




















"Yes we have!" says Mouse, "We've walked MILES!"

Everyone looks a bit confused.


"What about the wet-weather wellies?"

MRS OWL'S GUIDE TO PLANTING AN ACORN

You will need:



Acorns



A bucket



Plant pot or old yoghurt pot



compost



 The best acorns to plant are ones that have recently fallen. Look for one that isn't damaged and is mostly brown.



Put the acorns in a bucket of water - leave out any that float.




 Fill a pot with compost. Make a hole in the pot and place your acorn in it. Gently cover with more compost.




 Don't forget to water your pot.



When the seedling gets bigger, you can move the plant into a bigger pot.
