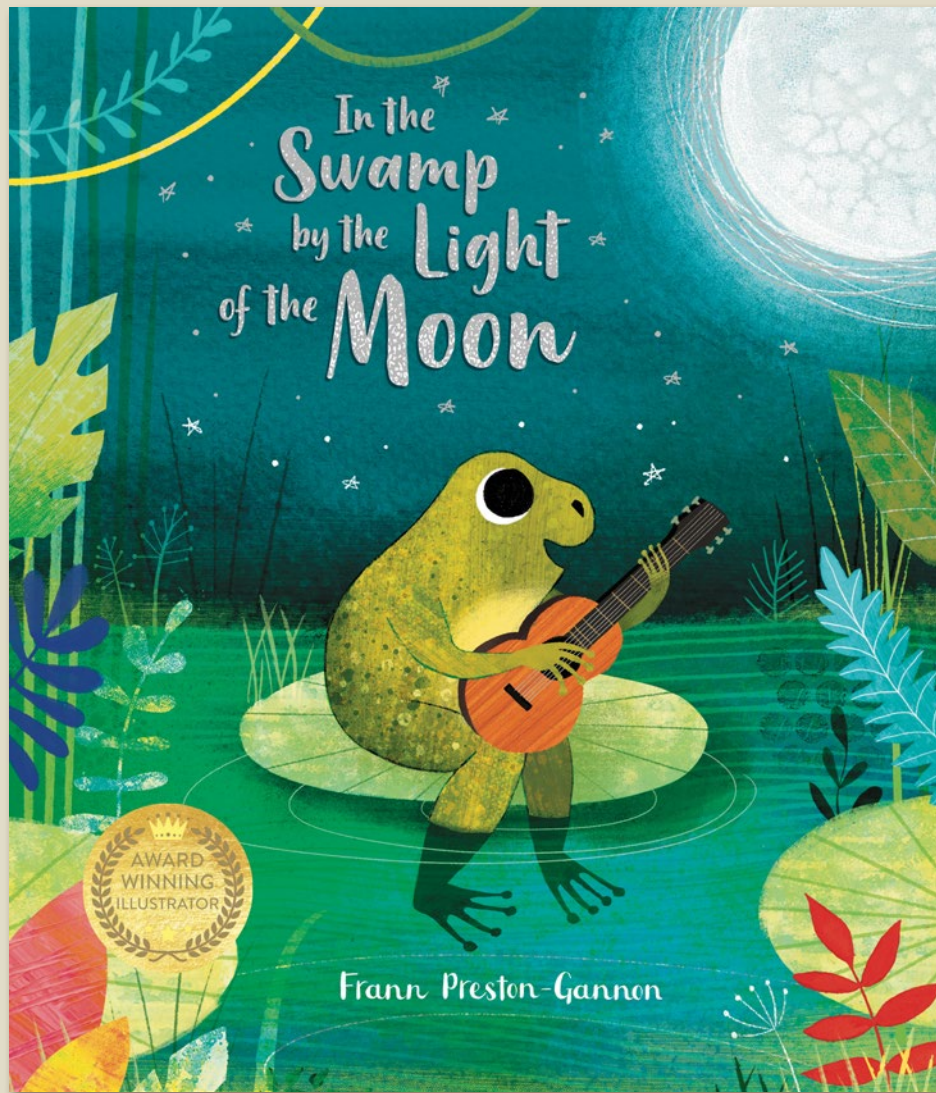


In the Swamp by the Light of the Moon

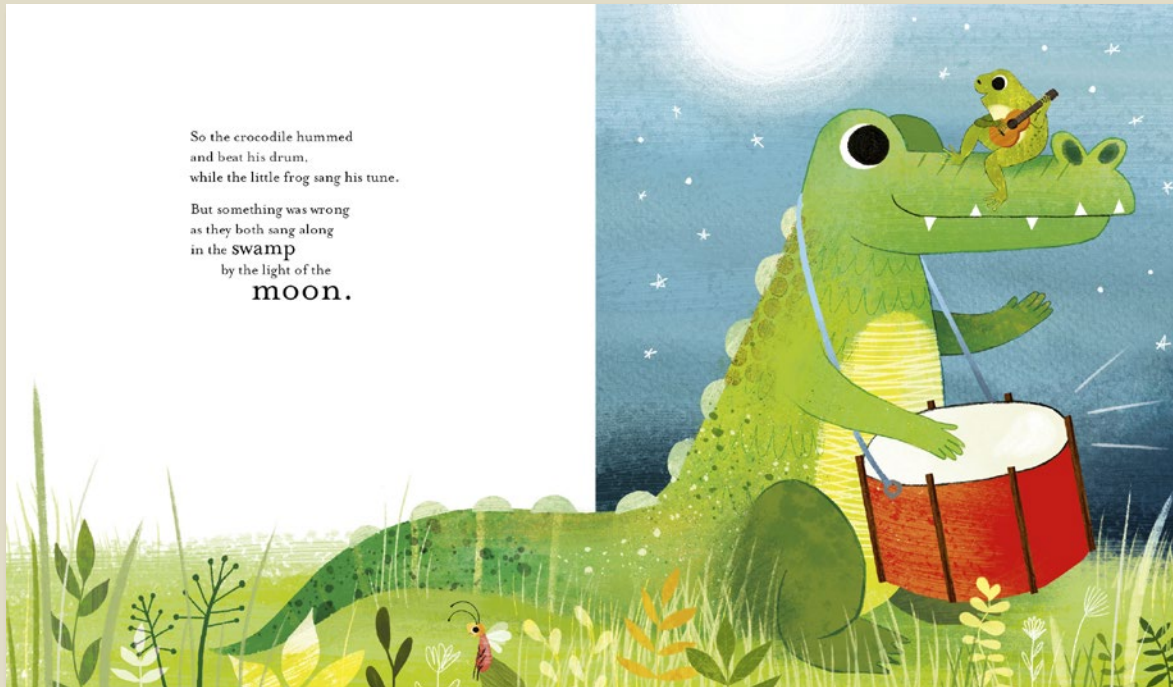
But all by himself his voice was so quiet
