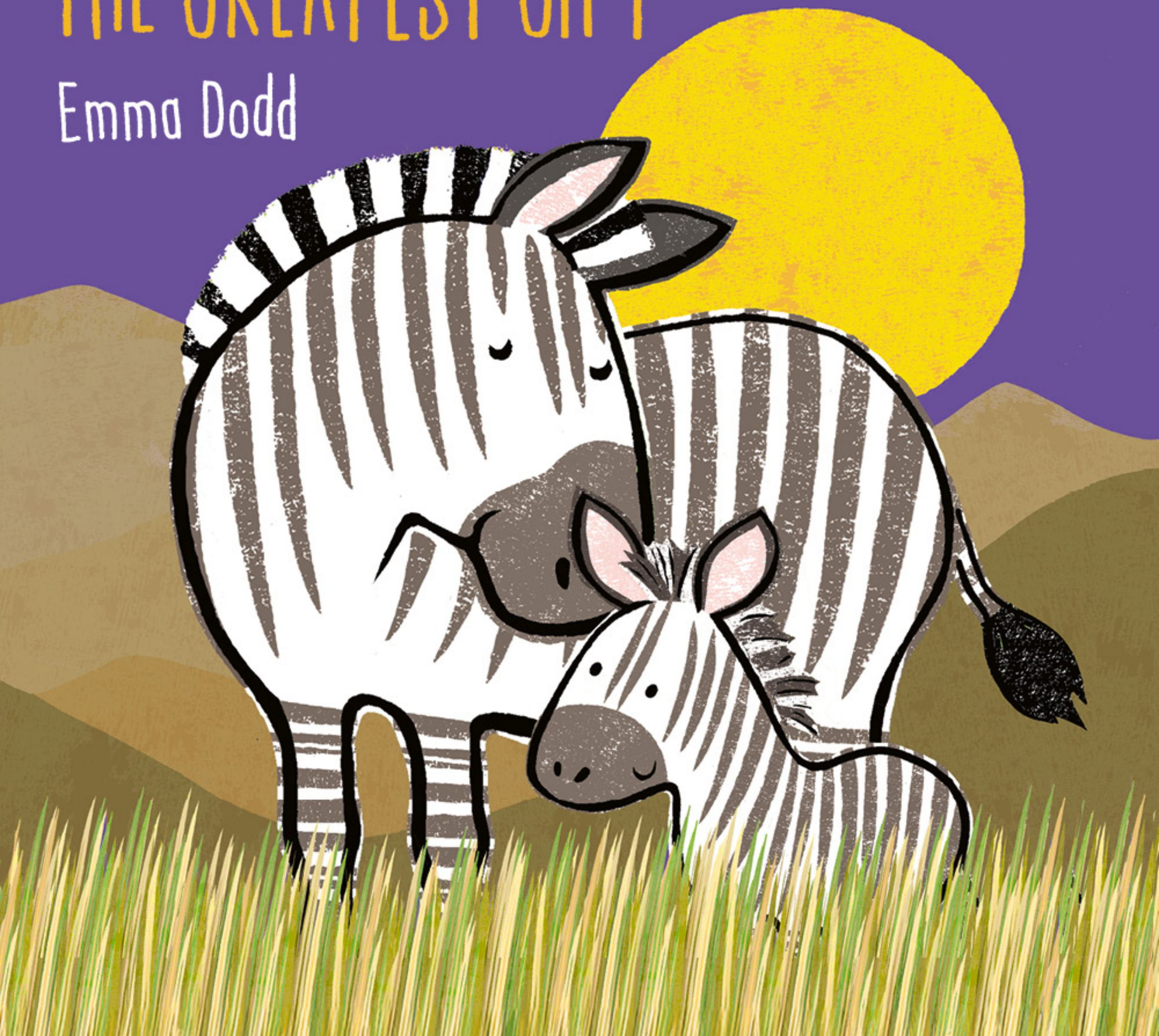


# THE GREATEST GIFT

if I only could.

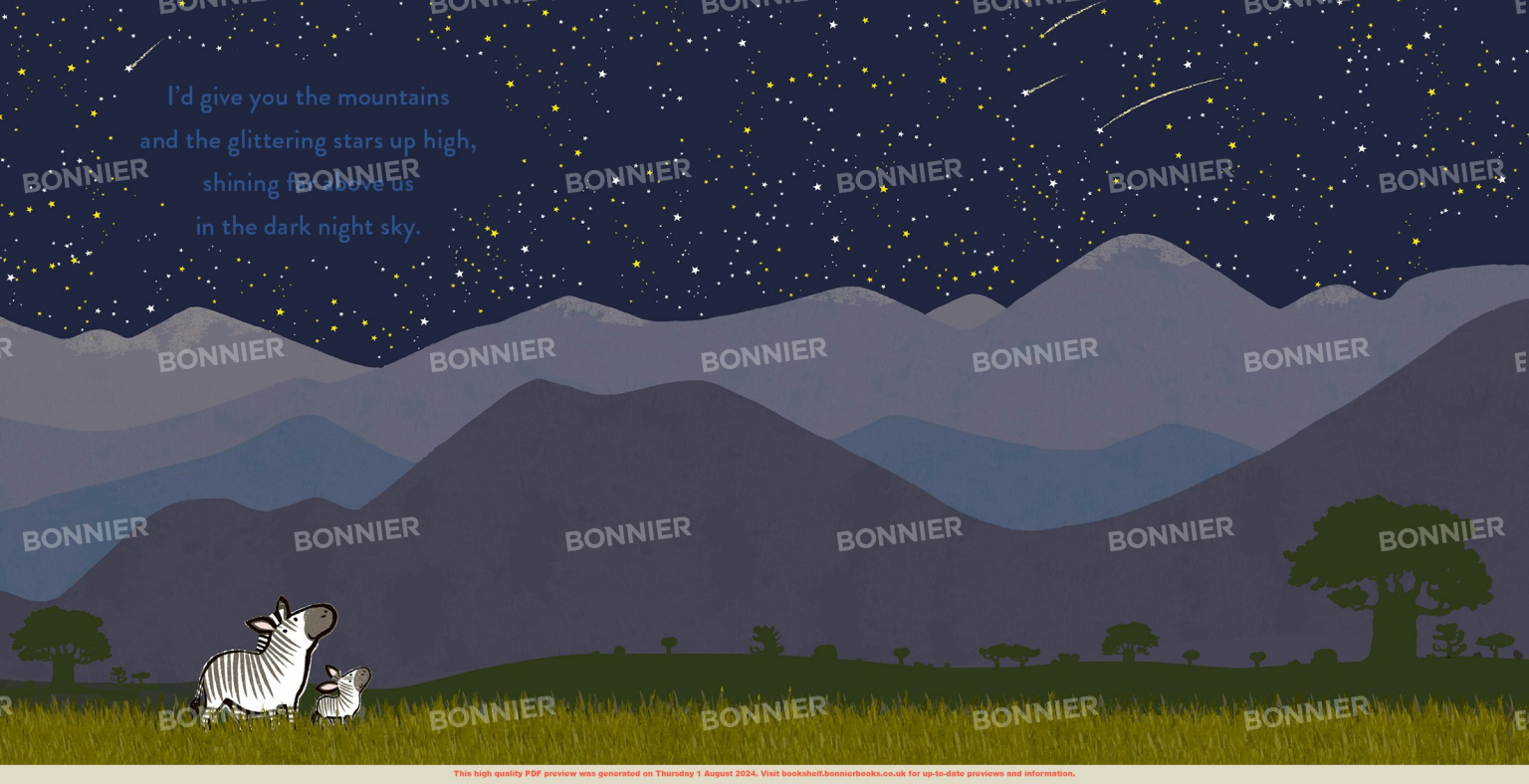
I'd give you the sun, the moon
