★ **TIP:** If your little one is anxious about nursery, try to make the journey together full of fun. Play a game, look for objects or do a silly walk!

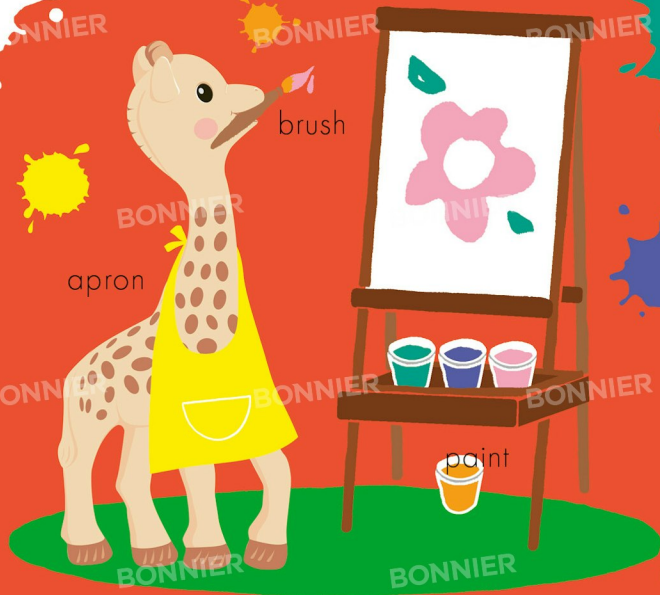
Sophie hangs her bag on a special hook with her name on it.

Look, Sophie. Today you will be doing painting. It's fun – and messy!

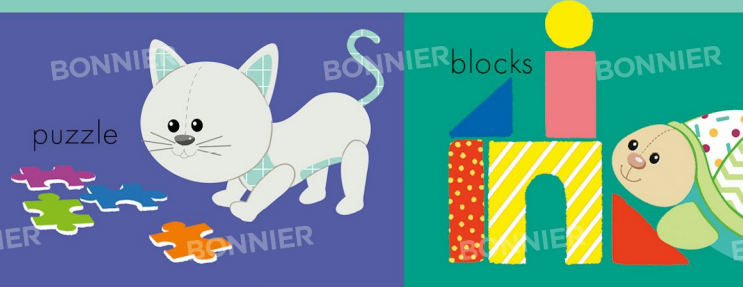
