INTRODUCTION

The Graf Archive covers the majority of the moon Orchis 2; its endless shelves, galleries and databanks contain texts, artworks, antiques, and even preserved plants and animals from every part of the galaxy.

Many items which cannot immediately be identified are moved to the underground Shadow Stacks, where they wait to be processed, often for many years. Venturing into these dusty basements is an important part of an Archivist's training, a kind of final exam: the challenge is to come back with a unexpected treasure. It can even be dangerous, as one young student discovered when the mummified ghost he was examining turned out to be merely hibernating...

These ancient hand-drawn maps were unearthed from the Shadow Stacks by a far luckier student. The Head Curator's theory is that they are the work of the great Ithorian artist Gammit Chond. We know only a little about Chond – few of his works have survived – but these maps show much of his characteristic style and flair.

Chond never travelled offworld, and one history has it that he never ventured more than a day's walk from his home. He was, however, fascinated by travellers' tales, and many of his works depict their stories of adventure and discovery in the rest of the galaxy.

They are not, of course, strictly accurate. You would not be advised to try to cross the Jundland Wastes using Chond's map of Iatooine. The artist was more interested in the feel of these strange worlds, and the often galaxy-shaking events which took place on them.

Taken together, they seem to be centred on the saga of the legendary Skywalker family. While we know that many of the things he has included are a matter of fact, some may merely be tall tales spun by explorers; but it all presents a unique view of a fascinating slice of history.

After several years of painstaking restoration, it is my great privilege, and that of the Graf Archive, to present this never-before-seen trove of art to the galaxy.

THE GALAXY

THE GALAXY IS GENERALLY THOUGHT TO BE DIVIDED INTO THE FOLLOWING REGIONS. GALACTIC NORTH IS THE DIRECTION TOWARDS THE TOP OF THIS CHART.

DEEP CORE: Densely packed stars rotate around the super-massive black hole at the heart of the galaxy. It is dangerous to navigate, and few travellers venture this far coreward.

CORE WORLDS: The richest and most important worlds cluster around the edges of the Deep Core. These include Coruscant, Corellia, Kuat, Hoonia Prime and other key systems.

COLONIES: This region contains planets colonised by the Core Worlds. The Colonies sit along major trade routes and some of them are extremely wealthy.

INNER RIM: When first settled, this area was known simply as the Rim – it was the frontier of galactic civilisation for centuries. As colonisation spread outwards, the Inner Rim worlds prospered.

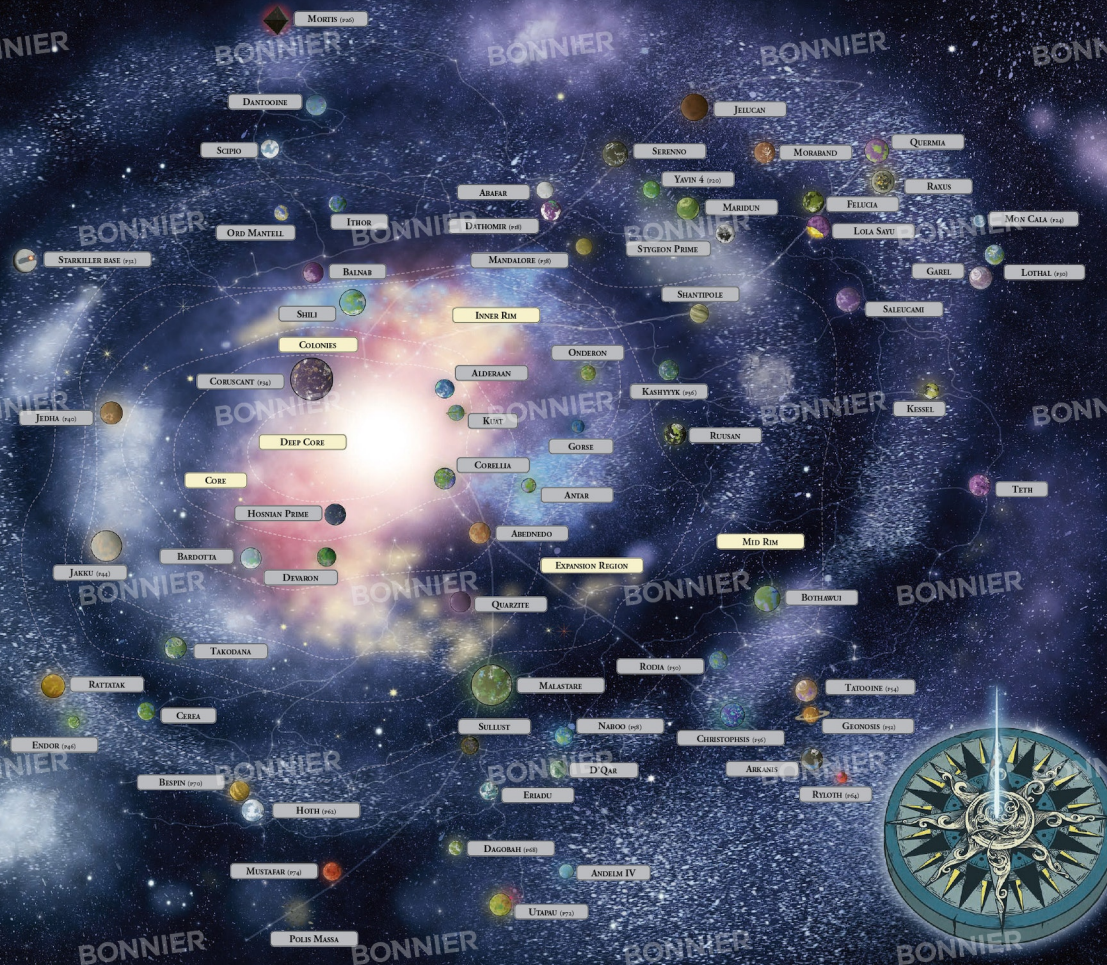
EXPANSION REGION: With competition for resources comes the need to expand, and the Expansion Region contains newer colonies sponsored by their coreward neighbours.

MID RIM: Many important worlds are found in the Mid Rim, including Naboo, Kashyyyk, Ithor and Malastare. Because it is relatively far from the Core, travellers should be wary of pirates.

OUTER RIM / TEBETOSSES: The largest region of the known galaxy is the Outer Rim, which contains many strange and often savage worlds. Some of the most important worlds in the Confederacy of Independent Systems – otherwise known as the Separatists, during the Clone Wars – were in this region.

UNKNOWN REGIONS: The Westward arm of the galaxy is mapped but largely unexplored. Who knows what lurks in the dark spaces beyond the frontiers of galactic civilisation?

WILD SPACES: Beyond the Outer Rim lies the unmapped expanse of Wild Space. Explorers and cartographers seek their fortune here at their peril.



TIMELINE

This timeline describes the period of history covered in these maps, from the Clone Wars between the Republic and the Separatists, to the Galactic Civil War between the Empire and the Rebel Alliance, and beyond.

Dates in this book are given using the 'any-ways' dating system, which is centred around the Battle of Yavin, when the first Death Star was destroyed. Therefore, 5 any is five years before the Battle of Yavin, and 5 any is five years after.

32 BBY

The galaxy is governed by the Republic. On Coruscant, the capital world, Senators from a thousand worlds meet to debate the future, while the Jedi Order maintains peace and harmony.



The powerful Trade Federation, which controls galactic trade, bullies the remote world of Naboo. Two Jedi, Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi, are sent to negotiate peace.



They discover the Trade Federation tries to assassinate the Jedi and sends their battle droid armies down to the planet to capture Queen Padmé Amidala.

Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi rescue the Queen, but are forced to flee. Their ship needs repairs, so they stop on the remote desert world of Tatooine. Here they meet the slave boy Anakin Skywalker, whose potential as a Jedi is the greatest Qui-Gon has ever seen.



The Jedi sign Anakin's freedom and take him away with them.

The Jedi escort Queen Amidala to Coruscant, but she cannot persuade the Senate to help Naboo. She returns to her homeworld with Qui-Gon, Obi-Wan and Anakin, and their Gungan friend Jar Jar Sinks. The Gungans fight a battle against the Trade Federation's droid army as the Queen makes her palace.



A sinister and deadly assassin has been tracking the Jedi: the Sith Lord Darth Maul. He and his Master, Darth Sidious, are secretly behind the Trade Federation's invasion. In a fierce battle beneath the city of Theed, he slays Qui-Gon Jinn, but is himself cut in half by Obi-Wan and seemingly destroyed.



31 BBY

The Gungans and the Naboo defeat the droid army with the help of Anakin Skywalker. The Trade Federation is forced to withdraw.



22 BBY

Senator Palpatine of Naboo has been made Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he is the evil Sith Lord Darth Sidious. He plans to start a galactic war to scare the Republic into building up the military he needs in order to seize absolute power for himself.



The former Jedi Master Count Dooku has sparked a crisis, with his Confederacy of Independent Systems – the so-called Separatists – threatening to split from the Republic. The Senate must decide whether or not to create an Army of the Republic. One prominent opponent of this plan is Padmé Amidala, who is now a Senator.



A series of attempts on Senator Amidala's life leads Obi-Wan Kenobi to the planet Kamano. Here he discovers an army of clones, secretly ordered by a now-dead Jedi Master, and based on the bounty hunter Jango Fett, who is the assassin he has been seeking. He follows Fett to Geonosis.



Anakin, now a Jedi apprentice, is assigned to protect Padmé. They travel to Naboo, where they begin to fall in love. Anakin is troubled by dreams about his mother, Shmi, whom he was forced to leave behind on Tatooine many years ago.



On Tatooine, Anakin discovers that his mother has been kidnapped by the Sand People. He is unable to save her life, and in a rage, he slaughters the tribe.



Obi-Wan is captured on Geonosis by the Separatists, but he and Anakin and Padmé when they try to rescue him.



Jedi Master Mace Windu leads a team of Jedi to the rescue, backed by the clone army that the Republic has built. Windu slays Fett, but Count Dooku escapes, pursued by Anakin Skywalker and Obi-Wan Kenobi.



21 BBY

The Jedi catch up with Dooku but he swears that he is the Sith Lord Darth Tyranus, the new apprentice of Darth Sidious. He easily defeats both Anakin and Obi-Wan. It is only the last-minute intervention of Grand Master Yoda that saves them. Dooku is forced to flee, but his master is done: the Republic now has its army.



On Naboo, Anakin marries Padmé Amidala in secret. Meanwhile, the Clone Wars have begun, as the Separatists under Count Dooku battle Palpatine's Republic.



The armies of the Republic are now led by Jedi Master Kenobi and Jedi Knight Skywalker defeat a Separatist invasion of the planet Christophsis with the help of Ashoka Tano, Skywalker's new Palawan apprentice.



The Separatists attempt to turn the planet Plooto against the Republic, capturing Senator Amidala. She escapes with the help of Jar Jar Binks and keeps Rodia's support.



20 BBY

With the help of the Twi'lek freedom fighter Cham Syndulla, Master Mace Windu retakes the planet Ryloth from the Separatists. Their heroics are long remembered in song among the Twi'lek people.



Republic forces launch a massive attack on Geonosis, the home of the Separatists' droid armies. They destroy the vast battle-droid factories.



20 BBY

The Nightisters of Dathomir attempt to assassinate Count Dooku. In revenge, he sends an army under his general, Grievous, to destroy them. Despite the witch Ol' Daka calling on army-wide attacks to oppose his droids, Grievous is successful.



The former Sith Lord Maul, thought to have perished during the Battle of Naboo, resurfaces with his fawning apprentice Savage Opress. Now equipped with cybernetic legs, he seeks revenge on his one-time Master Darth Sidious and his enemy Obi-Wan Kenobi.



20 BBY

When Onderon's King Sanjay Rash sides with the Separatists, a group of rebels under Steela Gerrera and her brother Saw fight bravely to resist them with the help of Ashoka Tano. The Onderon rebels would eventually form part of the Rebel Alliance.



19 BBY

Maul's Shadow Collective, formed of Death Watch and various criminal gangs, takes over the planet Mandalore. As revenge on Obi-Wan Kenobi, Maul kills Duchess Satine Kryze, for whom Kenobi had strong feelings. Maul's victory is short-lived, as Darth Sidious arrives to defeat both him and Opress.



Ashoka Tano is framed for a Separatist bombing by the traitorous Jedi Padawan Barris Offee. Though her innocence is eventually proven by her Master Anakin Skywalker, she decides to leave the Jedi Order.



Separatists attack Coruscant and kidnap Chancellor Palpatine. Skywalker and Kenobi mount a rescue. Skywalker defeats Dooku in single combat, and Palpatine goes his own way to killing the Count – secretly, his own apprentice.



Though he is the hero of the battle of Coruscant, Anakin is troubled by the fact that he has killed his own master, the Chancellor. He is also plagued by dreams that seem to predict the death of his wife.



Anakin discovers that Palpatine is Darth Sidious, but the Sith Lord promises he can help to save Padmé. When Mace Windu tries to arrest the Chancellor, Anakin helps to destroy the Jedi Master. He falls to the dark side and his new Master names him Darth Vader.



Vader is sent to the Jedi Temple to massacre all he finds there. Meanwhile, Palpatine issues Order 66 to the clone army: a secret command, endorsed by a chip in the clones' brains, which compels them to assassinate the Jedi. Almost all the Jedi perish, though Obi-Wan Kenobi and Grand Master Yoda survive.



19 BBY

On Utapau, Obi-Wan Kenobi's 40-or-more troops have cornered General Grievous, but they turn their fire on Kenobi as Order 66 is issued. Kenobi escapes and droids Grievous, killing the cyborg.



Grand Master Yoda goes to the Senate on Coruscant to confront Darth Sidious, but he is unable to defeat the Sith Lord in combat. The Jedi retreats and exiles himself to the planet Dagobah.



Vader travels to the lava world Mustafar, where he slays the Separatist leader, ending the Clone Wars for his Master. Obi-Wan follows him and, in an epic duel, defeats him. Vader's injuries are severe and require him to wear a cyborg suit of armour to survive from this point on.



Padmé Amidala gives birth to twins, Luke and Leia, but dies of a heart ailment. Luke is hidden on Tatooine with the Lars family, and Leia is adopted by Senator Bail Organa of Alderaan.



Supreme Chancellor Palpatine declares himself Galactic Emperor.



1 BBY

On the remote planet Lothal a group of rebels led by Hera Syndulla of Kroyon and the former Jedi Padawan Kanan Jarrus is formed. Ezra Bridger, an orphaned street thief, joins the crew of their ship the *Ghost* and begins to train in the ways of the Jedi.



4 BBY

After many battles, Kanan Jarrus is captured by the Grand Inquisitor, a fearsome Jedi hunter, and taken aboard Grand Moff Tarkin's flagship the *Swamp* in orbit above Mustafar. A daring raid by his friends Jees Farris, who then defeats the Inquisitor in combat. The Inquisitor and the *Swamp* are both destroyed.



0 BBY

A covert team of rebel agents is tasked with a crucial mission: to steal the plans of the Empire's new battle station, the Death Star. The mission is led by Cassian Andor and Jyn Erso, and takes the Rogue One team to the planet Jedha.



0 BBY

Darth Vader captures the *Tantive IV* and its passenger Princess Leia Organa, the Senator from Alderaan. He accuses her of being a rebel traitor who is in possession of the Death Star plans—but the Princess has already sent them off the ship, in the possession of her droid R2-D2.



R2-D2 and his counterpart C-3PO meet Luke Skywalker on Tatooine and take him to meet Obi-Wan Kenobi. When the Empire's Sith hit his uncle and aunt, Luke decides to train as a Jedi and to fight for the rebels against the oppressors.



Luke, Obi-Wan, R2-D2 and C-3PO travel to Mos Eisley spaceport where they hire Han Solo and Chewbacca to take them and the secret plans to the rebels on Alderaan. They travel in Solo's ship the *Millennium Falcon* to Alderaan, only to discover that the planet has been destroyed by the Death Star. The crew rescues Leia from Imperial custody and they flee to the *Millennium Falcon*.



Obi-Wan confronts his former pupil Darth Vader. He sacrifices himself, becoming one with the Force, as his friends make their escape. The Empire tracks the *Falcon* to Yavin 4.



As the Death Star closes on the rebel base, a desperate starfighter raid is launched against the battle station. Using the Force, Luke Skywalker fires the shot that destroys it, striking a key blow for the rebellion.



3 ABY

Darth Vader sends probe droids across the galaxy and eventually locates the new rebel base on Hoth. His invasion force is able to destroy it, but not before the rebels escape. Meanwhile, Luke is visited by the spirit of Obi-Wan Kenobi, who tells him to travel to Dagobah.



Luke meets Yoda on Dagobah and begins his Jedi training. Han, Leia, Chewbacca and the droids stop at Bespin to repair the *Falcon*, unaware that Vader's bounty hunter Boba Fett has tracked them there.



3 ABY

Vader captures Luke's friends and forces Han Solo to carbonite. Han, Finn, the Baron Administrator of Cloud City Lando Calrissian struggle with his conscience as Boba Fett takes Solo away as a trophy for Jabba the Hutt.



Luke travels to Cloud City to rescue his friends. He confronts Vader, who defies him in a duel. Vader reveals that he is Luke's father. Luke narrowly escapes in the *Millennium Falcon*.



4 ABY

Leia, Lando, Chewbacca, R2-D2 and Luke rescue Han Solo from Jabba the Hutt's palace on Tatooine, slaying the vile gangster. Luke is now a fully fledged Jedi Knight.



Luke returns to Dagobah, where his Master Yoda has reached the end of his life. The ancient Jedi tells Luke about his family—including the fact that Leia is his sister—and he comes one with the Force.



The Rebel Alliance is informed that a second Death Star is nearing completion and that the Emperor will be on board. They plan to destroy it in an all-out attack. Their fleet assembles for the raid, without realising that it is a trap, and the battle station is already operational.



Han Solo leads a commando team to the Sanctuary Moon of Endor to destroy the shield generator protecting the Death Star. They meet the Ewoks, who help them.



Luke Skywalker strikes down his father Darth Vader but refuses to kill him, knowing that would lead him to the dark side. The Emperor decides to kill Luke, but Anakin Skywalker cannot bear to see his son destroyed, so instead sacrifices his own life to destroy the Emperor.



Luke escapes the Death Star and, with the shield brought down, Lando Calrissian and Wedge Antilles destroy the battle station. Not long afterwards the Empire is finally defeated at the Battle of Jakku, and a New Republic is formed.



34 ABY

Kylo Ren, the dark enforcer of the First Order, seeks a map to the location of Luke Skywalker, who has withdrawn from galactic affairs. The explorer Lor San Tekka, however, has already given it to the Resistance pilot Poe Dameron and his droid BB-8.



A First Order stormtrooper, FN-2187, and scavenger, Rey, are brought together on Jakku by BB-8. They flee the First Order in a stolen ship found in a junkyard—the *Millennium Falcon*, and are soon intercepted by Han Solo and Chewbacca.



Han Solo takes FN-2187—now Finn—and Rey to Takodana. He asks Maz Kanata to arrange passage for BB-8's precious data. The First Order learns of this, and Kylo Ren attacks, capturing Rey and destroying Maz's castle.



The Resistance must attack the First Order's superweapon, Starkiller Base, when it destroys the Hothian system, which contains the Senate. A small team will travel to the base to take down the planetary shields, before fighters can attack.



Finn, Han Solo and Chewbacca fly the *Millennium Falcon* to Starkiller Base and meet Rey, who's freed herself from Kylo Ren's clutches. Together, they manage to take down the planetary shields and plant explosives.



Han Solo pleads with his son Ren—now known as Kylo Ren—to turn away from the dark side, but Ren embraces the darkness within himself, slaying his father.



Rey, whose Force abilities are suddenly awakened by the danger, takes up the lightsaber of Luke Skywalker and defeats Kylo Ren in battle.



Poe Dameron leads his X-wing squadron in an attack run on the Starkiller and fires the shots that destroy the monstrous weapon. Rey, Finn and Chewbacca escape as the base explodes.



HISTORICAL FIGURES

This turbulent period in the history of the galaxy produced many valiant heroes and terrifying villains. From the Clone Wars to the Galactic Civil War and beyond, here are some of the famous – and infamous – faces you will find in this book.



ADMIRAL ACKBAR

A legendary orator and brilliant tactician, Ackbar rose to the rank of Admiral for the Alliance to Restore the Republic, commanding the rebel fleet. His exploit during the Clone Wars with the New Galactic Grand Inquisitor Ploer-Luc Char was the planet's throne and later a Senate prize.



PADMÉ AMIDALA

The elected Queen and Senator from Naboo, Amidala fought democracy against the tyrannical Trade Federation and brought the Jedi into the war. Her secret marriage to Anakin Skywalker and pregnancy, as he fell to the dark side, a heartbreaking Padmé died shortly after giving birth to Luke and Leia.



WEDGE ANTILLES

The rebel pilot Wedge Antilles led the Galactic Alliance of Planets to destroy one or two Star Destroyers. He was one of the few survivors of the strike force at the Battle of Endor and personally blew up the reactor of the second Death Star. He died. He later flew several rebel missions for the New Republic.



MON MOTHMA

Mom Mothma was Senator for the planet Chandrila during the Clone Wars, but as Supreme Chancellor Palpatine's reign of terror grew she became a force for a new republic. She became a key leader in the Alliance to Restore the Republic and later served as the first Chancellor of the New Republic.



HONDO OHNKA

Hondo was a cunning Wookiee pirate and leader of the Clonewar. He operated from the Outer Rim planet Phelar. They engaged in kidnapping for ransom, robbery, black market arms trading and extortion. A brave warrior, he lived through clashes with the Jedi, the Separatists, and even Death Star.



SAVAGE OPRESS

Savage was a Nightrunner warrior who refused to be taken by his brother Maul. He and Maul returned into a megalomaniac. He was one of the dark side as an aggressive warrior. Maul and Luke his brother. Maul. The brothers died with Darth Sidious, who defused them and flew Opress.



ZEE OBRELLOS

The Empire brutally attacked the Lower People from the Clone Wars world. One of the few survivors was General Obrellos, a member of the High Galactic Council. A formidable warrior, the great light-headed Obrellos became a member of a rebel cell which came to be known as the Rebel.



LEIA ORGANA

Leia was raised by her adoptive parents on Alderaan as a princess and grew up to become both a Senator and a rebel leader. Her love for Han Solo, who was her father, Darth Vader, never knew the truth. After winning the Galactic Civil War, Leia married Han Solo and led the Resistance against the sinister First Order.



CAD BANE

The ruthless and deadly Duro bounty hunter was famed for his exploits during the Clone Wars – a deadly hitman who took from the Jedi. Trained in a planet back on Geonosis, and even the killing of the Republic's Supreme Chancellor, there was no job he would not take on for the right price.



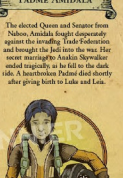
BB-8

The faithful companion in Resistance Pilot Poe Dameron. BB-8 is a spherical astromech droid, constructed with the help of Luke Skywalker by his master. After becoming blind, he was recruited to his mission. BB-8 was a clever and resourceful droid, well aware of his ability to charm.



JAR JAR BINKS

Jar Jar Binks was Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi during the invasion of Naboo and became friends with the Jedi and Queen Amidala. He was helped to rescue. Later he became a representative for his planet in the Galactic Senate, unwittingly helping Chancellor Palpatine to become part of the war.



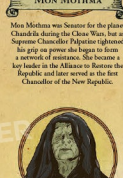
EZRA BRIDGER

With his parents assisted by the Empire for rebellion activities, Ezra grew up on the remote of Lothal. Capital City, spending his years, he became friends with the former Jedi Kanan Jarrus and his apprentice Ahsoka Tano. He was recruited to become part of the rebel cell.



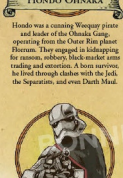
C-3PO

A protocol droid built from spare parts by Anakin Skywalker in his childhood on Tatooine. C-3PO was there in our own world from the Clone Wars. Despite his anxious nature, C-3PO proved to be a brave and resourceful hero. He was destroyed by his former pupil Anakin Skywalker.



PALPATINE

Born on Naboo, Sheev Palpatine became a Senator, and, through clever political cunning, Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he was Sidious. Dark Lord of the Sith, controlling both sides in the Clone Wars and setting the galaxy on a collision course. He was destroyed by his former pupil Anakin Skywalker.



CAPTAIN PHASMA

Alongside General Hux and Kylo Ren, Captain Phasma was one of the key commanders of the First Order. She was a being of amazing strength and led them into battle. Her abilities and powers were used with cunning to suppress a rebellion on the planet.



R3-D3

Heroic astromech droid R3-D3 witnessed some of the galaxy's most crucial events, from the invasion of Naboo and the Clone Wars to the fall of the Galactic Empire. He accompanied both Anakin Skywalker and Luke Skywalker on adventures and was instrumental in the destruction of the Death Star.



KYLO REN

At his birth, the son of Han Solo and Leia Organa was named Ben. His Jedi training with Luke Skywalker ended in tragedy when, seduced by the dark side, he betrayed the other students and was responsible for his own destruction. As Kylo Ren, the First Order's inflexible, he killed his father and became a dark warrior.



REY

Rey grew up on the planet Jakku, where she had been left as an orphan. She scavenged the old pressure parts to make a few gadgets, the junkshop Under Plun, and worked for her family. A chance encounter with a Resistance droid led her to learn the planet and discover her destiny as a Jedi.



LANDO CALRISSIAN

The renegade gambler Lando Calrissian was the owner of the planet Mos Eisley during the Millennium Falcon's first flight. He was a member of the Galactic Senate, and later, as Baron Administrator of Cloud City, he helped Luke Skywalker. He was later a member of the Galactic Senate. CHEWBACCA

The legendary Wookiee Chewbacca fought for the Republic in the Clone Wars, and later joined the Alliance to Restore the Republic. He was the first Wookiee to be recruited to the rebellion. As a pilot and engineer, he was also a member of the Rebel Alliance.



POE DAMERON

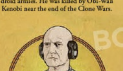

DANTOINE: Once used by the Rebel Alliance as a base, it was the location given by Princess Leia to Grand Moff Tarkin when he demanded the reveal their headquarters. Because Dantoine was too remote to serve as a demonstration of the Death Star's power, Tarkin targeted Alderaan instead.

DATHOMI: A mysterious world of jungles, swamps and mountains, haunted by witches and canoors. Dathomir's Nightisters were one of the known groups of Force-users who were not Jedi or Sith until conflict with Darth Tyrannus and Darth Sidious led to one of their clans being massacred.

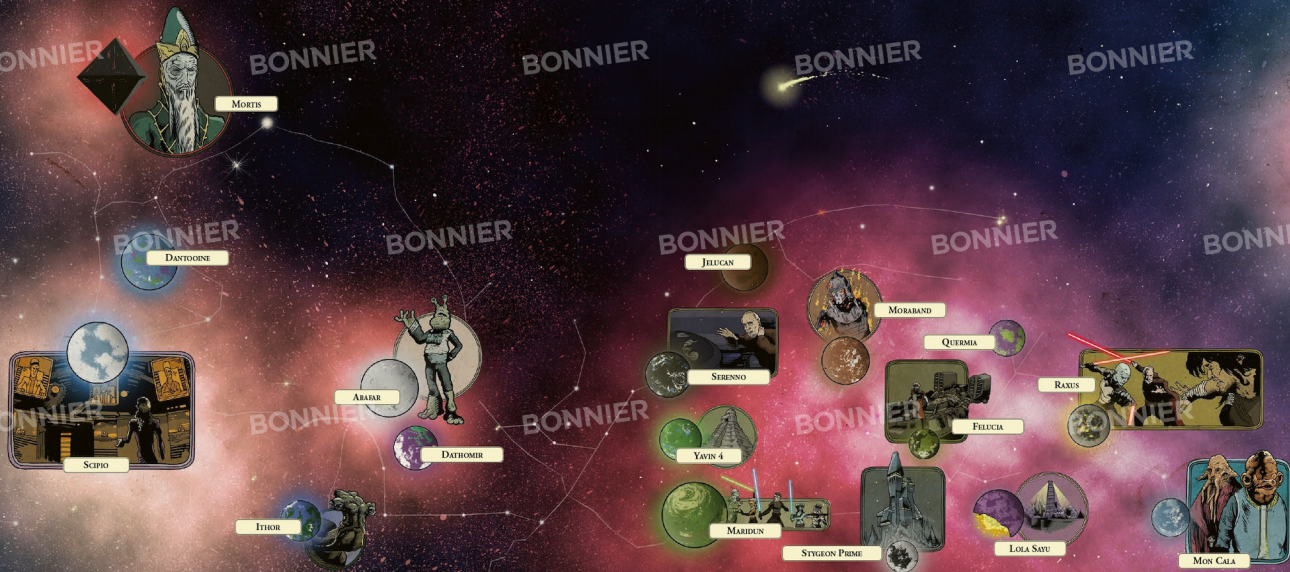
FELICIA: Felucia's position in the middle of an important hyperspace lane made it a key target during the Clone Wars. Many battles were fought for control of it. The planet itself is a farm world with great jungles of fungus. It is noted for its production of the valuable healing herb ysilium.

ITHOR: The peaceful Ithorian people, sometimes known as 'hammerheads', tend to the sacred jungles of their homeworlds. They are known for their remarkable farming technology; the Galactic Empire forced them to reveal their secrets in return for sparing the planet a devastating invasion.

JULICAN: A world of ice and towering mountain peaks. Julican was settled in two waves of colonists: the second-waves became rich miners, while the first-waves clung to their more rigid mountain traditions. It was notable as the homeworld of star-crossed lovers Thane Kyrell and Cierra Ree.

LOLA SAVA: From orbit, Lola Sava is a purple jewel of a planet. It is volcanic, with a cracked surface through which lakes of lava bubble up. It was once the site of a Jedi prison called the Citadel. When the Separatists battled over the planet, they used it to hold Jedi prisoners of their own.

MARIDUN: A grass-covered planet, home to the peace-loving Larmen. It was used to test a new Separatist weapon: the Defoliator, which destroyed life but not technology – like the Separatist battle droids. The scheme was foiled by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Ahsoka Tano and Aayla Secura.



MON CALA: The vast oceans of Mon Cala are home to the Mon Calamari and Quarren species. A bitter struggle between the two led to them taking opposite sides during the Clone Wars. The Republic defeated the Separatists. Lee-Char of the Mon Calamari proved himself in battle, becoming King.

The planet suffered under the Empire, and the Mon Calamari became key allies of the rebels. Admiral Ackbar was commander of the rebel fleet at the Battle of Endor.

Mon Calamari ships were some of the largest and most powerful in the rebel fleet.

MORABAND: The desolate homeworld of the Sith holds many evil secrets. In the Valley of the Dark Lords the tombs of powerful Sith are haunted by the presence of the dark side: Yoda travelled here as part of his quest to discover the secret of immortality and encountered a vision of Darth Bane.

MORIS: Discovered by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Moris is a mysterious realm resembling a bizarre planet whose landscape changes constantly. It was home to three powerful 'Force wideners', the Daughter, the Son and the Father, who represented the light, the dark, and balance respectively.

QUERMIA: Home to the Quarren species – tall, pale humanoid with long necks and two pairs of arms. Quarren Jedi Master Yarek Joo was a respected member of the Jedi Council, known for his skill with diplomacy, illusions and mind tricks.

RAXUS: The capital of the Confederacy of Independent Systems during the Clone Wars, Raxus is a beautiful world of forests, plains and oceans. From here, Count Dooku sparked the Separatist Crisis that led to the Clone Wars and the fall of the Republic.

SCIFIO: The InterGalactic Banking Clan was one of the most important organisations in the Outer Rim, based on the icy planet Scifio. During the Clone Wars this key Separatist planet was captured by the Republic, giving Chancellor Palpatine control of the galaxy's largest banking system.

STYGENO: A forested world that was home to Count Dooku, one of the central figures of the Clone Wars. An aristocrat who gave up his title to join the Jedi Order, he later became disillusioned and left to form the Separatists. He was also, secretly, Darth Tyrannus' apprentice to Darth Sidious.

STYGEON PRIME: The snow-covered mountains of Stygeon Prime hid the high-security prison known as the Spire. Darth Sidious imprisoned his former apprentice Maul here, and kept the remains of Jedi Master Luminara Unduli here to lure in any Jedi who survived the Order's destruction.

YAVIN 4: The small jungle moon which served as a base for the Rebel Alliance for their assault on the first Death Star. The location of the rebel base here was the crucial secret held back by the rebel leader and Senator Leia Organa during her interrogation by Darth Vader.

YAVIN 4

The fringed fourth moon of the red giant Yavin is its own for its mysterious monuments and great stepped temples, which sheltered the forces of the Alliance to Restore the Republic during the early days of the Galactic Civil War. The moon – and the hopes of the rebellion – would have been annihilated if not for the destruction of the Death Star.



It was Yui Kima in facted with a crucial mission by the Rebel Alliance to steal the plans of the Empire's secret weapon, the Death Star.



Yak Kerathian grubs burrow the trees beneath the moon's dense forests, feeding on tree roots.



Rebel pilots Ken Chamman and Shara Reeve were here in the aftermath of the Galactic Civil War. They planted Force-sensitive trees of the last such trees in the galaxy.



Slightly coloured wackadoodley lives in the forest canopy.



Plant-eating moorins forgoes as the forest floor. The rare ones are used for grubs' bait.



Continuum grubs beetles can be deadly to large swarms.



Shabellies are a species of rodent that burrow in pods. They are known to prey on whippers' birds.



Lizard rats are native to Yavin 4 swamps and are preyed on by many creatures.



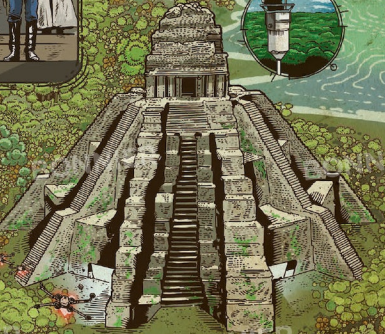

BATTLE OF YAVIN

In an attempt to discover the location of the rebel base and to destroy the rebellious forever, Grand Moff Tarkin and Darth Vader allow Princess Leia to be rescued from the Death Star by the crew of the *Millennium Falcon*. The Empire tracks the freighter to Yavin 4, where the rebels have one slim opportunity to destroy the battle station before it is able to fire on them.

Fan mathematicians X-wing an able to track the Death Star's starbases.

YAVIN 4

NEW CORAL CITY



SCUBA class reconspire to help the Mon Calamari in their battle against the Quarren.

While most of the population lives underwater, others come ashore to build outposts or ports along the waves.

MON CALA

Mon Cala is a strategically important ocean world inhabited by two aquatic species, the Mon Calamari and the Quarren. During the Imperial era, the planet suffered under occupation and began to provide secret support to the Alliance to Restore the Republic in the form of ships as well as soldiers like Admiral Ackbar.

With the tide of battle turning in favor of the Separatists, the Republic calls in a squad of Geonosis from Nelso.

The Separatists send in more droids to subdue the Quarren troops, causing massive casualties.

Master Ki-Finn defends Prince Lee-Char from Riff Tansen, but is captured, but the Prince escapes.

Captain Ackbar and his Mon Calamari Guard rally to support Prince Lee-Char against the Quarren and their Separatist allies.

With King Kallus dead, the Quarren refuse to let the young and inexperienced Prince Lee-Char become their new ruler. The long peace between them and the Mon Calamari breaks down into civil war.

The Jedi Council sends clone troops and Jedi, including Anakin Skywalker and Ahsoka Tano, to help against the Separatists.



Anakin uses the Force to subdue the central Platform Scanner so that Republic reinforcements can land.

As the civil war between the Mon Cala and the Quarren rages, the Separatist attack in hidden assault ships.

Prince Lee-Char faces his father's assassin Riff Tansen in single combat and slays the notorious Kaldemanda assassin.

King Yui Kallus aids the Republic and the Jedi to help against the Separatists. Soon after, he is assassinated by Riff Tansen, a Separatist Commander.

Riff Tansen and the Quarren chieftain Nisoor try to restore their relations from Count Dooku.

Anakin, Ki-Finn, Padmé Amidala, and Jar Jar Binks are captured but later escape.



The Son and the Daughter are capable of transforming into huge winged beasts.

MORTIS

During the Clone Wars, Anakin Skywalker, Obi-Wan Kenobi and Ahsoka Tano are drawn through a bizarre portal into the world of Mortis – a world seemingly fashioned from the Force itself. They encounter the Father, a Force Wielder who keeps the balance between his children, the Daughter and the Son. The Father intends to test Anakin, to discover if he is truly the Chosen One ...



Obi-Wan, Anakin and Ahsoka explore the lush, beautiful landscape of Mortis. It is riven with the Force and strangely unconnected with its floating islands of rock.



Obi-Wan and Anakin have strange visions inside a mountain cave. Obi-Wan is visited by the spirit of his old Master, Qui-Gon Jinn.



The Father

The Father keeps the balance between the Daughter and the Son. He always stands with the Dagger of Mortis to prevent the Son from usurping.



The Son shows Anakin a glimpse of his future, including the mother he that would kill as Death Vader. Even the Father sees Anakin's usurper of the vision.



The Son, transformed into a winged beast, kidnaps Ahsoka Tano.



The Son

In an underground chamber from the Alter of Mortis, he holds the Dagger of Mortis – the only weapon capable of killing the Father, the Son or the Daughter.



Ahsoka is kidnapped by the Son and infused with the dark side of the Force. That night she, who is trained against Obi-Wan and Anakin as they fight the Son for the Dagger.



The Daughter

Ahsoka is killed by the Son. The Daughter channels her life force through Anakin to revive her.



ALDERAAN TO TETH

ALDERAAN Known for its stunning natural beauty, Alderaan was one of the oldest members of the Galactic Republic, a peaceful world whose people valued art and culture. Because of its leaders' secret support for the Rebel Alliance, it was destroyed by the Empire using the Death Star.

ANTAR 4 Scene of the infamous *Antar Anarchy* carried out by Grand Moff Tarkin as a warning to former Separatists.

BALNAB A primitive world once visited by C-3PO and R2-D2. The planet's ruler was a hologram created by a group of stranded pit droids.

CORELLIA An important Core World known for its ships and pilots. Han Solo and Wedge Antilles were born here, and the Corellian Engineering Corporation manufactured the YT-1300 light freighter the *Millennium Falcon*, known as one of the fastest ships in the galaxy.

CORUSANT Capital of the Republic and later the Galactic Empire. It is a planet covered by a vast city of skyscrapers, rising miles into the sky.

After the Galactic Civil War the Galactic Senate of the New Republic moved from system to system on a rotating basis.

GAREL Briefly the hiding place of the rebel cell led by Hera Syndulla and Kanam Jarus, during the Imperial years.

GORSE A mining world, with one side permanently in darkness and the other in blazing sunlight. Kanam Jarus met Hera Syndulla here.

HOSSIAN PRIME With the Empire defeated, a New Republic rose from the ashes. Its capital was changed by election every few years, and while the Senate was based on Hossian Prime the First Order used Starkiller Base to destroy the system, the Senate, and much of the Republic fleet.

JEDHA An ancient world, dusty Jedha was once a place of holy pilgrimage. During Imperial occupation, extremist rebel Saw Gerrera had a hideout here.

KASHYYK The Wookiee homeworld, known for its majestic wroshyr trees. Crates spiral around their huge trunks.

KASSIL One side of this world is lush and beautiful; elegant palaces and their equally vibrant tended grounds sit among green forests and crystal lakes. On the other side of the world, vast colonies of slaves labor in the infamous spice mines. Spice smugglers can make vast profits on the 'Kessel Run.'



KUAT The shipyards of Kuat are famous throughout the galaxy; it was here that the Republic's *Assault* assault ships and the Empire's *Star Destroyers* were built. A vast man-made ring of factories and space docks encircles the planet, allowing huge vehicles to be built in orbit.

LOTHAL A quiet and peaceful agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal at first welcomed the Galactic Empire. However, the Empire soon began to oppress and exploit Lothal, strip-mining it for minerals. A famous cell of rebels formed here and won notable victories against the Empire.

MANDALORE The Mandalorian people were once renowned as fierce and deadly warriors. The New Mandalorians, however, have tried to put the violence of the past behind them. They are opposed by terrorists like Death Watch, operating from their exile on Mandalore's moon Concordia.

ONDERON Onderon's thick jungles are inhabited by deadly creatures. The humans on the planet live in cities protected by thick walls, such as the capital city *Jizi*. A key rebel leader, Saw Gerrera, waged a guerrilla campaign here against the occupying Separatist forces with the help of the Jedi.

ORD MANTELL A mountainous world covered by thick, pinkish clouds and inhabited by finkish and humans, Ord Mantell is well known as a base of the Black Sun gang. During the Clone Wars, Maul's Shadow Collective took over the Black Sun and fought a battle here against the Separatists.

RUSAAN During the Clone Wars, one of Rusaan's three moons had a Separatist moon base, Skytop Station, serving as a Republic transmission hub. General Grievous took the captured R2-D2 here to unlock the Republic's secrets in his databanks. The astromech was rescued by Anakin Skywalker.

SALEUCAMI Many people who wished to escape the chaos of the Clone Wars settled on remote Saleucami, including clone trooper Cut Lawquane, who deserted to raise a family. War did, eventually, reach the planet, as the Republic and the Separatists clashed in one of the final battles of the conflict.

SHANTIPOLE Lightning storms rage among the mountain spires of Shantipole; the atmosphere is highly dangerous for piloting starships. It is here, away from the watchful gaze of the Empire, that the Mon Calamari engineer Quarrie invented the prototype *Blade Wing* or *B-wing* fighter for the rebels.

SHILLI The homeworld of the Togrutu, who are instantly recognizable thanks to their brightly patterned skin, head-tails, and nostrils – hollow, one-shaped horns which allow the Togrutu to track movement. Two famous Jedi hailed from Shill: Jedi Master Shaak Ti and the Padawan Ahoka Tano.

TETH A mountainous jungle planet in a Hut-controlled area of Wild Space, Teth was once inhabited by the bizarre monks of the Bonarr Order, whose brains were transplanted into spider-like droid bodies. It was the scene of the daring rescue of the infant Rotta the Hutt by Anakin Skywalker.

LOTHAL

A once tranquil agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal suffered under the Galactic Empire, which ruthlessly strip-mined the planet for ores and crystals to fuel military production. It was on Lothal that the rebel cell founded by Kanan Jarrus and Hera Syndulla came together and won a series of notable victories against Imperial forces.



4 year: With the failure of the Grand Inquisitor, the Empire sends a replacement to Lothal to meet out the rebel cell: the Dark Lord of the Sith, Darth Vader.

4 year: Zeb Orson tries to subject to the Inquisitor's power, but is captured.

4 year: Darth Vader personally leads a search for Kanan Jarrus and Ezra Bridger.

5 year: Pursued by Kanan Jarrus, Ezra Bridger flees with stolen Imperial cargo.

6 year: The Lothal white tower manages to destroy a new prototype TIE fighter, on Empire Day.

6 year: Kanan Jarrus helps his apprentice Ezra Bridger to the old Jedi Temple on Lothal. There, Ezra is tested and is able to commune with Mace Windu.

6 year: Ezra Bridger and Garazeb Orson are sent out for fruit but end up stealing a TIE fighter.

6 year: Ephraim and Mox Bridger start to make underground radio broadcasts against Imperial rule: the Bridger Transmission.

7 year: Old Jedi Plo Koon is captured in the small settlement of Lothal, in an attempt to lure them into a trap.

8 year: Hera Syndulla knocks out Sannet Cull: Syrris, whom she has discovered is posing as a rebel sympathizer to lure them into a trap.

5 year: Ezra Bridger infiltrates the Imperial academy on Lothal, where he meets Zee Lonn: who also has a revolutionary hidden agenda.

Loth cats are a feline species native to Lothal. They walk the ground's surface, using their front paws to help out.

6 year: Zee Lonn and Mox Syndulla schoolmaster at Ayykol, helps in developing the Empire's activities.

6 year: Ezra Bridger, an orphan, lives in an abandoned communication tower. He collects Imperial helmets, including that of a TIE fighter pilot who attacked him.

STARKILLER BASE

The First Order's ultimate weapon, even more fearsome than the Death Star, is constructed from an entire planet. It fires a beam of phantom energy through hyperspace and is capable of destroying entire star systems. Recharging the weapon requires that the power of a sun be utterly drained.



GENERAL HEX

Planetary shields prevent ships from landing – unless they are crashing at lightning speed. Han Solo and Chewbacca bring the Millennium Falcon out of hyperspace towards the shield, an incredibly dangerous and skillful maneuver.



Kylo Ren attempts to restore and turn Rey to the dark side. However, she fights back, using the Force instinctively.



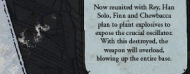
Kylo Ren, shot and wounded by Chewbacca, presses Rey and Finn outside the base. He shocks Finn and seriously wounds Han, before Rey overcomes a lightning and attacks fearfully. The Knight of Ren is defeated. As the Starkiller weapon is damaged and the planet begins to crumble, Rey is rescued by Chewbacca in the fallow.



General Han rallies the troops of the First Order as he prepares to fire the Starkiller weapon for the first time. The immensely powerful beam destroys five key Republic star systems and results in their very



Rey and Finn escape from Starkiller Base in a stolen First Order transport, pursued by stormtroopers. They are able to light off their attackers.

33 000: A series of attempts are made on the life of Senator Padmé Amidala. Venomous leeches are smuggled into her apartments while she sleeps.

38 000: Chancellor Palpatine is revealed as the Sith Lord Darth Sidious, and Jedi Masters Mace Windu, Yoda, and Jedi Knights Anakin Skywalker attempt to arrest him in his office. Sidious destroys them.

39 000: Anakin Skywalker falls to the dark side and is dubbed Darth Vader by his new Master, Sidious. For his first task, he leads the clone troopers of the 501st Legion to the Jedi Temple, where they slaughter the Jedi.

33 000: The child Anakin Skywalker is brought before the Jedi Council. Despite their misgivings, they agree that he may be trained.

32 000: The Jedi Temple has stood for millennia and seen generations of Padawan learners train in the ways of the Force. In mid-32 000, until the Jedi Purge afterwards, it becomes the pride of the Empire.

32 000: Yoda trains younglings at the Jedi Temple. Low-voice training light sabers are provided, to minimize the risk of injury.

CORUSCANT

Coruscant's surface is one colossal city, with skytowers reaching thousands of stories into the sky. It was also the seat of government for the Old Republic and, later, the Galactic Empire. Representatives from thousands of worlds met to argue in the Senate — until the Emperor dissolved it and took absolute power for himself. After the fall of the Empire, the New Republic's government moved from system to systems federally, to the Hothman system, which was destroyed by the First Order in 34 ABY.



The vast Galactic Senate Building dominates the Senate District. The chamber built 1,024 generations from the walls of the Republic.

33 000: CSM-105 Koro-Chi Broth's 3 650-ton assault AKA-121 counter-attack.

33 000: Anakin Skywalker commands a yamka and the new Jedi chase the assassin through the city.

39 000: Anakin Skywalker and Chancellor Palpatine attend the Galactic Opera House performance of *Lord Lark*.

32 000: The Jedi track Padmé's would-be assassin to the *Confessor Club*, where a 300-year-old ritual attempt is on Old War death sticks.

32 000: The assassin, a shape-shifting, Cammyid called Ziro Wionak, is captured but then assassinated by his employer Jango Fett.

Danno Jettster runs a diner in the run-down industrial district, CoCo Town.

32 000: The giant and terrifying *Ziro Rouse* brought to Coruscant from the planet Malastare for research, escapes through the capital.

KASHYYYK

A lush forest planet which is home to the mighty Wookiee species. They live in settlements built into the giant wroshyr trees, whose wood is also incorporated into much Wookiee technology. The Wookiees are known for their great physical strength and aptitude for engineering. During the rule of Emperor Palpatine, the species was used as slave labour.



In 1990 Master Yoda is seen on Kashyyyk with a battalion of clone troopers to reinforce the Wookiees in their battle against Separatist forces.

In 1991 Separatist troops target the Kashyyyk oil refinery in an attempt to cut off fuel supplies.

The famous Riddolph Grap Barracade, manufactured by Apparatus Engineering Works, was active during the Clone Wars.

Wookiees are trained by the Empire and sent to work on planets like Kamino. Wookiees rarely in get down by General Kibick.

In 1992 Chirp Oil is mined, but Master Yoda senses the danger and draws the troops away who try to annihilate him.

In 1993 Separatist troops rush across the Ispans to the capital city Kashkillo. They are met on the beaches by Wookiee army and the Republic's clone troops, who manage to repel the enemy.

Crusier catamaran style gunships, built by Apparatus Engineering, are served by one pilot and three gunners.

The signature weapon of the Wookiee warrior is the bowcaster.



JEDHA

Jedha is a place of pilgrimage, the home of a great temple held sacred by those who follow the teachings of the Church of the Force. During the age of the Galactic Empire, it is under Imperial occupation, where science teams mine and study lyber crystals.



San Geron's hidden settlements lie north of the rock rain.

An Imperial Star Destroyer hovers constantly close to the planet's surface.



The holy city, like many settlements on Jedha, sits atop a natural mesa.



Pilgrims on Jedha can be recognized by their distinctive robes and staves.

Stormtroopers patrol the chilly sands of Jedha's vast, wind-swept wastes.



Extremist rebel Saw Gerran has spent his life fighting guerrilla warfare against both the Republic and now the Empire. Motivated by the Rebel Alliance, he believes violence is the only way to achieve victory. His hidden base on Jedha was once used to store the skeletal remains of the dead.



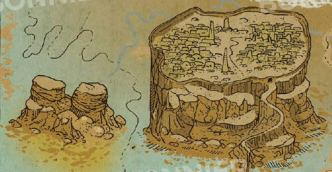

ABEDNEDO TO TATOOINE

ABEDNEDO: Emperor Palpatine's last cruel order, Operation Cinder was a revenge scheme that was to be put into effect only on his death. It targeted entire worlds for destruction, including Abednedo. An Abednedo pilot, Elio Asty, later flew for the Resistance at Starkiller Base.

BARDOTTA: A frozen, monomaniacal planet whose people are fascinated by mysticism. During the Clone Wars, Jedi Master Mace Windu and Jar Jar Binks foiled a plot by a sinister cult to drain Bardotta Queen Jula's life energy and channel it into their leader, Mother Talzin.

BOHAWAH: Dense rings of asteroids around the gas giant Bohawah offer a marketplace for plots, who must be highly skilled to navigate them. It was the scene of a major space battle during the Clone Wars, in which the tactical genius of Anakin Skywalker was key to defeating General Grievous.

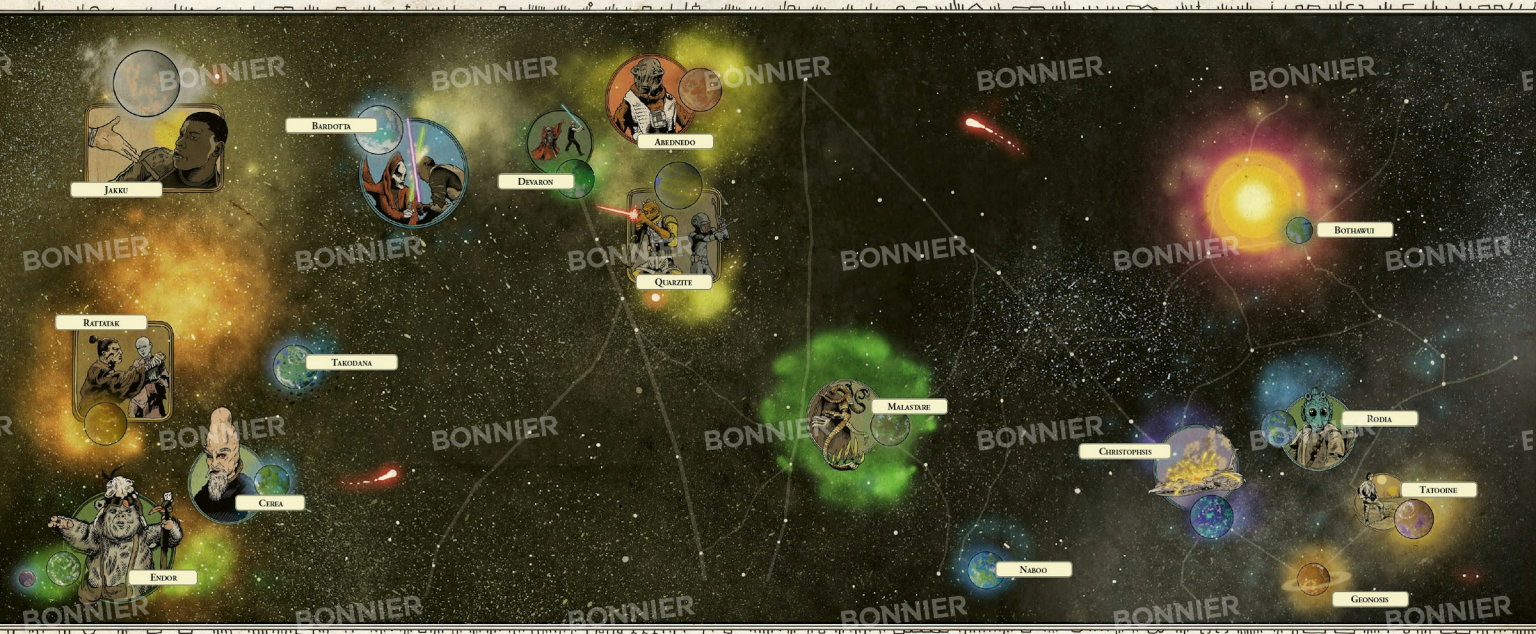
CEBRA: A beautiful world, largely unpoliced by the ravages of technology. It is home to the Ceraan people, whose towering cone-shaped skulls contain a binary brain. Ki-Adi-Mundi was a famous Ceraan Jedi Master who won many victories during the Clone Wars with his Galactic Marines.

CHRISTOPHIS: Crystal forests cover the surface of Christophis, tall jagged spires of turquoise rising from fields of hexagonal tiles. A fierce battle was fought here in the early days of the Clone Wars, when Jedi Master Halsey and Skywalker triumphed over the Separatist Whorm Loothsom.

DEVARON: A green and pleasant world of forests, rivers and tropical jungles, inhabited by the Devaronian species. The Jedi Temple on Devaron was attacked during the Clone Wars by the monstrous Savage Opress, who slew Jedi Master Halsey. Later, Luke Skywalker honed his lightsaber skills here.

ENDOR: This small forest moon orbits the gas giant of the same name. It is home to the furry Ewoks, the swamp-dwelling Duloks, and the Yuzzams of the grasslands. Endor was famously the scene of the titanic battle in which the second Death Star was destroyed and Emperor Palpatine perished.

GEONOSIS: An arid world whose insectoid inhabitants were skilled in engineering. The vast factories of Geonosis created millions of battle droids for the Separatists, and the Empire began to construct the first Death Star in orbit. Later, the planet was sterilised, killing almost all life.



JAKKU: Jakku is littered with the wreckage of starships that fell from orbit during the last great battle of the Galactic Civil War. Scavengers comb the debris for salvage. One such scavenger, Rey, was abandoned on Jakku as a child, and was later caught up in the struggle between the Resistance and the First Order.

MALASTARE: The homeworld of the Dag species, Malastare is a forest world whose core is rich in valuable fuel. During the Clone Wars, the Republic tested an electro-proton bomb here, designed to knock out droid armies. However, it awakened a colossal Zillo Beast, which then went on a rampage.

NABOO: One of the galaxy's most beautiful worlds, with lush grasslands, winding rivers and tall waterfalls. The crust of the planet is riddled with holes and passages which are filled with water. These can be used as a quick means of submarine travel from one part of the planet to another.

NABOO: The homeworld of the Sith Lord Darth Sidious. Born Sheev Palpatine, his scheming made him first a Senator, then Supreme Chancellor, then Emperor. The Trade Federation's invasion of his home planet was one of the first moves in his grand plan to seize control of the galaxy.

QUARZITE: The surface of Quarzite cannot support life. Its inhabitants the Belugans and the Kage fought a long war for control of the underground crystal caverns. Access to these caverns is only possible using a giant turbolift which leads from an orbiting space station down into the planet's crust.

RATTATAK: A dry, rocky world plagued by the attacks of pirates and warlords. One such pirate, Hal'Ster, owned a slave – the young Anji Ventress. When Hal'Ster was killed on Rattatak, the Jedi Ki Yarek took in Ventress and began to train her. His death at the hands of pirates led to her fall to the dark side.

RODIA: A warm, damp planet of swamps and jungles, Rodia is the homeworld of the Rodian species. During the Clone Wars, Rodia wavered between supporting the Republic and supporting the Separatists, but eventually Senator Padmé Amidala helped to sway them to the Republic's cause.

TARDONANA: Situated halfway between the Core Worlds and the wild frontier, Taldonana is a popular stop for travellers, explorers, fugitives and smugglers. The famous pirate Maz Kanata owned a castle here, where strange beings from all over the galaxy gathered to relax or do business.

TATOOINE: What little moisture there is on dusty Tatooine has to be extracted from the air by vaporators and is crucial to the survival of life. Humans and others scratch out a living here alongside the native Tusken Raiders – also known as the Sand People – and the Jawas who scavenge the sands.

A largely lawless world, Tatooine is controlled by the Hutt clans and is a hub of criminal activity. Smugglers and bounty hunters flock to shady dives in ports like Mos Eisley, while gamblers bet on deadly podraces and back-room sabacc games in Mos Espa and elsewhere.

The Graveyard of Giants – a vast plain of crashed starships – attracted scavengers, who sold their salvaged technology to local traders. Few people come to Jakku by choice.

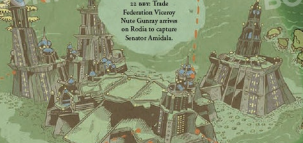

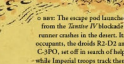

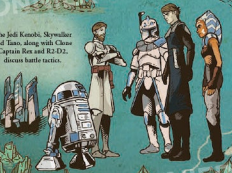

A small but beautiful jewel of a world, Naboo was the home planet of Queen Padmé Amidala and Senator Sheev Palpatine—who would go on to rule the galaxy as Emperor. Naboo is inhabited by the human society of the same name, and the native Gungans, an amphibious race who live in underwater cities.

THEED

The beautiful city of Theed is the capital of the Naboo. Yet war still rages over the city as well as in the fields. Beneath the Royal Palace is a hangar as a generator complex.

33 BBY: The Royal Palace is captured by the Trade Federation's forces, who have occupied the city. They hope to force Queen Amidala to sign a treaty surrendering to them. She escapes with the help of the Jedi, and along with her loyal troops they launch a bid to retake the city.

QUEEN'S THRONE

HANGAR

GENERATOR COMPLEX

The sinister Sith Lord Darth Maul returns down Qui-Gon Jinn to the planet's generator complex.

Obi-Wan Kenobi avenges the death of his Master by defeating Darth Maul. The arena is set in two and falls into the depths of the facility.



35 BBY: Naboo is ruled by an elected King or Queen. At the time of the invasion, the Queen was Padmé Amidala, who served two terms.



32 BBY: Jedi Knight Anakin Skywalker is secretly trained by Padmé Amidala.

Dichie, plant-eating birds are found in fields and courtyards used as park animals.



32 BBY: The Battle of Naboo is fought between the Gungans and the Trade Federation's battle droids. 90 minutes later, the droid control ship is destroyed in orbit by Anakin Skywalker.



32 BBY: The Insect Doctor Nuro Yarro, working for the Separatists, organizes the deadly Blue Shadow Virus to be sent to Naboo.

LIANOR SWAMP

Predatory tank-cars are found on Naboo and can even be used as mounts.

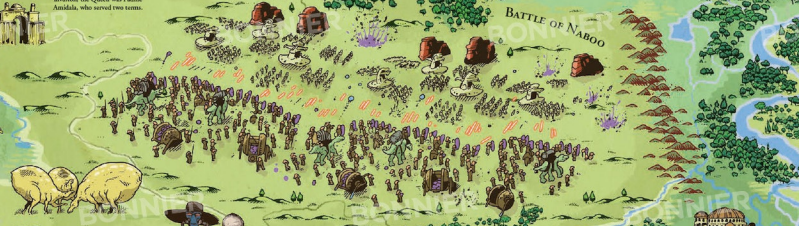


The Gungan Sacred Place is an ancient monument, important to the Gungans, north of the Lianor Swamp. A treaty with the Naboo was signed here.



32 BBY: Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn and his Padawan Obi-Wan Kenobi rescue the Trade Federation and land on Naboo to warn the Queen. They meet a Gungan courier, Jar Jar Binks.

BATTLE OF NABOO



32 BBY: Beauty hunter Cid Bazz Fwerggs Charismatic Diplomat during the Festival of Lights, but the girl is obsessed by an underclass Obi-Wan Kenobi.



32 BBY: The Gungans are ruled by a High Council, chaired by a Boss. At the time of the invasion, Boss Nass is in charge.



The city of Otoh Gunga is the main city on the planet of the Gungans. The tough hollows that it is made from are grown by the Gungans from the planet's natural plants.

PLANET CORE

Naboo's core is porous and full of water. It bungee-jumps between the top, then drops and bounces back up after 10 to 15 minutes. It's full of giant sea-birds, air-walkers, cliff fish, water-walkers.



SEA-CRAWLER

Gungan warriors ride kluksin into battle, and are armed with atlatls—long, dichie wooden poles which can sling projectiles up to 30 meters.



ANDELM IV TO UTAPAU

ANDELM IV: A remote world named for its beetles, a source of the rare mineral delectite. During the Galactic Civil War a crime lord called Jaum enslaved the population, forcing them to harvest delectite for the Empire. His plans were foiled by the Wookiee Chewbacca and his friend Zaro.

ARKANS: Rain falls endlessly on gloomy Arkans, ranging from drizzle to thunderstorms. The Empire built an academy here, run by Commandant Brendol Hux, to train a generation of elite officers. It was also the birthplace of Skywalker, which brought Force-sensitive children here for mysterious purposes.

BESPIN: A gas giant with no land, just layers of dense gas through which strange creatures swim. Valuable ubinna gas is collected from vast creatures called beldors and processed in the floating habitats in the upper, breathable layer of atmosphere, including the famous Cloud City.

DAGOBAH: Grand Master Yoda once described Dagoabah as 'one of the purest places in the galaxy'. He first came here towards the end of the Clone Wars, drawn by a strange message from his old friend Qui-Gon Jinn, who had died many years earlier. Jinn had discovered the secret of

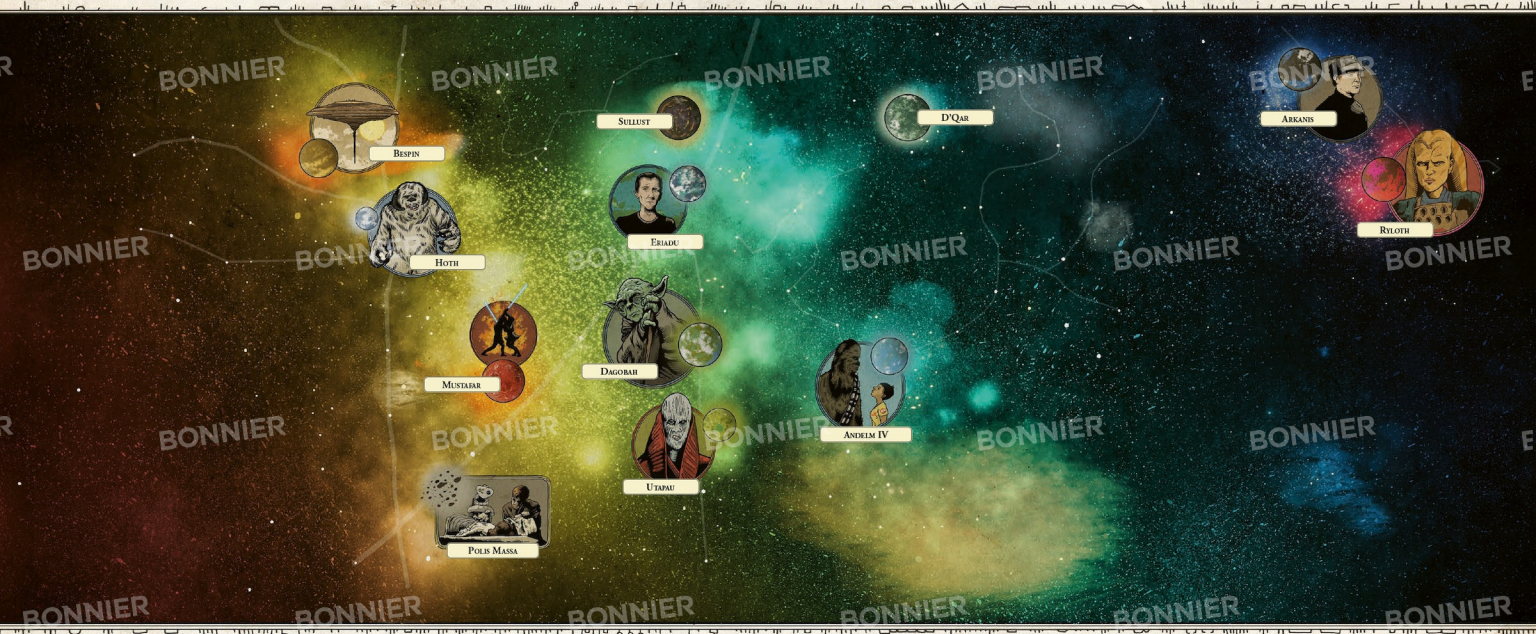
maintaining his identity after death and set Yoda on the path to discover it for himself.

Following his failure to defeat Emperor Palpatine, Yoda exiled himself to Dagobah to meditate on the Force until a new hope could arise. It was here that he met Luke Skywalker.

D'QAR: An obscure, tree-covered planet with no intelligent life and far from the main space lanes, D'Qar is of little interest. This made it a perfect choice as a secret base for the Rebel Alliance and later the Resistance – making it a target for the First Order's Starkiller weapon.

ENDOR: A once-savage wilderness of a world, until colonists tamed it. Among the early pioneers were the Tarkin family, who formed their own militia to protect against pirates and the local wildlife. Withiff Tarkin grew up here and learned many harsh lessons in survival.

HOTH: The frozen world Hoth was chosen as the new headquarters of the Rebel Alliance following the Battle of Yavin. The base was discovered by an Imperial probe droid, and Darth Vader moved swiftly to invade the planet. The Rebels only narrowly escaped the Echo Base's destruction.



KAMINO: This world is not on any maps. As part of an elaborate plot by Darth Sidious, it was erased from the Jedi Archives, and only rediscovered when Obi-Wan Kenobi was investigating the attempted assassination of the Naboo Senator Palpaté Amidala. Kenobi traced the would-be

assassin to the Wild Space planet Kamino, an endless ocean whose inhabitants had mastered the science of cloning. The Kaminoans had been paid to create a clone army for the Republic, using the DNA of the bounty hunter Jango Fett – the very assassin Kenobi was chasing.

MUSTAFAR: Lava belches from the volcanoes that cover Mustafar's surface, while swarms of droids harvest rare minerals from the molten rock. Despite the searing heat of this harsh world, it is inhabited by the native Mustafarians, who labour in the mines and factories and live in underground caverns hollowed out by rock-eating lava fleas.

Many dark deeds have taken place on Mustafar. Darth Vader betrayed and slew the Separatist Council here, ending the Clone Wars. He was then defeated and horribly maimed by Obi-Wan Kenobi.

POLIS MASSA: Once a planet, Polis Massa was mysteriously shattered into an asteroid field. A scientific base here studies the disaster, and following Order 66 Yoda and Obi-Wan Kenobi found safety at the research station. It was here that Luke Skywalker and Leia Organa were born.

RYLOTH: Ryloth has seen more than its share of war. During the Clone Wars, it was a battleground between the Republic and the Separatists, as Mace Windu and his forces battled to liberate the planet. Later, freedom fighter Chaim Syndulla opposed the Empire's cruel occupation.

A plot by Syndulla and his Free Ryloth group led to Emperor Palpatine and Darth Vader crash-landing on the planet after the Star Destroyer they were travelling in, the *Perilous*, was sabotaged and destroyed. However, the Lords of the Sith were able to escape the assassination attempt.

SULLUST: A barren world of volcanoes and lakes whose people live in vast underground cities. Half of all Sullustans work for the SoroSorb technology corporation. Sullustans are well known as pilots: Nien Nunb famously copiloted the *Millennium Falcon* at the battle of Endor.

UTAPAU: Hypersword storms batter the surface of Utapau, forcing many of the planet's inhabitants – the Uta and Patrans – to live in the giant sink-holes that lead down to the planet's crust. The Amani, recent settlers on Utapau, are hardy enough to dwell above ground in the grasslands.

During the Clone Wars, Utapau was an important base for the Separatists, and it was here that Obi-Wan Kenobi tracked down General Grievous and challenged him to a duel. After a fierce battle, the Jedi Master managed to tear open the cyborg's armour and destroy him using his own blaster.

BATTLE OF HOTH

Darth Vader's forces discovered the rebel base on Hoth two years after the Empire's defeat at the Battle of Yavin. An overwhelming assault drove the rebels from the planet, but a fatal mistake by the Imperial Admiral Ozzel meant that Vader's plan to crush the Rebellion failed.

Lines of trenches are dug into the snow, and blizzards continue to set in, but the rebel weapons cannot penetrate the AT-AT armor.



Once an Imperial pilot, Cassa Ban saw the rebels' need to fight against his new cause.



With the proton cannons in range, AT-ATs mean that even a blizzard on its side cannot stop the phantoms.



Rebel troops desperately try to hold off the Imperial advance until the evacuation can be completed.



Wedge Antilles was the one called on to command an AT-AT, bringing a cunning twist to the ground war.

Imperial snowtroopers wear specialized cold-weather gear to protect them in icy conditions.



On patrol, Luke Skywalker is ambushed by a vicious wampa and awakens in the base's lair.



Having escaped the wampa cave, Luke is aided by the visit of Old Watto, who tells him to go on the Death Star system. It is there, rescued by his friend Han Solo.

With the snowblowing, Darth Vader arrives at Echo Base, but is unable to prevent the Millennium Falcon from slipping away.

Echo Base is built under the surface of the planet, to conceal it from prying eyes.

ECHO BASE



Rebel forces escape the planet, breaking through the Imperial blockade.



1 Twi'lek society is organized into clans, with each clan having its own traditions.

2 A LAAT'i gunship and Ackbar's assault ship try to rescue Naha as Separatist troops begin their coup on Naha.

3 Maw Winda, showing great valor on the capital.

4 ART

RYLOTH

The homeworld of the Twi'lek species, Ryloth is a warm world with many volcanoes, jungles and valleys. The planet was the scene of decades of fierce resistance by guerrilla fighters, first against the invading Separatists, and then against the Galactic Empire.

5 Maw Winda leads a heroic last stand against Separatist forces, sacrificing his life to secure vital supplies.

6 The most famous of all houses on Ryloth, the towering Jitak.

7 Separatist general Wif Tander succeeds to Republic forces on Ryloth. Maw Winda is the planet's liberator.

8 Chon Sundalla's daughter Hana, at one point, joins Ryloth to fight the Empire.

9 Twi'lek rebel Chon Sundalla is a key figure in the Ryloth resistance, helping to liberate the planet from the Separatists. Later his rebel cell comes close to destroying the Emperor and Darth Vader.

10 DRUA'S VILLAGE

11 Customers on deadly predators, just reptiles and just droids. The Separatists attacked them against their troops outside Naha.

12 Twi'lek rebels sabotage a ship carrying Emperor Palpatine and Darth Vader, and the Sith Lords crash land on Ryloth. They destroy a Twi'lek village to cover their tracks.

KAMINO

This remote ocean planet is home to the Kaminoans, a race that has mastered the technology of cloning. Here the Grand Army of the Republic was created from the DNA of bounty hunter Jango Fett. The planet was detected from the Jedi Archives by the renegade Count Dooku to conceal the secret cloning project and only rediscovered in 22 BBY by Obi-Wan Kenobi.

At the time of the Clone Wars, the Prime Minister of Kamino was Lame Lu.



22 BBY: Obi-Wan Kenobi is recruited to investigate the Republic of Kamino by the Jedi.



The vast cloning facilities of Kamino could create whole armies of soldiers in a relatively short time.

22 BBY: Separatist agents attack the cloning facility on water worlds like Kamino. Jedi Master Windy Th, however, makes short work of them.



The majestic airbus - or air walker - are native to Kamino. These powerful creatures may be used as mounts.



22 BBY: Obi-Wan Kenobi confronts Jango Fett, who is hidden the assassination attempts of Padmé Amidala. The bounty hunter escapes.



TIPOCA CITY



22 BBY: Obi-Wan Kenobi meets Jango Fett and his clone son, Boba. He is suspicious of the Mandalorian wanting the star.



22 BBY: General Grievous leads a Separatist assault on Kamino, hoping to destroy the Republic's supply of clone troops.



22 BBY: Aay Voss attempts to steal the genetic material used to create the clones but is fought off by Anakin Skywalker.



- Blister**: Leader of the clone squad known as the Wolf Pack, known as Jedi Master Plo Koon. Sacrificed the Clone Wars and later befriended the rebels.
- Dixie**: Member of the elite 501st Legion. Dignity as a comrade as the trooper who rescued reinforcements. Jedi General Pong Krell the rebels.
- Evex**: Heroic elite ARC trooper who discovered Palpatine's plans to destroy the Jedi - but was frustrated and killed before he could reveal the truth.
- Grav**: As a Clone Marshal Code, commanded the 7th Sky Corps. Wounded during the battle with Jedi Master Kenobi, until he attempted to kill him during Order 66.
- Ray**: Loyals from ARC trooper who often fought alongside Jango Skywalker in the 501st. Later befriended the rebels.
- Hammock**: Reckless but steady with his remote cannon. He had no fear and nothing. Sacrificed his life to save his squad during the Battle of Umbara.
- Staxx**: A member of Clone Company. Wind helped rescue Republic and Clone. Killed in a battle of Pong Krell's treachery on Kamino.
- Patli**: All clones had his chip in their brains to make them follow Order 66. They activated only causing him to kill Jango Fett on Kamino.
- Jesse**: ARC Trooper and 501st Legion member. Jesse never let Sabotage. Umbara, Ring Vials and Anaxes, under Anakin Skywalker.
- Tyres**: A heavy support trooper. Fett was wounded on the field, soon becoming prone when he was wounded. He sacrificed himself to save the Republic.
- 99**: A schoolmate of Jango Fett, worked on the personal staff of the Kamino cloning facility. He was used and belated by his clone brothers.

He was guided by the voice of Qui-Gon Jinn. Yoda travels to Dagobah, where his old friend appears to him in the form of a stream of water.

Giant salamanders sleep here in the swamps of Dagobah.

The huge, tanked dachshund arrives in Dagobah, where it meets its with the environment thanks to its many legs.

DAGOBAH

A remote swampy world, teeming with life, Dagobah was the planet chosen by the Jedi Master Yoda when he exiled himself following the triumph of Emperor Palpatine, and where Luke Skywalker trained in the ways of the Jedi. A cave on the planet, along with the dark side of the Force, provided a test of his wisdom.

Drogonetulas are small creatures which live in the muddy waters of Dagobah, among other planets. A drogonetula is supposed to deliver E2-E2 but had to give him one.

The jabbid bird makes its way from mud and is known for its scolding song.

DOMAIN OF EVIL

Luke Skywalker is tested by Yoda, and enters a cave that is strong with the dark side. Though he is told he will not need his weapons, he strikes down a statue of Darth Vader with his lightsaber – only to discover his own face behind the mask.

Luke Skywalker arrives on Dagobah looking for Master Yoda. He fails to recognize the legendary Jedi in time.

Luke begins to train Luke Skywalker. "A Jedi uses the Force for knowledge and defense, never attack."

Yoda's Hut

Yoda's hut, built on Dagobah, is partly constructed from the litter that he travelled to the planet in.

Luke asks Luke's X-wing from the Empire where it had crashed. "She matters not," he tells Luke.

Luke trains Luke's agility and Force abilities.

Luke senses that his friends are in danger and makes to confront Darth Vader. Yoda and the spirit of Obi-Wan try to persuade him to complete his training first.

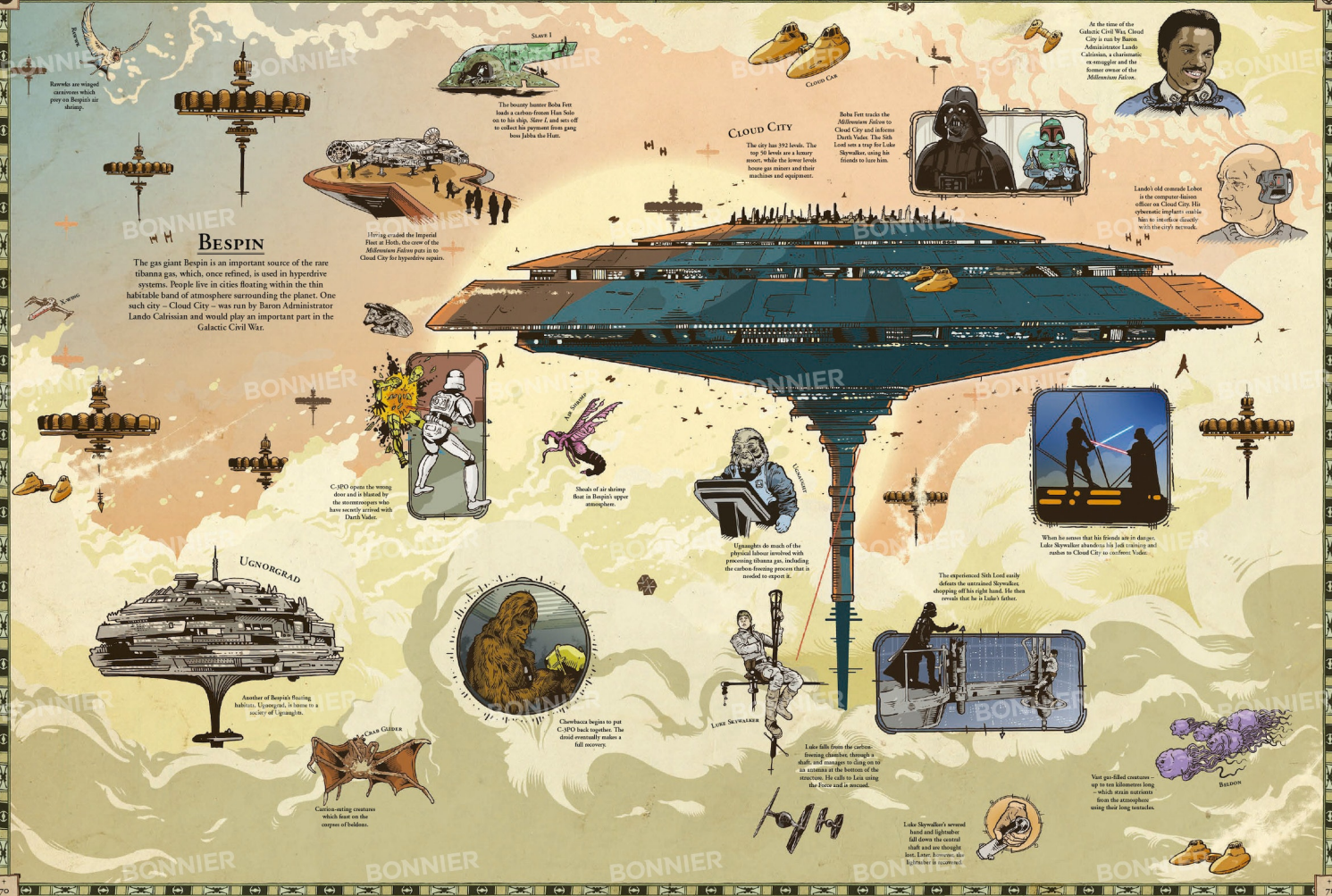


Luke at last becomes one with the Force, peacefully in his home.

BESPIN

The gas giant Beshpin is an important source of the rare thibanna gas, which, once refined, is used in hyperdrive systems. People live in cities floating within the thin habitable band of atmosphere surrounding the planet. One such city - Cloud City - was run by Baron Administrator Lando Calrissian and would play an important part in the Galactic Civil War.

Having created the Imperial Fleet at Hoth, the core of the Millennium Falcon was in its Cloud City by hyperdrive repair.

The bounty hunter Boba Fett leads a carbon-freeze team Solo on to his ship, Slave I, and sets off to collect his payment from gang boss Jabba the Hutt.

CLOUD CITY
The city has 392 levels. The top 50 levels are a luxury resort, while the lower levels house gas miners and their machinery and equipment.



Boba Fett tracks the Millennium Falcon to Cloud City and informs Darth Vader. The Sith Lord sends a spy to Luke Skywalker, using his friends to lure him.



At the time of the Galactic Civil War, Cloud City is run by Baron Administrator Lando Calrissian, a charismatic smuggler and the former owner of the Millennium Falcon.



Lando's old nemesis Laker is the computer analyst in charge of the city's network.

C-3PO spots the wrong door and is blamed by the astromech droids who have recently arrived with Darth Vader.



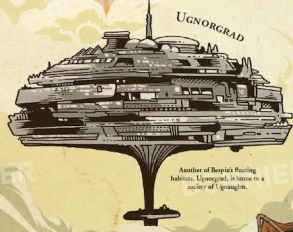
Sheds of air during fires in Bespin's upper atmosphere.

Another of Bespin's floating habitats, Ugnograd, is home to a society of Ugnaughts.

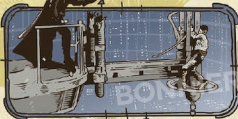


Chewbacca begins to put C-3PO back together. The droid eventually makes a full recovery.



LUKE SKYWALKER

Luke falls from the carbon-freezing chamber, clings to a shaft, and manages to cling on to an overhang at the bottom of the structure. He calls to Leia using the Force and is rescued.



The experienced Sith Lord easily defeats the untrained Skywalker, chopping off the right hand. He then reveals that he is Luke's father.



Carbon-eating creatures which feed on the corpses of babies.



Van gas-filled containers - up to an kilometer long, which drain nutrients from the atmosphere using their long tentacles.

Luke Skywalker's severed hand and lightbulbs fall down the vertical shaft and are brought back. Leia is rescued, the lightbulbs is repaired.





Jedi Master Te'Ash is stranded on Utapau by Separatist forces. The Jedi Council send Anakin Skywalker and Obi-Wan Kenobi to investigate.

UTAPAU

The wind-swept planet of Utapau is distinctive for its strange terrain, pockmarked with giant sink-holes into which the oceans drain, and its underground cities built from millions of animal bones. It is home to two native species, the Pau'ans and the Utaï, as well as more recent arrivals the Amani.

There are no giant bird-like creatures that can be used as flying mounts.

Recent arrivals on Utapau, the Amani people live in villages on the windswept plains.

While investigating Master Te'Ash's death, Anakin Skywalker discovers Separatist Magna-Gunds on the planet.

Jarads are used by the Amani people to carry heavy loads. They are strong, but slow.



General Grievous is discovered by Obi-Wan Kenobi, who uses ropes to disarm and blind him.



Obi-Wan Kenobi duels General Grievous, but the Kalmath cyborg escapes and the Jedi gives chase.

Sugi armor duels meet with Separatist agents on Utapau to sell a grain before harvest.

Master Te'Ash is captured while the Amani try to help.

The Utaï people do much of the manual labour on Utapau, under the direction of their slave masters the Pau'ans.

Kenobi's attempt to fit a limb and his moment on Chel'oo is in vain, but the Jedi escapes.

The Pau'ans people live in vast sink-hole cities beneath the planet's surface.

General Grievous attempts to escape Obi-Wan Kenobi on his remarkable TMSU-6 wheel bike.

Anakin Skywalker risks a Separatist plot to obtain a giant labor control, which can be used to create powerful weapons, destroying it instead.

The sea monster that lives in Utapau's lakes can grow up to eight meters long.

Utapau's lakes and rivers drain into the sink-holes, where many strange creatures live.

MUSTAFAR

Once described as 'where Jedi go to die', the searing lava-world Mustafar is a world of ill omen. Vast refineries extract precious minerals from the volcanic core of the planet – but it is better known for its history of violence, treachery and death.

19 year: Qui-Gon Jinn is killed by Darth Vader, who is the first time Vader is defeated, and his body is crushed and burned.

1 year: Kinga the Dathomirian is captured to keep the Sith in the arena, free of outside and lava fire.



19 year: Anakin Skywalker and Shmi Skywalker escape from the planet Mustafar.

19 year: Obi-wan Kenobi and Padme Amidala are killed by Darth Vader on his way to Palpatine, and his body is crushed and burned.



4 year: The Sith Emperor orders Mustafar to be destroyed. The planet is destroyed by the Jedi Kanan Jarrus. Rather than suffer the wrath of Darth Vader, the Emperor allows himself to fall to his death.



4 year: The Lorrdan whole is destroyed. The planet is destroyed by the Jedi Kanan Jarrus. Rather than suffer the wrath of Darth Vader, the Emperor allows himself to fall to his death.



19 year: Anakin Skywalker, now Darth Vader, destroys the Separatist leaders at the order of his new Master, Darth Sidious. This effectively ends the Clone Wars.



Sith Lords are hunted and killed. They hunt in packs and are well prepared by nature.



Lava flow ships across the fiery surface of Mustafar. They are large enough to be used as mountains by the native Mustafarians.
