

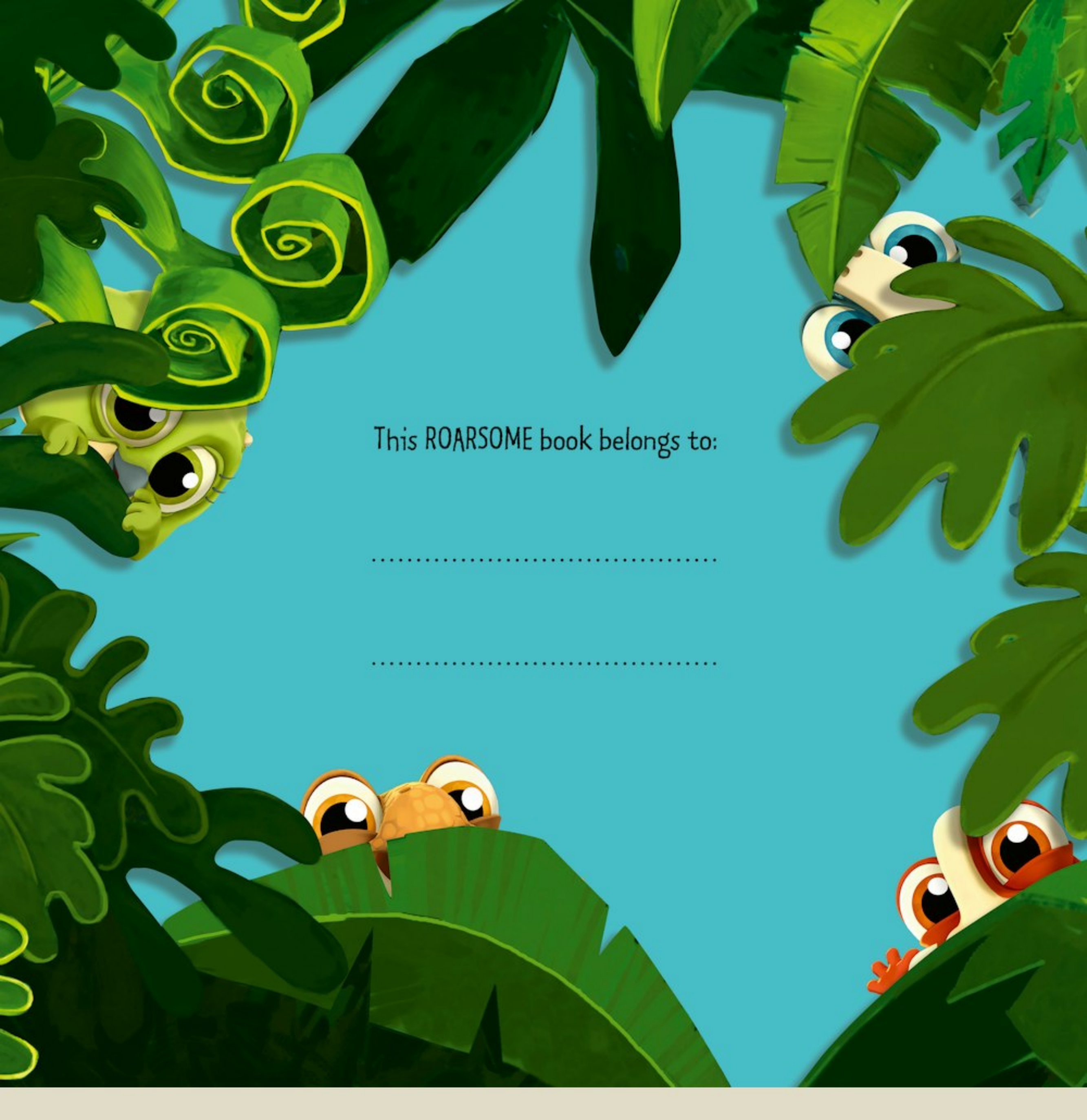

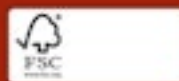

Could it be Termy coming back again?

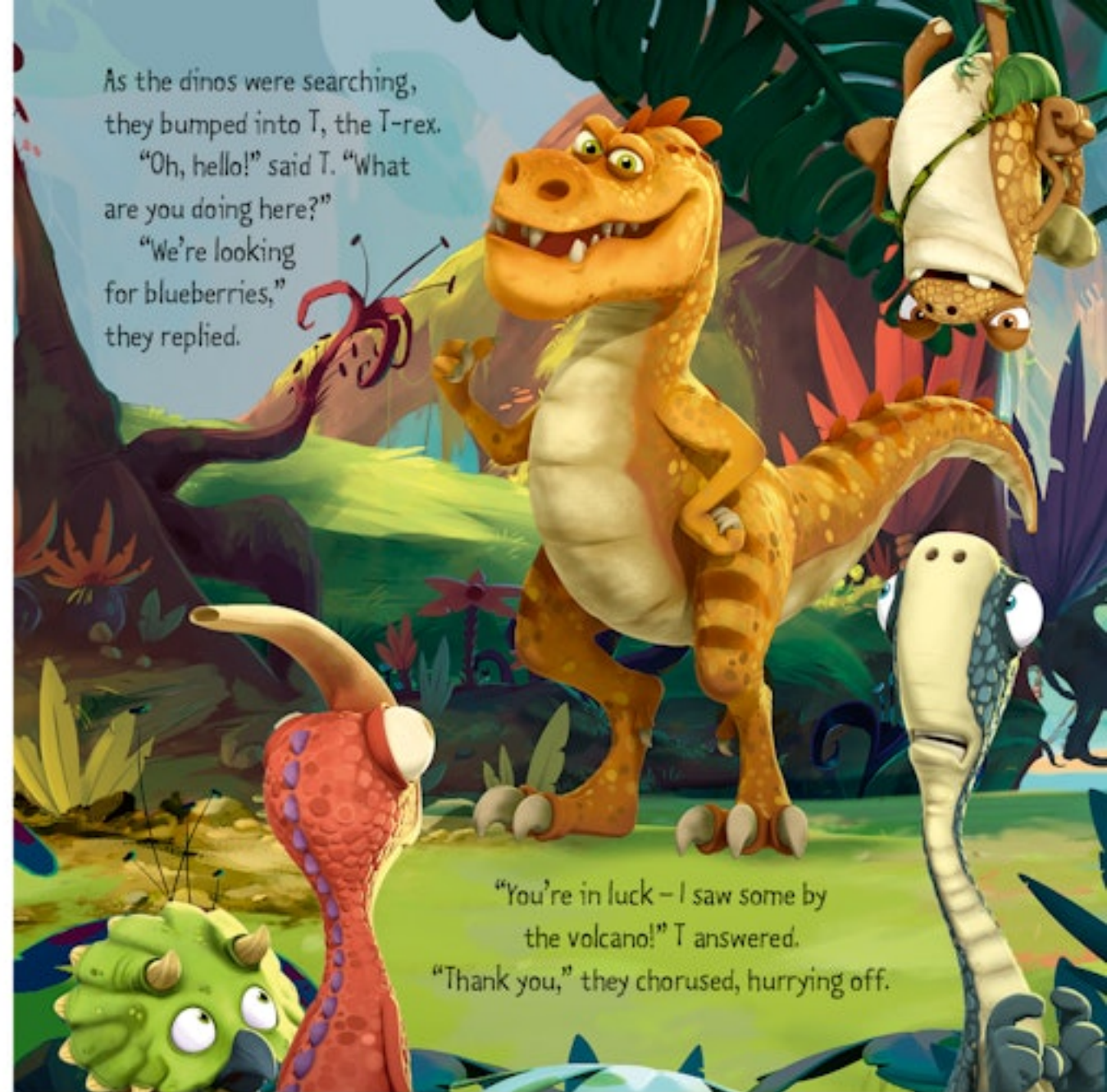
Poor Leena was watching out for Termy
