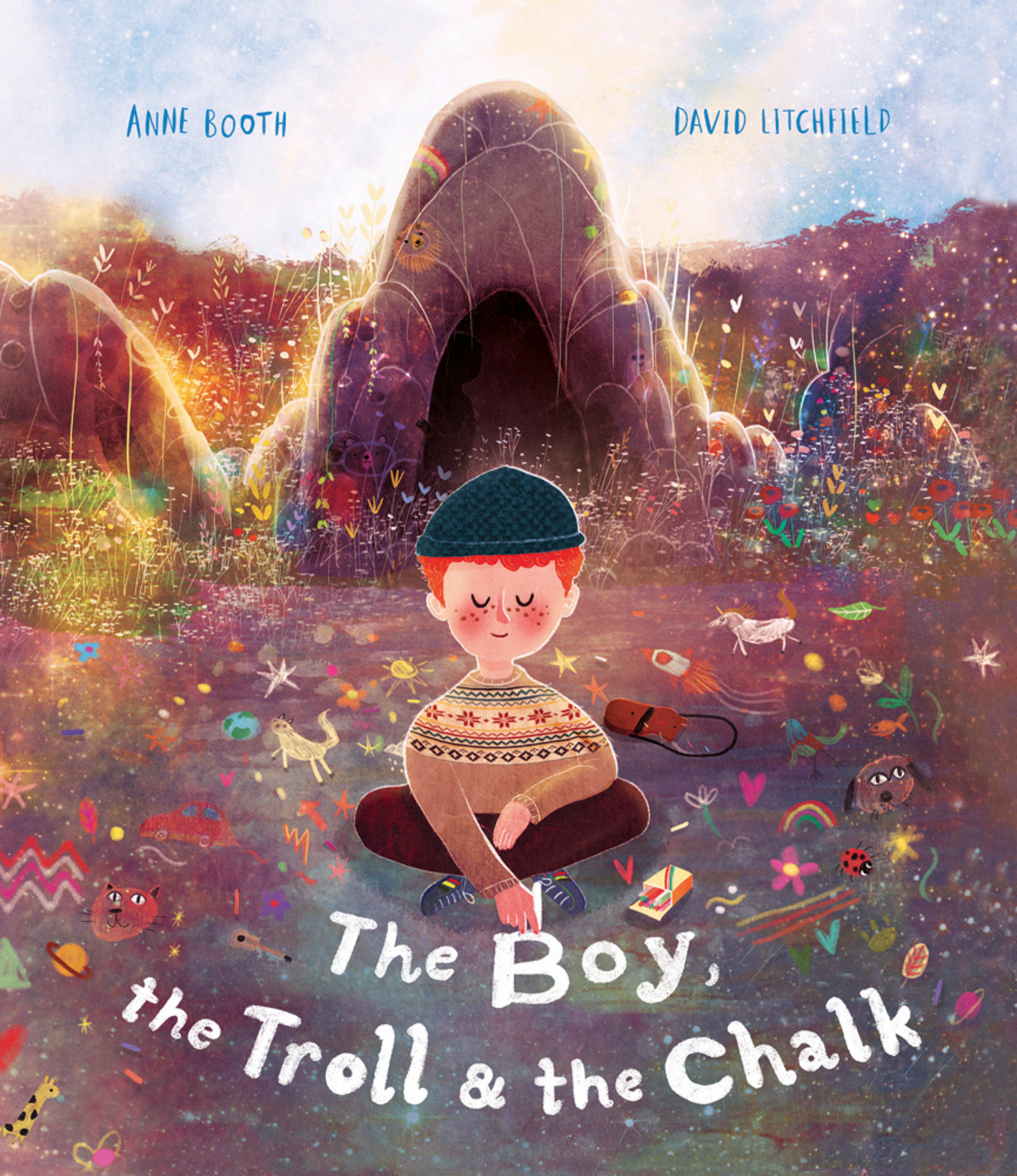

shouted the troll.





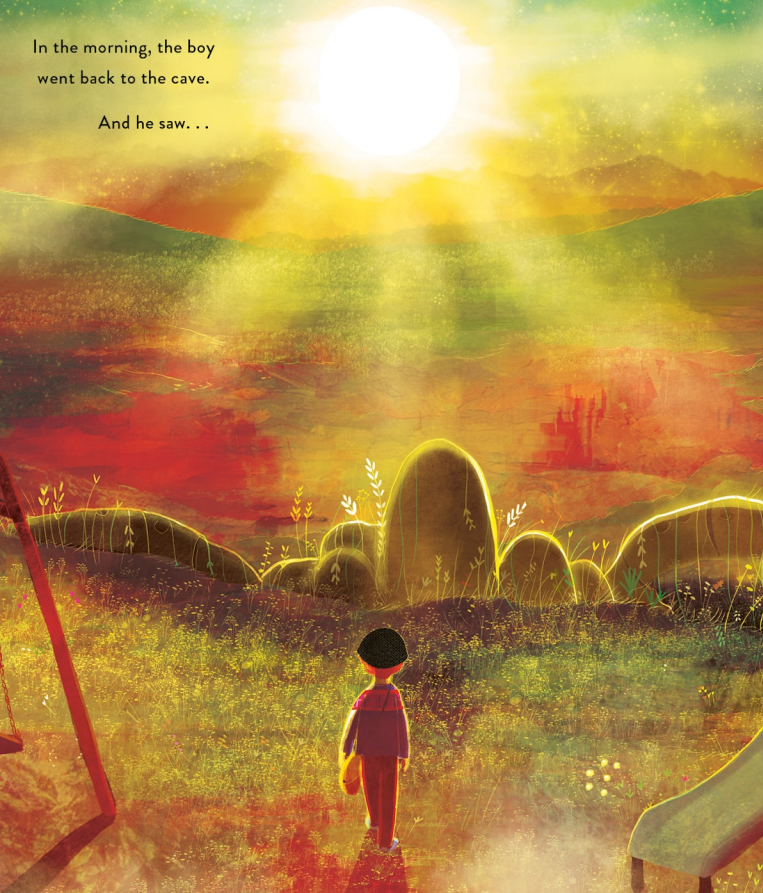
The next day, the boy went back to the cave,
