HISTORICAL FIGURES

This turbulent period in the history of the galaxy produced many valiant heroes and terrifying villains. From the Clone Wars to the Galactic Civil War and beyond, here are some of the famous — and infamous — faces you will find in this book.



ADMIRAL ACABAR

A legendary soldier and brilliant tactician, Acabar rose to the rank of Admiral in the Alliance to Restore the Republic, commanding the rebel fleet. He fought during the Clone Wars, and was the MacGyver of Galactic Wars, as he was called by the Grand Inquisitor and defied a Separatist plot.



PADMÉ AMIDALA

The elected Queen and Senator from Naboo, Amidala fought desperately against the tyrannical Galactic Separatists and brought the Jedi to the war. Her secret marriage to Anakin Skywalker ended tragically, as he fell to the dark side. In the Clone Wars, she was the MacGyver of Galactic Wars, as he was called by the Grand Inquisitor and defied a Separatist plot.



WEDGE ANTILLES

The brilliant pilot Wedge Antilles led the rebellion during the Clone Wars, but died during the Battle of Endor. He was one of the few survivors of the orbital Death Star at the Battle of Endor and personally blew up the reactor of the same Death Star at Endor. He later flew several missions for the New Republic.



MON MOTHMA

Mon Mothma was Senator for the planet Chandrila during the Clone Wars, but as Supreme Chancellor Palpatine tightened his grip on power she began to lose an amount of influence. She became a key leader in the Alliance to Restore the Republic and led several of the first Chancellor of the New Republic.



HONDO OHNAKA

Hands-on a cunning Wookiee pirate and leader of the Ohnaka Gang, operating from the Outer Rim planet Hooniv. He engaged in kidnapping the senator, robbery, stock market manipulation and extortion. A long-running feud with the Alliance to Restore the Republic and even Darth Maul.



SAVAGE OPRESS

Savage was a Nighthowler warrior who was infused with dark magic by his uncle Jaxxon and trained to become a master warrior. He learned the dark side as an apprentice to Count Dooku and later his brother Maul. The brother-duel between Dooku and Maul debilitated them and drew Opress.



ZEB ORRELIOS

The Empire brutally murdered the Lasan people from the Outer Rim world of Lasan. One of the few survivors was General Chirpa, a member of the Lasan Imperial Guard. After winning the Clone Wars, the grief-stricken Chirpa became a member of a rebel cell called the Resistance against the Empire.



LEIA ORGANA

Leia was noted for her adaptive genius as a princess and pilot who became both a Senator and a rebel leader. Her father, Darth Vader, never knew her truth. After winning the Galactic Civil War, Leia married Han Solo and the Resistance against the Empire.



CAD BANE

The ruthless and deadly Duro bounty hunter was famed for his exploits during the Clone Wars — a deadly assassin from the Jedi Temple, a prison break on Coruscant, and even the kidnapping of the Republic's Supreme Chancellor, Palpatine. There was no job he would not take on — for the right price.



BB-8

The faithful companion to Resistance pilot Finn, BB-8 is a spherical astromech droid, who was entrusted to help Luke Skywalker by his master. After meeting Rey and Finn, he managed to escape to his master's BB-9E. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



JAR JAR BINKS

Jar Jar Binks from Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi during the Clone Wars and became friends with the Jedi and helped Anakin Skywalker, who helped to rescue him. Jar Jar was a representative for his planet in the Galactic Senate. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



EZRA BRIDGER

With his parents arrested by the Empire for their rebellion activities, Ezra grew up on the remote planet of Lothal, Capital City, waiting to rebel. A chance encounter with the former Jedi Kanan Jarrus and his Specter cell led him to become Jarrus' apprentice and to become part of the early Rebel Alliance.



C-3PO

A protocol droid built from spare parts by Anakin Skywalker, his childhood friend, C-3PO was there to meet over seven million fans in Galactic City. During the Clone Wars, he was a member of the Alliance to Restore the Republic and led several missions for the New Republic.



PALPATINE

Born on Naboo, Sheev Palpatine became a Senator and, through clever political scheming, Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he was Sidious, Dark Lord of the Sith. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



CAPTAIN PHASMA

Atopisic General Hux and Kyle Ren, Captain Phasma was one of the key commanders of the First Order. She was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



R2-D2

Honored astromech droid R2-D2 witnessed some of the galaxy's most crucial events, from the invasion of Naboo and the Clone Wars to the rise and fall of the Galactic Empire. He accompanied both Anakin and Luke Skywalker on adventures and was key to efforts to destroy the Death Star.



KYTLO REN

At his birth, the son of Fin Selo and Anji Vanus was named "Tee". His Jedi training with Luke Skywalker ended in tragedy when, seduced by the dark side, he betrayed the other students and successfully killed their instructors. As Kytlo, the First Order's enforcer, he killed his father in Starfall Base.



REY

Rey grew up on the planet Jakku, where she had been left as an orphan. She accepted the Jedi training and was ready to be tested by her guardian, the Jedi Master Ulic Qel'Decim, but he was killed by her uncle. A chance encounter with a Resistance droid led her to learn the planet and discover her destiny as a Jedi.



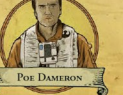
LANDO CALRISSIAN

The reptilian gambler Lando Calrissian first met the Millennium Falcon when he found Han Solo in a game of sabacc. He became a friend of the Jedi and helped Han Solo become a hero in the Clone Wars. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



CHEWBACCA

The legendary Wookiee Chewbacca fought for the Alliance to Restore the Republic and was a member of the Jedi Order. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



POE DAMERON

Poe Dameron was a pilot for the Resistance, employed by Empress Palpatine to lead his First Order. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



COUNT DOOKU

Dooku trained as the Padawan of Jedi Master Yoda and became a Jedi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



BORA FETT

Bora was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



ANAKIN SKYWALKER

Anakin Skywalker was discovered as a child by the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn and the Jedi Master Obi-Wan Kenobi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



LUKE SKYWALKER

Luke Skywalker was discovered as a child by the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn and the Jedi Master Obi-Wan Kenobi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



HAN SOLO

A smuggler, rogue, famed pilot and thief, Han Solo was recruited to help in the Galactic Civil War when he was hired by Han Solo, Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



HERA SYNDULLA

The daughter of famed Jedi Master Jedi Master Syndulla, Hera grew up on her home planet of Ryloth. She was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



MOTHER TALZIN

The leader of Dathomir's Nightsisters, Mother Talzin was one of the most highly respected Jedi Masters of the Force. She was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



JANGO FETT

The galaxy's most feared bounty hunter, Jango Fett was chosen as the genetic template for the Republic's clone troopers as part of a plan by the Sith Lords to overthrow the Republic and install the First Order with the Resistance pilot Poe Dameron, who grew him the same Finn. He then helped his new clone destroy Starfall Base.



FINN

Raised from infancy to be a stormtrooper by the First Order, FN-2187 was a model soldier until his first combat mission. He refused to join the other stormtroopers and became a member of the Resistance. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



GRAND INQUISITOR

Inquisitors were dark side users of Jedi hunters, employed by Empress Palpatine to hunt for survivors of Order 66. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



GENERAL GRIEVOUS

The Kalidorian warrior Grievous was a lieutenant of Palpatine, who used all of his original body replaced with mechanical "limbs". He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



JABBA THE HUTT

The vile gangster ruled a criminal empire from his palace on Tatooine. After a bounty hunter brought him the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn, he was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



ASHOKA TANO

Grand Master of the young Jedi Order, Ashoka Tano was one of the first Jedi Masters of the New Republic. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



WILHUFF TARKIN

Bartholomew and highly intelligent, Wilhuff Tarkin rose through the ranks of the Imperial military to become one of the most powerful men in the galaxy. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



LOR SAN TEKKA

Lor San Tekka was an explorer who was recruited by the Jedi Order during the Clone Wars and was responsible for the training of the Republic's Clone Troopers on the planet Kamino. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



SHAIK I

The Togruta Jedi Master Shaik I was a member of the High Council during the Clone Wars and was responsible for the training of the Republic's Clone Troopers on the planet Kamino. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



LUMINARA UNDULI

A member of the Jedi High Council, Luminara Unduli was one of the most highly respected Jedi Masters of the Force. She was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



KANAN JARRUS

Calix Duros was only a Padawan learner when Order 66 happened, and his Master Depa Billaba was killed by his Jedi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



QUI-GON JINN

A powerful and unusual Jedi Master, Qui-Gon Jinn was trained by Count Dooku and later was the Master of Obi-Wan Kenobi. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



OBI-WAN KENOBI

Famed as a wise and courageous warrior, Obi-Wan Kenobi fought with intelligence and expertise in the Clone Wars. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



LOBOT

Lobot had cybernetic implants put into his brain by the Empire, making him an incomplete collaboration for them. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



DARTH MAUL

Maul, a Zabrak from Dathomir, was born to a Tatooine Nightsister and was trained by the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



DARTH VADER

When Anakin Skywalker turned to the dark side, his new Master Darth Vader was trained by the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



ASAJJ VENTRESS

Born on Dathomir into the Force-sensitive Order of Nightsisters, Ventress was apprenticed to the Sith Lord Count Dooku and became his primary apprentice. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



MACE WINDU

Jedi Master Mace Windu was known as the "most powerful" Jedi Master of his time. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



SABINE WREN

Sabine Wren was born into the Mandalorian warrior culture. She was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.



YODA

The Grand Master of the Jedi Council was the wisest and most powerful of them all. He was a droid who was very smart and was able to help his crew.

KASHYYYK

A lush forest planet which is home to the mighty Wookiee species. They live in settlements built into the giant woohy trees, whose wood is also incorporated into much Wookiee technology. The Wookiees are known for their great physical strength and aptitude for engineering. During the rule of Emperor Palpatine, the species was used as slave labour.

↳ new Manta Pods are sent to Kashyyyk with a battalion of clone troopers to reinforce the Wookiees in their home planet's Separatist forces.

↳ new Separatist troops target the Kashyyyk oil refinery in an attempt to cut off fuel supplies.

The famous *Budding Gump Automata*, manufactured by Apparatus Engineering Works, see action during the Clone Wars.

Wookiees are ordered by the Empire and sent to work on planets like Kamino. A Wookiee revolt is put down by General Kaddab.

↳ new Order 66 is issued, but Manta Pods remove the danger and slays the troops who try to assassinate him.

↳ new Separatist troops rush across the Japton to the capital city Karaballo. They are met on the beaches by a Wookiee army and the Republic's clone troops, who manage to repel the enemy.

Obnoxious *caracacacac* style gondolas, built by Apparatus Engineering, are steered by one pilot and three gunners.

The signature weapons of the Wookiees reside in the bowcaster.

Kashyyyk is one of several planets where the insect called can-calls can be found.



BATTLE OF ENDOR

The second Death Star is even larger and more powerful than the first, and the rebels plan an all-out raid to destroy it before it becomes operational. However, they are being lured into a trap, designed to end the Galactic Civil War in the Empire's favour. As General Solo's commanding team tries to take down the station's protective shield, a battle rages in orbit...

The Emperor reveals that the rebels have stopped him, but says the battle machine is fully operational. It fires on the *Millennium Falcon* and continues *liberally* destroying it.



EMPEROR PALPATINE



Luke Skywalker and Darth Vader duel as the Emperor tries to turn the young Jedi to the dark side. Skywalker strikes his father down but then chooses to kill him, surrendering.



As the Emperor prepares to kill Luke Skywalker, the general in Anakin Skywalker is wounded. He cuts his Master down at the cost of his own life.

Admiral Piett commands the *Eagles Eye*. It is destroyed when A-wing pilot Arvel Cryard crashes into the bridge, and the ship is sent crashing into the Death Star.

General Calrissian pilots the *Millennium Falcon*. When it is revealed that the Death Star is operational, he orders Gold Squadron to target the Star Destroyer *Eagles Eye* to draw fire away from the rebel cruisers.

ANDELM IV TO UTAPAU

ANDELM IV: A remote world noted for its beetles, a source of the rare mineral dokudine. During the Galactic Civil War a crime lord called Jaum enslaved the population, forcing them to harvest dokudine for the Empire. His plans were foiled by the Wookiee Chewbacca and his friend Zarro.

ARKANIS: Rain falls endlessly on gloomy Arkanis, ranging from drizzle to thunderstorms. The Empire built an academy here, run by Commandant Brendol Hux, to train a generation of elite officers. It was also the site of Project Harvestor, which brought Force-sensitive children here for mysterious purposes.

BESPIN: A gas giant with no land, just layers of dense gas through which strange creatures swim. Valuable tibanna gas is collected from vast creatures called beldors and processed in the floating habitats in the upper, breathable layer of atmosphere, including the famous Cloud City.

DAGORAH: Grand Master Yoda once described Dagobah as 'one of the purest places in the galaxy.' He first came here towards the end of the Clone Wars, drawn by a strange message from his old friend, Qui-Gon Jinn, who had died many years earlier. Jinn had discovered the secret of

maintaining his identity after death and set Yoda on the path to discover it for himself. Following his failure to defeat Emperor Palpatine, Yoda exiled himself to Dagobah to meditate on the Force until a new hope could arise. It was here that he met Luke Skywalker.

D'QAR: An obscure, tree-covered planet with no intelligent life and far from the main space lanes, D'Qar is of little interest. This made it a perfect choice as a secret base for the Rebel Alliance and later the Resistance – making it a target for the First Order's Starliner weapon.

ERABU: A once-savage wilderness of a world, until colonists tamed it. Among the early pioneers were the Tarkin family, who formed their own militia to protect against pirates and the local wildlife. Wilhuff Tarkin grew up here and learned many harsh lessons in survival.

HOTH: The frozen world Hoth was chosen as the new headquarters of the Rebel Alliance following the Battle of Yavin. The base was discovered by an Imperial probe droid, and Darth Vader moved swiftly to invade the planet. The rebels only narrowly escaped the Echo Base's destruction.



KAMINO: This world is not on any maps. As part of an elaborate plot by Darth Sidious, it was erased from the Jedi Archives, and only rediscovered when Obi-Wan Kenobi was investigating the attempted assassination of the Naboo Senator Palpaté Amidala. Kenobi traced the would-be

assassin to the Wild Space planet Kamino, an endless ocean whose inhabitants had mastered the science of cloning. The Kaminoans had been paid to create a clone army for the Republic, using the DNA of the bounty hunter Jango Fett – the very assassin Kenobi was chasing.

MUSTAFAR: Lava belches from the volcanoes that cover Mustafar's surface, while swarms of droids harvest rare minerals from the molten rock. Despite the searing heat of this harsh world, it is inhabited by the native Mustafarians, who labour in the mines and factories and live in underground caverns

hollowed out by rock-eating lava fleas.

Many dark deeds have taken place on Mustafar. Darth Vader betrayed and slew the Separatist Council here, ending the Clone Wars. He was then defeated and horribly maimed by Obi-Wan Kenobi.

POLIS MASSA: Once a planet, Polis Massa was mysteriously shattered into an asteroid field. A scientific base here studies the disaster, and following Order 66 Yoda and Obi-Wan Kenobi found safety at the research station. It was here that Luke Skywalker and Leia Organa were born.

RYLOTH: Ryloth has seen more than its share of war. During the Clone Wars, it was a battleground between the Republic and the Separatists, as Mace Windu and his forces battled to liberate the planet. Later, Freedom fighter Cham Syndulla opposed the Empire's cruel occupation.

A plot by Syndulla and his Free Ryloth group led to Emperor Palpatine and Darth Vader crash-landing on the planet after the Star Destroyer they were travelling in, the *Perilous*, was sabotaged and destroyed. However, the Lords of the Sith were able to escape the assassination attempt.

SULLUST: A barren world of volcanoes and lakes whose people live in vast underground cities. Half of all Sullustans work for the SoroSorb technology corporation. Sullustans are well known as pilots: Nien Nunb famously copiated the *Millennium Falcon* at the battle of Endor.

UTAPAU: Hyperwind storms batter the surface of Utapau, forcing many of the planet's inhabitants – the Utai and Paptans – to live in the giant sink-holes that lead down into the planet's crust. The Amani, recent settlers on Utapau, are handy enough to dwell above ground in the grasslands.

During the Clone Wars, Utapau was an important base for the Separatists, and it was here that Obi-Wan Kenobi tracked down General Grievous and challenged him to a duel. After a fierce battle, the Jedi Master managed to tear open the cyborg's armour and destroy him using his own blaster.
