She’s escaped!”

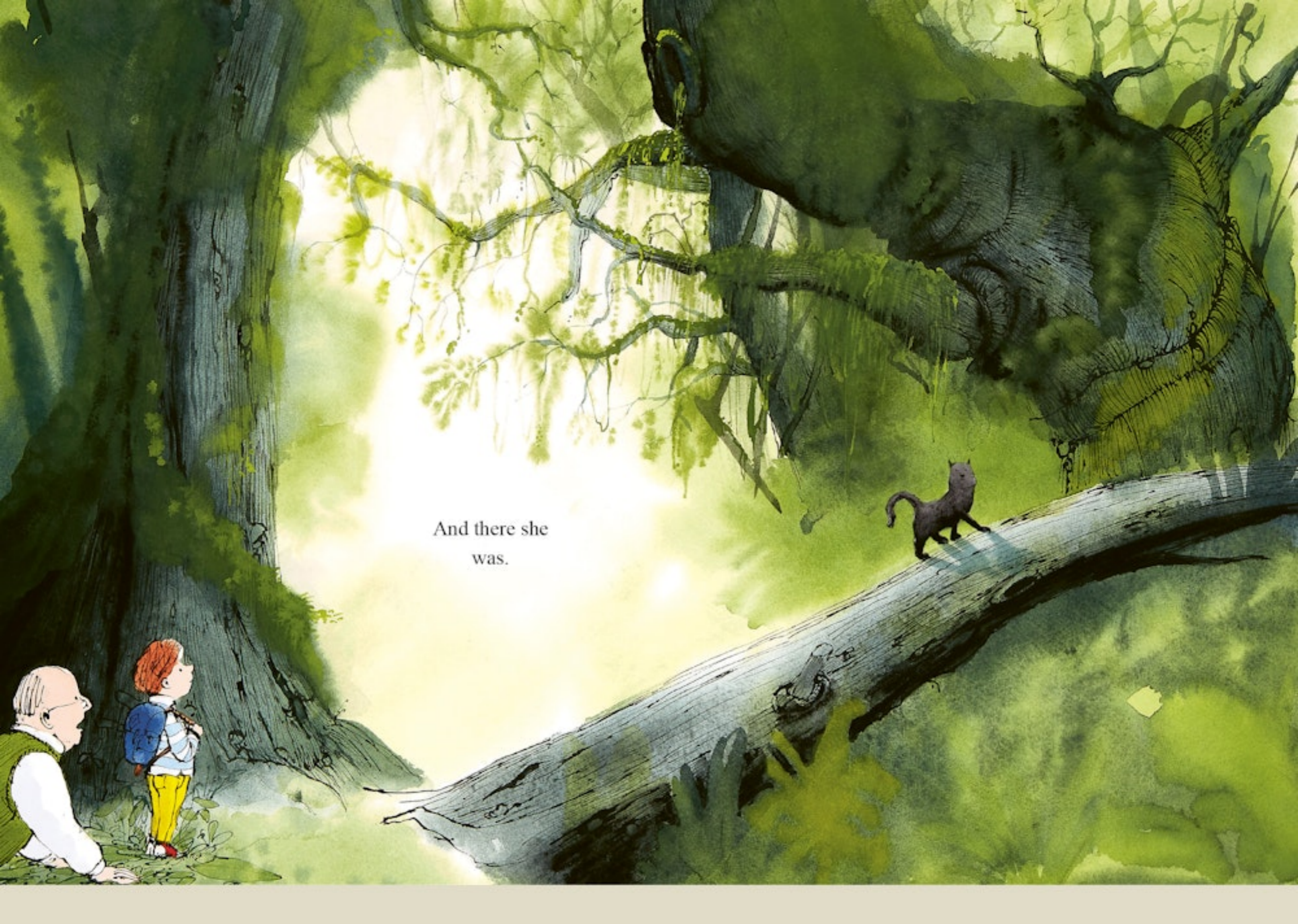


There wasn't a moment to lose!

follow her.



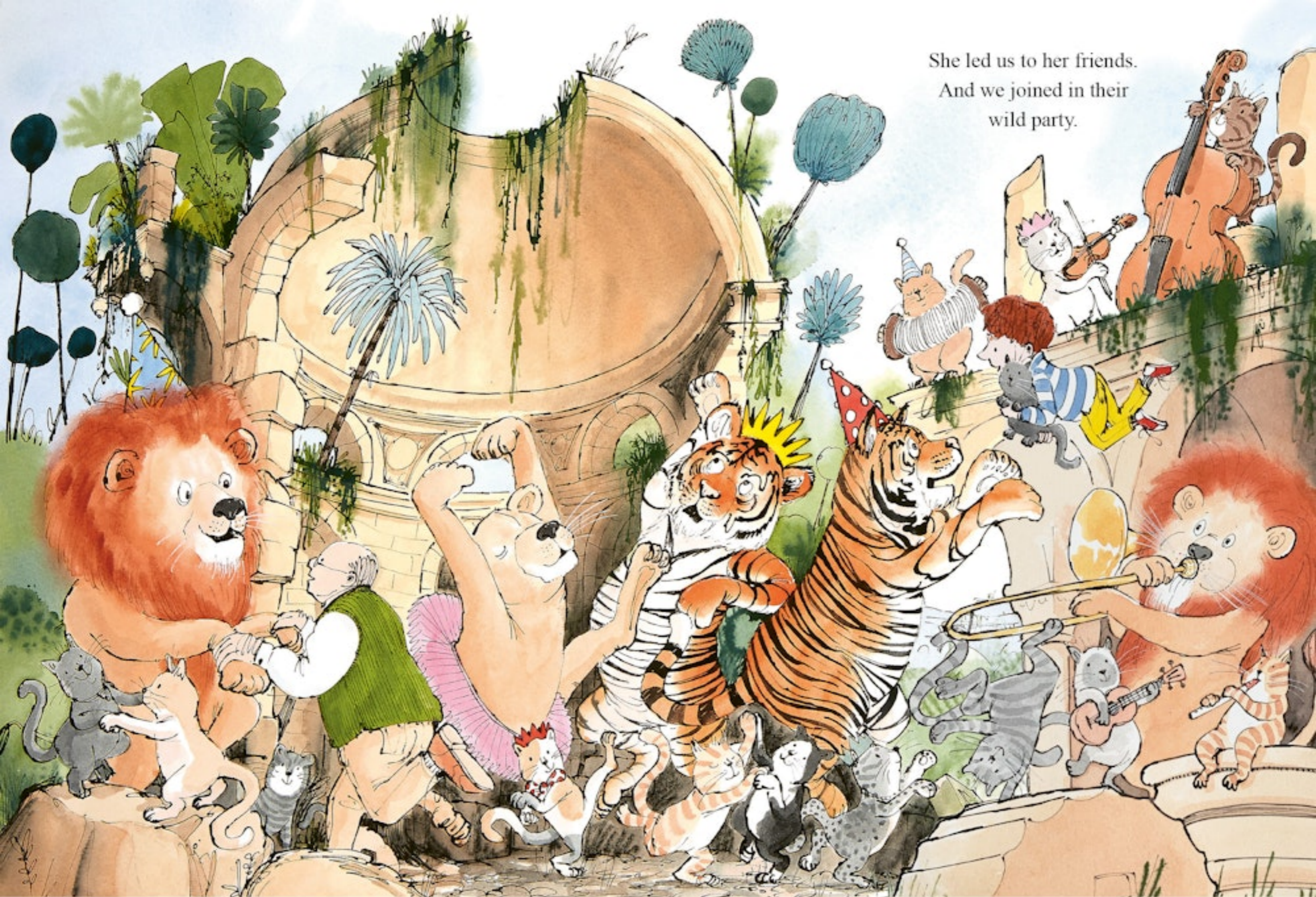
And got lost along

wild party.



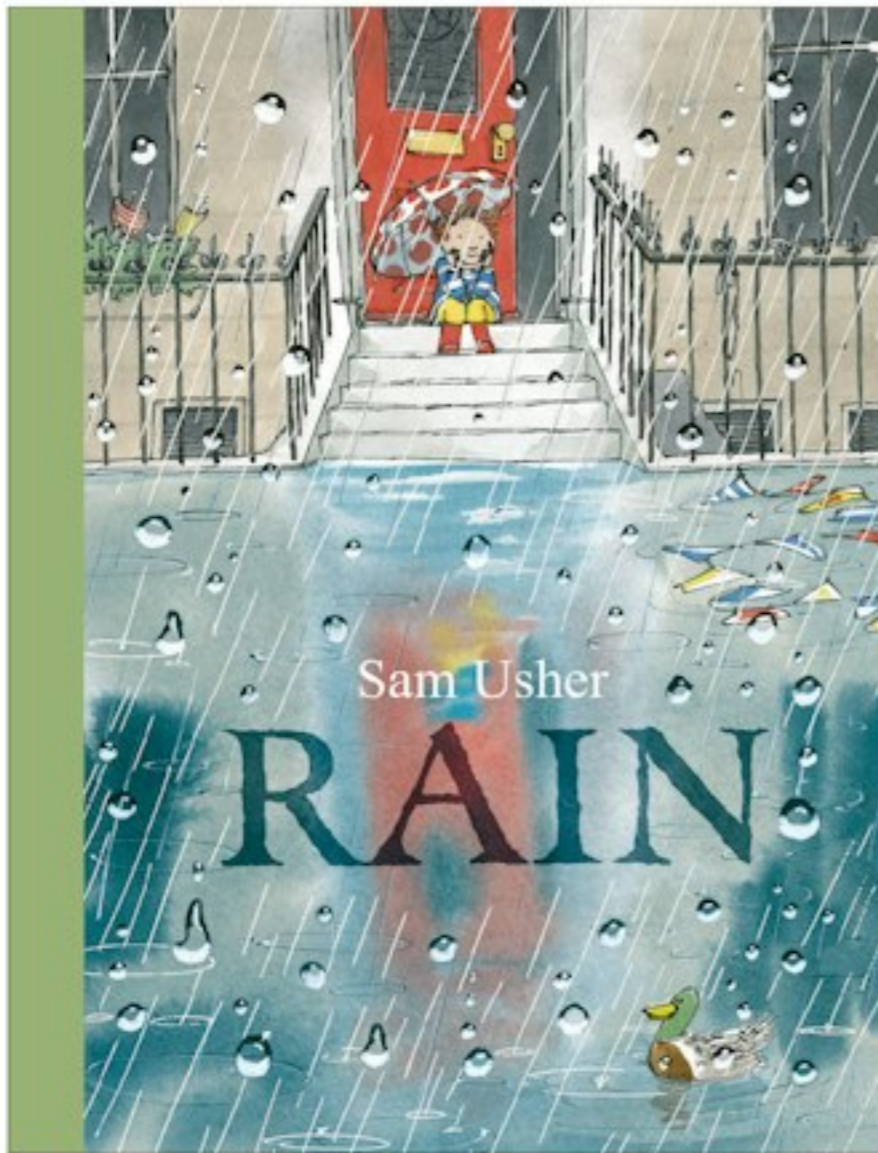


Back at home,

have in store!”

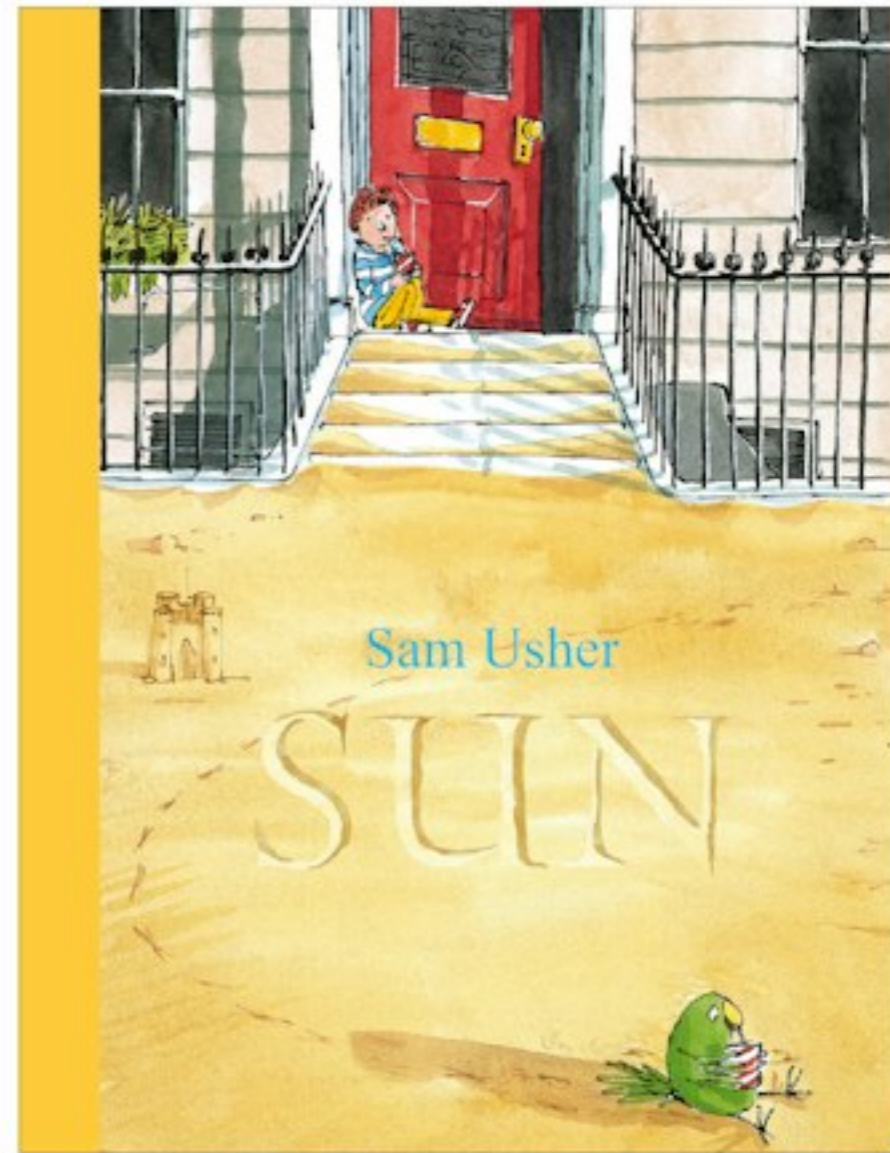
And I agreed.

stay again tomorrow?”



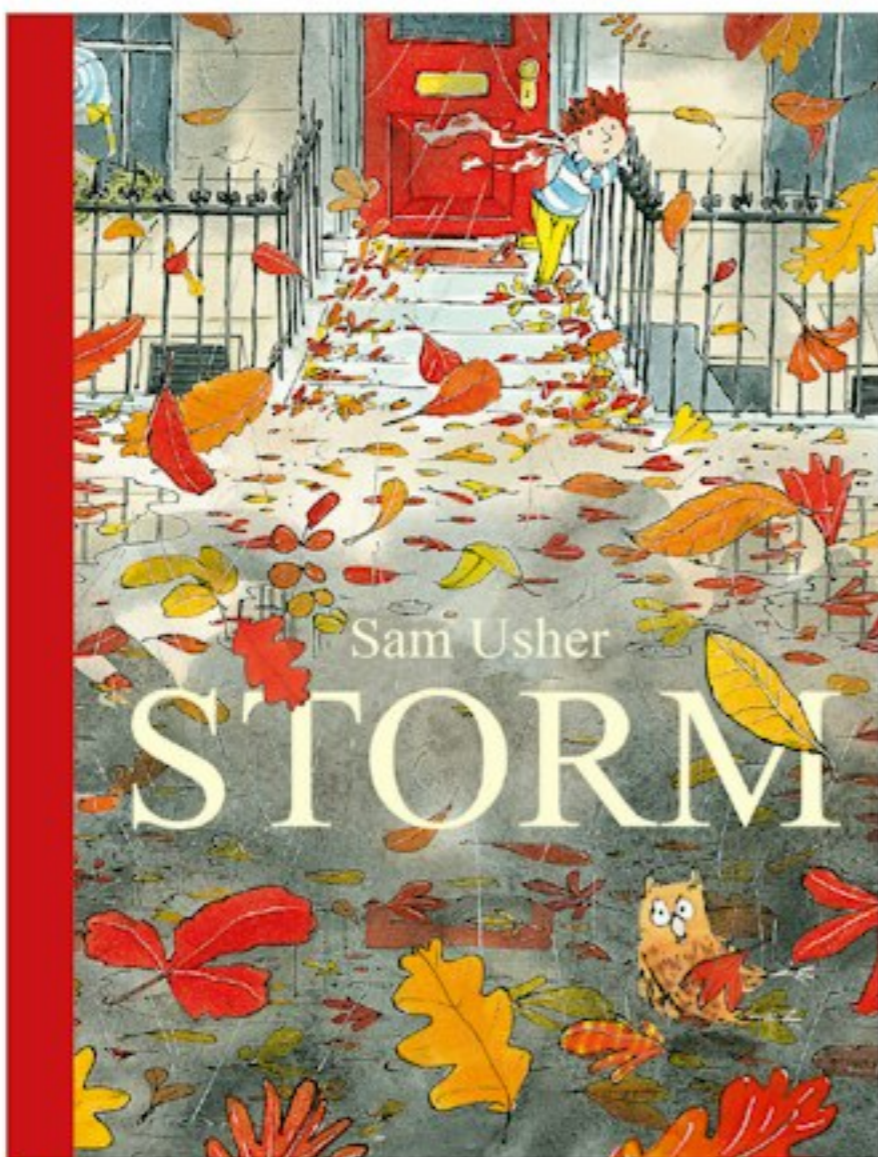

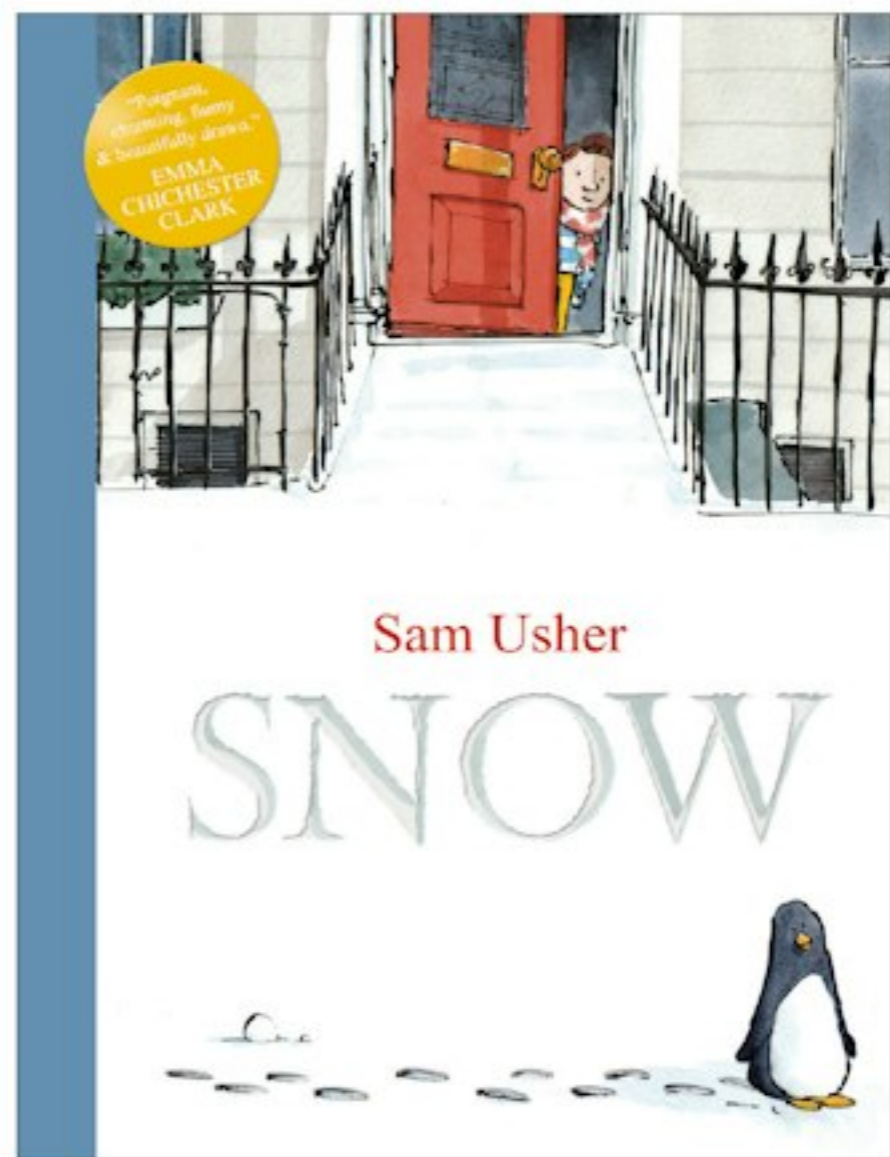
