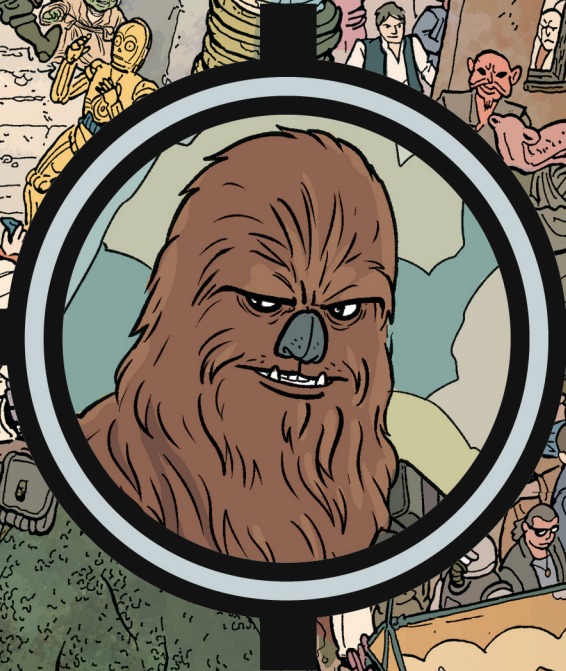
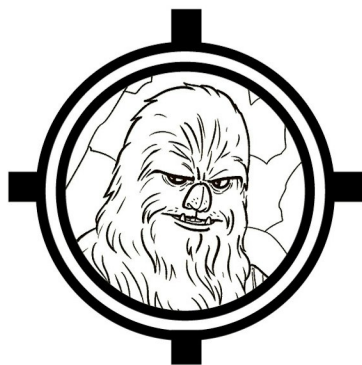

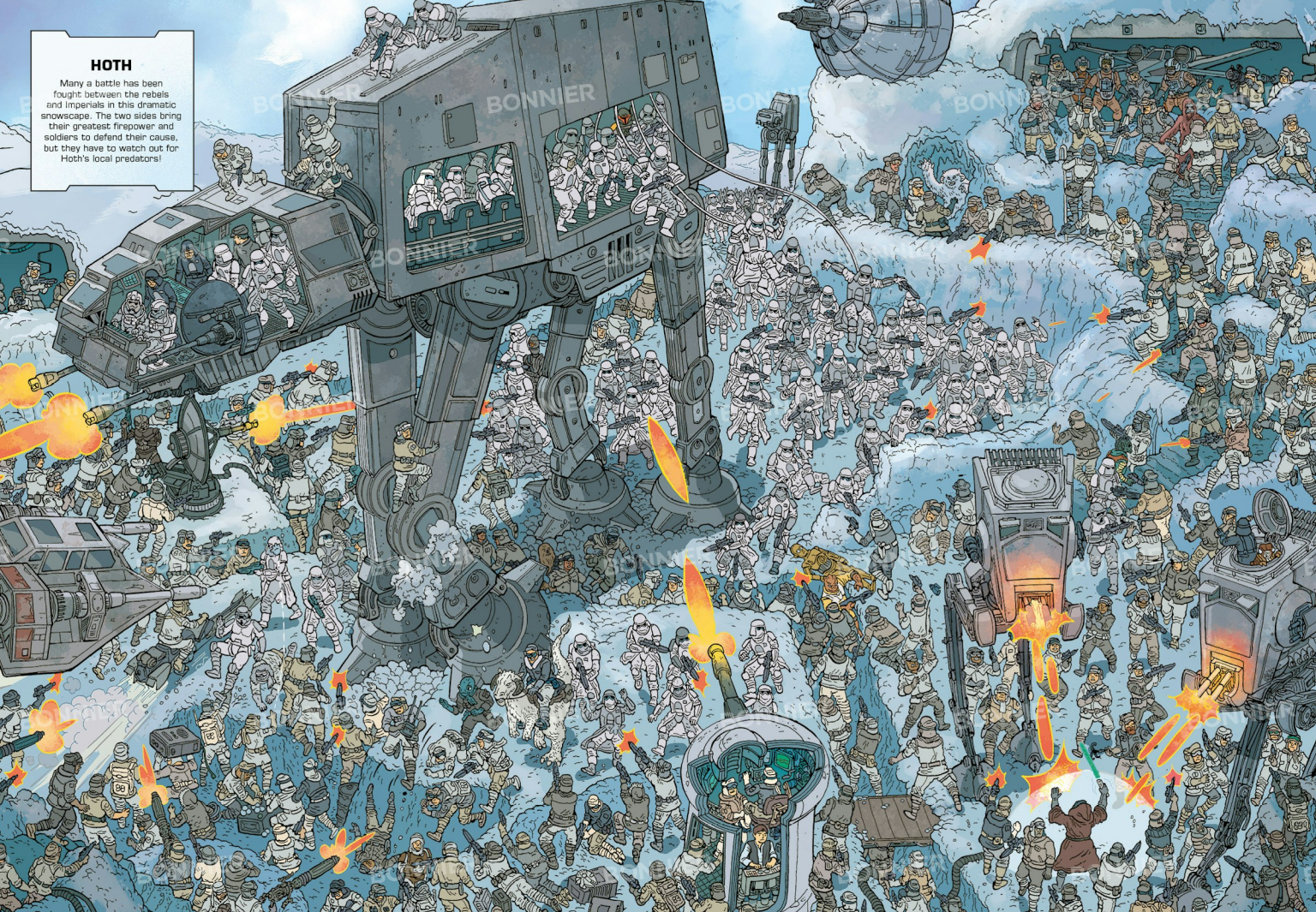
JAWA MARKET

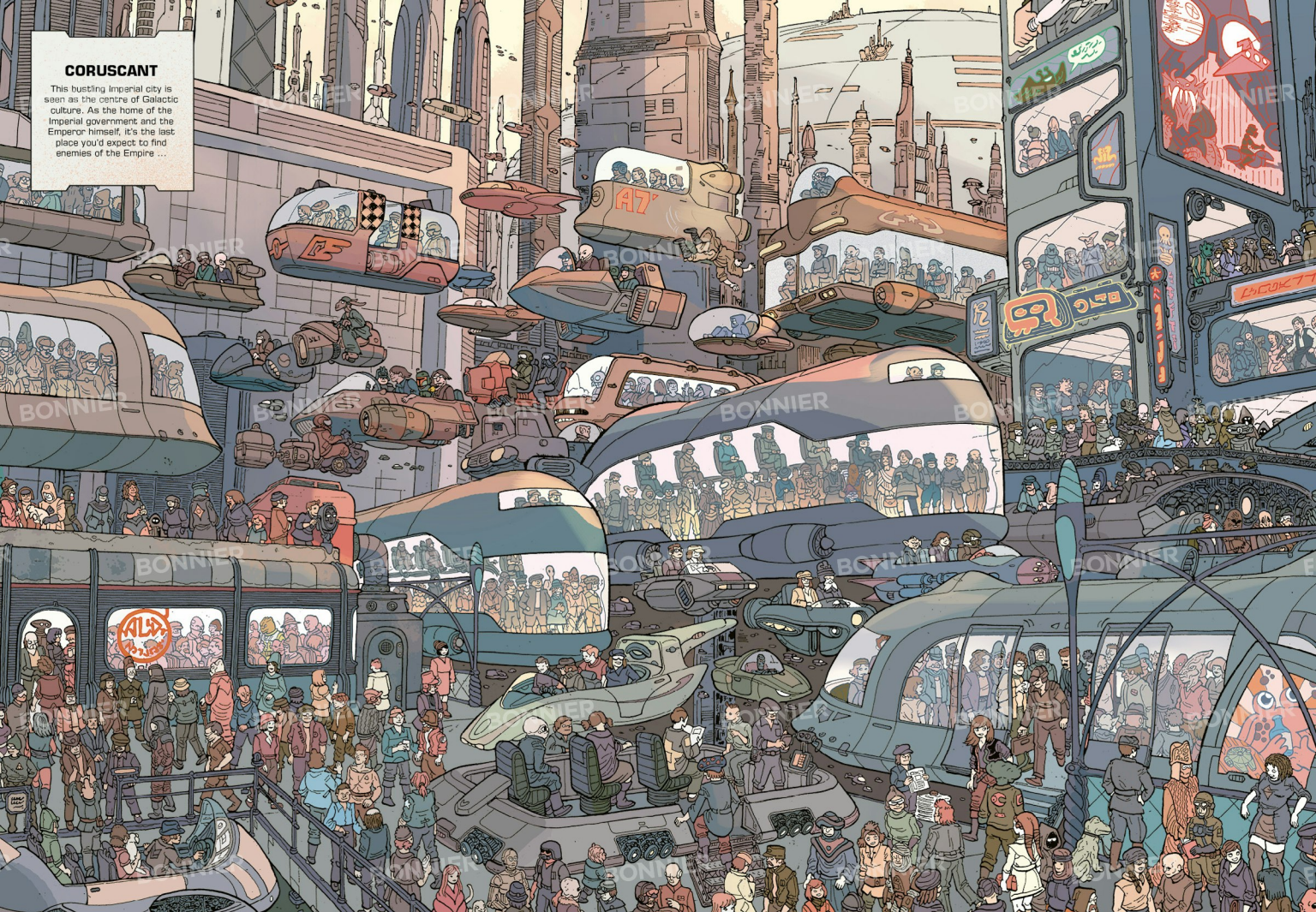

MOS EISLEY

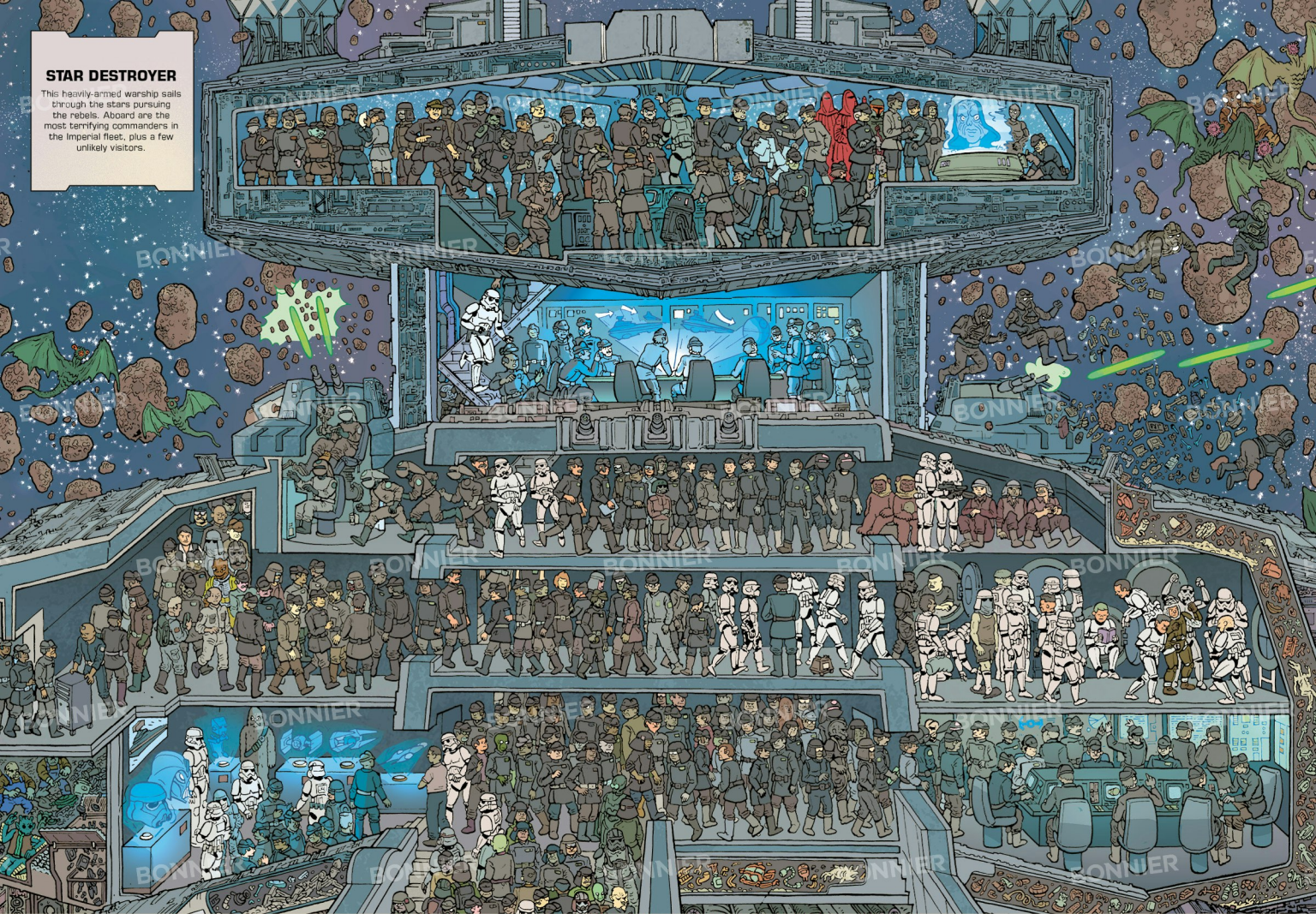
A busy day in the marketplace draws visitors from all over the universe. Described once as a "hive of scum and villainy",

Mos Eisley plays host to smugglers, black-market traders and all-round criminal activity – the perfect hiding place for rebels.



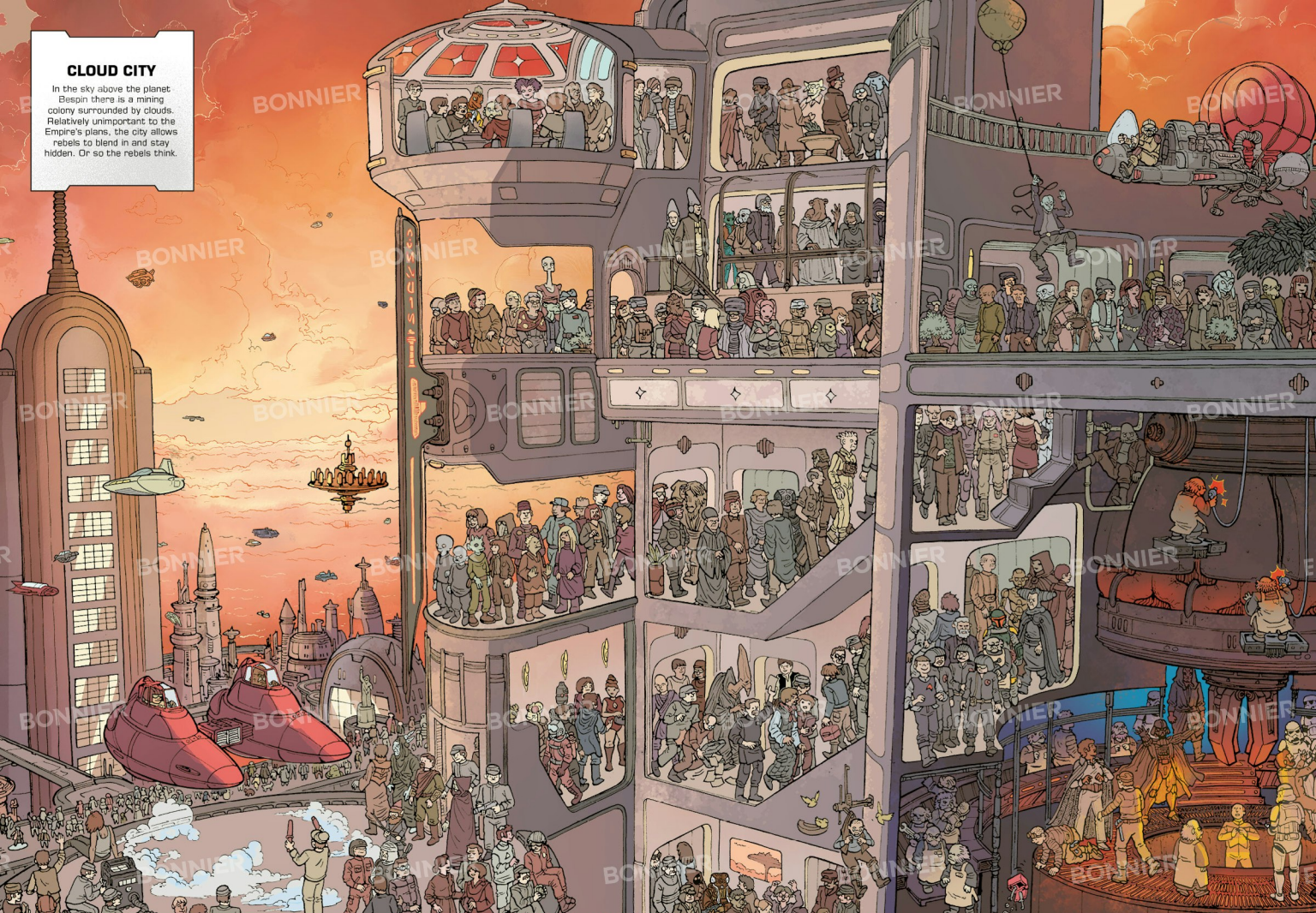
STAR DESTROYER

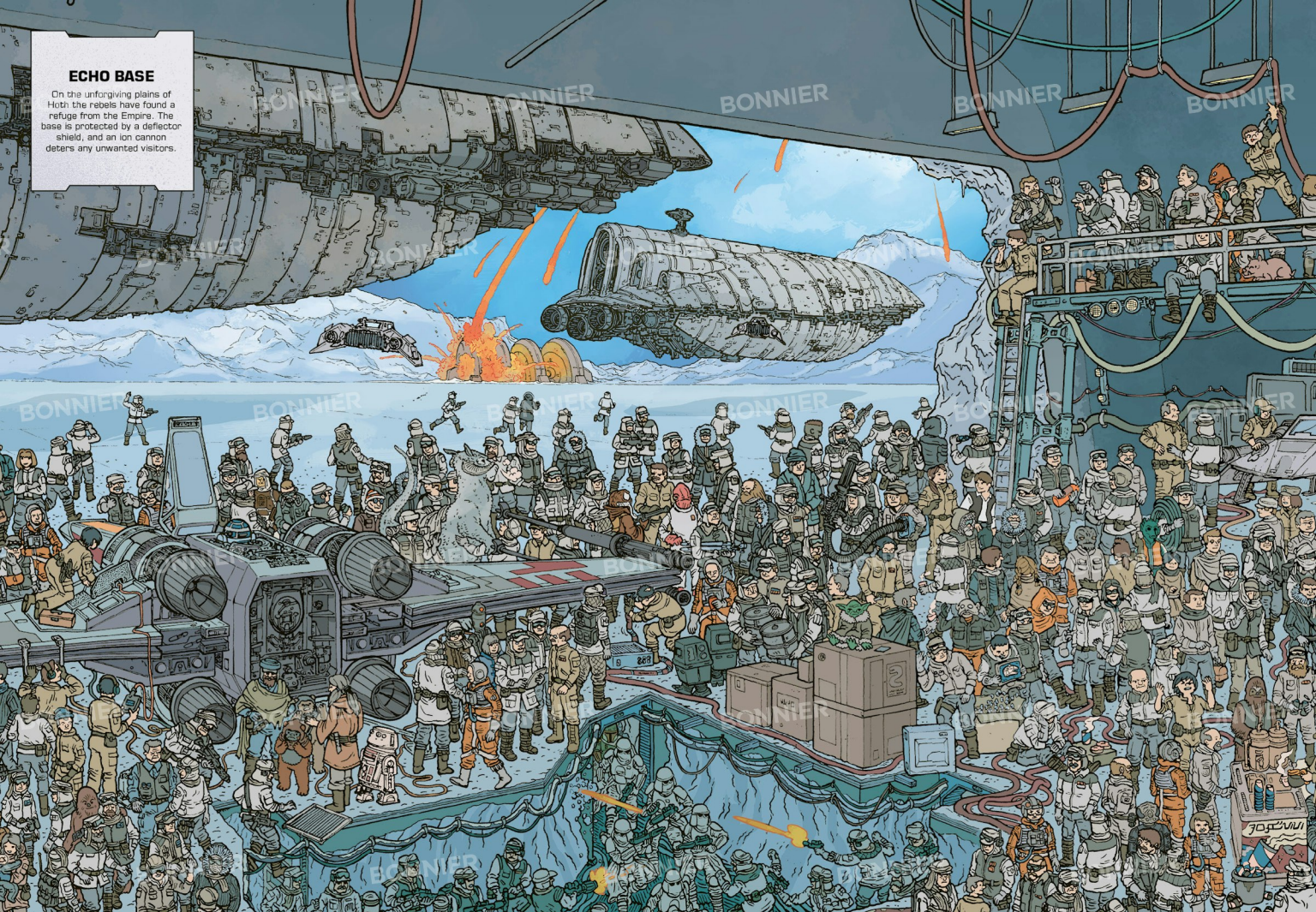
CLOUD CITY

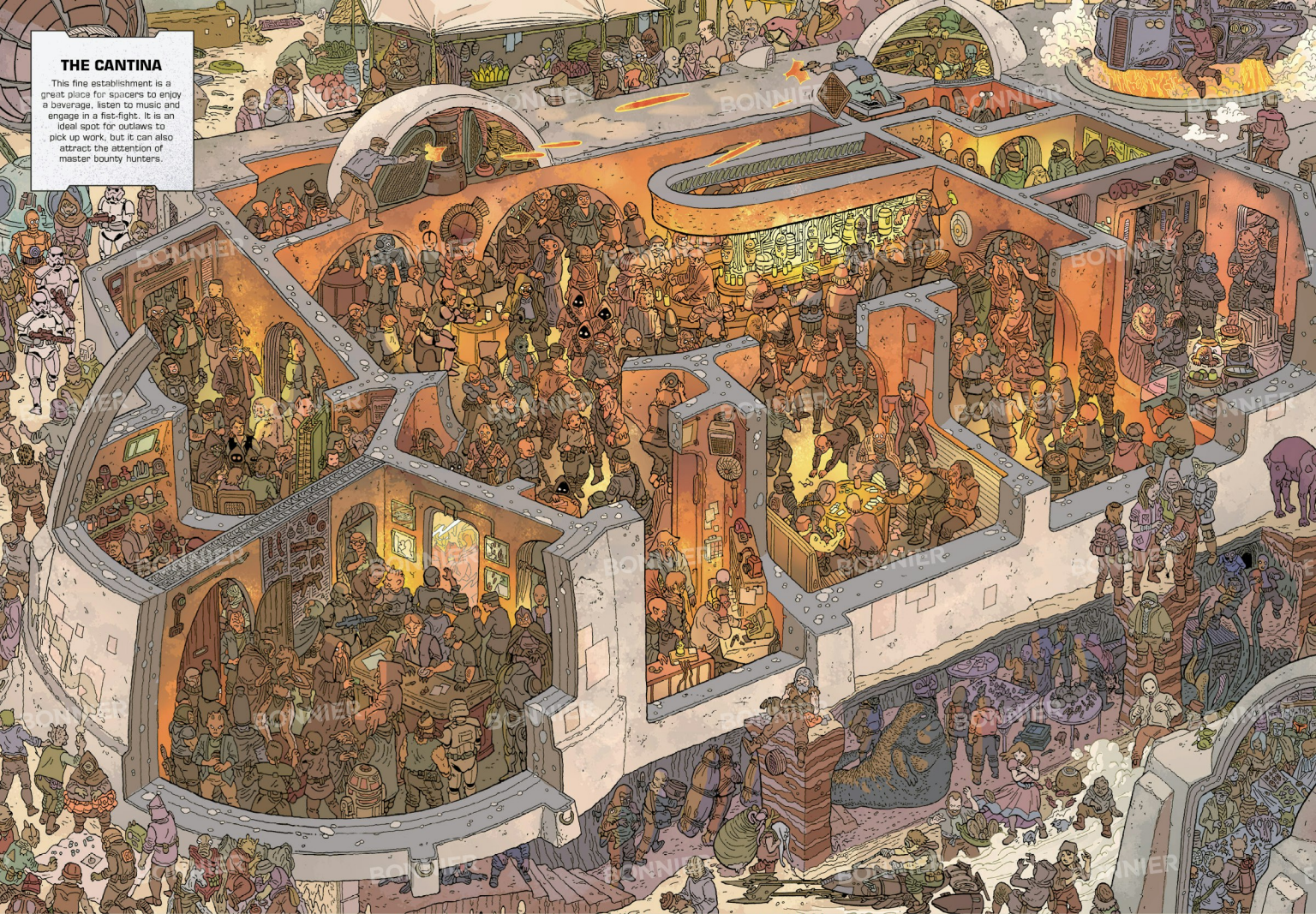
ECHO BASE

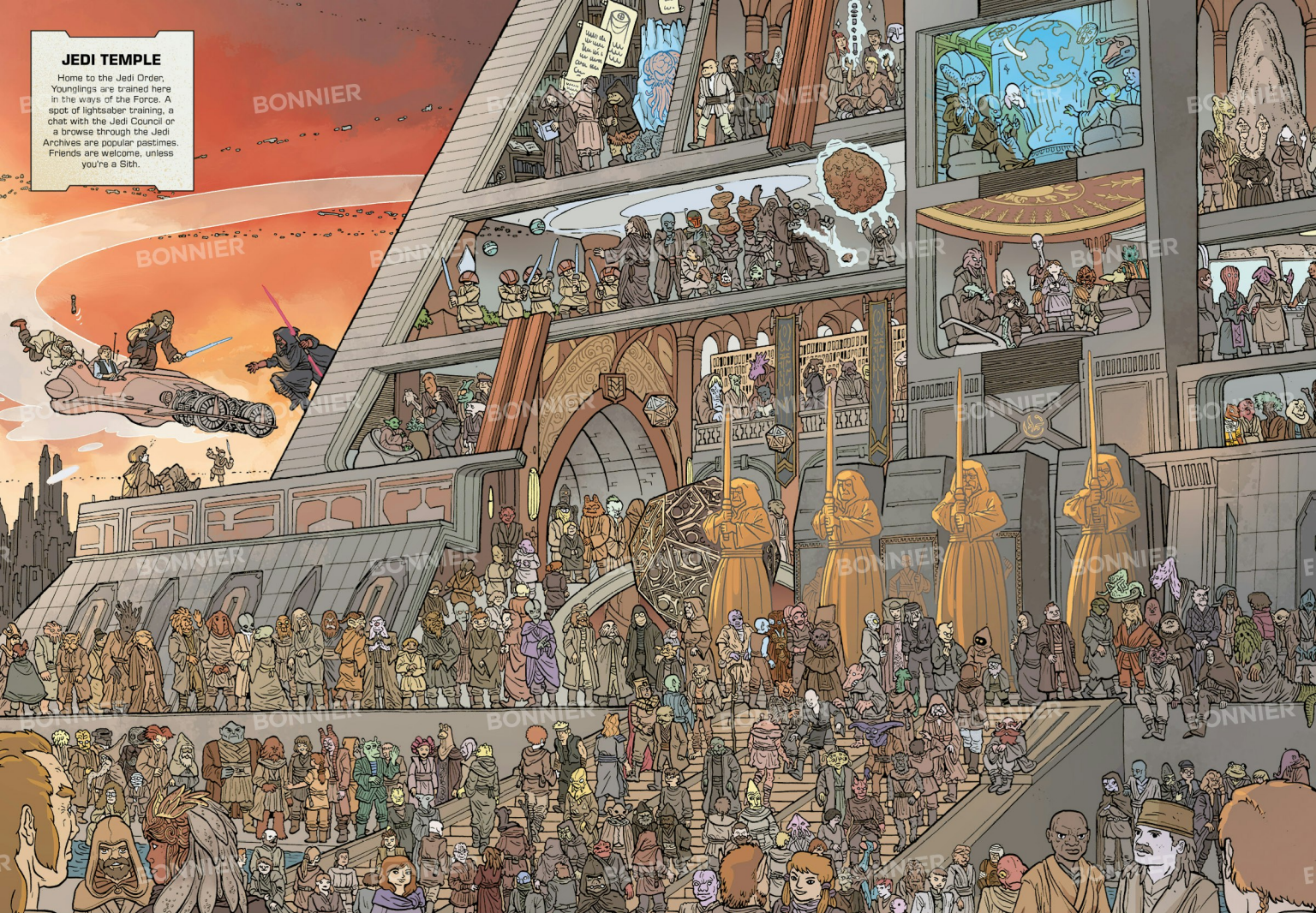
EWOK VILLAGE

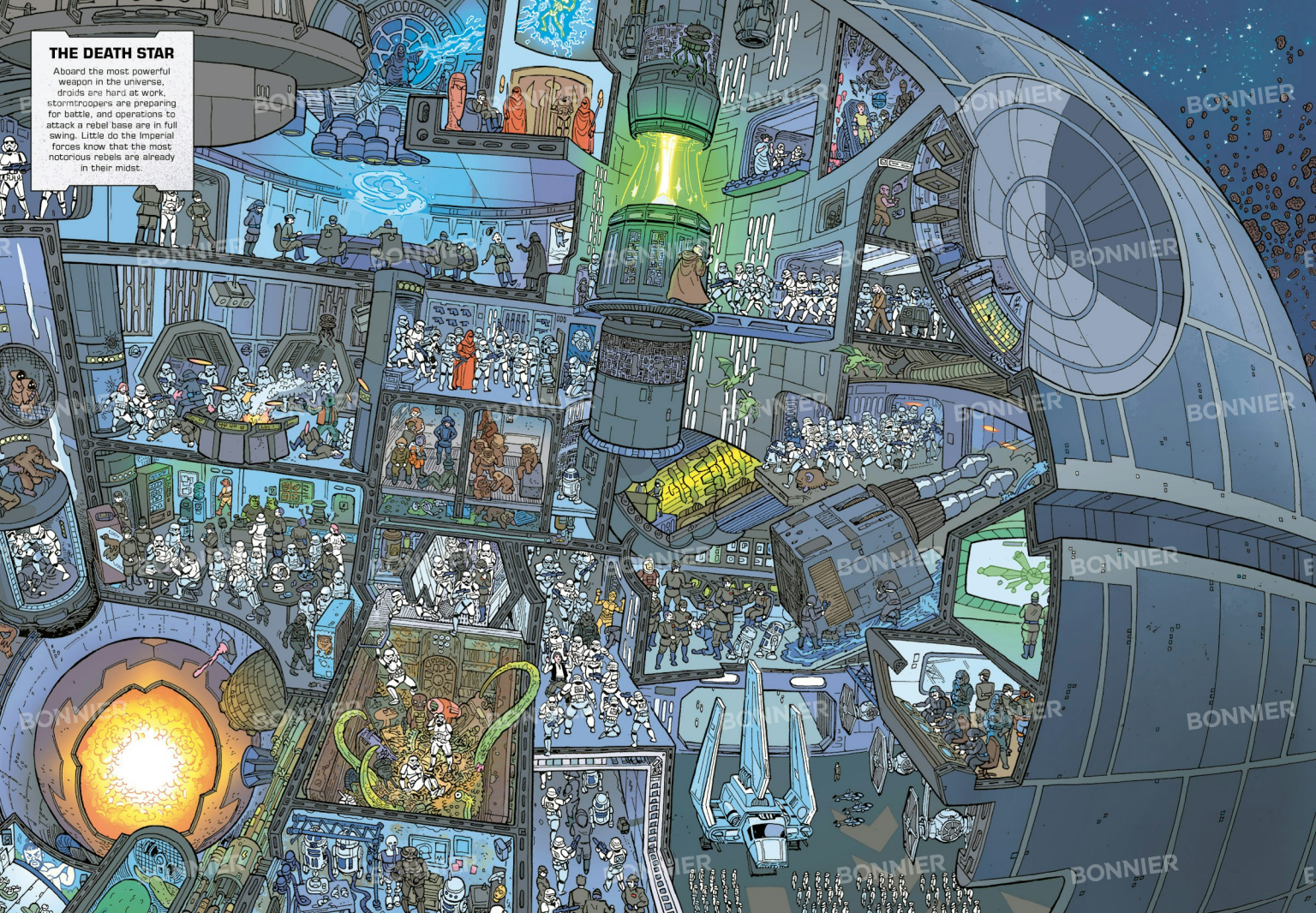
JEDI TEMPLE

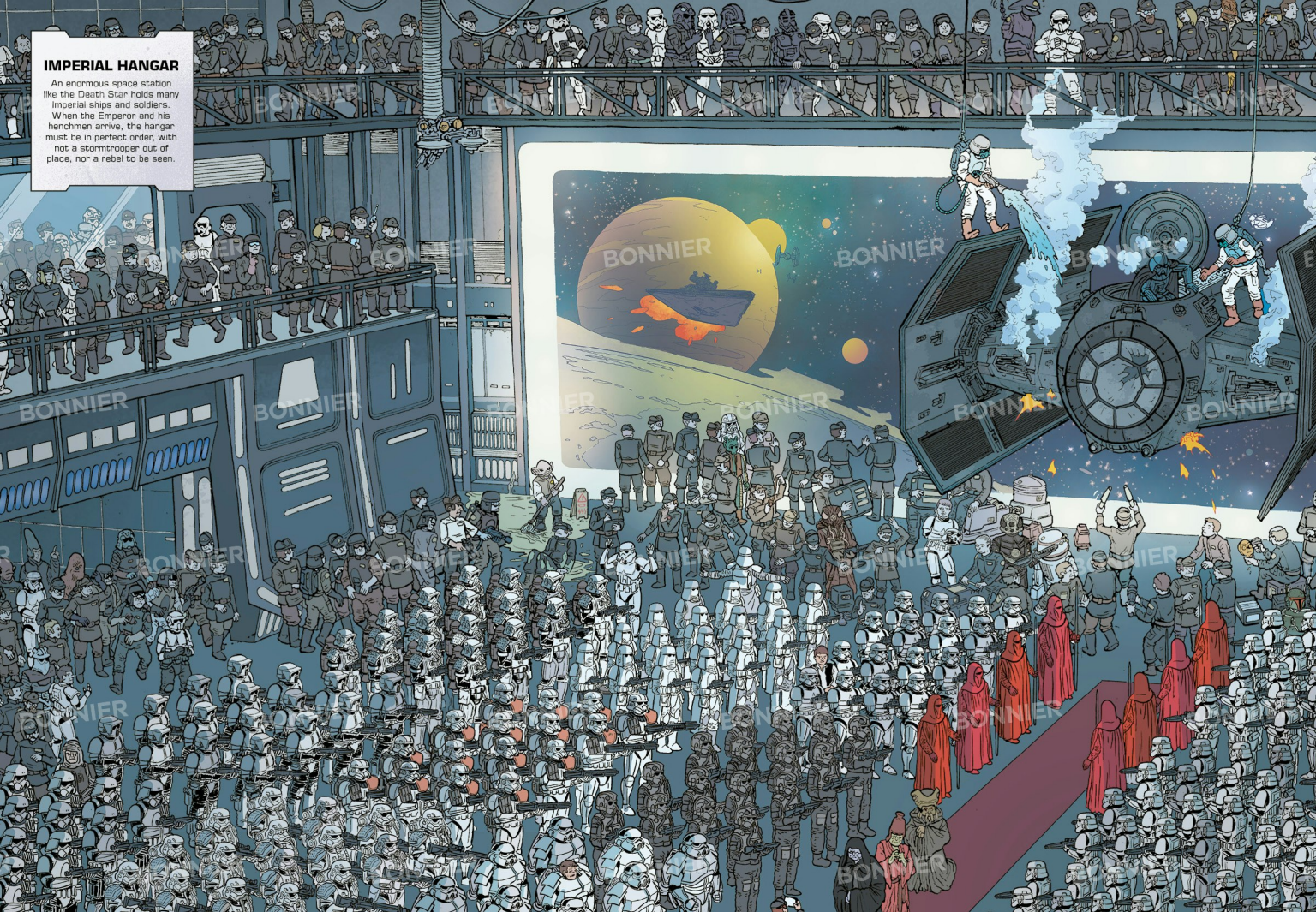
JABBA'S PALACE

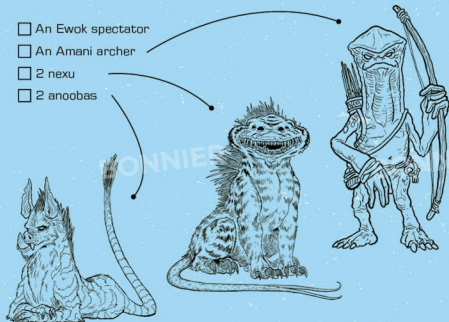

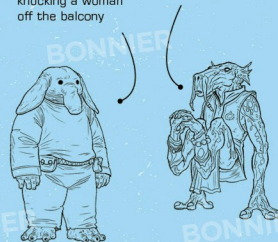
