

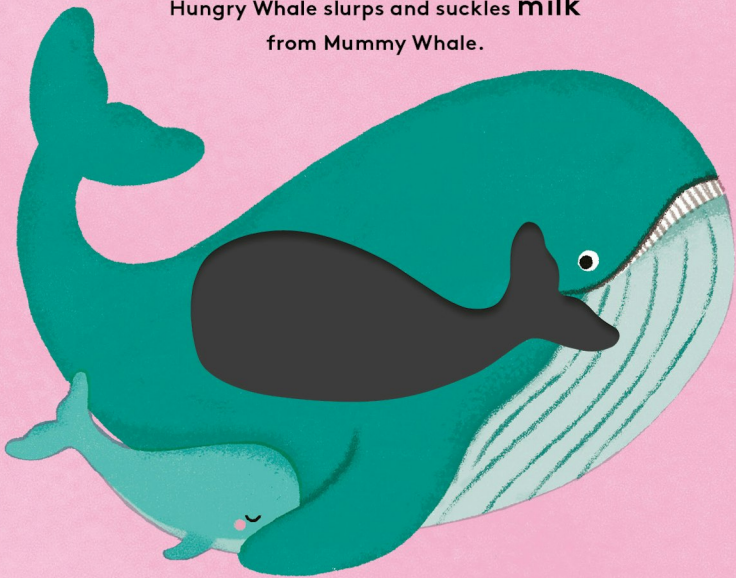

from Mummy Whale.




The milk helps Whale grow a thick

is busy with big **boats**.

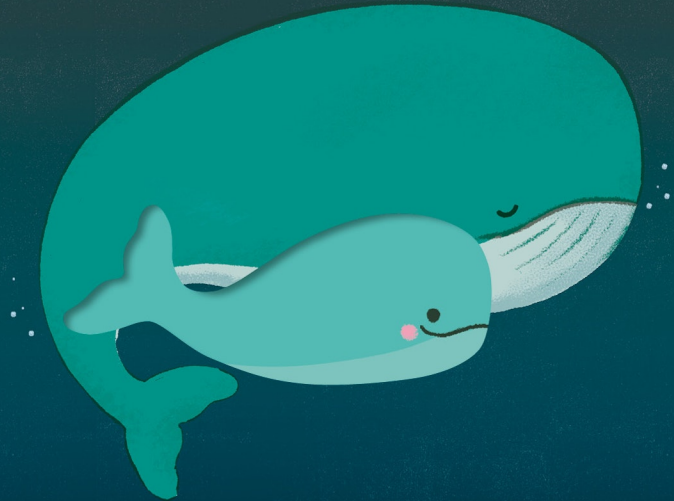
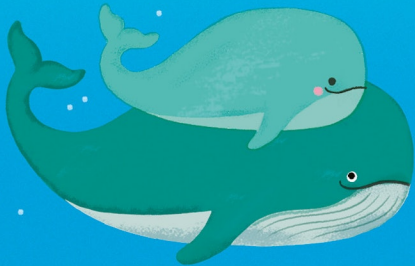
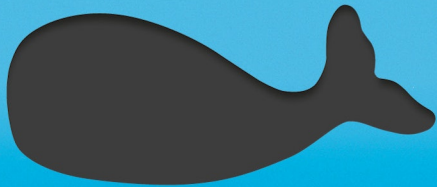
It's tricky for Whale
