INTRODUCTION

The Graf Archive covers the majority of the moon Orchis 2; its endless shelves, galleries and databanks contain texts, artworks, antiques, and even preserved plants and animals from every part of the galaxy.

Many items which cannot immediately be identified are moved to the underground Shadow Stacks, where they wait to be processed, often for many years. Venturing into these dusty basements is an important part of an Archivist's training, a kind of final exam: the challenge is to come back with a unexpected treasure. It can even be dangerous, as one young student discovered when the mummified ghast he was examining turned out to be merely hibernating...

These ancient hand-drawn maps were unearthed from the Shadow Stacks by a far luckier student. The Head Curator's theory is that they are the work of the great Ithorian artist Gammit Chond. We know only a little about Chond – few of his works have survived – but these maps show much of his characteristic style and flair.

Chond never travelled offworld, and one history has it that he never ventured more than a day's walk from his home. He was, however, fascinated by travellers' tales, and many of his works depict their stories of adventure and discovery in the rest of the galaxy.

They are not, of course, strictly accurate. You would not be advised to try to cross the Jundland Wastes using Chond's map of Tatooine. The artist was more interested in the feel of these strange worlds, and the often galaxy-shaking events which took place on them.

Taken together, they seem to be centred on the saga of the legendary Skywalker family. While we know that many of the things he has included are a matter of fact, some may merely be tall tales spun by explorers: but it all presents a unique view of a fascinating slice of history.

After several years of painstaking restoration, it is my great privilege, and that of the Graf Archive, to present this never-before-seen trove of art to the galaxy.

THE GALAXY

THE GALAXY IS GENERALLY THOUGHT TO BE DIVIDED INTO THE FOLLOWING REGIONS. GALACTIC NORTH IS THE DIRECTION TOWARDS THE TOP OF THIS CHART.

DEEP CORE Densely packed stars rotate around the super-massive black hole at the heart of the galaxy. It is dangerous to navigate, and few travellers venture this far coreward.

CORE WORLDs The richest and most important worlds cluster around the edges of the Deep Core. These include Coruscant, Coriolis, Kuat, Hothian Prime and other key systems.

COLONIES This region contains planets colonised by the Core Worlds. The Colonies sit along major trade routes and some of them are extremely wealthy.

INNER RIM When first settled, this area was known simply as 'the Rim' – it was the frontier of galactic civilization for centuries. As colonisation spread outwards, the Inner Rim worlds prospered.

EXPANSION REGION With competition for resources comes the need to expand, and the Expansion Region contains newer colonies sponsored by their coreward neighbours.

MID RIM Many important worlds are found in the Mid Rim, including Naboo, Kashyyyk, Ilhor and Malastare. Because it is relatively far from the Core, travellers should be wary of pirates.


OUTER RIM TERRITORIES The largest region of the known galaxy is the Outer Rim, which contains many strange and often savage worlds. Some of the most important worlds in the Confederacy of Independent Systems – otherwise known as the Separatists, during the Clone Wars – were in this region.

UNKNOWN REGIONS The Westward arm of the galaxy is mapped but largely unexplored. Who knows what lurks in the dark spaces beyond the frontiers of galactic civilisation?

WILD SPACE Beyond the Outer Rim lies the unmapped expanse of Wild Space. Explorers and cartographers seek their fortune here at their peril.

TIMELINE

This timeline describes the period of history covered in these maps, from the Clone Wars between the Republic and the Separatists, to the Galactic Civil War between the Empire and the Rebel Alliance, and beyond.

Dates in this book are given using the 'say-as' dating system, which is centred around the Battle of Yavin, when the first Death Star was destroyed. Therefore, 5 say is five years before the Battle of Yavin, and 5 say is five years after.

32 BBY The galaxy is governed by the Republic. On Coruscant, the capital world, Senators from a thousand worlds meet to debate the future, while the Jedi Order maintains peace and harmony.

The powerful Trade Federation, which controls galactic trade, bullies the remote world Naboo. Two Jedi, Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi, are sent to negotiate peace. However, the Trade Federation tries to assassinate the Jedi and sends their battle droid armies down to the planet to capture Queen Padmé Amidala.

Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi rescue the Queen, but are forced to flee. Their ship needs repair, so they stop on the remote desert world Tatooine. Here they meet the slave boy Anakin Skywalker, whose potential as a Jedi is the greatest Qui-Gon has ever seen. The Jedi win Anakin's freedom and take him away with them.

The Jedi escort Queen Amidala to Coruscant, but she cannot persuade the Senate to help Naboo. She returns to her homeworld with Qui-Gon, Obi-Wan and Anakin, and their Gungan friend Jar Jar Binks. The Gungans fight a battle against the Trade Federation's droid army as the Queen retakes her palace.

A sinister and deadly assassin has been tracking the Jedi: the Sith Lord Darth Maul. He and his Master, Darth Sidious, are secretly behind the Trade Federation's invasion. In a fierce battle beneath the city of Theed, he slays Qui-Gon Jinn, but it himself cut in half by Obi-Wan and seemingly destroyed.



31 BBY The Gungans and the Naboo defeat the droid army with the help of Anakin Skywalker. The Trade Federation is forced to withdraw.

31 BBY Senator Palpatine of Naboo has been made Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he is the evil Sith Lord Darth Sidious. He plans to start a galactic war to scare the Republic into building up its military he needs in order to seize absolute power for himself.

The former Jedi Master Count Dooku has sparked a crisis, with his Confederacy of Independent Systems – the so-called Separatists – threatening to split from the Republic. The Senate must decide whether or not to create an Army of the Republic. One prominent opponent of this plan is Padmé Amidala, who is now a Senator.

A series of attempts on Senator Amidala's life leads Obi-Wan Kenobi to the planet Kamino. Here he discovers an army of clones, secretly ordered by a now-dead Jedi Master, and based on the bounty hunter Jango Fett, who is the assassin he has been seeking. He follows Fett to Geonosis.

Anakin, now a Jedi apprentice, is assigned to protect Padmé. They travel to Naboo, where they begin to fall in love. Anakin is troubled by dreams about his mother, Shmi, whom he was forced to leave behind on Tatooine many years ago.

On Tatooine, Anakin discovers that his mother has been kidnapped by the Sand People. He is unable to save her life, and in a rage, he slaughters the tribe.

Obi-Wan is captured on Geonosis by the Separatists, as are Anakin and Padmé when they try to rescue him.

Jedi Master Mace Windu leads a team of Jedi to the rescue, backed by the clone army that now serves the Republic. Windu slays Fett, but Count Dooku escapes, pursued by Anakin Skywalker and Obi-Wan Kenobi.



31 BBY The Jedi catch up with Dooku but he reveals that he is the Sith Lord Darth Tyranus, the new apprentice of Darth Sidious. He easily defeats both Anakin and Obi-Wan. It is only the last-minute intervention of Grand Master Yoda that saves them. Dooku is forced to flee, but his work is done: the Republic now has its army.

On Naboo, Anakin marries Padmé Amidala in secret. Meanwhile, the Clone Wars have begun, as the Separatists under Count Dooku battle Palpatine's Republic.

The armies of the Republic are now led by Jedi Master Kenobi and Jedi Knight Skywalker during a Separatist invasion of the planet Christophsis with the help of Ahsoka Tano, Skywalker's new Padawan apprentice.

The Separatists attempt to turn the planet Rodia against the Republic, capturing Senator Amidala. She escapes with the help of Jar Jar Binks and keeps Rodia's support.

31 BBY With the help of the Twi'lek freedom fighter Charr Syndulla, Master Mace Windu makes the planet Ryloth from the Separatists. Their heroics are long remembered in song among the Twi'lek people.

Republic forces launch a massive attack on Geonosis, the home of the Separatist droid armies. They destroy the vast battle-droid factories.

30 BBY The Nightsisters of Dathomir attempt to assassinate Count Dooku. In revenge, he sends an army under his general, Grievous, to destroy them. Despite the witch Old Daka raising an army of the undead to oppose his droids, Grievous is successful.

The former Sith Lord Maul, thought to have perished during the Battle of Naboo, resurfaces with his fearsome apprentice Savage Opress. Now equipped with cyborg legs, he seeks revenge on his one-time Master Darth Sidious and his enemy Obi-Wan Kenobi.



30 BBY When Onderon's King Sisay Rash sides with the Separatists, a group of rebels under Soile Gerra and her brother Saw fight bravely to resist them with the help of Ahsoka Tano. The Onderon rebels would eventually form part of the Rebel Alliance.



29 BBY Maul's Shadow Collective, formed of Death Watch and various criminal gangs, takes over the planet Mandalore. As revenge on Obi-Wan Kenobi, Maul kills Duchess Satine Kryze, for whom Kenobi had strong feelings. Maul's victory is short-lived, as Darth Sidious arrives to defeat both him and Obi-Wan.



Ahsoka Tano is framed for a Separatist bombing by the treacherous Jedi Padawan Barriss Offee. Though her innocence is eventually proven by her Master Anakin Skywalker, she decides to leave the Jedi Order.



Separatist attack Coruscant and kidnap Chancellor Palpatine. Skywalker and Kenobi mount a rescue. Skywalker defeats Dooku in single combat, and Palpatine goads him into killing the Count – secretly, his own apprentice.



Though he is the hero of the battle of Coruscant, Anakin is troubled by the Jedi's mistrust of him and his mentor the Chancellor. He is also plagued by dreams that seem to predict the death of his wife.



Anakin discovers that Palpatine is Darth Sidious, but the Sith Lord promises he can help to save Padmé. When Mace Windu tries to arrest the Chancellor, Anakin helps to destroy the Jedi Master. He falls to the dark side and his new Master names him Darth Vader.



Vader is sent to the Jedi Temple to massacre all he finds there. Meanwhile, Palpatine issues Order 66 to the clone army: a secret command, enforced by a chip in the clones' brains, which compels them to assassinate the Jedi. Almost all the Jedi perish, though Obi-Wan Kenobi and Grand Master Yoda survive.



1 BBY On Utapau, Obi-Wan Kenobi's clone troopers have cornered General Grievous, but they turn their fire on Kenobi as Order 66 is issued. Kenobi escapes and duels Grievous, killing the cyborg.



Grand Master Yoda goes to the Senate on Coruscant to confront Darth Sidious, but he is unable to defeat the Sith Lord in combat. The Jedi retreats and exiles himself to the planet Dagobah.



Vader travels to the lava world Mustafar, where he slays the Separatist leaders, ending the Clone Wars for his Master. Obi-Wan follows him and, in an epic duel, defeats him. Vader's injuries are severe and require him to wear a cybernetic suit of armor to survive from this point on.



Padmé Amidala gives birth to twins, Luke and Leia, but does not herself survive. Luke is hidden on Tatooine with the Lars family, and Leia is adopted by Senator Bail Organa of Alderaan.



Supreme Chancellor Palpatine declares himself Galactic Emperor.



On the remote planet Lothal, a group of rebels led by Hera Syndulla of Ryloth and the former Jedi Padawan Kanan Jarrus is formed. Ezra Bridger, an orphaned street thief, joins the crew of their ship the *Ghost* and begins to train in the ways of the Jedi.



After many battles, Kanan Jarrus is captured by the Grand Inquisitor, a fearsome Jedi hunter, and taken aboard Grand Moff Tarkin's flagship the *Sovereign* in orbit above Mustafar. A daring raid by his friends frees Jarrus, who then defeats the Inquisitor in combat. The Inquisitor and the *Sovereign* are both destroyed.



A covert team of rebel agents is tasked with a crucial mission: to steal the plans of the Empire's new battle station, the Death Star. The mission is led by Cassian Andor and Jyn Erso, and takes the Rogue One team to the planet Jedha.



0 BBY Darth Vader captures the *Tantive IV* and its passenger Princess Leia Organa, the Senator from Alderaan. He accuses her of being a rebel traitor who is in possession of the Death Star plans – but the Princess has already sent them off the ship, in the possession of her droid R2-D2.



R2-D2 and his counterpart C-3PO meet Luke Skywalker on Tatooine and take him to meet Obi-Wan Kenobi. When the Empire kills his uncle and aunt, Luke decides to train as a Jedi and to fight for the rebels against the oppressors.



Luke, Obi-Wan, R2-D2 and C-3PO travel to Mos Eisley spaceport where they hire Han Solo and Chewbacca to take them and the secret plans to the rebels on Alderaan. They travel in Solo's ship the *Millennium Falcon* to Alderaan, only to discover that the planet has been destroyed by the Death Star. The crew rescues Leia from Imperial custody and they flee to the *Millennium Falcon*.



Obi-Wan confronts his former pupil Darth Vader. He sacrifices himself, becoming one with the Force, as his friends make their escape. The Empire tracks the *Falcon* to Yavin 4.



At the Death Star closes on the rebel base, a desperate starfighter raid is launched against the battle station. Using the Force, Luke Skywalker fires the shot that destroys it, striking a key blow for the rebellion.



Darth Vader sends probe droids across the galaxy and eventually locates the new rebel base on Hoth. His invasion force is able to destroy it, but not before the rebels escape. Meanwhile, Luke is visited by the spirit of Obi-Wan Kenobi, who tells him to travel to Dagobah.



Luke meets Yoda on Dagobah and begins his Jedi training. Han, Leia, Chewbacca and the droids stop at Bespin to repair the *Falcon*, unaware that Vader's bounty hunter Boba Fett has tracked them there.



0 ABY Vader captures Luke's friends and frenemy Han Solo in carbonite. Han's friend, the Bess Administrator of Cloud City Lando Calrissian, struggles with his conscience as Boba Fett takes Solo away as a trophy for Jabba the Hutt.



Luke travels to Cloud City to rescue his friends. He confronts Vader, who defeats him in a duel. Vader reveals that he is Luke's father. Luke narrowly escapes in the *Millennium Falcon*.



Leia, Lando, Chewbacca, R2-D2 and Luke rescue Han Solo from Jabba the Hutt's palace on Tatooine, slaying the vile gangster. Luke is now a fully fledged Jedi Knight.



Luke returns to Dagobah, where his Master Yoda has reached the end of his life. The ancient Jedi tells Luke about his family – including the fact that Leia is his sister – and becomes one with the Force.



The Rebel Alliance is informed that a second Death Star is nearing completion and that the Emperor will be on board. They plan to destroy it in an all-out attack. Their fleet assembles for the raid, without realising that it is a trap, and the battle station is already operational.



Han Solo leads a commando team to the Sanctuary Moon of Endor to destroy the shield generator protecting the Death Star. They meet the Ewoks, who help them.



Luke Skywalker strikes down his father Darth Vader but refuses to kill him, knowing that would lead him to the dark side. The Emperor decides to kill Luke, but Anakin Skywalker cannot bear to see his son destroyed and instead sacrifices his own life to destroy the Emperor.



Luke escapes the Death Star and, with the shield brought down, Lando Calrissian and Wedge Antilles destroy the battle station. Not long afterwards the Empire is finally defeated at the Battle of Jakku, and a New Republic is formed.



1 ABY Kylo Ren, the dark enforcer of the First Order, seeks a map to the location of Luke Skywalker, who has withdrawn from galactic affairs. The explorer Poe Dameron, however, has already given it to the Resistance pilot Poe Dameron and his droid BB-8.



A First Order stormtrooper, FN-2187, and a scavenger, Rey, are brought together on Jakku with BB-8. They flee the First Order in a stolen ship found in a junkyard, the *Millennium Falcon*, and are soon intercepted by Han Solo and Chewbacca.



Han Solo takes FN-2187 – now Finn – and Rey to Takodana. He asks Maz Kanata to arrange passage for BB-8's precious data. The First Order learns of this, and Kylo Ren attacks, capturing Rey and destroying Maz's castle.



The Resistance must attack the First Order's superweapon, Starkiller Base, when it destroys the Hosian system, which contains the Senate. A small team will travel to the base to take down the planetary shields, before fighters can attack.



Finn, Han Solo and Chewbacca fly the *Millennium Falcon* to Starkiller Base and meet Rey, who has freed herself from Kylo Ren's clutches. Together, they manage to take down the planetary shields and plant explosives.




Han Solo pleads with his son Ben – now known as Kylo Ren – to turn away from the dark side. But Ren embraces the darkness within himself, slaying his father.



Rey, whose Force abilities are suddenly awakened by the danger, takes up the lightsaber of Luke Skywalker and defeats Kylo Ren in battle.



Poe Dameron leads his X-wing squadron in an attack run on the Starkiller and fires the shot that destroys the monolithic weapon. Rey, Finn and Chewbacca escape as the base explodes.

REY

The ruthless and deadly Death Immortal was forced to flee his empire during the Clone Wars – a daring heist that took the Jedi Temple, a prison break on Coruscant, and even the killing of the Republic's Supreme Chancellor, Palpatine. There was no job he would not take on – for the right price.

The faithful companion to Resistance pilot Poe Dameron, BB-8, a spherical astromech droid, was extracted with the help of Luke Skywalker by his master. After meeting Rey and Finn, he managed to escape in his moisture. BB-8 was a clever and resourceful droid, well aware of his master's desire to become Jedi.

Jar Jar Binks was Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi's friend during the invasion of Naboo and became friends with the Jedi and Queen Amidala, whom he helped to rescue. Later he became a representative for his planet in the Galactic Senate, successfully helping Chancellor Palpatine to seize absolute power.

With his powers assisted by the Empire for rebellion activities, Ezra grew up on the streets of Lothal's Capital City, training to survive. A chance encounter with the former Jedi Kanan Jarrus and his Spectre crew led him to become Jacen's apprentice and to become part of the Jedi Order Alliance.

A protocol droid built from spare parts by Anakin Skywalker, in his childhood on Tatooine, C-3PO was fluent in over seven million forms of communication. Despite his sentient nature, C-3PO played a pivotal role in the Galactic Civil War, strengthen his comrade companion and commanding R2-D2.


Born on Naboo, Sheev Palpatine became a Senator, and through clever political scheming, Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he was Sidious, Dark Lord of the Sith, controlling both sides in the Clone Wars and using shadow power as Emperor. He was destroyed by his former pupil Anakin Skywalker.

Alongside General Hux and Kylo Ren, Captain Phasma was one of the key commanders of the First Order. She was in charge of training stormtroopers and led them into battle formation. Her distinctive armor was covered with crimson stripes derived from a starship once owned by Emperor Palpatine himself.

Heroic armament droid R2-D2 witnessed many of the galaxy's most crucial events, from the invasion of Naboo and the Clone Wars to the rise and fall of the Galactic Empire. He accompanied both Anakin and Luke Skywalker on adventures and was key to efforts to destroy the Death Star.

At his birth, the son of Han Solo and Leia Organa was named 'Rey'. His Jedi training with Luke Skywalker ended in tragedy when, induced by the dark side, he betrayed the other students and was responsible for their destruction. As Kylo Ren, the First Order's enforcer, he killed his father on Starkiller Base.

Rey grew up on the planet Jakku, where she had been left at an early age. She captured the ship grounded for parts to travel to her guardian, the jedi-like Uncle Poe, and worked for her family. A chance encounter with a Resistance droid led her to leave the planet and discover her destiny as a Jedi.



The reptilian gambler Lando Calrissian lost his ship the Millennium Falcon to his friend Han Solo in a game of odds. Later, as Baron Administrator of Cloud City, he betrayed Solo to the Empire but soon had a change of heart. General Calrissian helped the rebels destroy the second Death Star at the Battle of Endor.



The lovable Wookiee Chewbacca fought for the Republic in the Clone Wars, and later became one of the heroes of the Battle of Yavin. He and his friend Han Solo became key figures in the rebellion. As a pilot and engineer, he was also a mighty warrior and crack shot with his bowcaster.



Poe Dameron was not a pilot for the Republic who was recruited by General Grievous for his Resistance organization. He helped to map the way to the location of Luke Skywalker, despite the First Order operating and intercepting him, and freed the droids that destroyed the Starkiller superweapon. He was killed by Anakin Skywalker.




Dooku trained as the Padawan of Jedi Master Yoda and became a Master himself. He came to believe the Republic was corrupt and left to form a Separatist army against it. At the Sixth Level Death Test, he was the opponent of Darth Sidious, and his Master betrayed him. He was killed by Anakin Skywalker.



Boba was a clone of his father' Jango Fett, and as a boy witnessed his death at the hands of Jedi Master Mace Windu. He grew up to become one of the galaxy's most dangerous bounty hunters. Near the end of the Galactic Civil War, he fell into a trap set on Tatooine while working for Jabba the Hutt.



Anakin Skywalker was discovered as a child slave on the planet Tatooine by the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn. His incredible potential led to him being trained as a Jedi, and he became one of the Republic's greatest heroes. However, he came under the sway of the Sith Lord Darth Vader and fell to the dark side.



The last boy from Tatooine who longed for the stars became one of the galaxy's most important figures. The last Jedi Knight, raised by Obi-Wan Kenobi and Yoda, joined the Rebel Alliance, tracked his father Anakin Skywalker back to the light, and overthrew the Empire. Later, he withdrew from galactic affairs.



A smuggler, famed pilot and much more, Han Solo became caught up in the Galactic Civil War when he was forced to take Obi-Wan Kenobi and Luke Skywalker to Alderaan. He joined the rebels, helped to free the world, married Princess Leia, but was then tragically struck down by his son, Ben.



The daughter of famed Twi'lek freedom fighter Chen Sabe, Hera grew up on her home planet Ryloth during the Clone Wars and Imperial occupation. Trapped in a life destined to be a slave to the Empire, she escaped to Alderaan. She joined the Rebels to free Ryloth from the Empire and became a leading member of a rebel cell based on Lothal.



The leader of Dathomir's Nightbrothers, Mother Talzin was a powerful matriarch who wielded the dark side of the Force, physical body and all, and against the Sith Lord Darth Sidious and Darth Tyranus, who eventually won Graavos to destroy her clan. She was killed serving her son Maul from Palpatine and Darth Sidious.



The galaxy's most feared bounty hunter, Jango Fett was chosen as the genetic template for the Republic's clone troopers as part of a plot by the Sith Lord Chancellor Palpatine and Count Dooku. He fought Obi-Wan Kenobi and was killed during the Battle of Geonosis by Jedi Master Mace Windu.

Raised from infancy to be a stormtrooper by the First Order, FN-2187 was a model soldier until his first combat mission. He refused to fire on innocent people and fled the First Order with the Resistance pilot Poe Dameron, who gave him the name Finn. He then helped his new friends destroy Starkiller Base, and he was destroyed.

Inspiration was dark-side using Jedi hunting, employed by Emperor Palpatine to root out survivors of Order 66. The Grand Inquisitor was sent in the planet Lothal to find Kanan Jarrus, but after a series of battles Jarrus defeated him in a duel ahead of the Clone Wars, and he was destroyed.

The Kalundru warlord Grievous was a hutt-like cyborg, with almost all of his original body replaced with mechanical upgrades. Trained in lightsaber combat by Count Dooku, he became a key Separatist general, commanding vast armies. He was killed by Anakin Skywalker during the assault on Geonosis by the克隆人军队.

The vile gangster Jabba the Hutt was a hutt-like cyborg who ruled a criminal empire from his palace on Tatooine. After a bounty hunter brought him Han Solo, the Hutt's former employee, Jannah, hung him from a执行死刑在 the wall of his throne room. It was during the Gangster's execution by Luke Skywalker that the Mass was slain by Prince Leia.


Grand Master Yoda assigned this young but talented Twi'lek Jedi to Anakin Skywalker as his Padawan learner. He served heroically in the Clone Wars, before a massive plan led her to leave the Order. Later, as the agent Tukkenn, she helped establish a network of agents against Imperial tyranny.

Extremely ambitious and highly intelligent, Wilhuff Tarkin rose through the ranks of the Imperial military to become one of the most powerful men in the galaxy. As Grand Moff, he commanded the first Death Star; he helped establish a network of agents against Imperial tyranny.

Loz San Tekka was an explorer who was fascinated by the legends of the Jedi and became a member of the Church of the Force which kept Jedi alive in the age of the Empire. He possessed a map that could help to locate Luke Skywalker and gave it to the bounty hunter Ben Solo to track him down.

The Twi'lek Jedi Master Shaak Ti was a member of the High Council during the Clone Wars and was responsible for the training of the Republic's clone army on the planet Kamino. Through a skilled and cunning strategy she was killed by Darth Vader during the Battle of the克隆人战争.

A member of the Jedi High Council, Luminara Unduli was one of the most highly regarded Jedi Masters of her time. Following the victory of Emperor Palpatine over the Jedi, Unduli was assumed by Yoda, Palpatine, and her comrade as a trap to draw in survivors of Order 66.

Cabba Dune was only a Padawan learner when Order 66 happened, and his Master Dooku killed him helping him escape. Taking the name Kanan Jarrus, he fled his old life and became a member of the Resistance.

A powerful and emotional Jedi Master, Qui-Gon Jinn was raised by Count Dooku and in turn was the Master of Obi-Wan Kenobi. He learned the secret of maintaining his consciousness after death, a power he passed on to Yoda and Kenobi. Jinn was slain by the Sith Lord Darth Maul during the invasion of Naboo.

Famed as a wise negotiator and cunning master, Obi-Wan Kenobi fought with intelligence and courage in the Clone Wars. With the rise of the Empire, he took it upon himself to search out Luke Skywalker, his former padawan, and the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn. He was thus renamed by Obi-Wan Kenobi, only to rise again as a cyborg clone host.

Lobot had cyborg implants put into his brain by the Empire, enabling him to run complex calculations for them. Later, while helping Luke to meet Emperor Palpatine's goals, he was actually rescued, and his cyborg brain took over. He helped to rescue the Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn. He was thus renamed by Obi-Wan Kenobi, only to rise again as a cyborg clone host.

Maul, a Zabrak from Dathomir, was born in Taris of the Nightbrothers but was taken by the Empire, enabling him to be kidnapped as a child. Through a series of trials, he became a devastating Sith master and served the Sith Lord Darth Vader as his second right-hand. At the last, he turned on his Master, destroying him to save the life of his son, Luke Skywalker.

Born on Dathomir into the Ferocious clan of Nightbrothers, Ventress was appointed to the Sith Lord Count Dooku and became his comrade. Dooku and Ventress tried to kill each other, and the attack cost her her life as a bounty hunter. She died bravely, protecting the Jedi Qui-Gon Jinn.

Jedi Master Mace Windu was known as one of the Order's greatest champions – his skill with a lightsaber and the Force was almost unmatched. He fought many battles of the Clone Wars as a general, including the one on Coruscant. He was killed by Darth Maul while trying to arrest the Sith Lord.

Sabine Wren was born into the Mandalorian warrior tradition. As a child she joined the Imperial Academy as a cadet. However, the Sith Lord Darth Vader and strongly drew to her in single combat. After Palpatine brought her to a standstill, Tala informed her wife when he previously raised Luke Skywalker.

ABA FAR TO YAVIN 4



ABA FAR A barren world rich in drydenium. During the Clone Wars the Separatists loaded a stolen freighter with this explosive and tried to use it to blow up a top Republic military conference. They were thwarted by D-Squad, a covert team of droids under Colonel Meebur Gason.

DANTOOINE Once used by the Rebel Alliance as a base, it was the location given by Princess Leia to Grand Moff Tarkin when he demanded she reveal their headquarters. Because Dantooine was too remote to serve as a demonstration of the Death Star's power, Tarkin targeted Alderaan instead.

DATHOMIR A mysterious world of jungles, swamps and mountains, haunted by witches and succors. Dathomir's Nightsisters were one of the known groups of Force-users who were not Jedi or Sith until conflict with Darth Tyranus and Darth Sidious led to one of their clans being massacred.

FELUCIA Felucia's position in the middle of an important hyperspace lane made it a key target during the Clone Wars. Many battles were fought for control of it. The planet itself is a farm world with great jungles of fungus. It is noted for its production of the valuable healing herb myrrin.

IMON The peaceful Imonian people, sometimes known as 'hummerheads', tend to the sacred jungles of their homeworld. They are known for their remarkable farming technology; the Galactic Empire forced them to reveal their secrets in return for sparing the planet a devastating invasion.

JELUCAN A world of ice and towering mountain peaks. Jelucan was settled in two waves of colonists; the second-wavers became rich miners, while the first-wavers clung to their more rigid mountain traditions. It was once the site of a Jedi prison called the Citadel. When the Separatists took over the planet, they used it to hold Jedi prisoners of their own.

LOLA SAYU From orbit, Lola Sayu is a purple jewel of a planet. It is volcanic, with a cracked surface through which lakes of lava bubble up. It was once the site of a Jedi prison called the Citadel. When the Separatists took over the planet, they used it to hold Jedi prisoners of their own.

MARIUS A grass-covered planet, home to the peace-loving Lurmen. It was used to test a new Separatist weapon: the Defolator, which destroyed life but not technology – like the Separatists' battle droids. The scheme was foiled by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Ahsoka Tano and Aayla Secura.

MON CALA The vast oceans of Mon Cala are home to the Mon Calamari and Quarren species. A bitter struggle between the two led to them taking opposite sides during the Clone Wars. The Republic defeated the Separatists; Lee-Chor of the Mon Calamari proved himself in battle, becoming King.

The planet suffered under the Empire, and the Mon Calamari became key allies of the rebels. Admiral Ackbar was commander of the rebel fleet at the Battle of Endor.

Mon Calamari ships were some of the largest and most powerful in the rebel fleet.

MORABAND The desolate homeworld of the Sith holds many evil secrets. In the Valley of the Dark Lords the tombs of powerful Sith are haunted by the presence of the dark side. Yoda travelled here as part of his quest to discover the secret of immortality and encountered a vision of Darth Bane.

MORTIS Discovered by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Mortis is a mysterious realm resembling a bizarre planet whose landscape changes constantly. It was home to three powerful 'Force wielders', the Daugher, the Son and the Father, who represented the light, the dark and balance respectively.

QUERMIA Home to the Quarren species – tall, pale humanoids with long necks and two pairs of arms.

Quarren Jedi Master Yarad Poof was a respected member of the Jedi Council, known for his skill with diplomacy, illusions and mind tricks.

RAXUS The capital of the Confederacy of Independent Systems during the Clone Wars, Raxus is a beautiful world of forest, plains and oceans.

From here, Count Dooku sparked the Separatist Crisis that led to the Clone Wars and the fall of the Republic.

SCIPIO The InterGalactic Banking Clan was one of the most important organisations in the Outer Rim, based on the icy planet Scipio. During the Clone Wars this key Separatist planet was captured by the Republic, giving Chancellor Palpatine control of the galaxy's largest banking system.

SYRION PRIME A forested world that was home to Count Dooku, one of the central figures of the Separatists. Darth Sidious impersonated his former apprentice Maul here, and kept the remains of Jedi Master Luminara Unduli here to lure any Jedi who survived the Order's destruction.

YAVIN 4 The small jungle moon which served as a base for the Rebel Alliance for their assault on the first Death Star.

The location of the rebel base here was the crucial secret held back by the rebel leader and Senator Leia Organa during her interrogation by Darth Vader.





JORIN DURVAL VANNER

The vulnerability created by the Death Star gives it a small thermal exhaust port, only two meters wide. Located at the maximum thrust near the northern pole of the station, Jorin Vanner and Garven Dreis make attack runs with Gold and Red Squadrons, but neither succeeds.



LUKE SKYWALKER



WEDGE ANTILLES

With Darth Vader watching from on the solid warships, it falls to Luke Skywalker to make the final assault run. As he enters the cockpit, with his wingman Wedge Antilles forced to back off his attack, he is spurred to focus beyond the grave by the spirit of his Master, Obi-Wan Kenobi.





ALDERAAN	Alderaan Known for its stunning natural beauty, Alderaan was one of the oldest members of the Galactic Republic, a peaceful world whose people valued art and culture. Because of its leaders' secret support for the Rebel Alliance, it was destroyed by the Empire using the Death Star.
ANTAR 4	Scene of the infamous Antar Atrocity carried out by Grand Moff Tarkin as a warning to former Separatists.
BALNAK	A primitive world once visited by C-3PO and R2-D2. The planet's ruler was a hologram created by a group of stranded pit droids.
CORELLIA	An important Core World known for its ships and pilots. Han Solo and Wedge Antilles were born here, and the Corellian Engineering Corporation manufactured the YT-1300 light freighter the <i>Millennium Falcon</i> , known as one of the fastest ships in the galaxy.
CORUSCAN	Capital of the Republic and later the Galactic Empire. It is a planet covered by a vast city of skyscrapers, rising miles into the sky.
GAREE	Briefly the hiding place of the rebel cell led by Hera Syndulla and Kanan Jarrus, during the Imperial years.
HONIAN PRIME	With the Empire defeated, a New Republic rose from the ashes. Its capital was changed by election every few years, and while the Senate was based on Honian Prime the First Order used Starkiller Base to destroy the system, the Senate, and much of the Republic fleet.
JEDHA	An ancient world, dusty Jedha was once a place of holy pilgrimage. During Imperial occupation, extremist rebel Saw Gerrera had a hideout here.
KASHYK	The Wookiee homeworld, known for its majestic wookiee trees. Cities spiral around their huge trunks.
KENNEL	One side of this world is lush and beautiful; elegant palaces and their exquisitely tended grounds sit among green forests and crystal lakes. On the other side of the world, vast colonies of slave labour in the infamous spice mines. Spice smugglers can make vast profits on the 'Kessel Run.'

KUAT The shipyards of Kuat are famous throughout the galaxy; it was here that the Republic's *Avenger* assault ships and the Empire's Star Destroyers were built. A vast man-made ring of factories and space docks encircles the planet, allowing huge vehicles to be built in orbit.

LOTHAL A quiet and peaceful agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal at first welcomed the Galactic Empire. However, the Empire soon began to oppress and exploit Lothal, strip-mining it for minerals. A famous cell of rebels formed here and won notable victories against the Empire.

MANDALORE The Mandalorian people were once renowned as fierce and deadly warriors. The New Mandalorians, however, have tried to put the violence of the past behind them. They are opposed by terrorist like Death Watch, operating from their exile on Mandalore's moon Concordia.

ONDERON Onderon's thick jungles are inhabited by deadly creatures. The humans on the planet live in cities protected by thick walls, such as the capital city Iziz. A key rebel leader, Saw Gerrera, waged a guerrilla campaign here against the occupying Separatist forces with the help of the Jedi.

OND MANTELL A mountainous world covered by thick, pinkish clouds and inhabited by Falleen and humans, Ord Mantell is well known as a base of the Black Sun gang. During the Clone Wars, the Separatist leader General Grievous took the captured R2-D2 here to unlock the Republic secrets in his databanks. The astromech was rescued by Anakin Skywalker.

RUUSAN During the Clone Wars, one of Ruusan's three moons had a Separatist base, Skynop Station, eavesdropping on Republic transmissions. General Grievous took the captured R2-D2 here to unlock the Republic secrets in his databanks. The astromech was rescued by Anakin Skywalker.

SALUSCAI Many people who wished to escape the chase of the Clone Wars settled on remote Saluscai, including clone trooper Cut Lawquane, who deserved to raise a family. He did, eventually, reach the planet, at the Republic and the Separatist clashed in one of the final battles of the conflict.

SHANTOOLE Lightning storms rage among the mountain spires of Shantooole; the atmosphere is highly dangerous for piloting starships. It is here, away from the watchful gaze of the Empire, that the Mon Calamari engineer Quarrie invented the prototype Blade Wing or B-wing fighter for the rebels.


SUTHI The homeworld of the Togruta, who are instantly recognizable thanks to their brightly patterned skin, head-tails, and montrals – hollow, cone-shaped horns which allow the Togruta to track movement. Two famous Jedi hailed from Shu: Jedi Master Shaak Ti and the Padawan Ahsoka Tano.

TETH A mountainous jungle planet in a Hutt-controlled area of Wild Space. Teth was once inhabited by the bizarre monks of the Ilumian Order, whose brains were transplanted into spider-like droid bodies. It was the scene of the daring rescue of the infant Rotta the Hutt by Anakin Skywalker.



LOTHAL

A once tranquil agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal suffered under the Galactic Empire, which ruthlessly strip-mined the planet for ores and crystals to fuel military production. It was on Lothal that the rebel cell founded by Kanan Jarrus and Hera Syndulla came together and won a series of notable victories against Imperial forces.







A rocky desert world inhabited by an insectoid race, whose great domes and spires resemble natural formations.


Geonosis has long been renowned for its manufacturing industries; the Separatist droid armies were built here, and the first Death Star was partially constructed in orbit. Later, however, the Empire ruthlessly scoured the planet.





CHRISTOPHSIS

Christophsis is known for its crystal landscape, with vast plains of hexagonal gems and jagged forests of spires. It was the site of a desperate battle during the Clone Wars, in which Republic forces under General Kenobi and General Skywalker defeated a Separatist invasion force.



**NABOO**

A small but beautiful jewel of a world, Naboo was the home planet of Queen Padme Amidala and Senator Sheev Palpatine – who would go on to rule the galaxy as Emperor. Naboo is inhabited by the human society of the same name, and the native Gungans, an amphibious race who live in underwater cities.

In set: Jedi Knight Anakin Skywalker is secretly married to Padme Amidala.

Delta plant eating droids are used for food and sometimes used as pack animals.

In set: The Battle of Naboo is fought between the Gungans and the Trade Federation's battle droids. All seems lost until the droid control ship is destroyed in orbit by Anakin Skywalker.

In set: The iconic Doctor Nute Gunray, working for the Separatists, engineers the deadly Blue Shadow Virus to infect Naboo.


**BATTLE OF NABOO**

In set: Naboo is ruled by a shadow King or Queen. At the time of the invasion, the Queen was Padme Amidala, who turned two terms.

The Gungan Sacred Place is an ancient monument important to the Gungans, north of the Lianorm Swamp. A treaty with the Naboo was signed here.

**LAKE PAONGA**

In set: Bounty hunter Cad Bane kidnaps Chancellor Palpatine during the Festival of Light, but the plan is foiled by an undercover Obi-Wan Kenobi.



In set: The Gungan city of Otoh Gunga is the underwater capital city of the Gungans. The rough bubbles that it is made from are grown by the Gungans from the planet's natural plasma.



Gungan workers ride kouree land battles, and are armed with attack - long, flexible wooden poles which can cling explosive up to 30 meters.





ANDELM IV TO UTAPAU

ANDELM IV A remote world noted for its beetles, a source of the rare mineral dodecrite. During the Galactic Civil War a crime lord called Jaam enslaved the population, forcing them to harvest dodecrite for the Empire. His plans were foiled by the Wookiee Chewbacca and his friend Zatros.

ARKANS Rain falls endlessly on gloomy Arkans, ranging from drizzle to thunderstorms. The Empire built an academy here, run by Commandant Brendol Hux, to train a generation of elite officers. It was also the site of Project Harvester, which brought Force-sensitive children here for mysterious purposes.

BESPIN A gas giant with no land, just layers of dense gas through which strange creatures swim. Valuable tibanna gas is collected from van creatures called beldors and processed in the floating habitats in the upper, breathable layer of atmosphere, including the famous Cloud City.

DAGOBAH Grand Master Yoda once described Dagobah as 'one of the poorest places in the galaxy'. He first came here towards the end of the Clone Wars, drawn by a strange message from his old friend Qui-Gon Jinn, who had died many years earlier. Jinn had discovered the secret of

maintaining his identity after death and set Yoda on the path to discover it for himself. Following his failure to defeat Emperor Palpatine, Yoda exiled himself to Dagobah to meditate on the Force until a new hope could arise. It was here that he met Luke Skywalker.

D'QAR An obscure, tree-covered planet with no intelligent life and far from the main space lanes, D'Qar is of little interest. This made it a perfect choice as a secret base for the Rebel Alliance and later the Resistance – making it a target for the First Order's Starkiller weapon.

HOTH The frozen world Hoth was chosen as the new headquarters of the Rebel Alliance following the Battle of Yavin. The base was discovered by an Imperial probe droid, and Darth Vader moved swiftly to invade the planet. The rebels only narrowly escaped the Echo Base's destruction.



KAMINO This world is not on any maps. As part of an elaborate plot by Darth Sidious, it was erased from the Jedi Archives, and only rediscovered when Obi-Wan Kenobi was investigating the attempted assassination of the Naboo Senator Padmé Amidala. Kenobi traced the would-be assassin to the Wild Space planet Kamino, an endless ocean whose inhabitants had mastered the science of cloning. The Kaminoans had been paid to create a clone army for the Republic, using the DNA of the bounty hunter Jango Fett – the very assassin Kenobi was chasing.

MUSTAFAR Lava belches from the volcanoes that cover Mustafar's surface, while swarms of droids harvest rare minerals from the molten rock. Despite the searing heat of this harsh world, it is inhabited by the native Mustafarians, who labour in the mines and factories and live in underground caverns hollowed out by rock-eating lava flows.

POLIS MASSA Once a planet, Polis Massa was mysteriously shattered into an asteroid field. A scientific base here studies the disaster, and following Order 66 Yoda and Obi-Wan Kenobi found safety at the research station. It was here that Luke Skywalker and Leia Organa were born.


RYLOTH Ryloth has seen more than its share of war. During the Clone Wars, it was a battleground between the Republic and the Separatists, as Mace Windu and his forces battled to liberate the planet. Later, freedom fighter Charr Syndulla opposed the Empire's cruel occupation.

SULLUST A barren world of volcanoes and lakes whose people live in van underground cities. Half of all Sullustans work for the SoroSuub technology corporation. Sullustans are well known as pilots. Nien Nunb famously co-piloted the *Millennium Falcon* at the battle of Endor.


UTAPAU Hyperspace storms batter the surface of Utapau, forcing many of the planet's inhabitants – the Utai and Pau'ans – to live in giant sink-holes that lead down into the planet's crust. The Amasi, nomad settlers on Utapau, are hardy enough to dwell above ground in the grasslands. During the Clone Wars, Utapau was an important base for the Separatists, and it was here that Obi-Wan Kenobi tracked down General Grievous and challenged him to a duel. After a fierce battle, the Jedi Master managed to tear open the cyborg's armour and destroy him using his own blaster.

BATTLE OF HOTH


