This could be tricky...

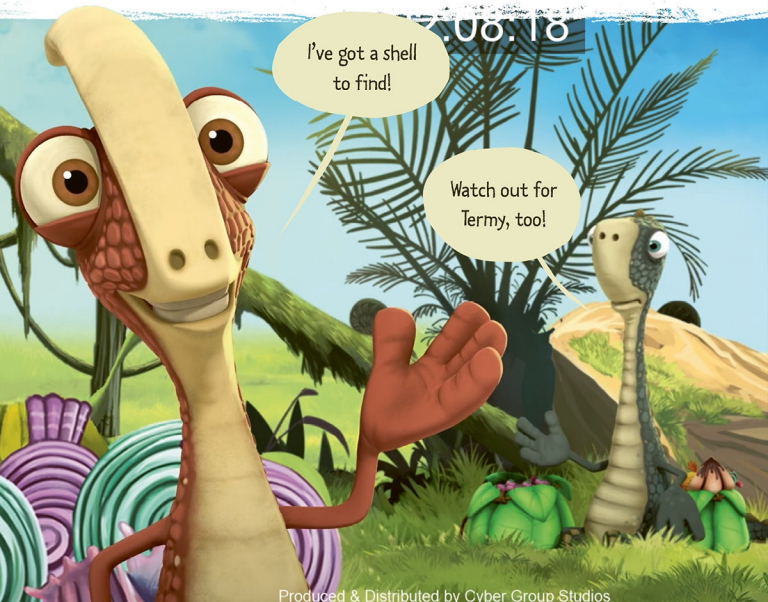
