HOW TO USE THIS BOOK

1. Ask an adult to cut along the dotted line on the cover.
2. Lay the back cover on a flat surface, unfold the flaps, and press out the marked pieces.
3. Carefully tear out the last page in the book – this is a double-sided background card.
4. Hold the flaps of the back cover upright and slide the background card into the slots at the back.
5. To create the characters, press out all the pieces inside. Slot each one into a stand.
6. To create the 3D car, follow the instructions inside. An adult could help you with the careful folding.
7. There are story cards at the back of the book. Remove these to play through their adventures with the Prehistoric Props.
8. Mix and match props, characters, and backgrounds to act out endless stories of your own, and collect the other books in the series to keep the fun going!

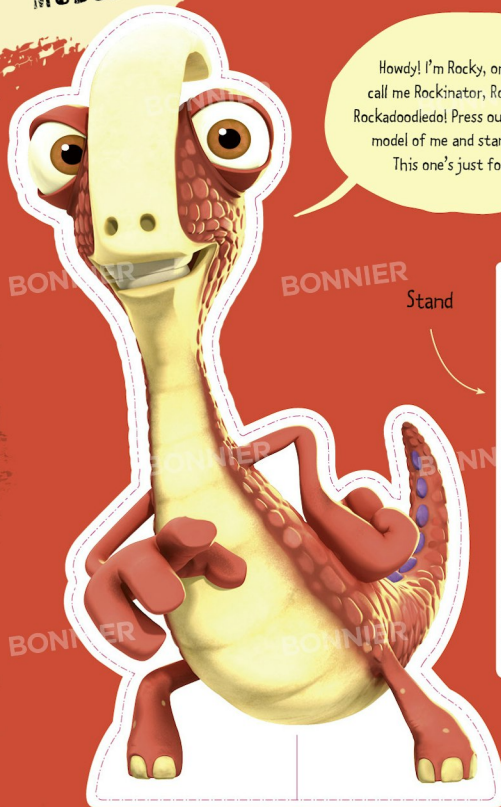


MEET ROCKY!

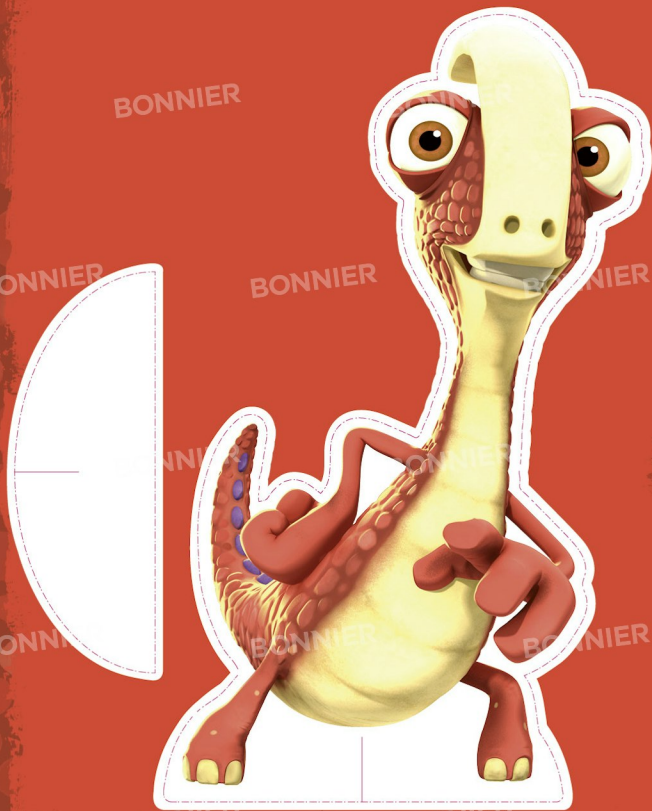
SPECIES: Parasaurolophus

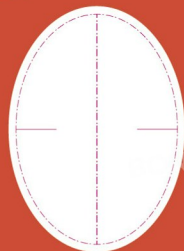

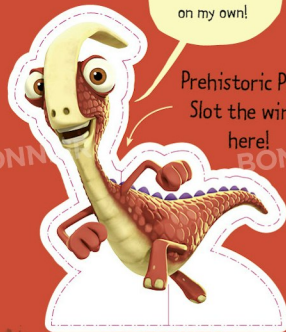

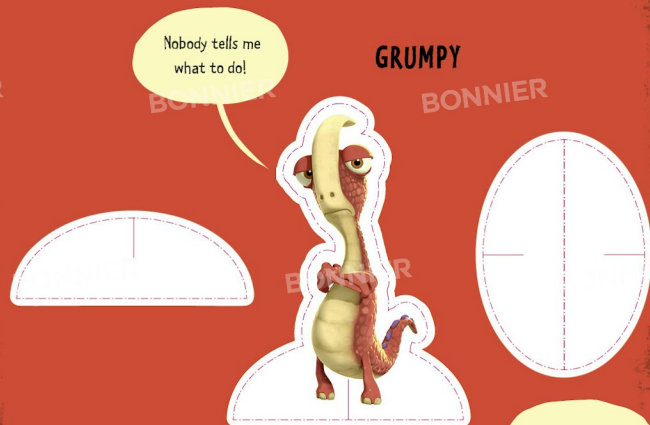

1. Carefully press out the car pieces.

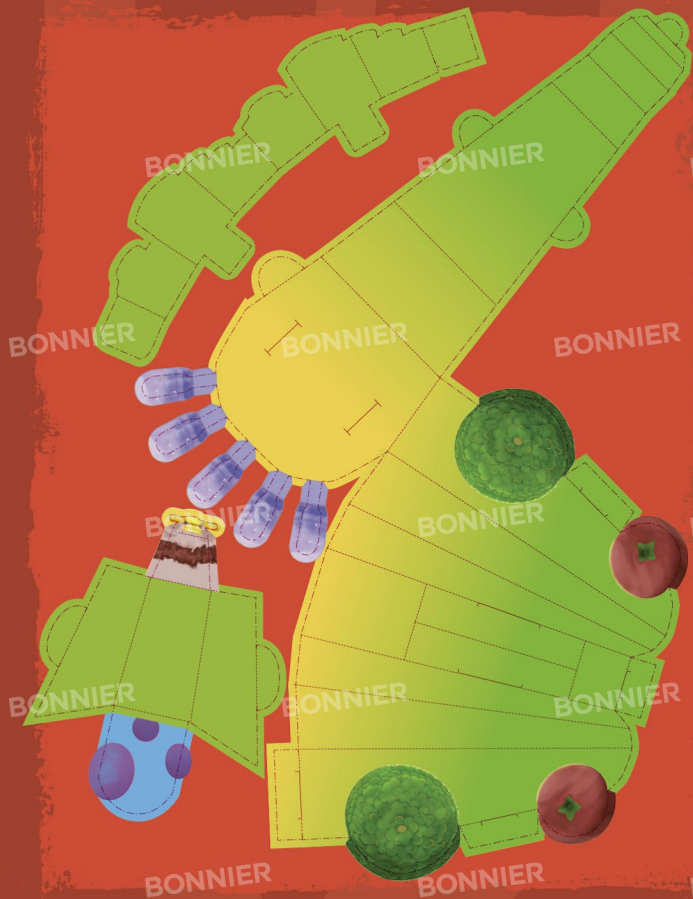


2. Face down, gently crease up the marked lines. The labels will be hidden inside at the end.

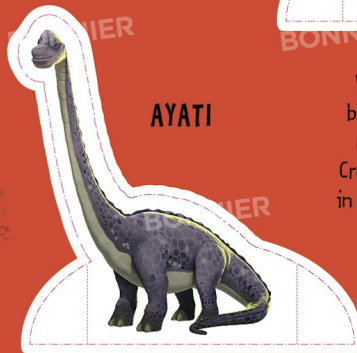

ARCHIE

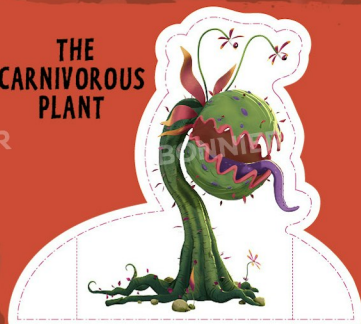


Whatever we're playing, I'm in!

the water's hungry...

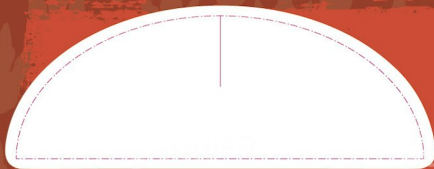
GIGANTOSAURUS

STORY CARD

ROCK OUT

Rocky's trying to climb Mount Oblivion faster than any dino before, but the mountain starts to rumble and a falling rock hurts his foot – it's an earthquake from the jungle!

Every other dino runs away, but Rocky limps toward the jungle to investigate, refusing any help from his friends. Soon, he finds out that the earthquake is actually Giganto stomping around. He's hurt his foot too!

Giganto won't let anyone near, even though he's shaking everything in Cretacia.

STORY CARD

THE LOST EGG

Rocky finds a strange egg in a nest without a parent. It's a bit boring, and he wants to play – maybe it's a fun new ball? But Mazu makes sure he takes care of it instead.

They search for the egg's parents everywhere, but Archie doesn't know, Termy only wants to eat it, and it's definitely not from the Carnivorous Plant!

Rocky starts racing around, impatient to get rid of the egg, but he trips over and nearly breaks it on the ground!

STORY CARD

THE BIGGEST HERO

When a treetop game goes wrong and Bill slips off a branch, Rocky swings down and saves him! And when a rolling boulder threatens the den, Rocky... wastes time boasting!

Luckily, Tiny smashes it out of the way, and Mazu gives her a pair of flying wings as a reward, but now Rocky's jealous.

Tiny helps Patchy break a coconut, helps Marshall reach food: everyone thinks she's the bravest! Frustrated, Rocky steals the flying wings to prove he's even braver.

STORY CARD

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Rocky wants to stomp around like Giganto, but his friends say it's too hot to play. He sail down the cool river instead, and find Ayati stuck in the terrible heat, unable to fit in the river and cool off.

Rocky puts himself in charge: he tries splashing her, and bending a tree for shade, but nothing works. Mazu plays relaxing music – but Rocky wants loud drumming!

After all, Giganto doesn't do what anyone says, so why should he?

Oddly, it just rolls back to him, and Rocky starts to like it. When Ayati tries to sit on top of it to keep it warm, Rocky even throws himself in the way to rescue it.

Finally, Giganto storms along, he sniffs and prods it, then gently builds a nest and takes a nap beside it. If a big strong dino like Giganto can be so gentle and caring, Rocky realises that he should be too.

Finally, the egg hatches: it's a little red parasauropodus, just like Rocky! He accepts that it's cool to be kind, and takes the egg home to his herd.

Mazu finds a healing flower to help Giganto, but they can't get close to his foot. Rocky remembers how his mother helps him feel better, and uses his crest to make a calm mooring noise. At last, Giganto starts to relax.

Rocky tries to climb a tree to get closer. His sore foot stops him, but now he's seen that even the toughest dinos need help sometimes, he lets his friends lift him up.

Rocky comforts Giganto while Mazu heals the big dino's foot - and a grateful Gigantosaurus hurls Rocky right to the top of Mount Oblivion, faster than any dino before!

Annoyed that his friends won't do what he says, Rocky runs off on his own to bring ice back from the Frozen Lands, but he can't move fast enough on his own to stop it melting.

That's when he sees Giganto patiently trotting along behind a group of tiny dragonflies, following them to a refreshing waterfall.

Rocky climbs up to divert the waterfall into the river, but gets stuck. Accepting that even Giganto needs his friends, he asks Bill, Tiny and Mazu to help him down.

Together, they fan Ayati through the hot day, and fall asleep cool together.

But his first flight goes all wrong and he crashes into hungry Temy's lake! Thankfully, Tiny's nearby to fish him out just in time.

The next day, there's a rumble on the savannah. Giganto's chasing birds, and he's storming towards their den!

Rocky runs out to lead Giganto away while his friends watch from the den roof, but he only makes Giganto bump right into it, and Tiny gets stuck on the big dino's head.

Rocky flies up to rescue her, and they soar away to safety, happy that they're both heroes after all.
