














Hello Ben, I'm MEGAMESS!

That's why I'm here. We're going to take this mess to the NEXT LEVEL!"






"Not a bad idea," said Megamess.

He put lids on the pens,




then stacked some paper plates,




and collected the cans and bottles.












Cease! Desist!
