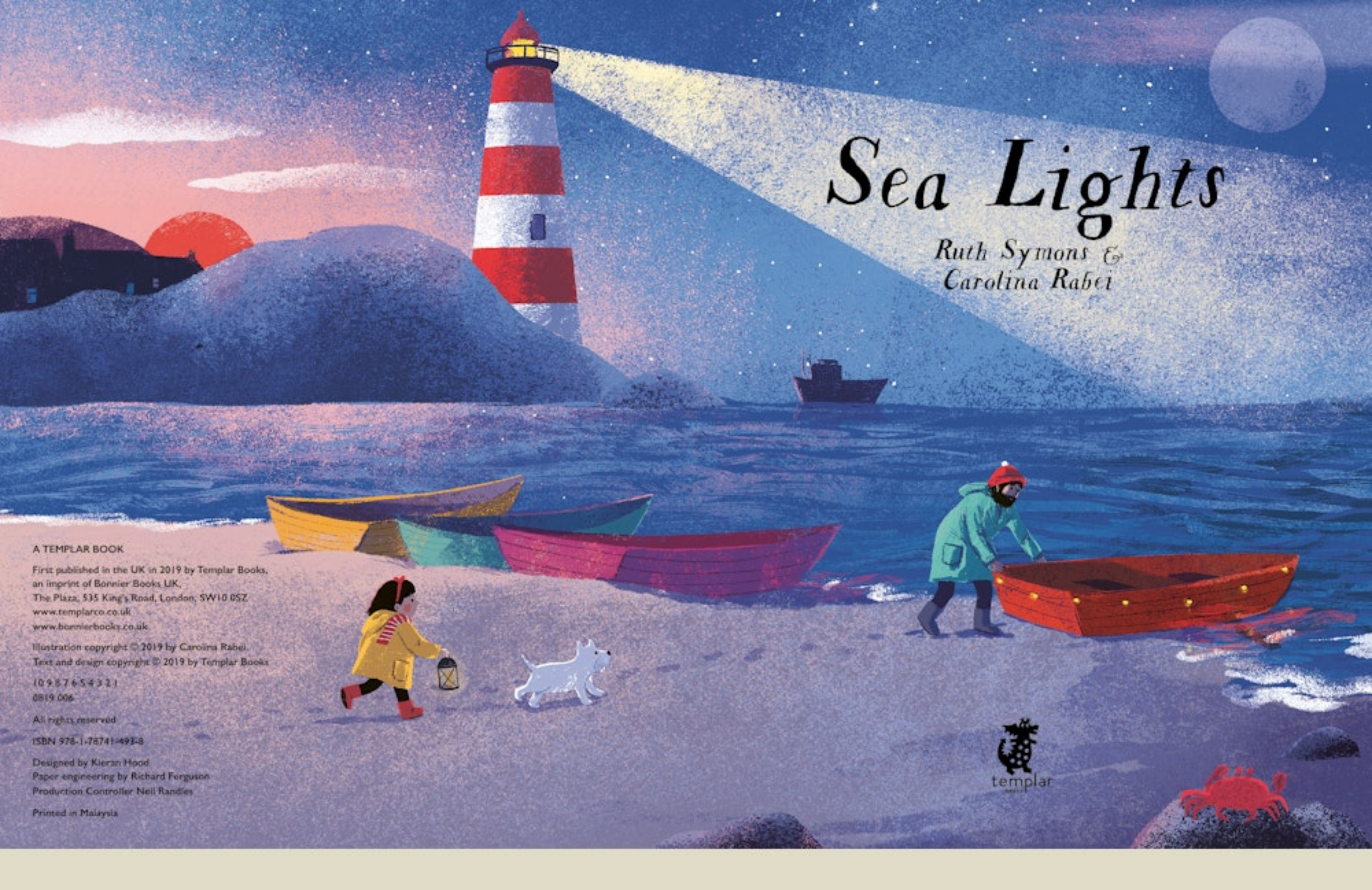


Sea Lights

and the moonlight guides us home.



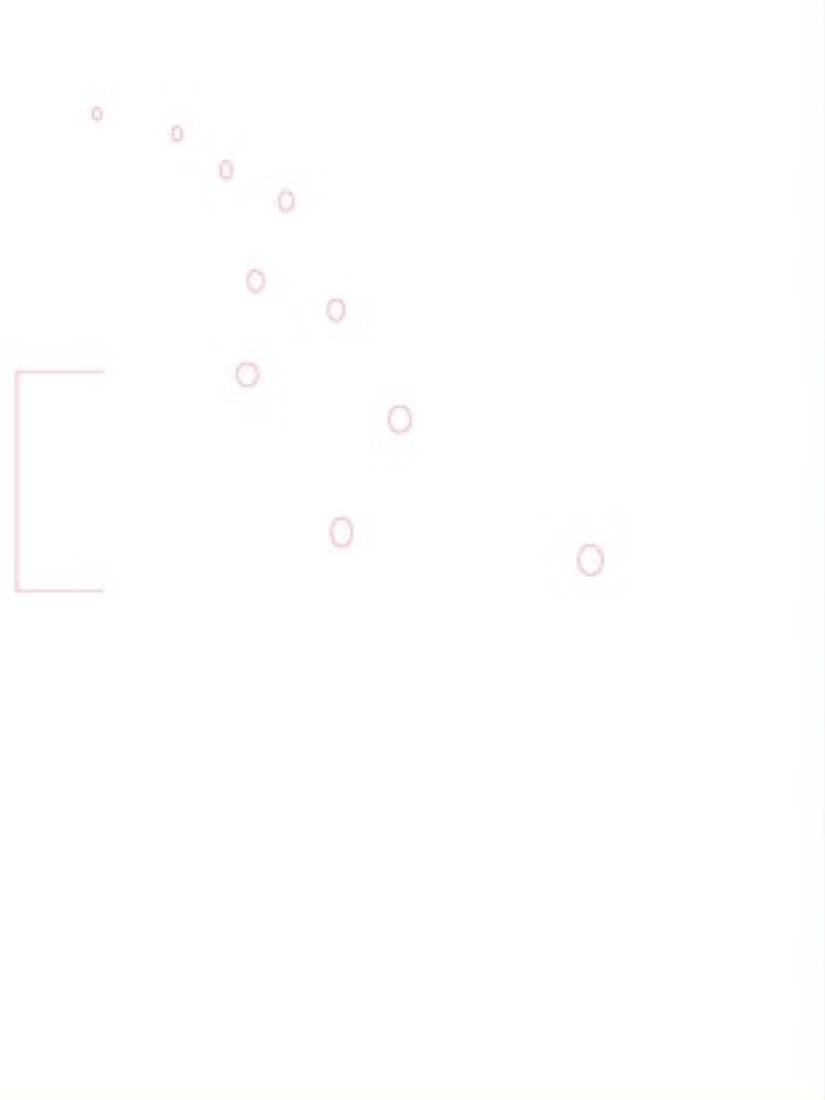


Cliffs loom above us, waves crash on the rocks
