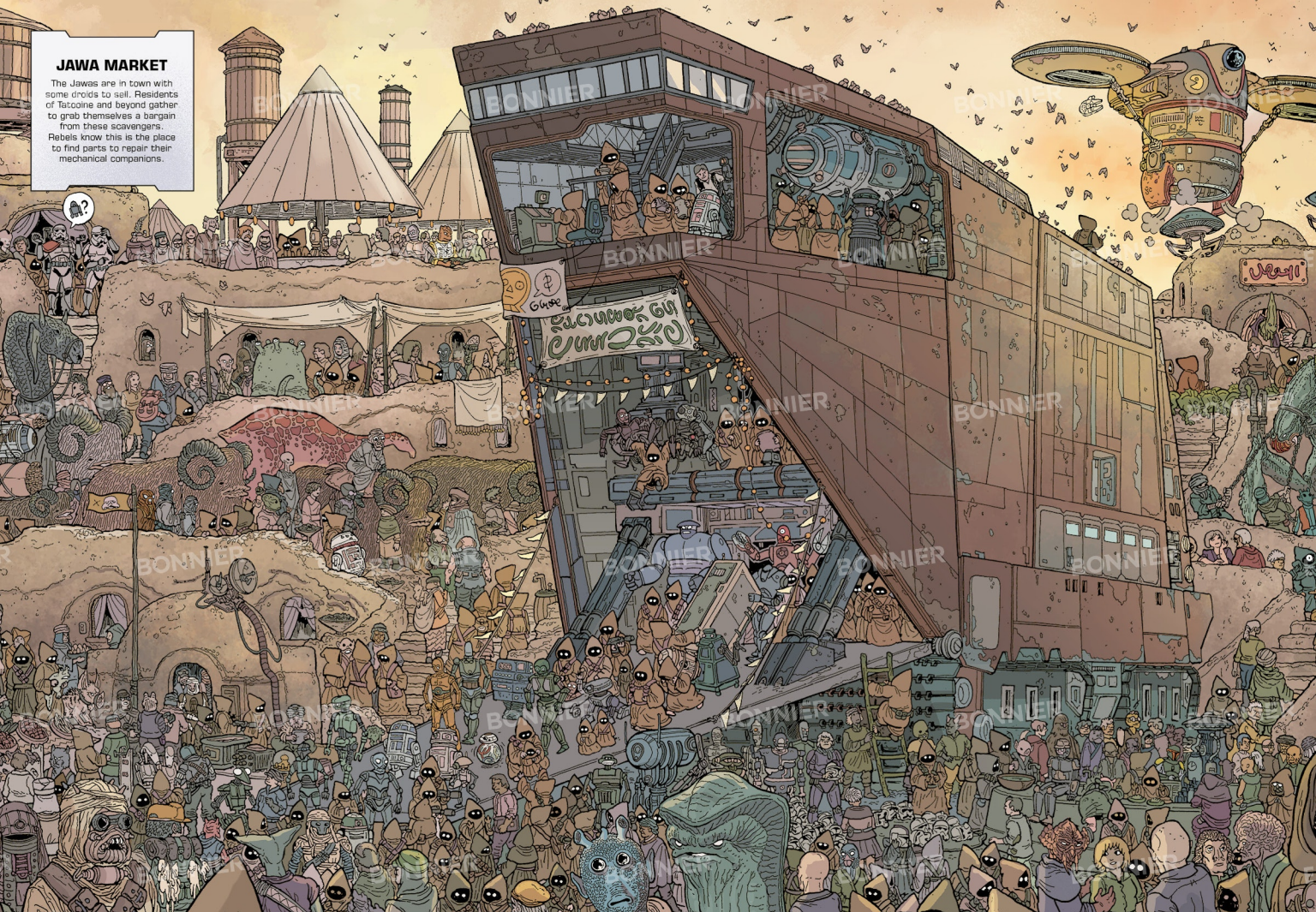

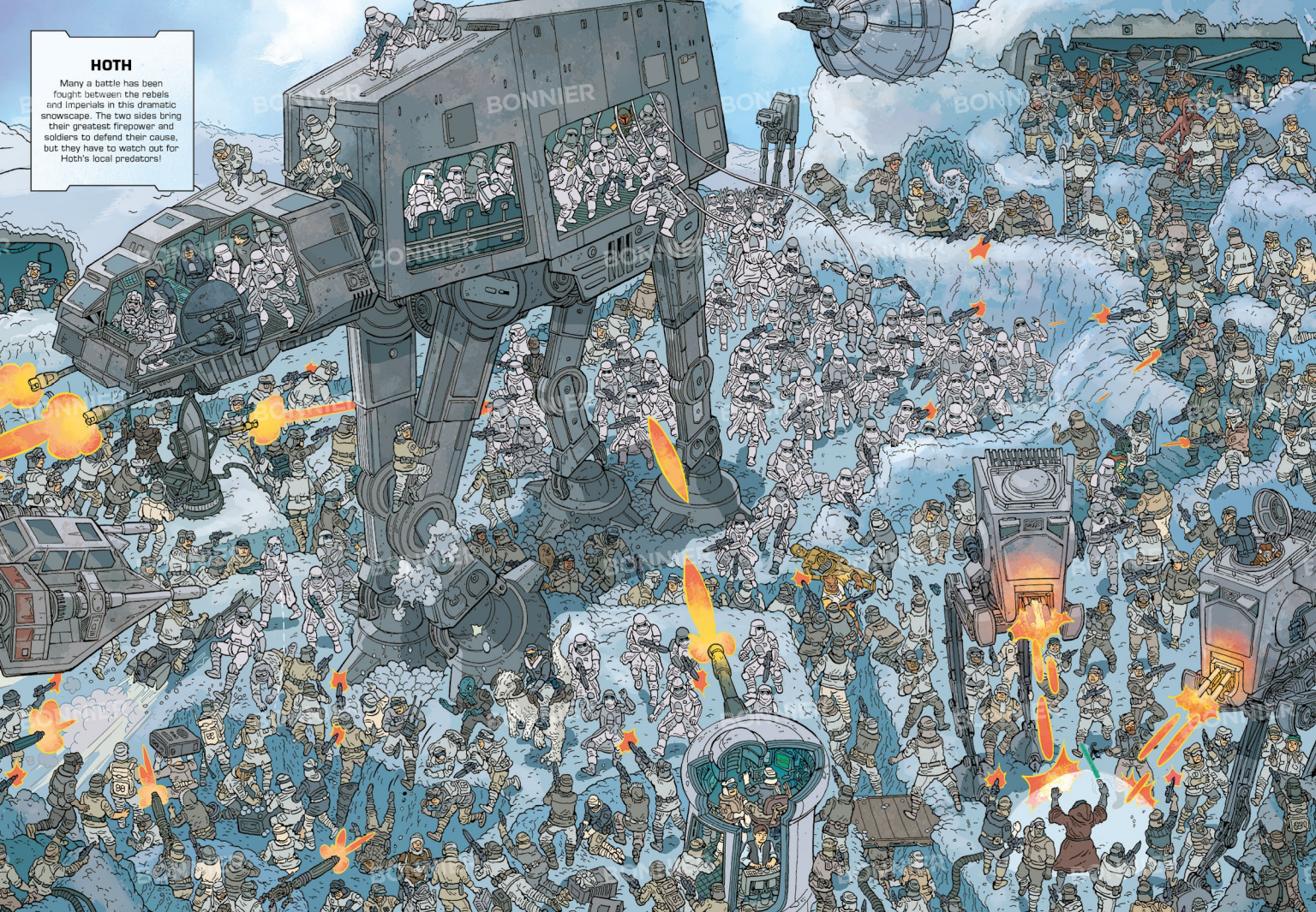
## JAWA MARKET

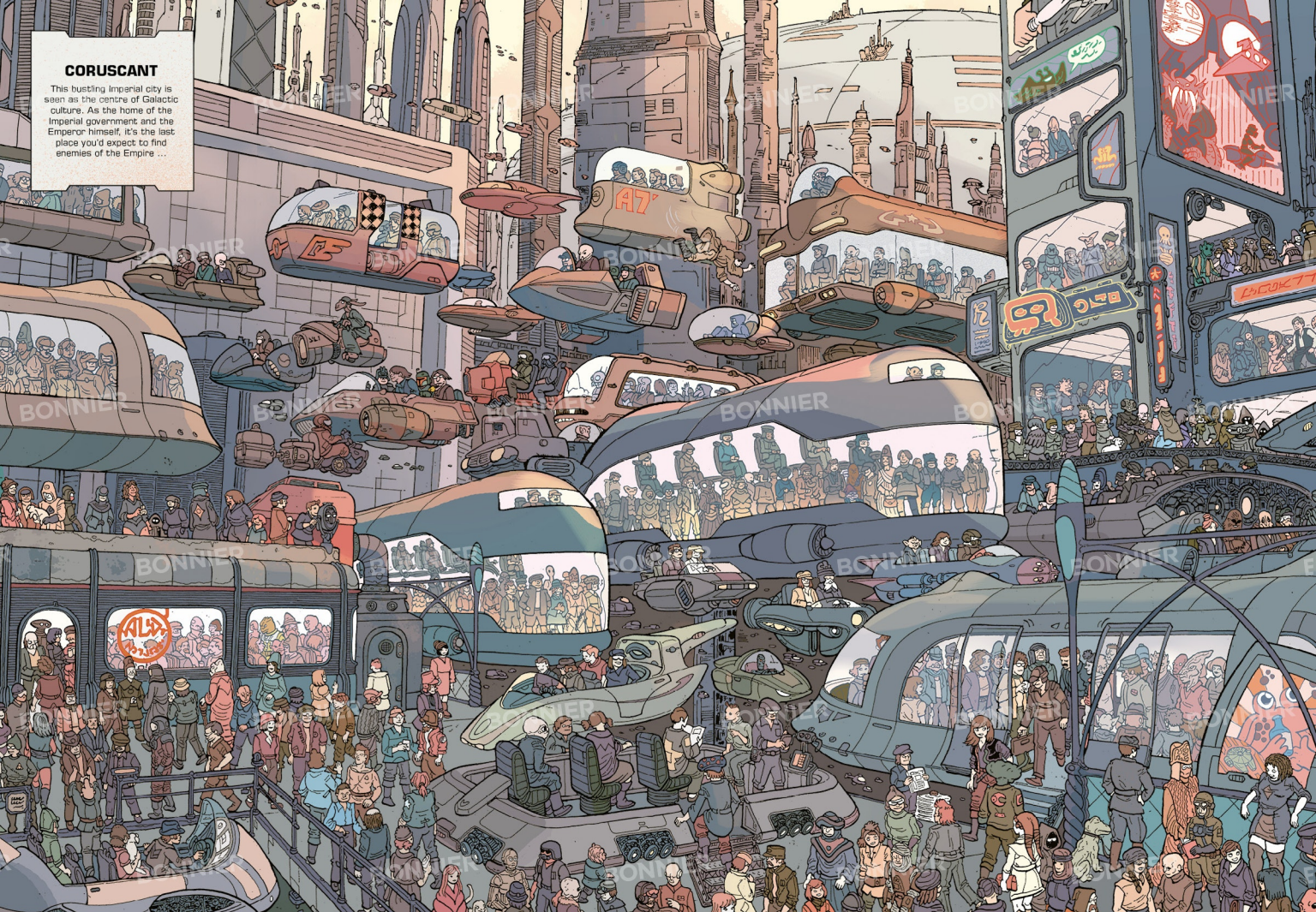
## GEONOSIS

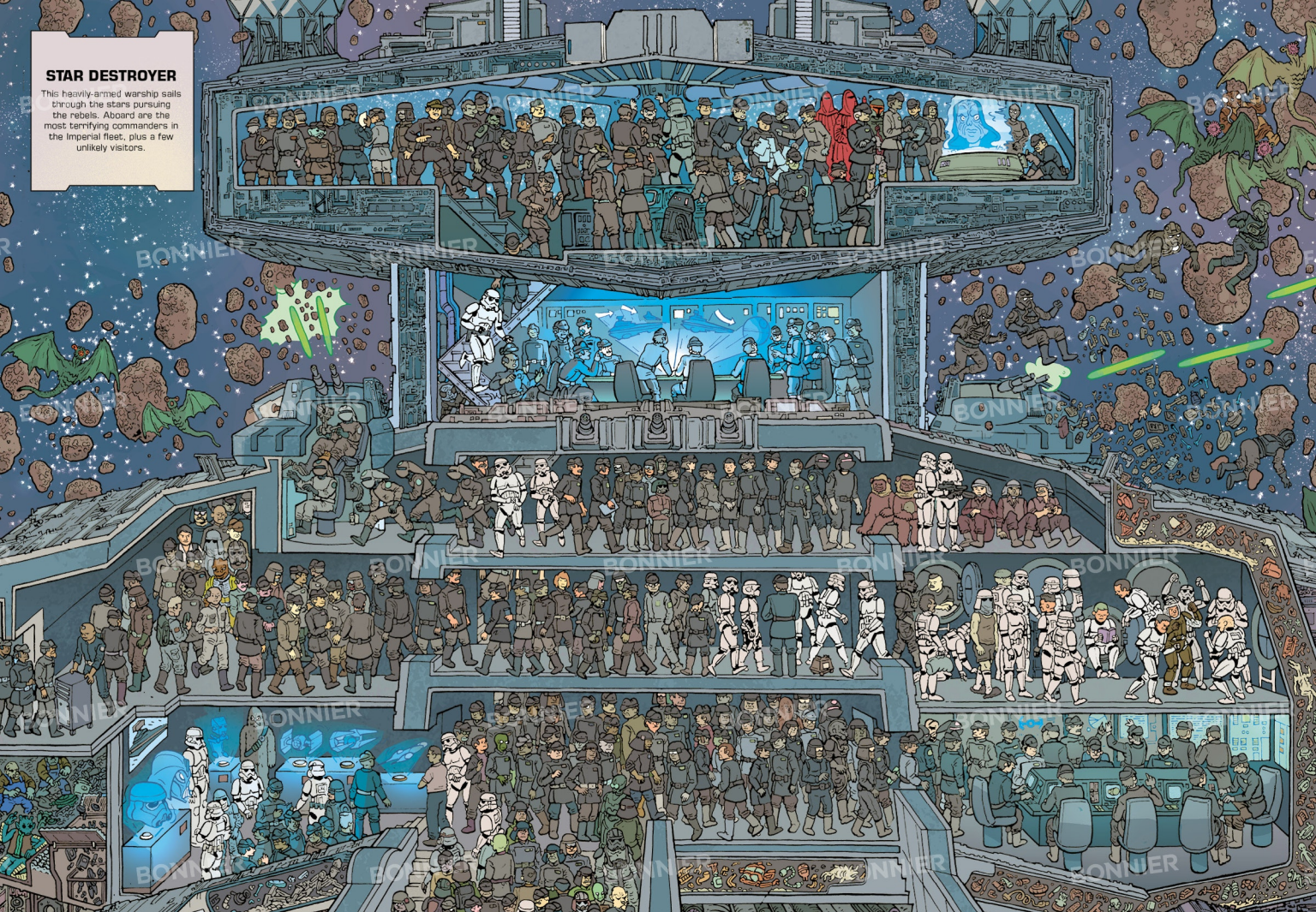
## MOS EISLEY

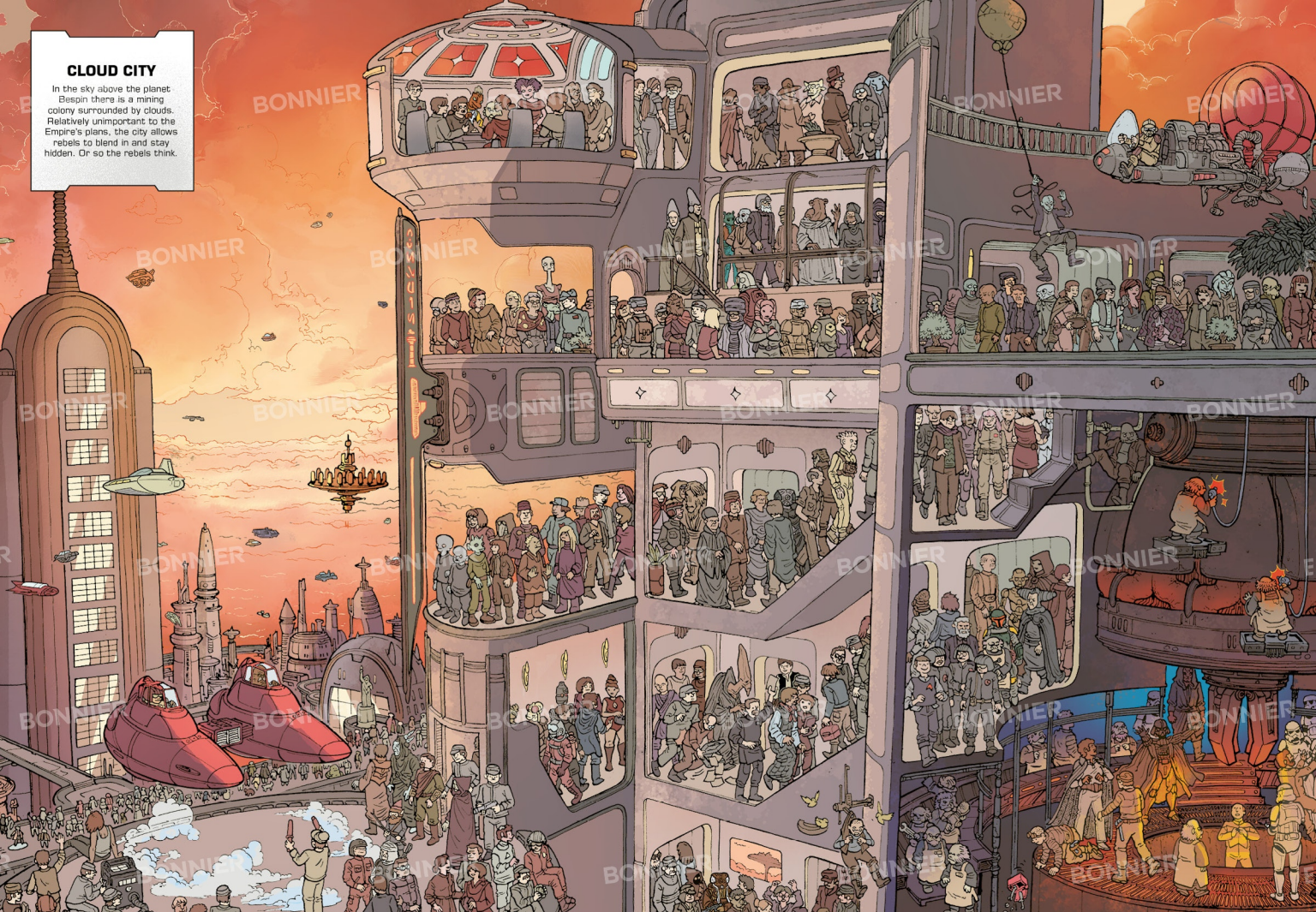
## STAR DESTROYER

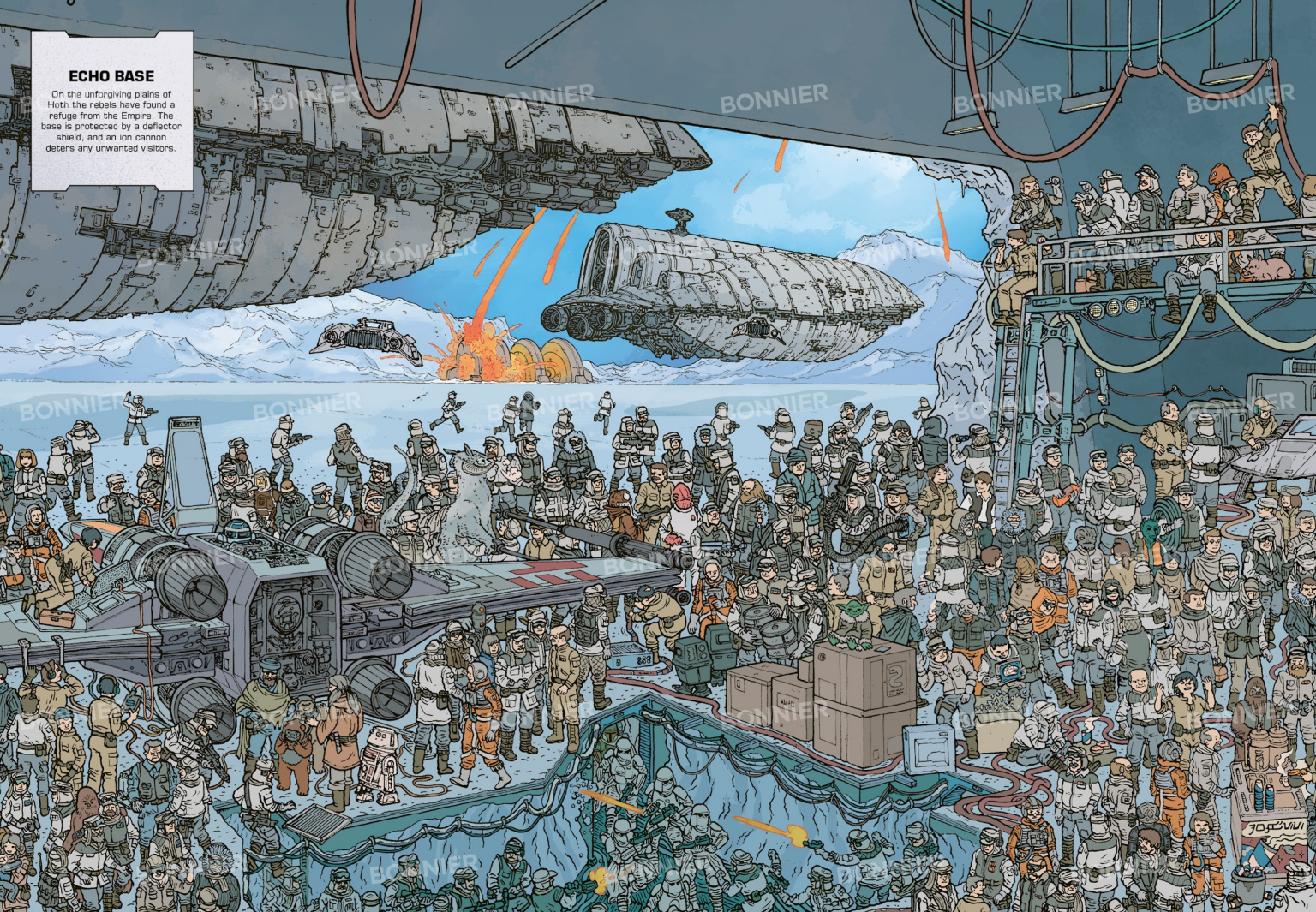
## CLOUD CITY

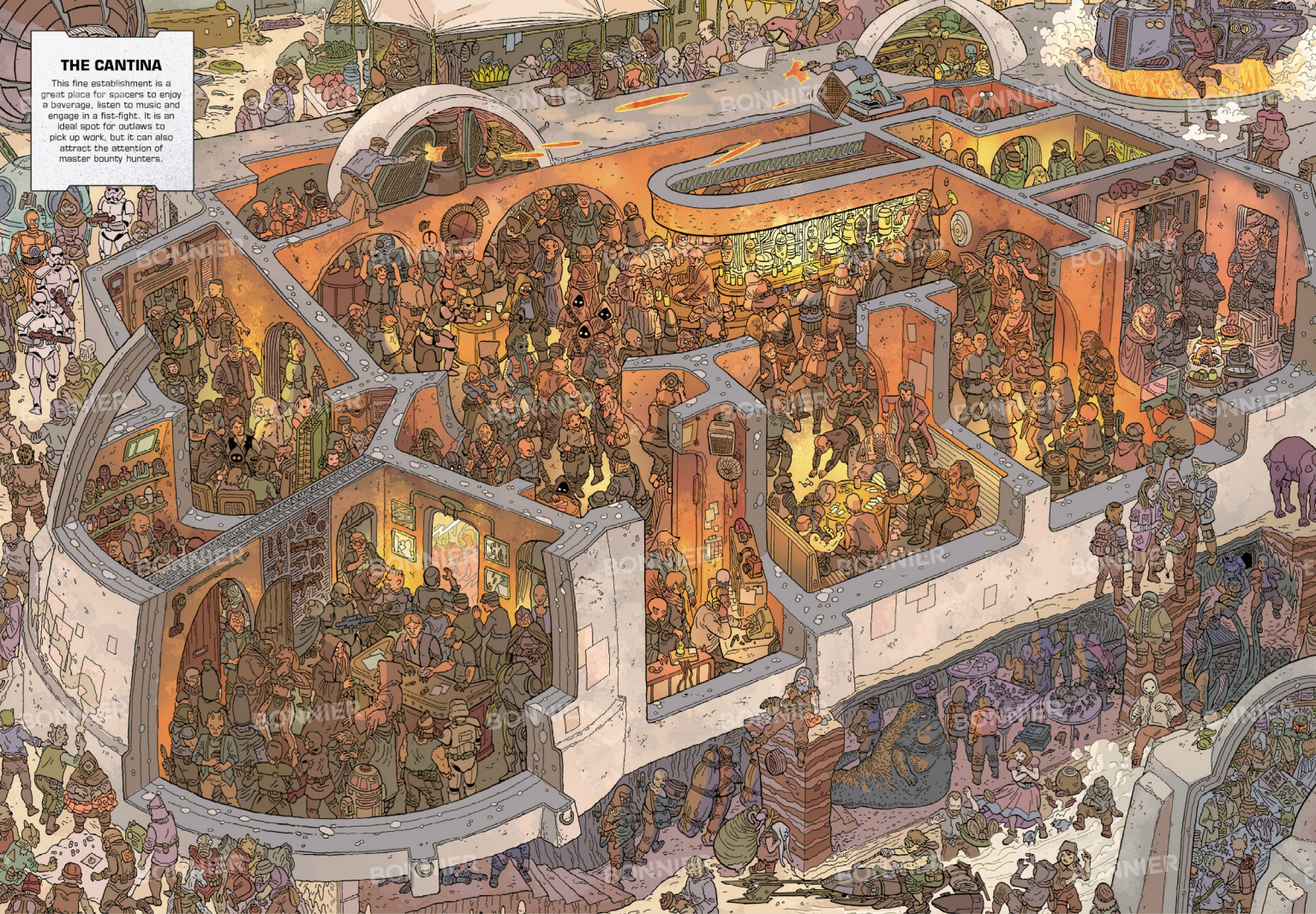
## ECHO BASE

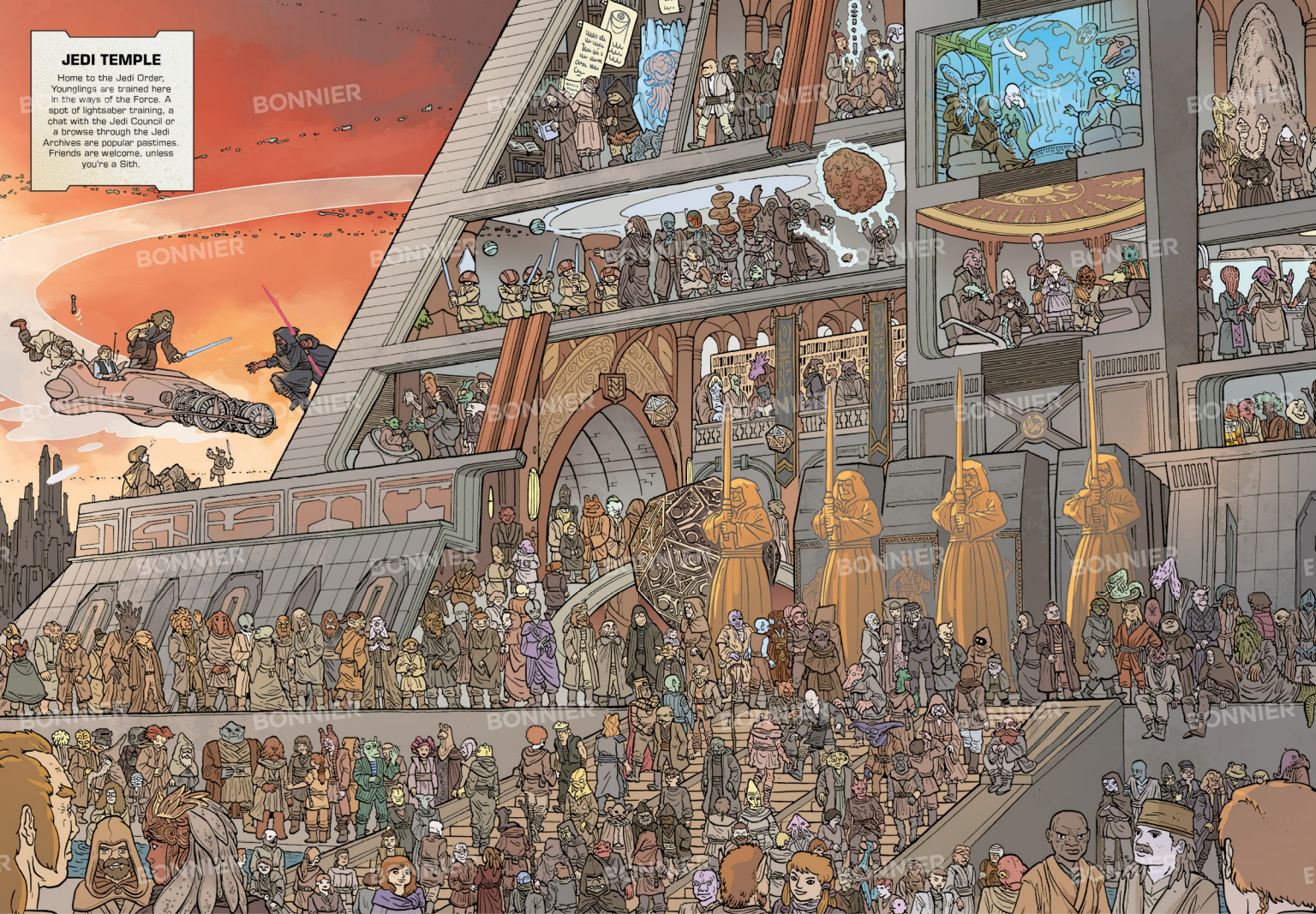
## EWOK VILLAGE

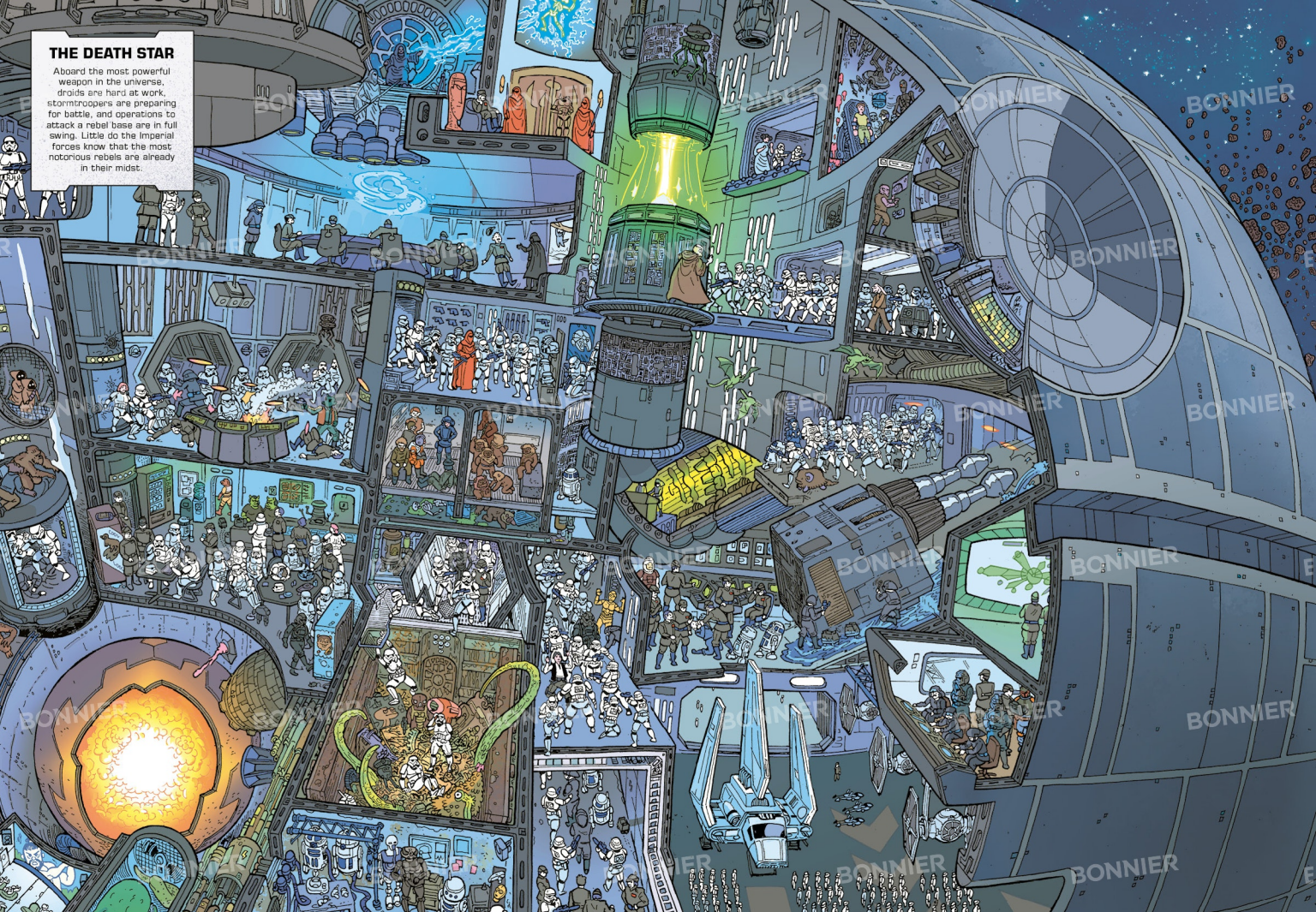
## JEDI TEMPLE

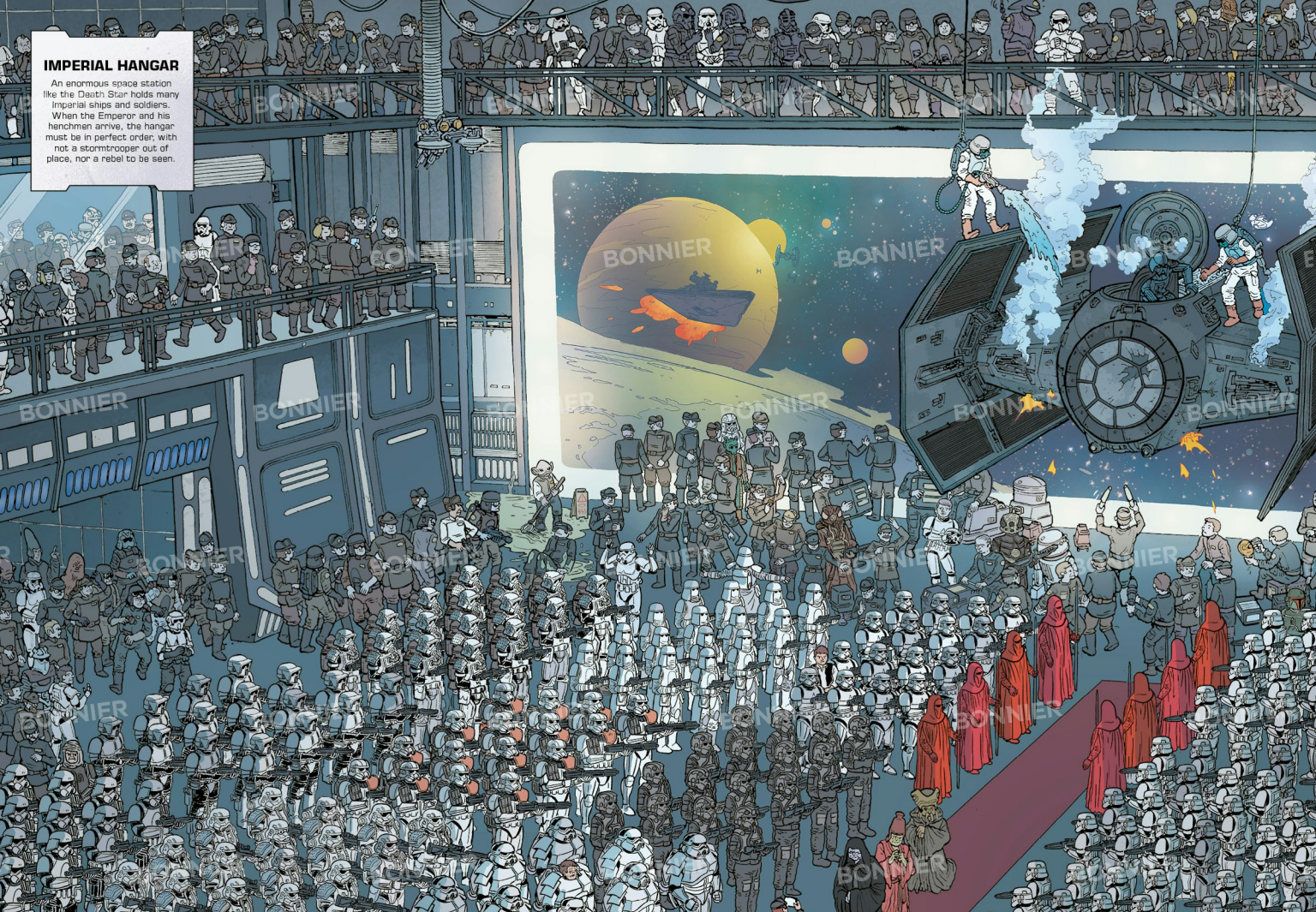
## JABBA'S PALACE

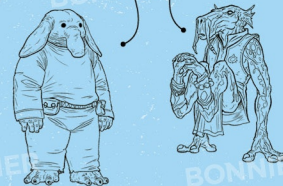

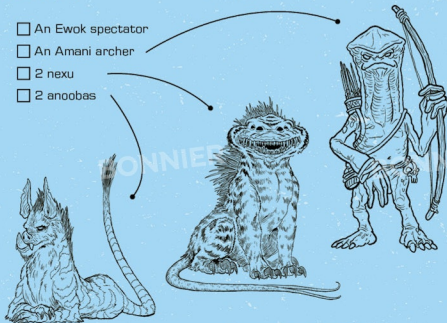
