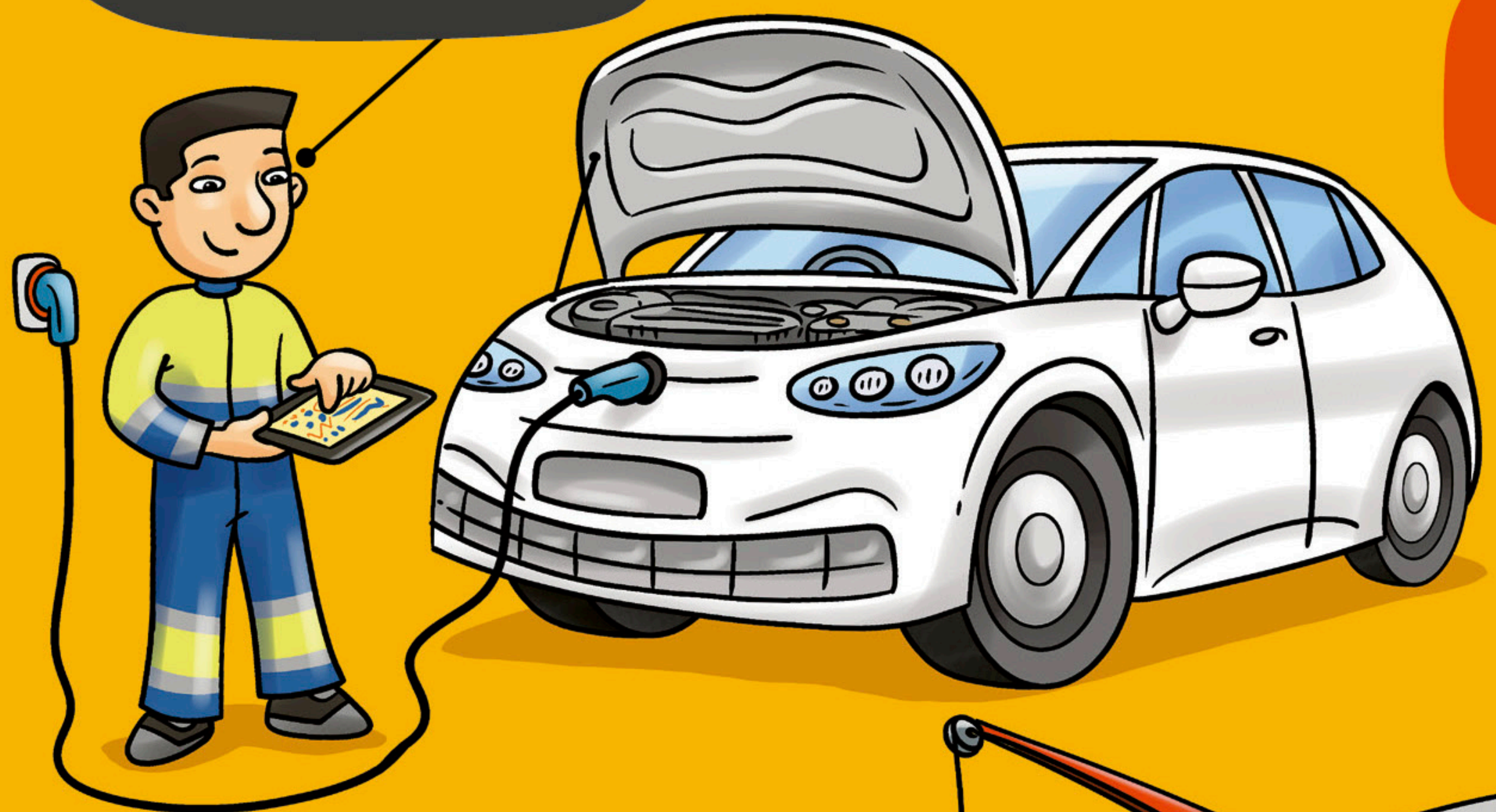

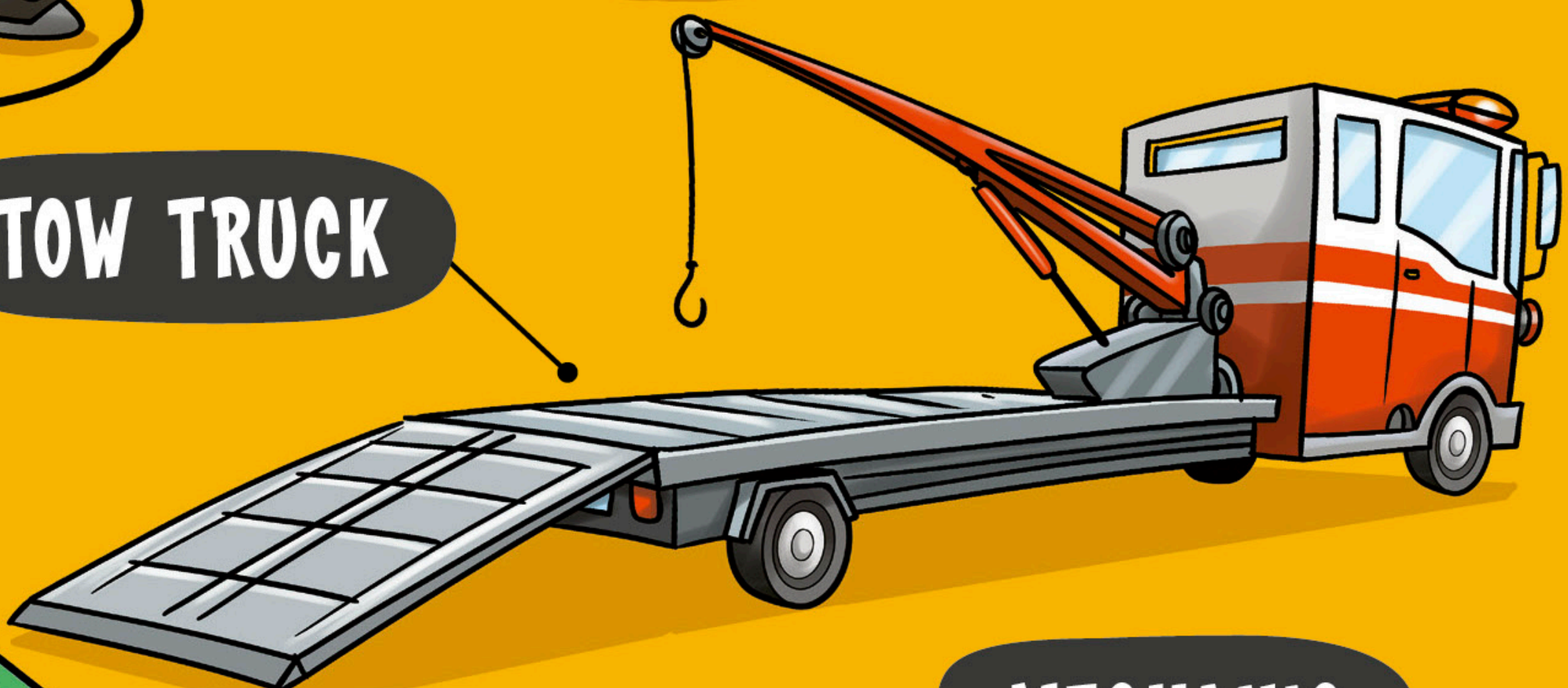

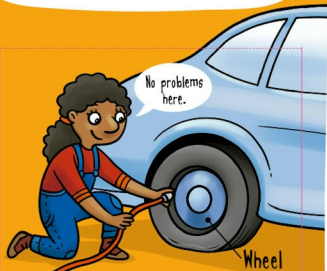

VEHICLE SERVICING

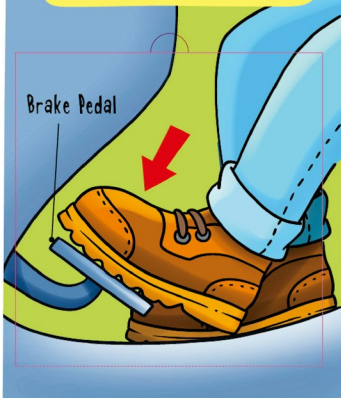
Wheel

Tired tyres

Indicators

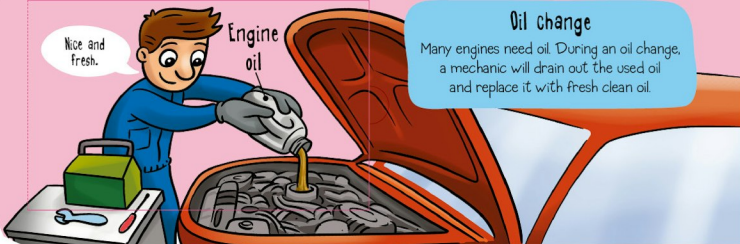
The indicators tell other drivers which way you are going next.
