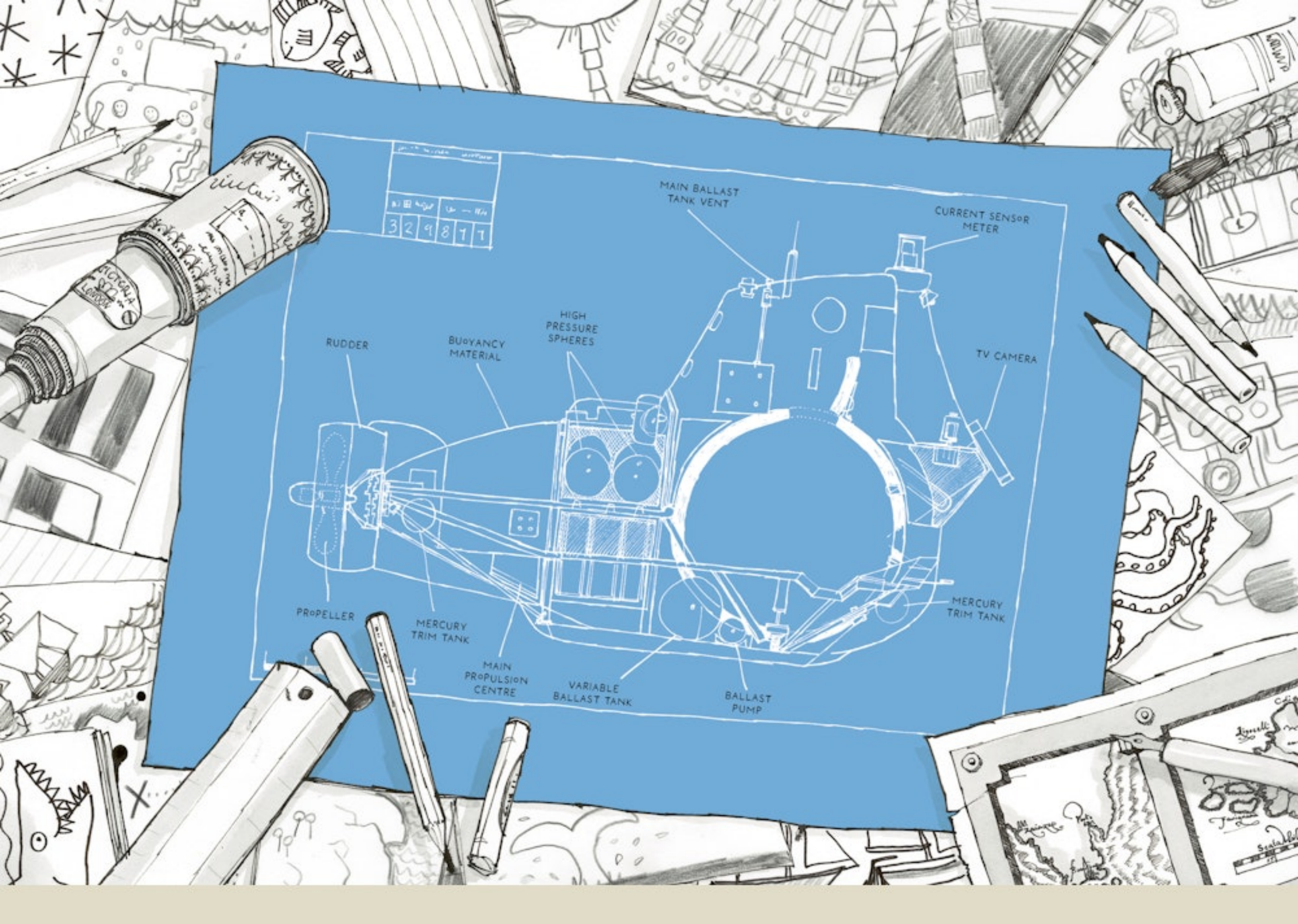

looked."



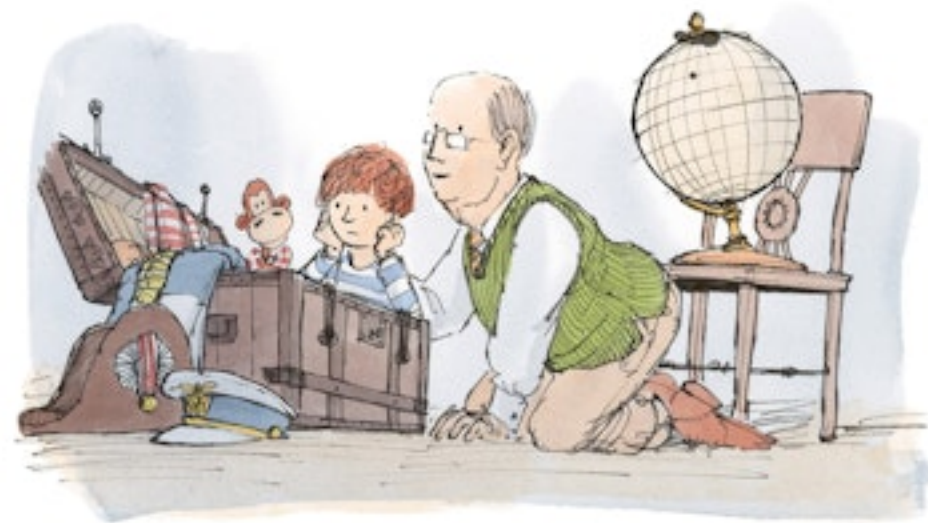
So we went down

There wasn't a moment to lose.

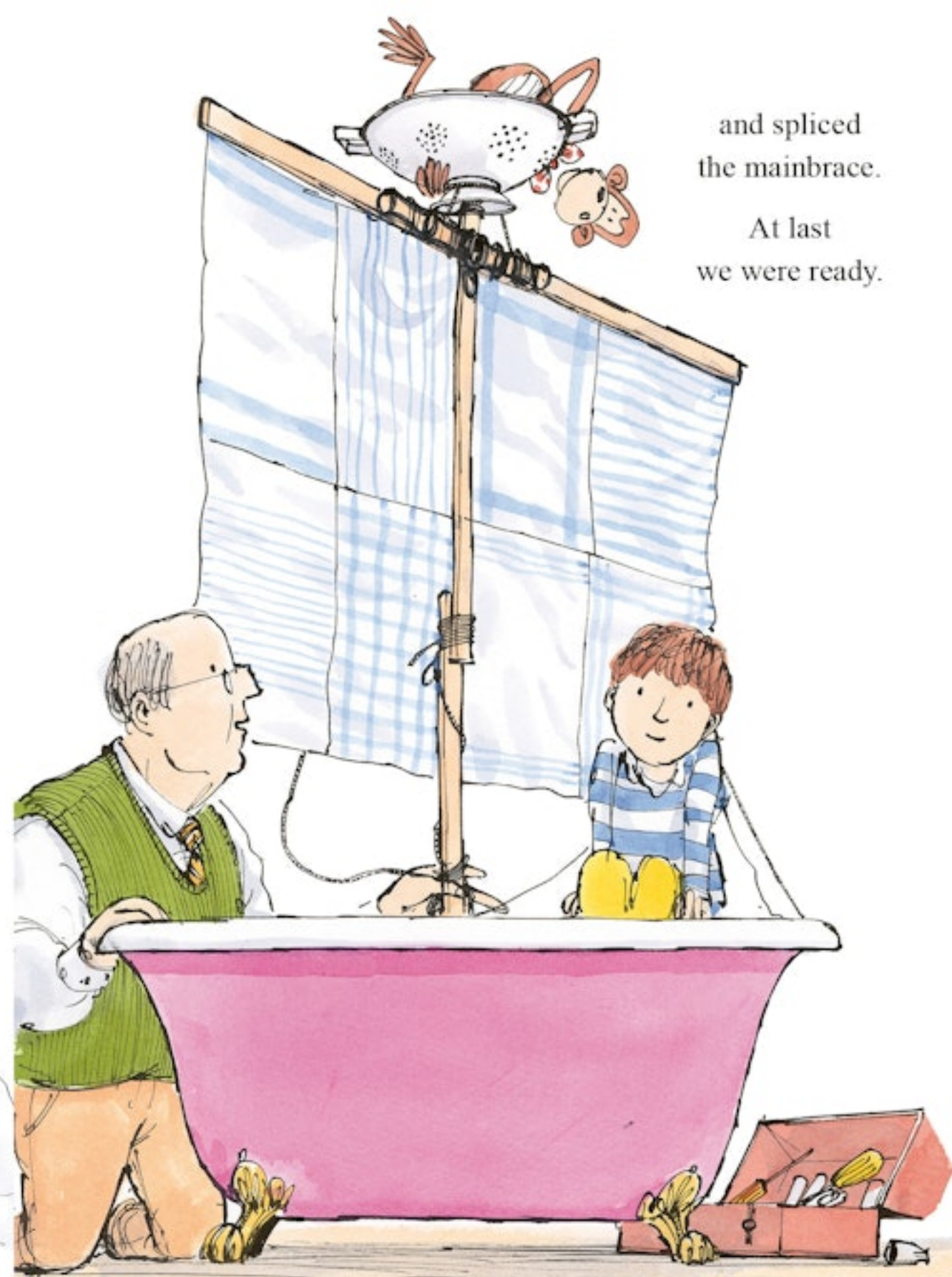


So we bashed and clanged,

And Monkey said, "Ship ahoy!"

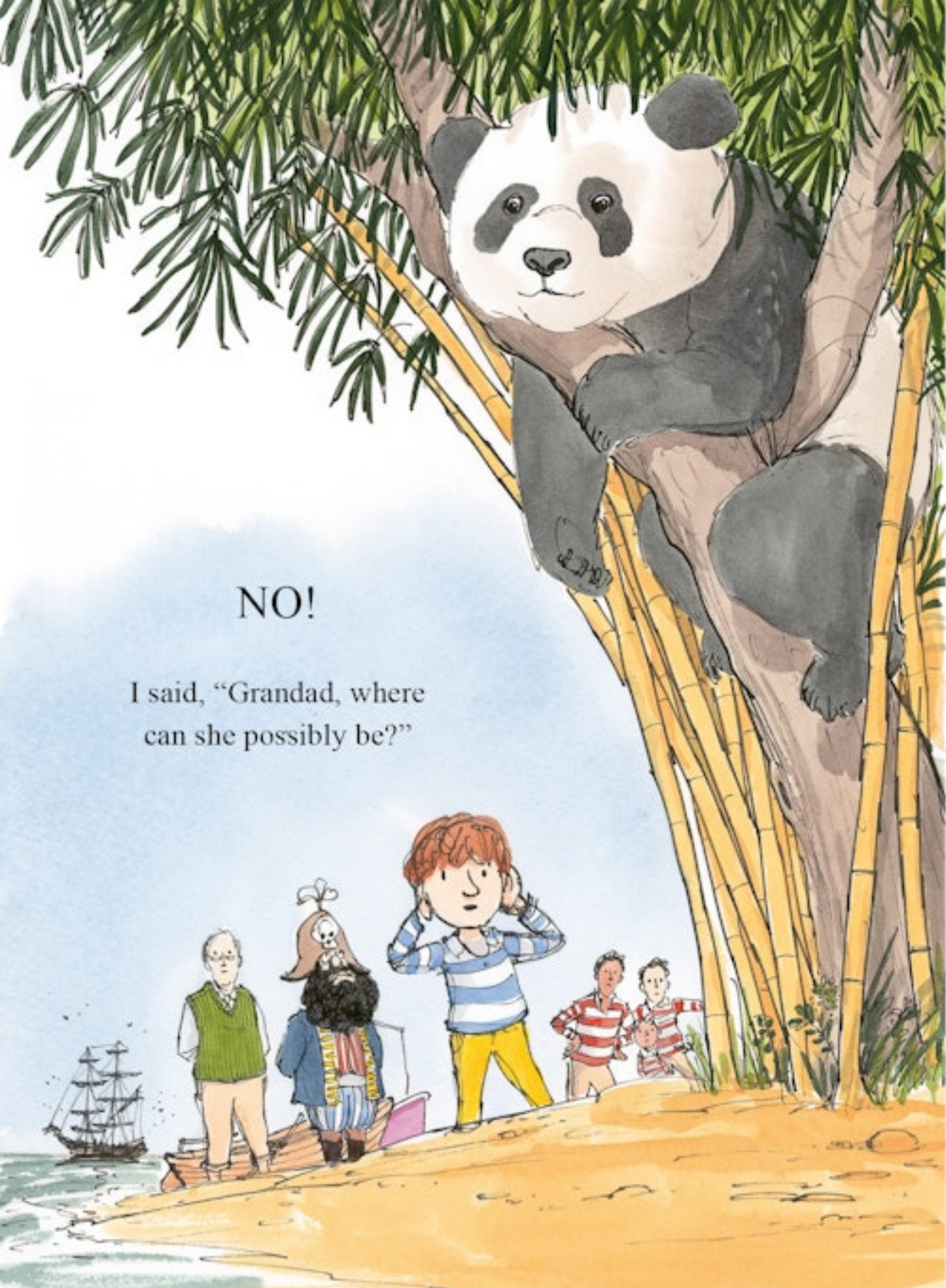


"Excuse me," I said,

and storms,



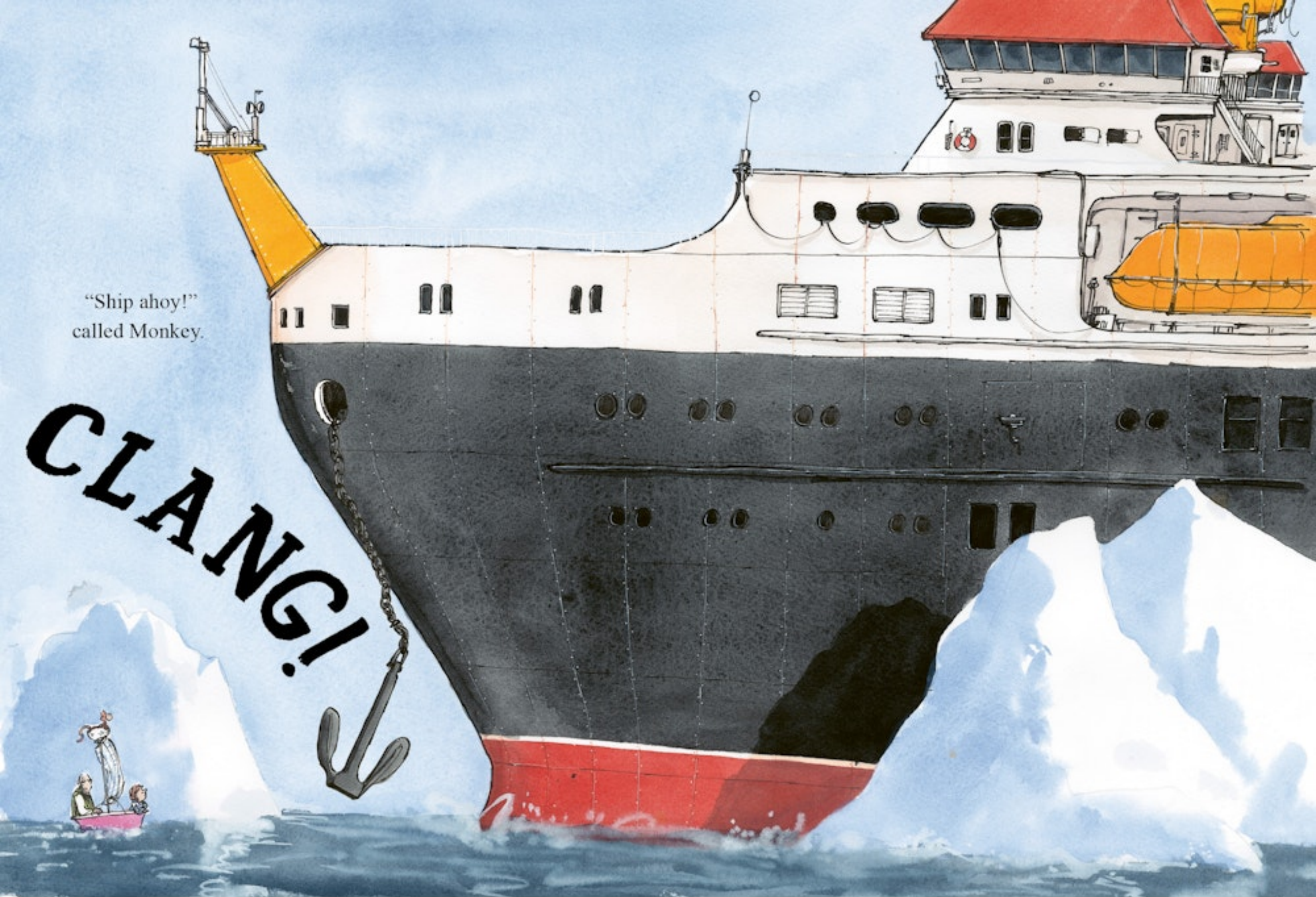
We were back on the open sea.

And did we find my penguin?

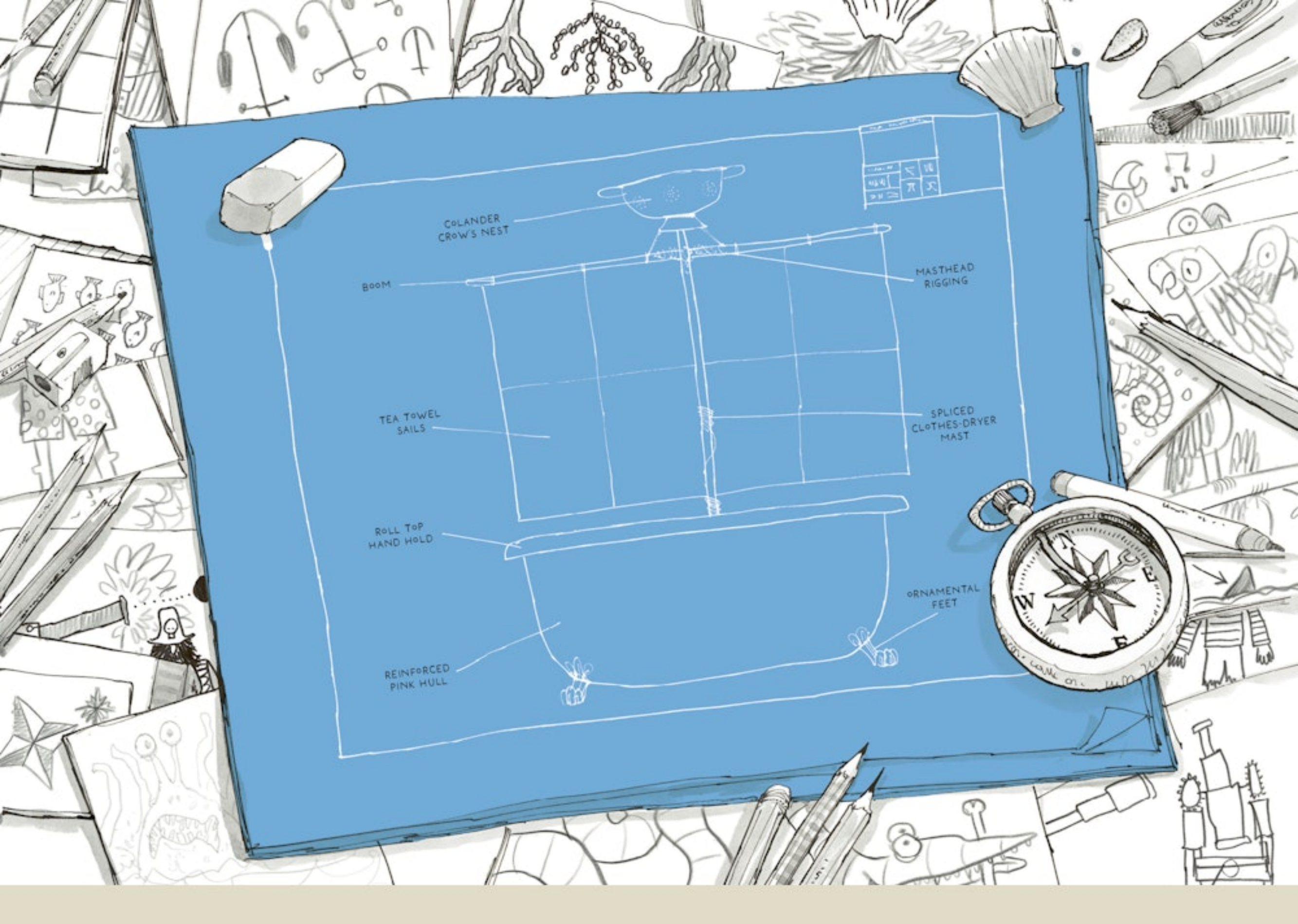






Back on dry land,
