


One summer the Robinsons decided to go on a sailing holiday.

Feeling lucky to be alive, they began – with the help of a few good books – to make themselves at home.












A month went by without any sign of rescue. But with a roof over their heads, food to eat and plenty of books to read, the Robinsons lived happily on the island.








The pirates were **VERY ANGRY**. And their Captain, Betsy Bloodbucket, was the angriest of them all.
