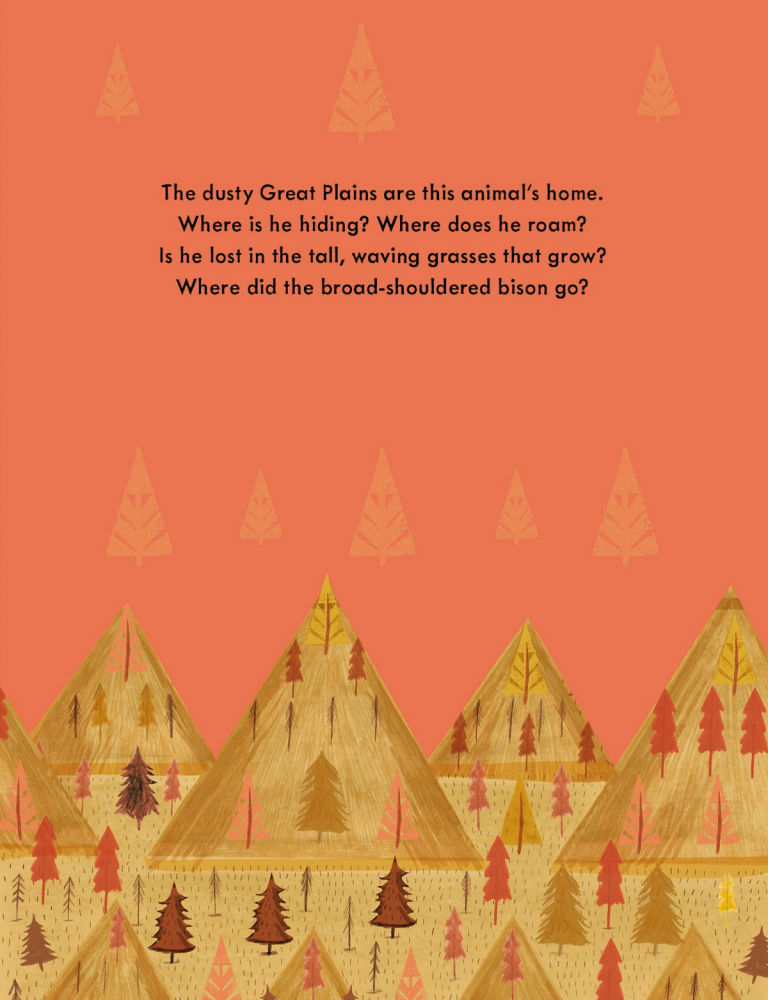

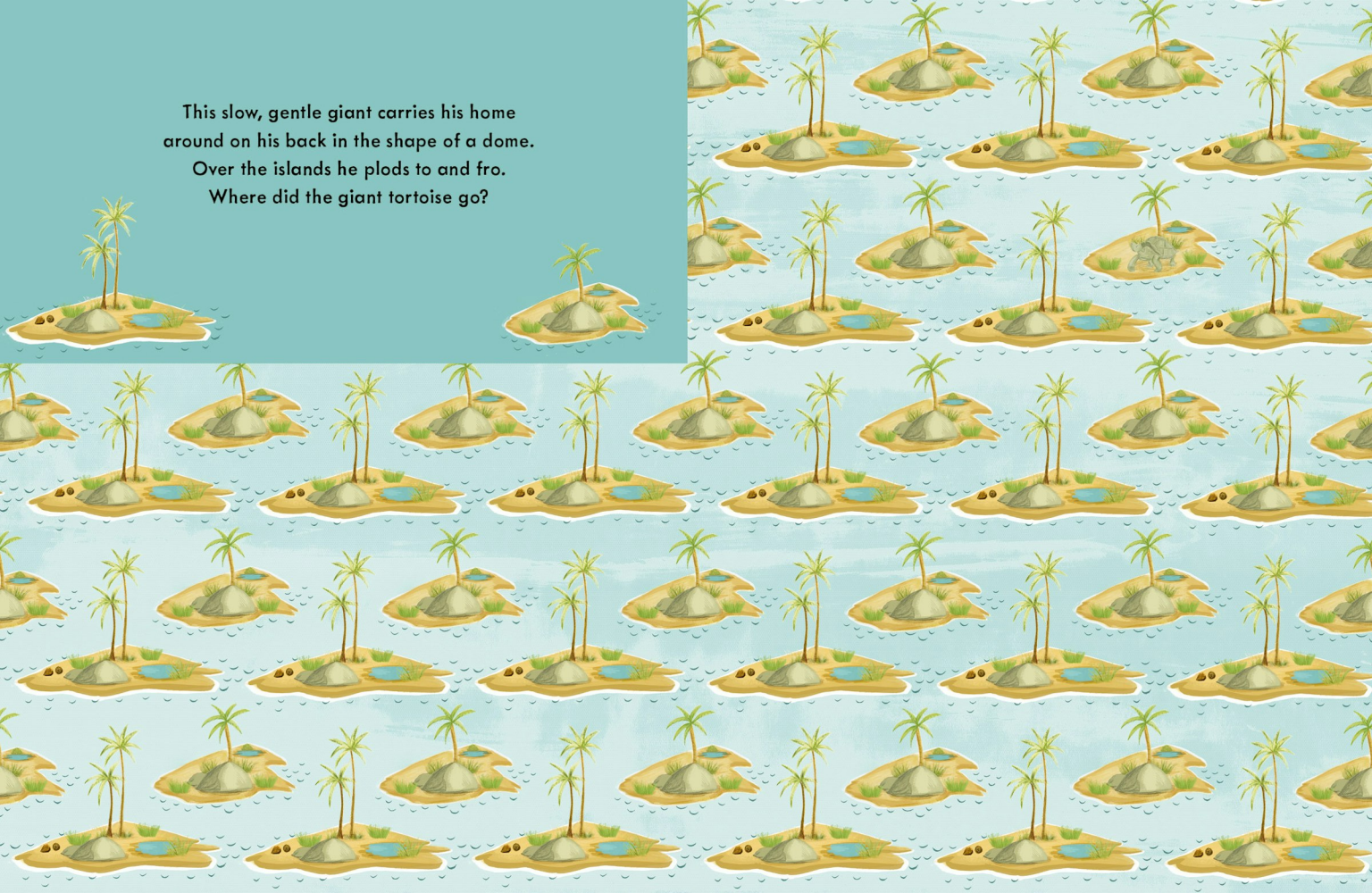
The dusty Great Plains are this animal's home.
