



GENERAL DESCRIPTION: The Tau Warriors have tough, bumpy, like megaliths.

EARTH HABITATS: Although rarely found on Earth, they occasionally appear near active volcanoes. If you look down into a crater, you may be able to spot their crafts, Tau Drones. They are 100% mechanical in appearance.

MISSION: To destroy all Cyberbrains.

NOTES: The Tau are technologically advanced. Their lives, created in volcanic magma tunnels, are packed with gadgets, and their heart-generating units for use in cold habitats are terrific feats of engineering.
