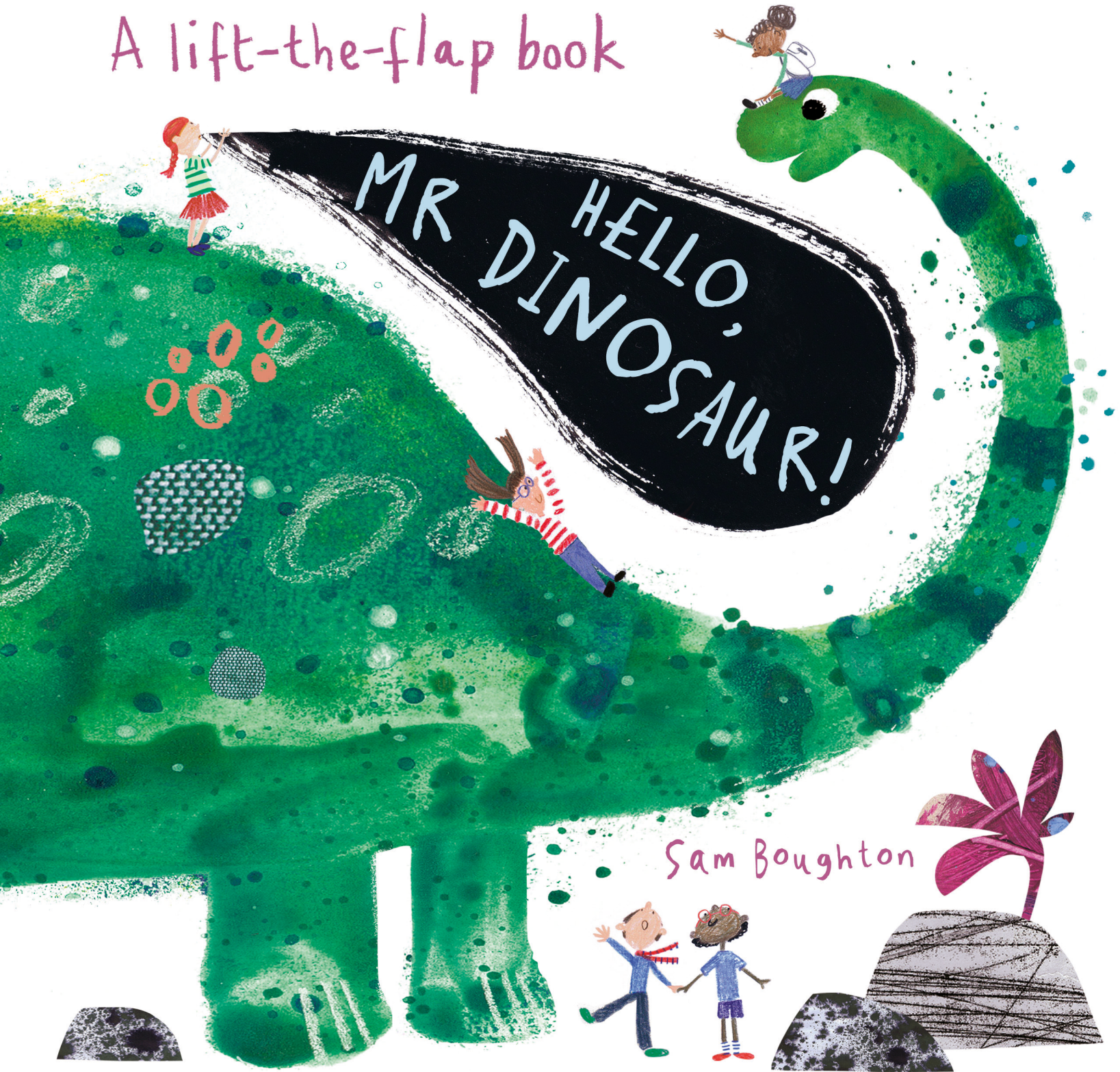

Mr Velociraptor!



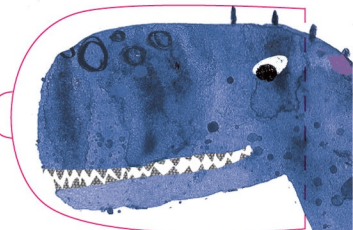
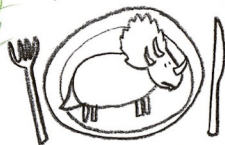
Say hello to the Triceratops family!

Mrs Triceratops!

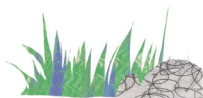
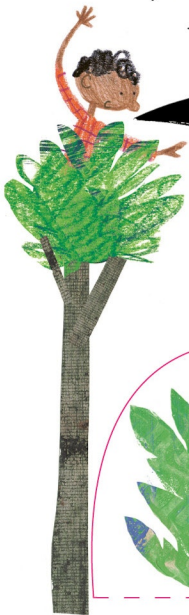
Their head frill

Triceratops!

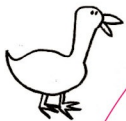


Hello
