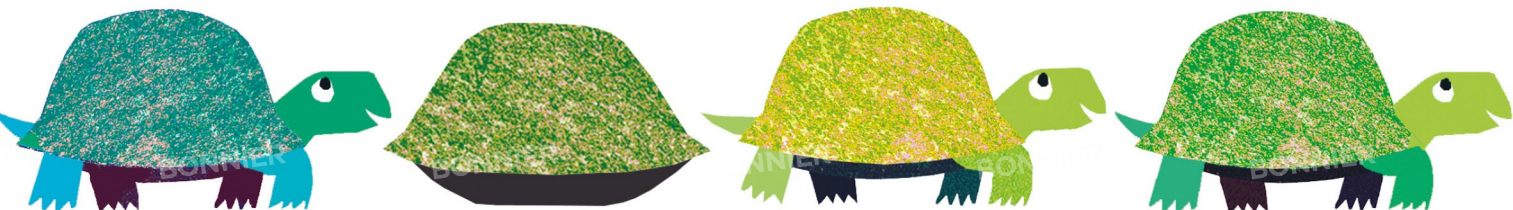

only one bump?**



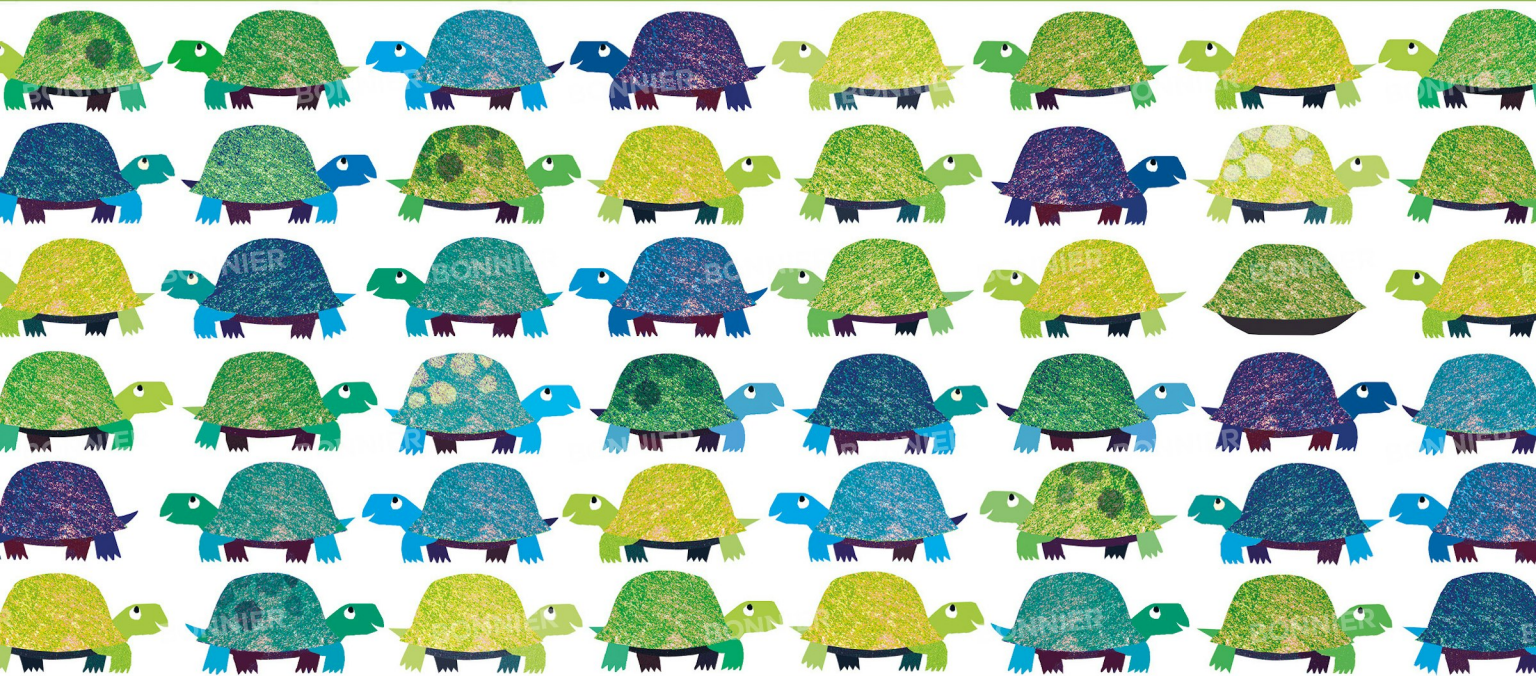
A pod of seals bark,

has lost its bamboo?



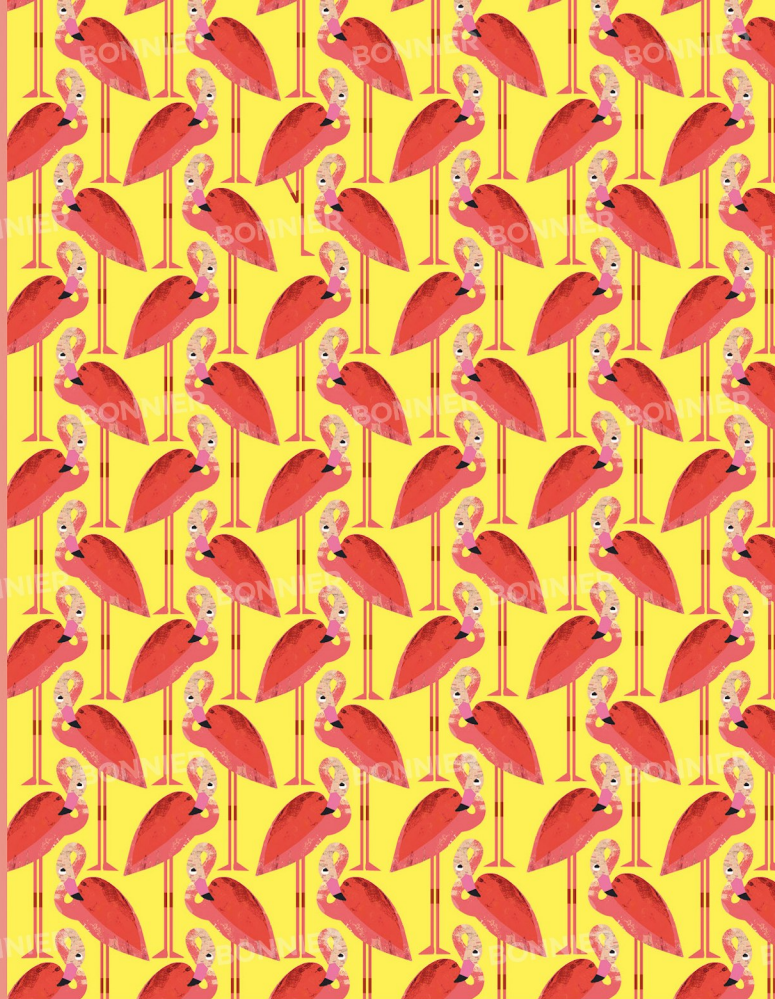


A crash full of rhinos

their leg in the air?



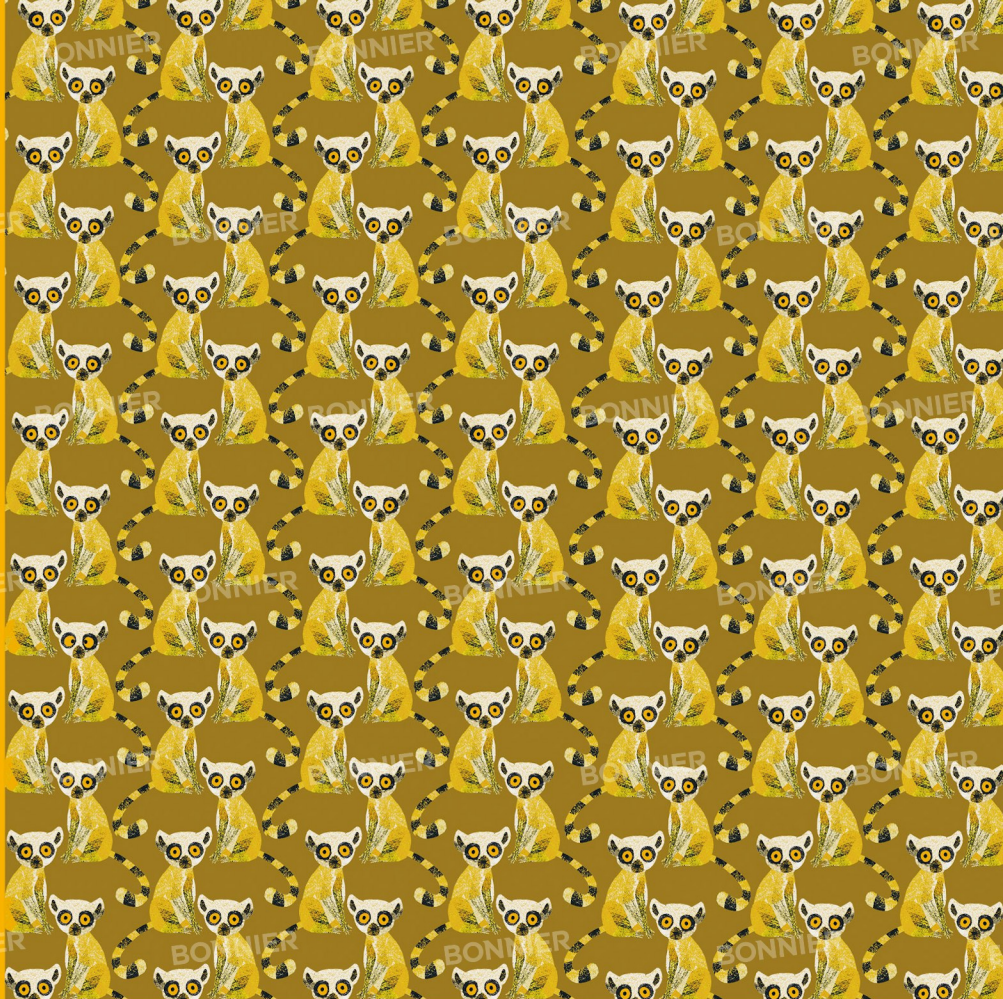
A dazzling shoal

can you spot where it hides?



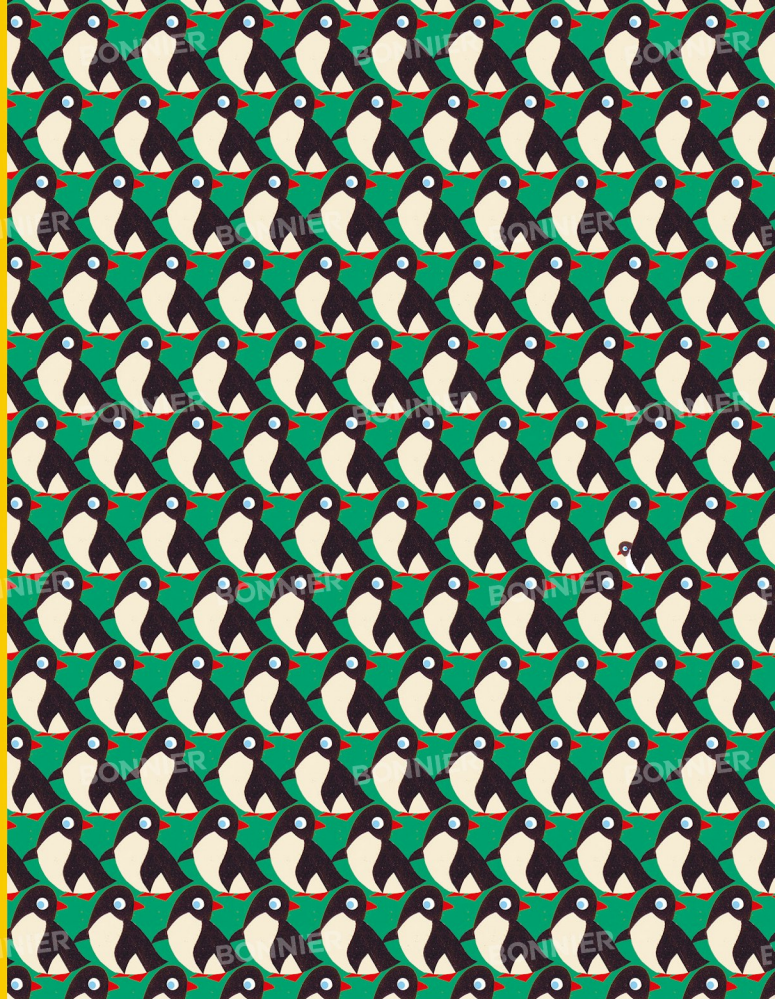
A lemur troop sit

as it looks at its nose?



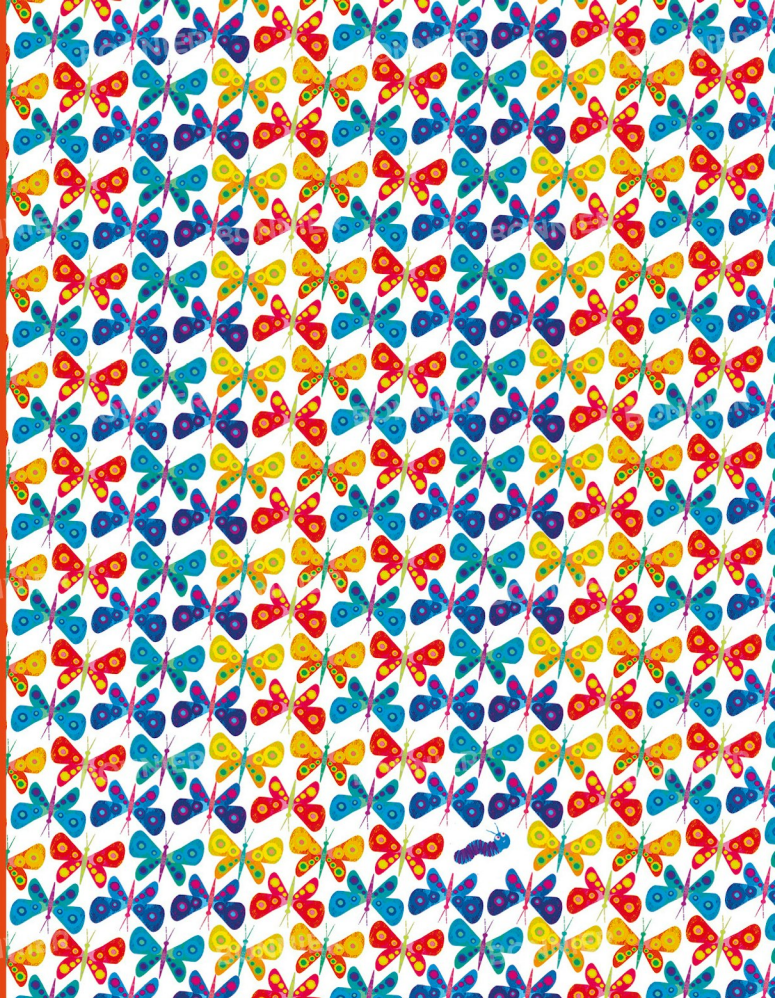
Elegant penguins
