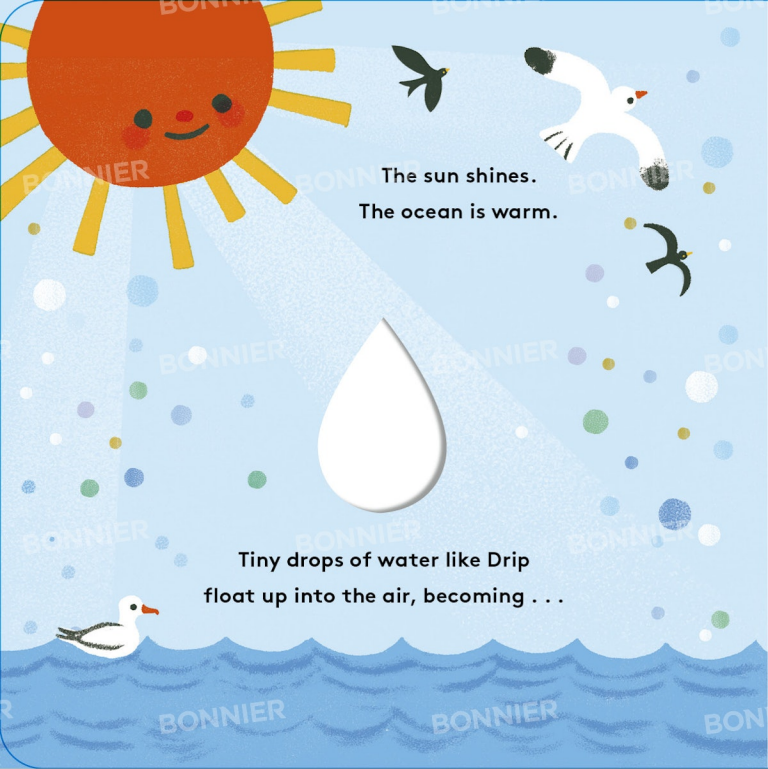
Small streams join it, and it

It is just beginning.



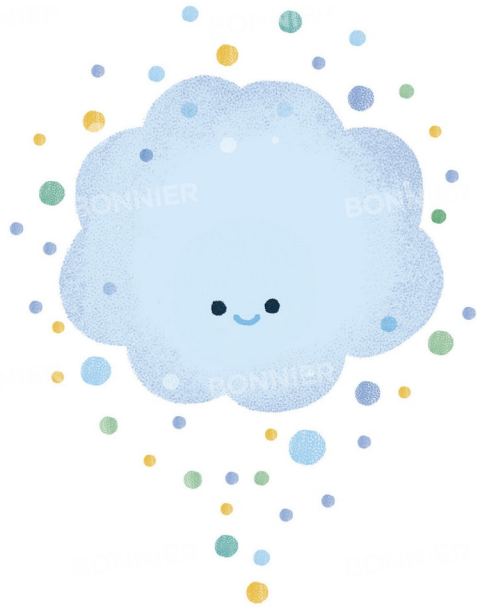
The sea is **big** and **blue**

float up into the air, becoming . . .

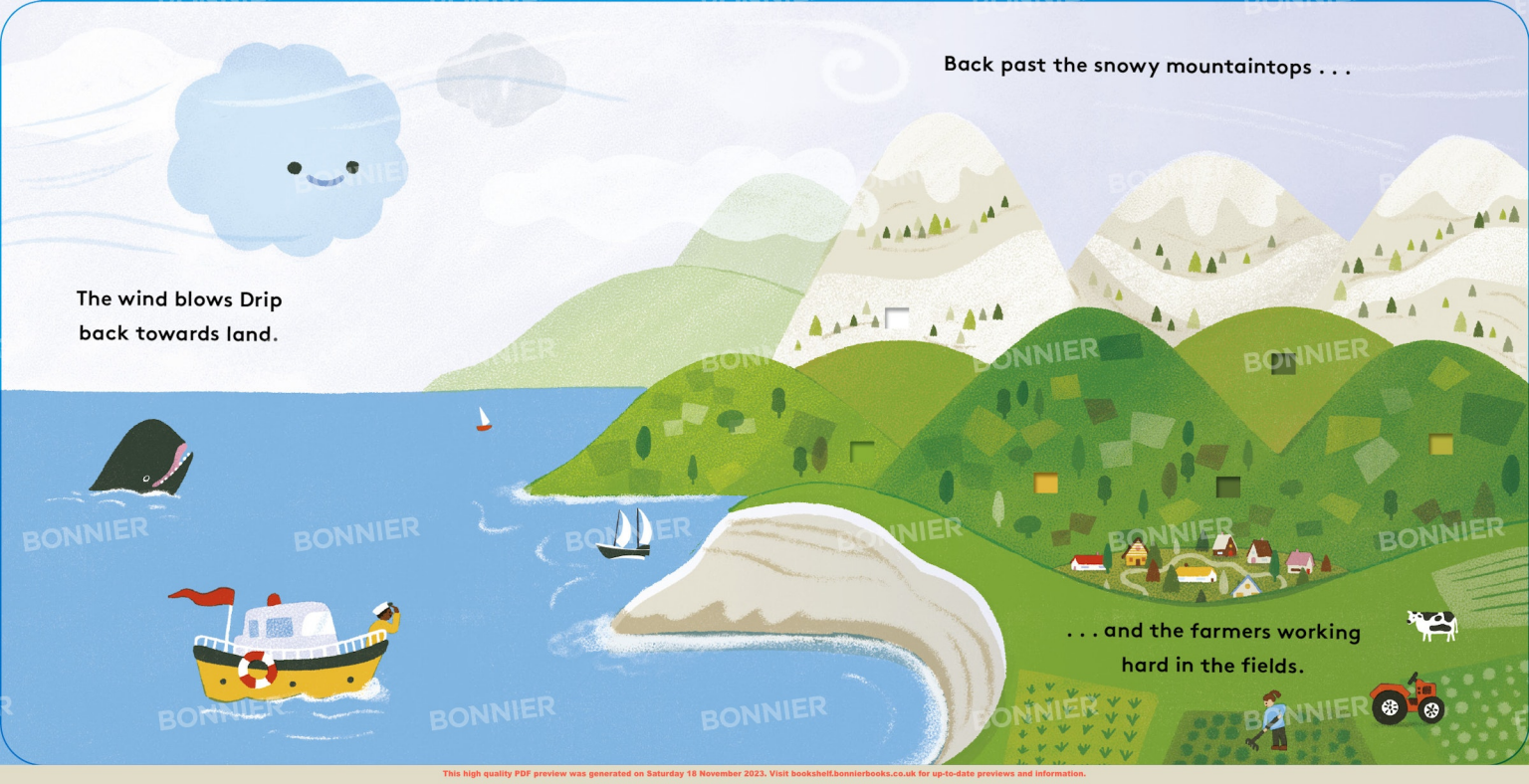
. . . a cloud!

of the trees and plants.





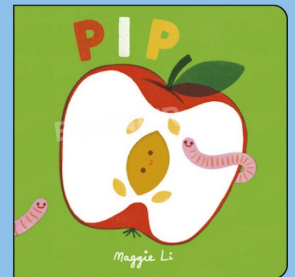
Here is **Drip**.
