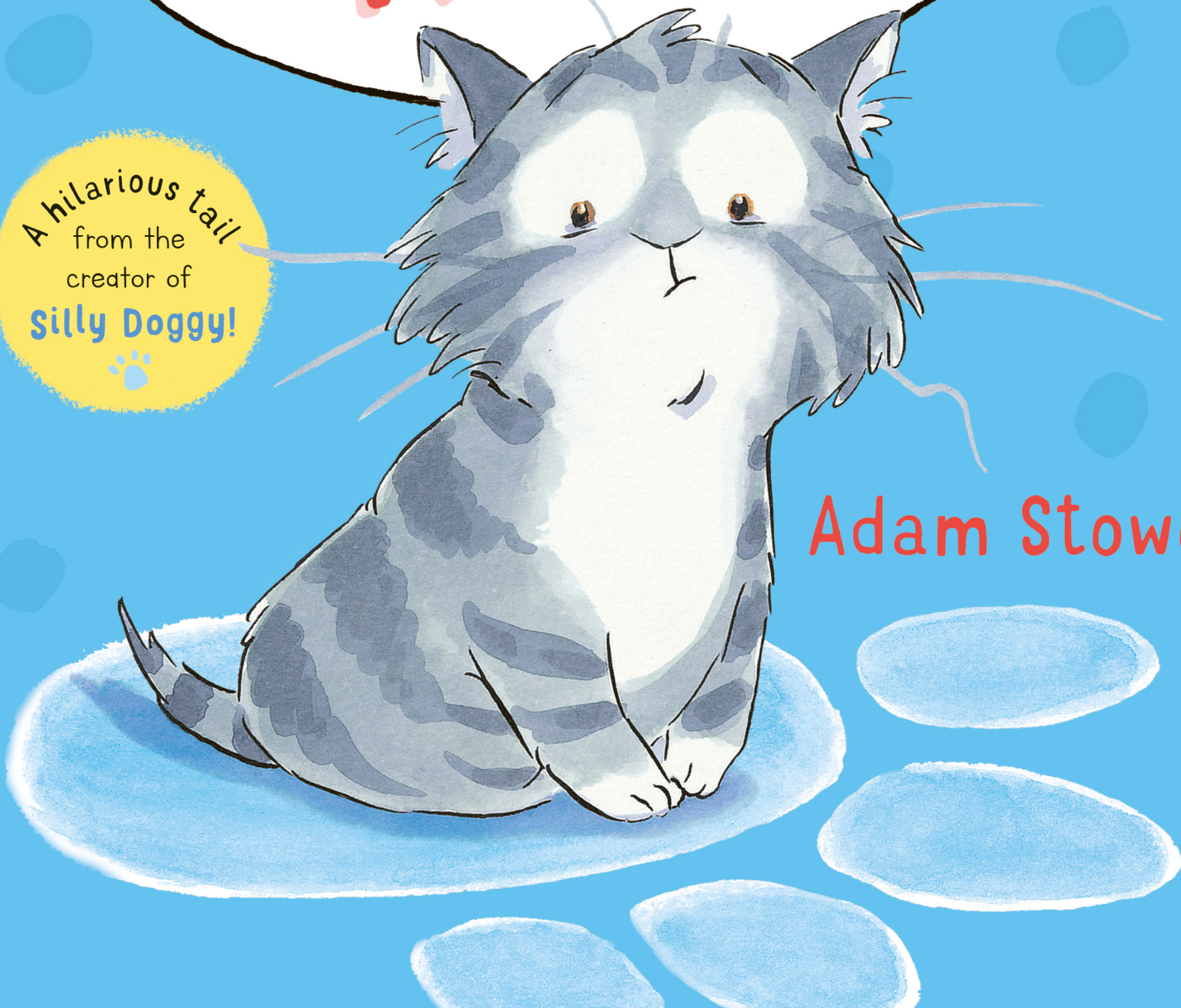

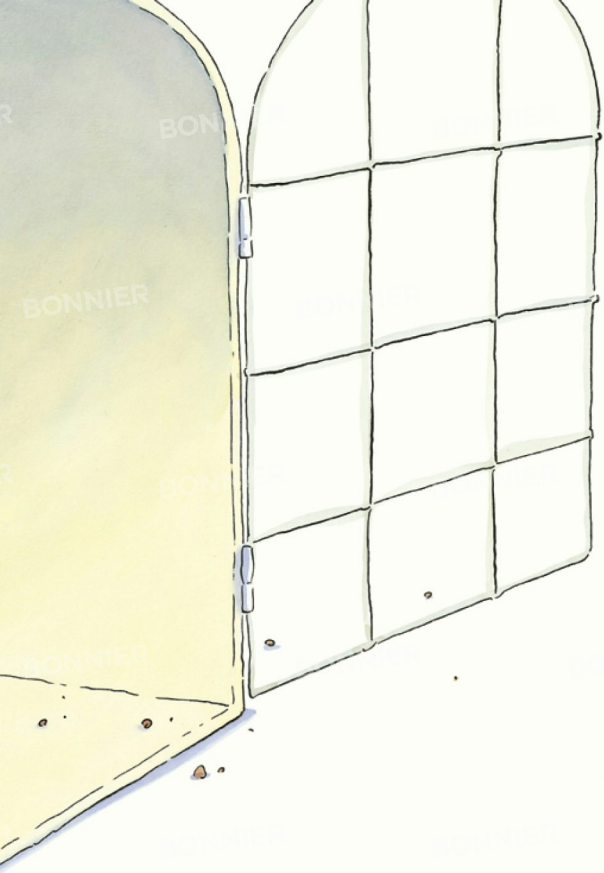

Kitty!



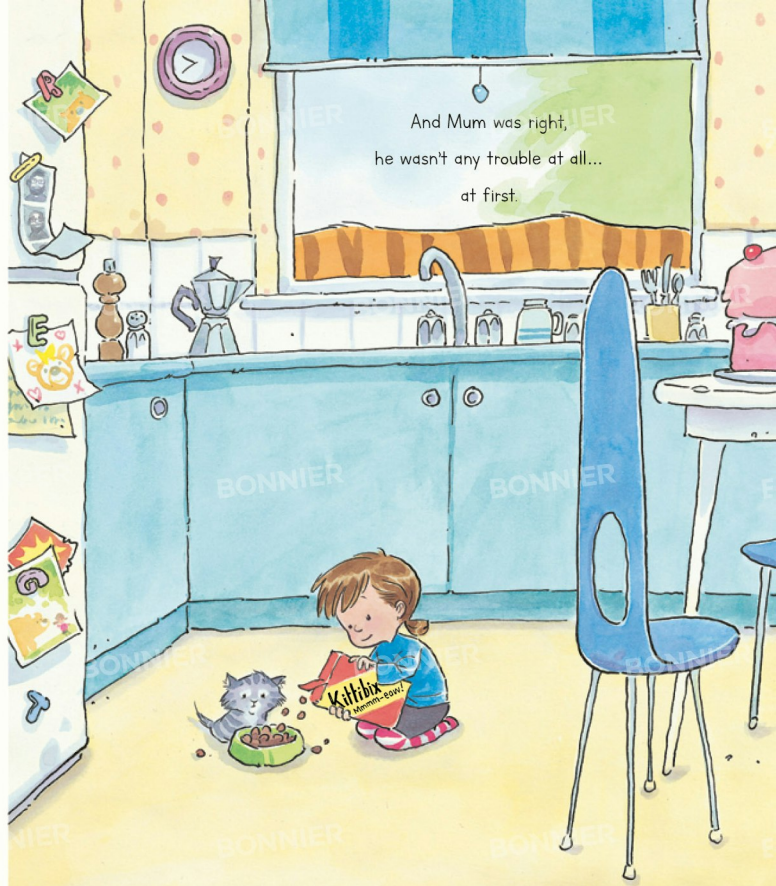


He was a bit scruffy...

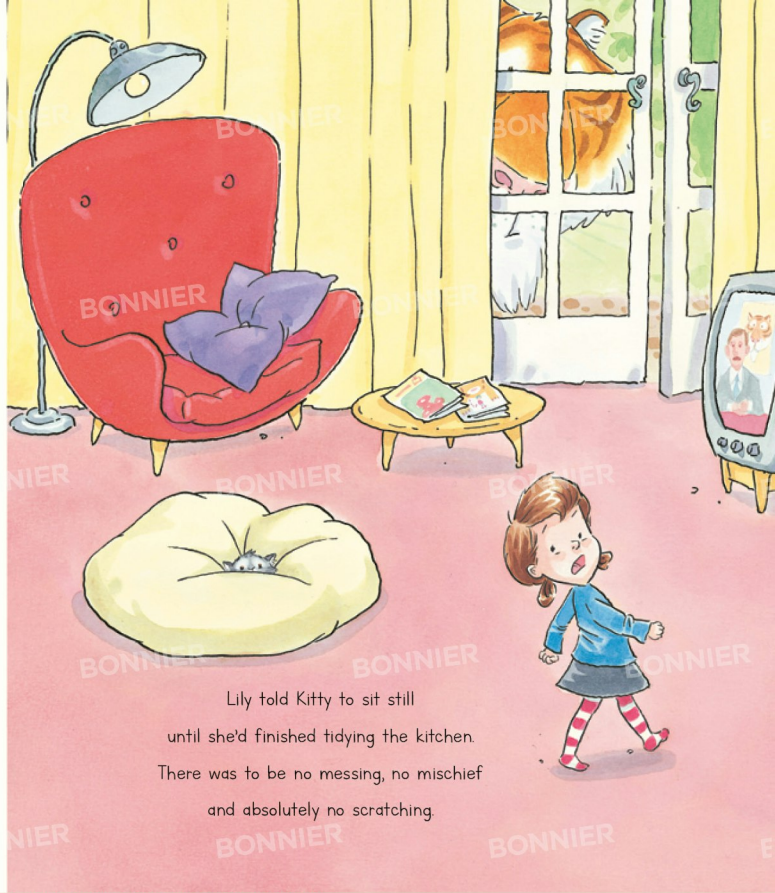


What a mess!

Kitty!

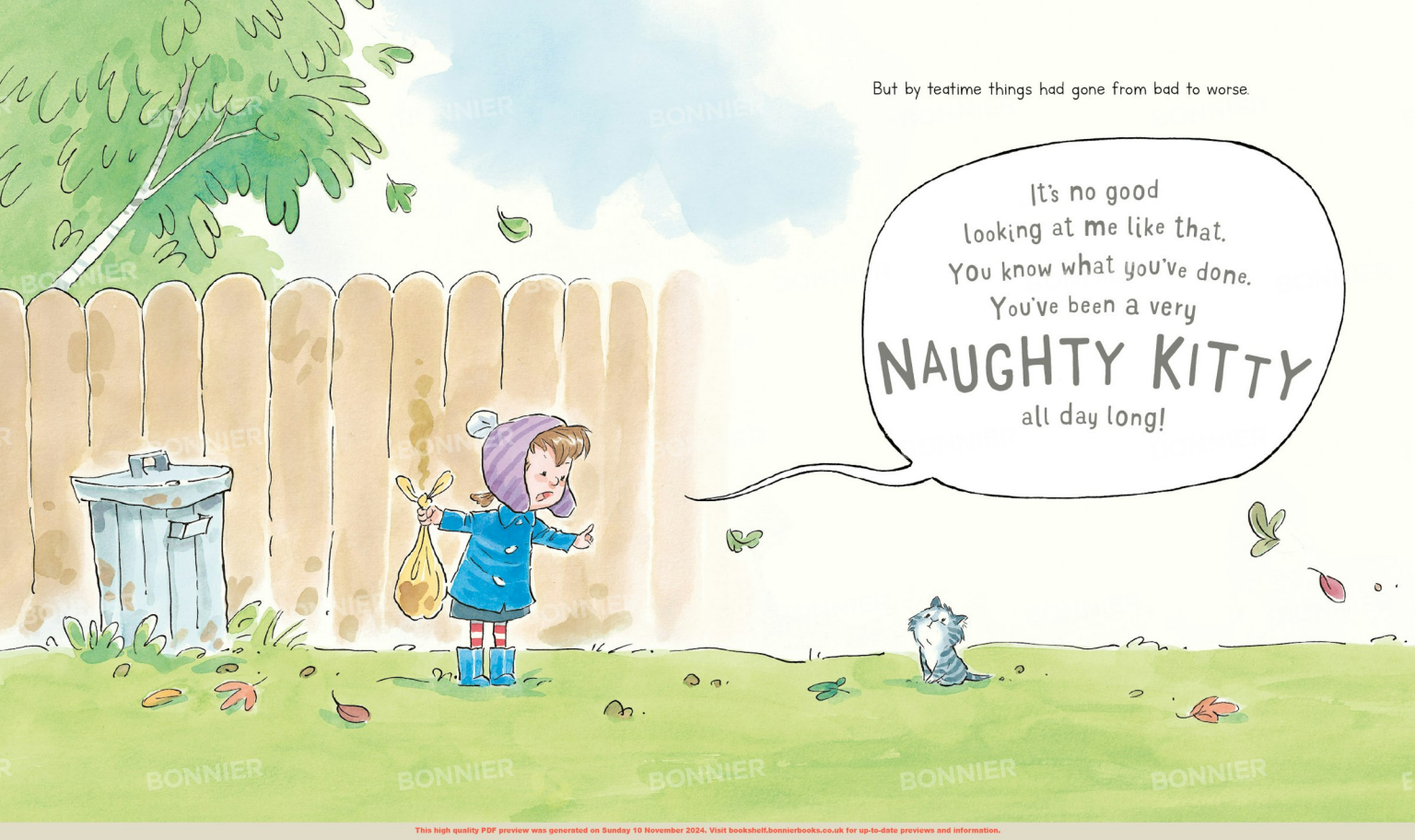
Lily was getting cross.

GRRRROOOWWWWWL!

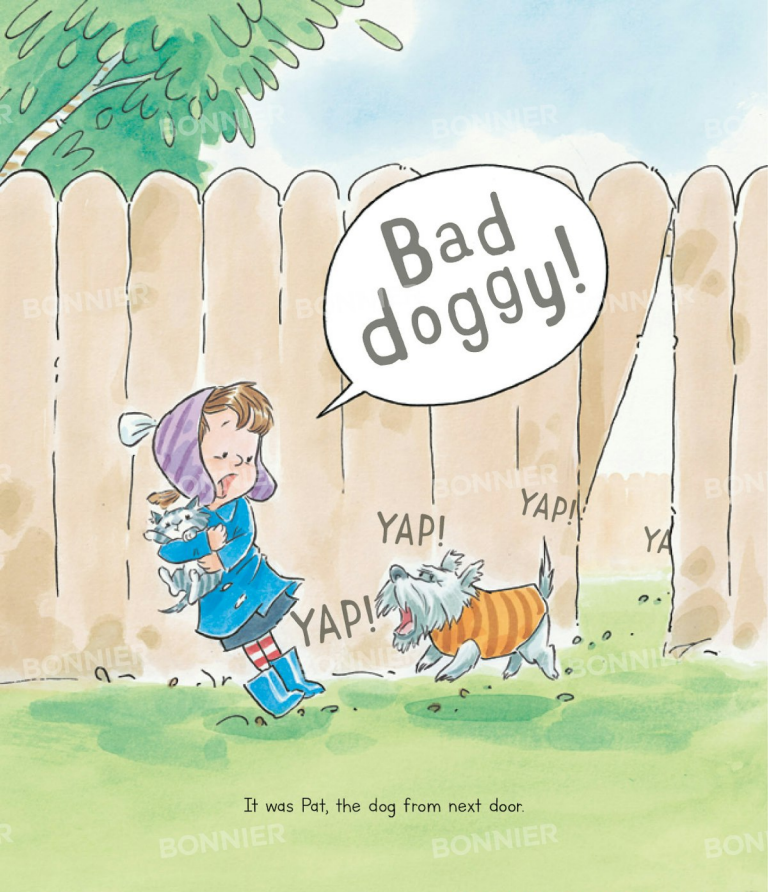


There was something in the garden.
