The dinos hopped aboard their new lilly pad boats and rowed out into the lake. "What are we looking for again?" Bill asked.




"ARRRGH!"

Everyone else soon followed on bubbles of


soared high over the lake.

Rocky tried to get closer but the fireflies sped off.




"When you've got to glow, you've got to glow!" Tiny giggled.
