INTRODUCTION

The Graf Archive covers the majority of the moon Orchis 2; its endless shelves, galleries and databanks contain texts, artworks, antiques, and even preserved plants and animals from every part of the galaxy.

Many items which cannot immediately be identified are moved to the underground Shadow Stacks, where they wait to be processed, often for many years. Venturing into these dusty basements is an important part of an Archivist's training, a kind of final exam: the challenge is to come back with a unexpected treasure. It can even be dangerous, as one young student discovered when the mummified ghost he was examining turned out to be merely hibernating...

These ancient hand-drawn maps were unearthed from the Shadow Stacks by a far luckier student. The Head Curator's theory is that they are the work of the great lithorian artist Gammit Chond. We know only a little about Chond – few of his works have survived – but these maps show much of his characteristic style and flair.

Chond never travelled offworld, and one history has it that he never ventured more than a day's walk from his home. He was, however, fascinated by travellers' tales, and many of his works depict their stories of adventure and discovery in the rest of the galaxy.

They are not, of course, strictly accurate. You would not be advised to try to cross the Jundland Wastes using Chond's map of Tatooine. The artist was more interested in the feel of these strange worlds, and the often galaxy-shaking events which took place on them.

Taken together, they seem to be centred on the saga of the legendary Skywalker family. While we know that many of the things he has included are a matter of fact, some may merely be tall tales spun by explorers; but it all presents a unique view of a fascinating slice of history.

After several years of painstaking restoration, it is my great privilege, and that of the Graf Archive, to present this never-before-seen trove of art to the galaxy.

THE GALAXY IS GENERALLY THOUGHT TO BE DIVIDED INTO THE FOLLOWING REGIONS. GALACTIC NORTH IS THE DIRECTION TOWARDS THE TOP OF THIS CHART.

DEEP CORE Densely packed stars rotate around the super-massive black hole at the heart of the galaxy. It is dangerous to navigate, and few travellers venture this far inward.

CORE WORLDS: The richest and most important worlds cluster around the edges of the Deep Core. These include Coruscant, Correllia, Kuat, Hothman Prime and other key systems.

Colonies This region contains planets colonised by the Core Worlds. The Colonies sit along major trade routes and some of them are extremely wealthy.

INNER RIM: When first settled, this area was known simply as 'the Rim' – it was the frontier of galactic civilisation for centuries. As colonisation spread outwards, the Inner Rim worlds prospered.

EXPANSION REGION: With competition for resources comes the need to expand, and the Expansion Region contains newer colonies sponsored by their coreward neighbors.

MID RIM: Many important worlds are found in the Mid Rim, including Naboo, Kashyyyk, Ithor and Malastare. Because it is relatively far from the Core, travelers should be wary of pirates.

OUTER RIM TERRITORIES: The largest region of the known galaxy is the Outer Rim, which contains many strange and often savage worlds. Some of the most important worlds in the Confederacy of Independent Systems – otherwise known as the Separatists, during the Clone Wars – were in this region.

UNKNOWN REGIONS: The Westward arm of the galaxy is mapped but largely unexplored. Who knows what lurks in the dark spaces beyond the frontiers of galactic civilisation?

Wild Space: Beyond the Outer Rim lies the unmapped expanse of Wild Space. Explorers and cartographers seek their fortune here at their peril.



TIMELINE

This timeline describes the period of history covered in these maps, from the Clone Wars between the Republic and the Separatists, to the Galactic Civil War between the Empire and the Rebel Alliance, and beyond.

Dates in this book are given using the "year-0" dating system, which is centered around the Battle of Yavin, when the first Death Star was destroyed. Therefore, 3 YAV is five years before the Battle of Yavin, and 5 YAV is five years after.

32 BBY The galaxy is governed by the Republic. On Coruscant, the capital world, Senators from a thousand worlds meet to debate the future, while the Jedi Order maintains peace and harmony.



The powerful Trade Federation, which controls galactic trade, bullies the remote world Naboo. Two Jedi, Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi, are sent to negotiate peace. However, the Trade Federation tries to assassinate the Jedi and sends their battle droid armies down to the planet to capture Queen Padmé Amidala.



Qui-Gon Jinn and Obi-Wan Kenobi rescue the Queen, but are forced to flee. Their ship needs repairs, so they stop on the remote desert world Tatooine. Here they meet the slave boy Anakin Skywalker, whose potential as a Jedi is the greatest Qui-Gon has ever seen. The Jedi win Anakin's freedom and take him away with them.



The Jedi escort Queen Amidala to Coruscant, but she cannot persuade the Senate to help Naboo. She returns to her homeworld with Qui-Gon, Obi-Wan and Anakin, and their Gungan friend Jar Jar Binks. The Gungans fight a battle against the Trade Federation's droid army as the Queen retakes her palace.



A sinister and deadly assassin has been tracking the Jedi: the Sith Lord Darth Maul. He and his Master, Darth Sidious, are secretly behind the Trade Federation's invasion. In a fierce battle beneath the city of Theed, he slays Qui-Gon Jinn, but is himself cut in half by Obi-Wan and seemingly destroyed.



31 BBY The Gungans and the Naboo defeat the droid army with the help of Anakin Skywalker. The Trade Federation is forced to withdraw.



30 BBY Senator Palpatine of Naboo has been made Supreme Chancellor. Secretly, he is the evil Sith Lord Darth Sidious. He plans to start a galactic war to scare the Republic into building up the military he needs in order to seize absolute power for himself.



The former Jedi Master Count Dooku has sparked a crisis, with his Confederacy of Independent Systems – the so-called Separatists – threatening to split from the Republic. The Senate must decide whether or not to create an Army of the Republic. One prominent opponent of this plan is Padmé Amidala, who is now a Senator.



A series of attempts on Senator Amidala's life leads Obi-Wan Kenobi to the planet Kamino. Here he discovers an army of clones, secretly ordered by a now-dead Jedi Master, and based on the bounty hunter Jango Fett, who is the assassin he has been seeking. He follows Fett to Geonosis.



Anakin, now a Jedi apprentice, is assigned to protect Padmé. They travel to Naboo, where they begin to fall in love. Anakin is troubled by dreams about his mother, Shmi, whom he was forced to leave behind on Tatooine many years ago.



On Tatooine, Anakin discovers that his mother has been kidnapped by the Sand People. He is unable to save her life, and in a rage, he slaughters the tribe.



Obi-Wan is captured on Geonosis by the Separatists, as are Anakin and Padmé when they try to rescue him.



Jedi Master Mace Windu leads a team of Jedi to the rescue, backed by the clone army that now serves the Republic. Windu slays Fett, but Count Dooku escapes, pursued by Anakin Skywalker and Obi-Wan Kenobi.



29 BBY The Jedi catch up with Dooku but he reveals that he is the Sith Lord Darth Tyranus, the new apprentice of Darth Sidious. He easily defeats both Anakin and Obi-Wan. It is only the last-minute intervention of Grand Master Yoda that saves them. Dooku is forced to flee, but his work is done: the Republic now has its army.



On Naboo, Anakin marries Padmé Amidala in secret. Meanwhile, the Clone Wars have begun, as the Separatists under Count Dooku battle Palpatine's Republic.



The armies of the Republic are now led by Jedi Master Kenobi and Jedi Knight Skywalker defeat a Separatist invasion of the planet Christophsis with the help of Ahsoka Tano, Skywalker's new Padawan apprentice.



The Separatists attempt to turn the planet Rodia against the Republic, capturing Senator Amidala. She escapes with the help of Jar Jar Binks and keeps Rodia's support.



28 BBY With the help of the Twi'lek freedom fighter Cham Syndulla, Master Mace Windu retakes the planet Ryloth from the Separatists. Their heroics are long remembered in song among the Twi'lek people.



Republic forces launch a massive attack on Geonosis, the home of the Separatists' droid armies. They destroy the vast battle-droid factories.



27 BBY The Nightmarchers of Dathomir attempt to assassinate Count Dooku. In revenge, he sends an army under his general, Grievous, to destroy them. Despite the witch Old Daka raising an army of the undead to oppose his droids, Grievous is successful.



The former Sith Lord Maul, thought to have perished during the Battle of Naboo, resurfaces with his teenage apprentice Savage Opress. Now equipped with cybernetic legs, he seeks revenge on his one-time Master Darth Sidious and his merry Obi-Wan Kenobi.



26 BBY When Onderon's King Sanjay Rash sides with the Separatists, a group of rebels under Sola Gerra and her brother Saw fight bravely to resist them with the help of Ahsoka Tano. The Onderon rebels would eventually form part of the Rebel Alliance.



25 BBY Maul's Shadow Collective, formed of Death Watch and various criminal gangs, takes over the planet Mandalore. As revenge on Obi-Wan Kenobi, Maul kills Duchess Satine Kryze, for whom Kenobi had strong feelings. Maul's victory is short-lived, as Darth Sidious arrives to defeat both him and Opus.



Ahsoka Tano is framed for a Separatist bombing by the traitorous Jedi Padawan Barriss Offee. Though her innocence is eventually proven by her Master Anakin Skywalker, she decides to leave the Jedi Order.



Separatists attack Coruscant and kidnap Chancellor Palpatine. Skywalker and Kenobi mount a rescue. Skywalker defeats Dooku in single combat, and Palpatine goads him into killing the Count – secretly, his own apprentice.



Though he is the hero of the battle of Coruscant, Anakin is troubled by the Jedi's mistrust of him and his mentor the Chancellor. He is also plagued by dreams that seem to predict the death of his wife.



Anakin discovers that Palpatine is Darth Sidious, but the Sith Lord promises he can help to save Padmé. When Mace Windu tries to arrest the Chancellor, Anakin helps to destroy the Jedi Master. He falls to the dark side and his new Master names him Darth Vader.



Vader is sent to the Jedi Temple to massacre all he finds there. Meanwhile, Palpatine issues Order 66 to the clone army: a secret command, enforced by a chip in the clones' brains, which compels them to assassinate the Jedi. Almost all the Jedi perish, though Obi-Wan Kenobi and Grand Master Yoda survive.



19 BBY

On Utapau, Obi-Wan Kenobi's clone troops have captured General Grievous, but they turn their fire on Kenobi as Order 66 is issued. Kenobi escapes and duels Grievous, killing the cyborg.



Grand Master Yoda goes to the Senate on Coruscant to confront Darth Sidious, but he is unable to defeat the Sith Lord in combat. The Jedi retreats and exiles himself to the planet Dagobah.



Vader travels to the law world Mustafar, where he slays the Separatist leaders, ending the Clone War for his Master. Obi-Wan follows him and, in an epic duel, defeats him. Vader's injuries are severe and require him to wear a cyborg suit of armor to survive from this point on.



Padmé Amidala gives birth to twins, Luke and Leia, but does not herself survive. Luke is hidden on Tatooine with the Lars family, and Leia is adopted by Senator Bail Organa of Alderaan.



Supreme Chancellor Palpatine declares himself Galactic Emperor.



1 BBY

On the remote planet Lothal a group of rebels led by Hera Syndulla of Ryloth and the former Jedi Padawan Kanan Jarrus is formed. Ezra Bridger, an orphaned street thief, joins the crew of their ship the *Ghost* and begins to train in the ways of the Jedi.



4 BBY

After many battles, Kanan Jarrus is captured by the Grand Inquisitor, a fearsome Jedi hunter, and taken aboard Grand Moff Tarkin's flagship the *Sovereign* in orbit above Mustafar. A daring raid by his friends from Jarrus, who then defeats the Inquisitor in combat. The Inquisitor and the *Sovereign* are both destroyed.



0 BBY

A covert team of rebel agents is tasked with a crucial mission: to steal the plans of the Empire's new battle station, the Death Star. The mission is led by Cassian Andor and Jyn Erso, and takes the Rogue One team to the planet Jedha.



0 BBY

Darth Vader captures the *Tantive IV* and its passenger Princess Leia Organa, the Senator from Alderaan. He accuses her of being a rebel traitor who is in possession of the Death Star plans—but the Princess has already sent them off the ship, in the possession of her droid R2-D2.



R2-D2 and his counterpart C-3PO meet Luke Skywalker on Tatooine and take him to meet Obi-Wan Kenobi. When the Empire kills his uncle and aunt, Luke decides to train as a Jedi and to fight for the rebels against the oppressors.



Luke, Obi-Wan, R2-D2 and C-3PO travel to Mos Eisley spaceport where they hire Han Solo and Chewbacca to take them and the secret plans to the rebels on Alderaan. They travel in Solo's ship the *Millennium Falcon* to Alderaan, only to discover that the planet has been destroyed by the Death Star. The crew rescues Leia from Imperial custody and they flee to the *Millennium Falcon*.



Obi-Wan confronts his former pupil Darth Vader. He sacrifices himself, becoming one with the Force, as his friends make their escape. The Empire tracks the *Falcon* to Yavin 4.



As the Death Star closes on the rebel base, a desperate starfighter raid is launched against the battle station. Using the Force, Luke Skywalker fires the shot that destroys it, striking a key blow for the rebellion.



3 ABY

Darth Vader sends probe droids across the galaxy and eventually locates the new rebel base on Hoth. His invasion force is able to destroy it, but not before the rebels escape. Meanwhile, Luke is visited by the spirit of Obi-Wan Kenobi, who tells him to travel to Dagobah.



Luke meets Yoda on Dagobah and begins his Jedi training. Han, Leia, Chewbacca and the droids stop at Bespin to repair the *Falcon*, unaware that Vader's bounty hunter Boba Fett has tracked them there.



3 ABY

Vader captures Luke's friends and friend Han Solo in carbonite. Han's friend, the Bann Administrator of Cloud City Lando Calrissian, struggles with his conscience as Boba Fett takes Solo away as a trophy for Jabba the Hutt.



Luke travels to Cloud City to rescue his friends. He confronts Vader, who defeats him in a duel. Vader reveals that he is Luke's father. Luke narrowly escapes in the *Millennium Falcon*.



4 ABY

Leia, Lando, Chewbacca, R2-D2 and Luke rescue Han Solo from Jabba the Hutt's palace on Tatooine, slaying the vile gangster. Luke is now a fully fledged Jedi Knight.



Luke returns to Dagobah, where his Master Yoda has reached the end of his life. The ancient Jedi tells Luke about his family—including the fact that Leia is his sister—and becomes one with the Force.



The Rebel Alliance is informed that a second Death Star is nearing completion and that the Emperor will be on board. They plan to destroy it in an all-out attack. Their fleet assembles for the raid, without realizing that it is a trap, and the battle station is already operational.



Han Solo leads a commando team to the Sanctuary Moon of Endor to destroy the shield generator protecting the Death Star. They meet the Ewoks, who help them.



Luke Skywalker strikes down his father Darth Vader but refuses to kill him, knowing that would lead him to the dark side. The Emperor decides to kill Luke, but Anakin Skywalker cannot bear to see his son destroyed and instead sacrifices his own life to destroy the Emperor.



Luke escapes the Death Star and, with the shield brought down, Lando Calrissian and Wedge Antilles destroy the battle station. Not long afterwards the Empire is finally defeated at the Battle of Jakku, and a New Republic is formed.



34 ABY

Kylo Ren, the dark enforcer of the First Order, seeks a map to the location of Luke Skywalker, who has withdrawn from galactic affairs. The explorer Lor San Tekka, however, has already given it to the Resistance pilot Poe Dameron and his droid BB-8.



A First Order stormtrooper, FN-2187, and a scavenger, Rey, are brought together on Jakku with BB-8. They flee the First Order in a stolen ship found in a junkyard, the *Millennium Falcon*, and are soon intercepted by Han Solo and Chewbacca.



Han Solo takes FN-2187—now Finn—and Rey to Takodana. He asks Maz Kanata to arrange passage for BB-8's precious data. The First Order learns of this, and Kylo Ren attacks, capturing Rey and destroying Maz's castle.



The Resistance must attack the First Order's superweapon, Starkiller Base, when it destroys the Hosnian system, which contains the Senate. A small team will travel to the base to take down the planetary shields, before fighters can attack.



Finn, Han Solo and Chewbacca fly the *Millennium Falcon* to Starkiller Base and meet Rey, who has freed herself from Kylo Ren's clutches. Together, they manage to take down the planetary shields and plant explosives.



Han Solo pleads with his son Ben—now known as Kylo Ren—to turn away from the dark side. But Ren embraces the darkness within himself, slaying his father.



Rey, whose Force abilities are suddenly awakened by the danger, takes up the lightsaber of Luke Skywalker and defeats Kylo Ren in battle.



Poe Dameron leads his X-wing squadron in an attack run on the Starkiller and fires the shot that destroys the monstrous weapon. Rey, Finn and Chewbacca escape as the base explodes.



ABAFAR TO YAVIN 4

ABAFAR A barren world rich in dyolanium. During the Clone Wars the Separatists loaded a stolen freighter with this explosive and tried to use it to blow up a top Republic military conference. They were thwarted by D-Squad, a covert team of droids under Colonel Meebur Gascon.

DANTOONIE Once used by the Rebel Alliance as a base, it was the location given by Princess Leia to Grand Moff Tarkin when he demanded she reveal their headquarters. Because Dantoone was too remote to serve as a demonstration of the Death Star's power, Tarkin targeted Alderaan instead.

DATHOMER A mysterious world of jungles, swamps and mountains, haunted by witches and nincoms. Dathomir's Nightstewers were one of the known groups of Force-users who were not Jedi or Sith until conflict with Darth Tyranus and Darth Sidious led to one of their clans being massacred.

FELICIA Felucia's position in the middle of an important hyperspace lane made it a key target during the Clone Wars. Many battles were fought for control of it. The planet itself is a farm world with great jungles of fungus. It is noted for its production of the valuable healing herb mytilin.

ITHOR The peaceful Ithorian people, sometimes known as 'hammerheads', tend to the sacred jungles of their homeworlds. They are known for their remarkable farming technology; the Galactic Empire forced them to reveal their secrets in return for sparing the planet a devastating invasion.

JELUCAN A world of ice and towering mountain peaks. Jelucan was settled in two waves of colonists: the second-wavers became rich miners, while the first-wavers clung to their more rigid mountain traditions. It was notable as the homeworld of star-crossed lovers Thane Kyrill and Ciena Ree.

LOLA SATU From orbit, Lola Satu is a purple jewel of a planet. It is volcanic, with a cracked surface through which lakes of lava bubble up. It was once the site of a Jedi prison called the Citadel. When the Separatists took over the planet, they used it to hold Jedi prisoners of their own.

MARIDUN A grass-covered planet, home to the peace-loving Lurmen. It was used to test a new Separatist weapon: the Defoliator, which destroyed life but not technology – like the Separatists' battle droids. The scheme was foiled by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Ahnoka Tano and Aayla Secura.



MON CALA The vast oceans of Mon Cala are home to the Mon Calamari and Quarren species. A bitter struggle between the two led to them taking opposite sides during the Clone Wars. The Republic defeated the Separatists; Lee-Char of the Mon Calamari proved himself in battle, becoming King.

The planet suffered under the Empire, and the Mon Calamari became key allies of the rebels. Admiral Ackbar was commander of the rebel fleet at the Battle of Endor.

Mon Calamari ships were some of the largest and most powerful in the rebel fleet.

MORABAND The desolate homeworld of the Sith holds many evil secrets. In the Valley of the Dark Lords the tombs of powerful Sith are haunted by the presence of the dark side. Yoda travelled here as part of his quest to discover the secret of immortality and encountered a vision of Darth Bane.

MORTIS Discovered by the Jedi Anakin Skywalker, Mortis is a mysterious realm resembling a bizarre planet whose landscape changes constantly. It was home to three powerful 'Force wielders', the Daughter, the Son and the Father, who represented the light, the dark and balance respectively.

QUERMIA Home to the Quarren species – tall, pale humanoid with long necks and two pairs of arms. Quarren Jedi Master Yael Poof was a respected member of the Jedi Council, known for his skill with diplomacy, illusions and mind tricks.

RAXUS The capital of the Confederacy of Independent Systems during the Clone Wars, Raxus is a beautiful world of forests, plains and oceans. From here, Count Dooku sparked the Separatist Crisis that led to the Clone Wars and the fall of the Republic.

SCPIO The InterGalactic Banking Clan was one of the most important organisations in the Outer Rim, based on the icy planet Scpio. During the Clone Wars this key Separatist planet was captured by the Republic, giving Chancellor Palpatine control of the galaxy's largest banking system.

SERENNO A forested world that was home to Count Dooku, one of the central figures of the Clone Wars. An aristocrat who gave up his title to join the Jedi Order, he later became disillusioned and left to form the Separatists. He was also, secretly, Darth Tyranus, apprentice to Darth Sidious.

STYGION PRIME The snow-capped mountains of Stygiion Prime hid the high-security prison known as the Spire. Darth Sidious imprisoned his former apprentice Maul here, and kept the remains of Jedi Master Luminara Unduli here to lure in any Jedi who survived the Order's destruction.

YAVIN 4 The small jungle moon which served as a base for the Rebel Alliance for their assault on the first Death Star. The location of the rebel base here was the crucial secret held back by the rebel leader and Senator Leia Organa during her interrogation by Darth Vader.

DATHOMIR

A remote world lit by a dim red star, Dathomir's jungles, forests and swamplands were home to the Nightbrothers – a clan of Force-using witches – and the Zabrak Nightbrothers, famed for their fighting prowess.

The planet is infamous as the home of the warlords Asajj Ventress and Darth Maul, who were both trained in the ways of the dark side before turning away from the Sith.

BATTLE OF YAVIN

In an attempt to discover the location of the rebel base and to destroy the rebellion forever, Grand Moff Tarkin and Darth Vader allow Princess Leia to be rescued from the Death Star by the crew of the *Millennium Falcon*. The Empire tracks the freighter to Yavin 4, where the rebels have one last opportunity to destroy the battle station before it is able to fire on them.

Fast, maneuverable X-wings are able to evade the Death Star's turbolasers.



Grand Moff Tarkin refuses to believe that his battle station is under threat and refuses to launch during the attack.



With Darth Vader about to destroy Luke Skywalker's X-wing, the *Millennium Falcon* attempts to rescue him.



After the battle, Imperial pilot Cassa Rex is sent to rescue Darth Vader. She is shocked by the destruction of the Death Star and the death of many friends.

While most of the population lives in underwater cities, some cities are built entirely or partially above the water.

MON CALA

Mon Cala is a strategically important ocean world inhabited by two aquatic species, the Mon Calamari and the Quarren. During the Imperial era the planet suffered under occupation and began to provide secret support to the Alliance to Restore the Republic in the form of ships as well as soldiers like Admiral Ackbar.

With the risk of battle looming in favor of the Separatists, the Republic calls in a squad of Geonosis from Naboo.

Captain Ackbar's Mon Calamari Guard.

Captain Ackbar and his Mon Calamari Guard only to support Prince Lee-Char against the Quarren and their Separatist allies.

The Jedi Council sends clone troopers and Jedi, including Anakin Skywalker and Ahsoka Tano, to help against the Separatists.

Anakin uses the Force to collapse the central Phantasm Scanner so that Republic reinforcements can land.

Prince Lee-Char loses his father's mentor, Riff Tansum, in a single combat and slays the infamous Karabidde commander.

As the civil war between the Mon Cala and the Quarren rages, the Separatists attack in Tiberus assault ships.

With King Tiberus dead, the Quarren refuse to let the young and inexperienced Prince Lee-Char become their new ruler. The long peace between them and the Mon Calamari breaks down into civil war.

Riff Tansum and the Quarren challenge Anakin to resolve their hatred from Coruscant.

Anakin, Kit Fisto, Padmé Amidala and Jar Jar Binks are captured but later escape.

Mace Lu Fisto defends Prince Lee-Char from Riff Tansum—but is captured, but the Prince escapes.

Anakin, Kit Fisto, Padmé Amidala and Jar Jar Binks are captured but later escape.

MORTIS

During the Clone Wars, Anakin Skywalker, Obi-Wan Kenobi and Ahsoka Tano are drawn through a bizarre portal into the world of Mortis—a world seemingly fashioned from the Force itself. They encounter the Father, a Force Wielder who keeps the balance between his children, the Daughter and the Son. The Father intends to test Anakin, to discover if he is truly the Chosen One...



The Son and the Daughter are capable of transforming into huge, winged beasts.

Obi-Wan, Anakin and Ahsoka explore the lush, beautiful landscapes of Mortis. It is a world with the Force and a strange, ancient, with its floating islands of rock.



Obi-Wan and Anakin have strange visions inside a mountain cave. Obi-Wan is visited by the spirit of his old Master, Qui-Gon Jinn.

In an underground chamber lies the Altar of Mortis. It holds the Daggers of Mortis—the only weapons capable of killing the Father, the Son or the Daughter.

Ahsoka is kidnapped by the Son and, infected with the dark side of the Force, filled with rage, she is forced against Obi-Wan and Anakin as they fight the Son for the Daggers.

Anakin is killed by the Son. The Daughter demands her life force through Anakin to revive him.

The Son shows Anakin a glimpse of his future, including the terrible fate that awaits him as Darth Vader. Later, the Father saves Anakin's memory of this vision.



The Son, transformed into a winged beast, kidnaps Ahsoka Tano.

The Father keeps the balance between the Daughter and the Son. He discovers himself with the Daggers of Mortis to prevent the Son from attempting...

ALDERAAN TO TETH

ALDERAAN Known for its stunning natural beauty, Alderaan was one of the oldest members of the Galactic Republic, a peaceful world whose people valued art and culture. Because of its leaders' secret support for the Rebel Alliance, it was destroyed by the Empire using the Death Star.

ANTAR 4 Scene of the infamous *Antar Atrocity* carried out by Grand Moff Tarkin as a warning to former Separatists.

BALNAB A primitive world once visited by C-3PO and R2-D2. The planet's ruler was a hologram created by a group of stranded pit droids.

CORELLIA An important Core World known for its ships and pilots. Han Solo and Wedge Antilles were born here, and the Corellian Engineering Corporation manufactured the YT-1300 light freighter the *Millennium Falcon*, known as one of the fastest ships in the galaxy.

CORUSCANT Capital of the Republic and later the Galactic Empire. It is a planet covered by a vast city of skyscrapers, rising miles into the sky.

After the Galactic Civil War the Galactic Senate of the New Republic moved from system to system on a rotating basis.

GABRI Briefly the hiding place of the rebel cell led by Hera Syndulla and Kanan Jarrus, during the Imperial years.

GORM A mining world, with one side permanently in darkness and the other in blazing sunlight. Kanan Jarrus met Hera Syndulla here.

HOINIAN PRIME With the Empire defeated, a New Republic rose from the ashes. Its capital was changed by election every few years, and while the Senate was based on Hoinian Prime the First Order used Starkiller Base to destroy the system, the Senate, and much of the Republic fleet.

JEDHA An ancient world, dusty Jedha was once a place of holy pilgrimage. During Imperial occupation, extremist rebel Saw Gerrera had a hideout here.

KASHIYYIK The Woolkie homeworld, known for its majestic wushyr trees. Cities spiral around their huge trunks.

KESSEL One side of this world is lush and beautiful: elegant palaces and their exquisitely tended grounds sit among green farms and crystal lakes. On the other side of the world, vast colonies of slaves labour in the infamous spice mines. Spice smugglers can make vast profits on the 'Kessel Run.'



Kuat The shipyards of Kuat are famous throughout the galaxy; it was here that the Republic's *Axial* assault ships and the Empire's *Star Destroyer* were built. A vast man-made ring of factories and spacedocks encircles the planet, allowing huge vehicles to be built in orbit.

LOTHAL A quiet and peaceful agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal at first welcomed the Galactic Empire. However, the Empire soon began to oppress and exploit Lothal, strip-mining it for minerals. A famous cell of rebels formed here and won notable victories against the Empire.

MANDALORE The Mandalorian people were once renowned as fierce and deadly warriors. The New Mandalorians, however, have tried to put the violence of the past behind them. They are opposed by terrorists like Death Watch, operating from their exile on Mandalore's moon Concordia.

ONDERON Onderon's thick jungles are inhabited by deadly creatures. The humans on the planet live in cities protected by thick walls, such as the capital city Iuz. A key rebel leader, Saw Gerrera, waged a guerrilla campaign here against the occupying Separatist forces with the help of the Jedi.

OLD MANTELL A mountainous world covered by thick, pinkish clouds and inhabited by Falleen and humans, Old Mantell is well known as a base of the Black Sun gang. During the Clone Wars, Maul's Shadow Collective took over the Black Sun and fought a battle here against the Separatists.

RUANAN During the Clone Wars, one of Ruanan's three moons hid a Separatist base, Skytop Station, eavesdropping on Republic transmissions. General Grievous took the captured R2-D2 here to unlock the Republic secrets in his databanks. The astromech was rescued by Anakin Skywalker.

SALUCAMI Many people who wished to escape the chaos of the Clone Wars settled on remote Salucami, including clone trooper Cax Lawquane, who deserved to raise a family. War did, eventually, reach the planet, as the Republic and the Separatists clashed in one of the final battles of the conflict.

SHANTIPOLE Lightning storms rage among the mountain spires of Shantipole; the atmosphere is highly dangerous for piloting starships. It is here, away from the watchful gaze of the Empire, that the Mon Calamari engineer Quarrie invented the prototype Blade Wing or B-wing fighter for the rebels.

SHILIC The homeworld of the Yogruta, who are instantly recognizable thanks to their brightly patterned skin, head-tails, and mantras - hollow, cone-shaped horns which allow the Yogruta to track movement. Two famous Jedi hailed from Shilic: Jedi Master Shaak Ti and the Padawan Ahsoka Tano.

TETH A mountainous jungle planet in a Hutt-controlled area of Wild Space. Teth was once inhabited by the bizarre monks of the B'omarr Order, whose brains were transplanted into spider-like droid bodies. It was the scene of the daring rescue of the infant Rotta the Hutt by Anakin Skywalker.

LOTHAL

A once tranquil agricultural world known for its jogan fruit, Lothal suffered under the Galactic Empire, which ruthlessly strip-mined the planet for ores and crystals to fuel military production. It was on Lothal that the rebel cell founded by Kanan Jarrus and Hera Syndulla came together and won a series of notable victories against Imperial forces.



4 year: Zee Looze and Mace Tupper, who were in the Imperial Academy, begin to investigate the Empire's activities.

5 year: Eon Bridge, an orphan, dies in an accidental communications tower. He collects Imperial soldiers, including that of a TIE fighter pilot who attacked him.

Loth cats are a feline species native to Lothal. They catch the groundhills, hunting their main prey the kothan.

6 year: Eon Bridge infiltrates the Imperial Academy on Lothal, where he meets Zee Looze—who also has a rebellious hidden agenda.

7 year: Hera Syndulla tracks out Senator Gellius, whom she has discovered is posing as a rebel sympathizer to have them into a trap.

8 year: Eon Bridge joins the crew of the Ghost.

9 year: The Lothal rebels manage to destroy a new prototype TIE fighter on Empire Day.

10 year: Pursued by Kanan Jarrus, Eon Bridge flees with stolen Imperial cargo.

11 year: Kanan Jarrus takes his apprentice Eon Bridge to the old Jedi Temple on Lothal. Here, Eon is tested and is able to communicate with Mace Tupper.

12 year: Eon Bridge and Garazeb Ordelean are sent out for fruit but end up meeting a TIE fighter.

13 year: Old Jedi Plo Koon, a warrior in the small settlement of Jorjol, is an outcast to the rebels.

14 year: Ephraim and Mira Bridger start to make underground radio broadcasts against Imperial rule—the Bridger Transmission.

15 year: The Lothal rebels occupy a radio tower and broadcast a stirring message of resistance against the Empire.

16 year: Darth Vader joins them on a mission for Kanan Jarrus and Eon Bridge.

17 year: With the failure of the Grand Inquisitor, the Empire sends a replacement to Lothal to hunt for the rebel cell: the Dark Lord of the Sith Darth Vader.

18 year: Zee Looze becomes a subject to the legendary goddess Lando Calrissian.



STARKILLER BASE

The First Order's ultimate weapon, even more fearsome than the Death Star, is constructed from an entire planet. It fires a beam of phantom energy through hyperspace and is capable of destroying entire star systems. Recharging the weapon requires that the power of a sun be utterly drained.



GENERAL HUX

Phantom shields prevent ships from landing - unless they are travelling at lightspeed. Han Solo and Chewbacca bring the Millennium Falcon out of hyperspace beneath the shields, an incredibly dangerous and skilled maneuver.



Kylo Ren attempts to convert and turn Rey to the dark side. However, she fights back, using the Force instinctively.



Kylo Ren, hurt and wounded by Chewbacca, pursues Rey and Finn outside the base. He duels Finn and seriously wounds him, before Rey intervenes a light Saber and attacks furiously. The Knight of Ren is defeated. As the Starkiller weapon is destroyed and the planet begins to crumble, Rey is rescued by Chewbacca in the Falcon.



Rey and Finn escape from Starkiller Base in a stolen First Order transport, pursued by stormtroopers. They are able to fight off their attackers.



General Hux rallies the troops of the First Order as he prepares to fire the Starkiller weapon for the last time. The immensely powerful beam destroys five key Republic star systems and much of their navy.



Now reunited with Rey, Han Solo, Finn and Chewbacca plan to place explosives to expose the crucial weakness. With this destroyed, the weapon will overheat, blowing up the entire base.



Finn, who was once captured on the base, helps Han Solo and Chewbacca make their way inside. He aims to rescue Rey.



CAPTAIN PHASMA



Finn, Han Solo and Chewbacca make their way inside and capture Captain Phasma. They have her to turn the base's shields.



With the phantom shields brought down, the Falcon's lightsaber weapons are able to attack the facility.



KYLO REN



Kylo Ren fully embraces the dark side, surrendering his father, Han Solo.

Rey escapes from her cell by using a Jedi mind trick and looks for a way off the planet. By chance, she finds Finn, Han Solo and Chewbacca infiltrating the base.



The mysterious Supreme Leader Snoke orders to talk to his underlings via a giant hologram in his throne room. It is here that he orders Hux to use the Starkiller Base against the Republic.

The second Death Star is even larger and more powerful than the first, and the rebels plan an all-out raid to destroy it before it becomes operational. However, they are being lured into a trap, designed to end the Galactic Civil War in the Empire's favour. As General Solo's commando team tries to take down the station's protective shield, a battle rages in orbit...

The Emperor reveals that the rebels have trapped him in his way: the battle station is fully operational. It lies on the Moon Calamari and the rebels' Liberty is destroyed.



EMPEROR PALPATINE



Luke Skywalker and Darth Vader duel as the Emperor tries to turn the young Jedi to the dark side. Skywalker strikes his father down but then refuses to kill him, remembering.

As the Emperor prepares to kill Luke Skywalker, the problem is resolved. Skywalker is revealed, the Emperor is killed, and the rebels are victorious.

33,000: During a visit, the bounty hunter Cad Bane takes a Force-sensitive Rodian child away as the sister of Senator Polypus, who plans to use his powers for evil.

33,000: Mace by lack of judgment, Jar Jar Binks escapes the battle droids which are trying to kill him.



33,000: Senator Padmé Amidala is already pledged allegiance to the Separatists and when Amidala later returns.



33,000: Amidala is imprisoned in a high-security room while battle droids hunt for Jar Jar Binks and C-3PO.

33,000: Trade Federation Viceroy Nute Gunray arrives on Rodia to capture Senator Amidala.



33,000: C-3PO is captured by battle droids.



33,000: Senator Amidala makes a daring escape from prison, capturing some battle droids.



33,000: The talking "Jungle Monster" - a Kwazel Maw - comes on Jar Jar's screen.



33,000: C-3PO manages to send a distress call about Senator Amidala's capture.



33,000: Jar Jar Binks is mistaken for a Jedi by the Separatists and tries to rescue Amidala.

The swamps of Rodia are home to countless varieties of snakes.



Ghosts are deadly snakes like predators that can bury themselves in soil. Luke Skywalker was once near the mouth of the Jedi Master.



GEONOSIS

A rocky desert world inhabited by an insectoid race, whose great domes and spires resemble natural formations. Geonosis has long renowned for its manufacturing industries: the Separatist droid armies were built here, and the first Death Star was partially constructed in orbit. Later, however, the Empire ruthlessly mined the planet.



11 years: Darth Vader and the architect De Aguiar conduct the Commission's tour of a planet now around of life by the Empire.



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THE SECOND BATTLE OF GEONOSIS

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TATOOINE

Once described as the place that's farthest away from the bright centre of the universe, the remote desert planet Tatooine hides beneath its twin suns. It is home to two native species, Jawas and Tusken, as well as a wide variety of newcomers. Tatooine is famous as the homeworld of two great Jedi – Anakin and Luke Skywalker.

MOS ESPA

A port city run by the Hutts, Mos Espa is known for its dangerous gambling circuit and especially the famous Boonta Eve Classic Podrace.

16 years: Jedi Master Yoda, a Twi'lek, makes a bet with Qui-Gon Jinn on a podrace. The stakes are a new Jedi temple for Qui-Gon's Jedi Order and the freedom of the slave boy Anakin Skywalker.



17 years: Following the Jedi Purge, Qui-Gon Jinn brought the infant Luke Skywalker to Tatooine. He would watch over the child for the next 13 years.



18 years: Luke Skywalker, on searching for R2-D2, is rescued by a gang of Sand People but rescued at the last moment by Obi-Wan Kenobi.



19 years: Separated from each other, R2-D2 and C-3PO are both captured by Jawa scavengers.



20 years: The escape pod launched from the Tantive IV blacked out in the desert. In response, the droids R2-D2 and C-3PO set off in search of help, while Imperial troops track them.

CHRISTOPHSIS

Christophsis is known for its crystal landscape, with vast plains of hexagonal gems and jagged forests of spires. It was the site of a desperate battle during the Clone Wars, in which Republic forces under General Kenobi and General Skywalker defeated a Separatist invasion force.

Anakin Skywalker gets an unexpected surprise as he is introduced to his new Padawan apprentice, Ahsoka Tano.

Clone troopers of the 501st Legion fight a desperate battle against the Separatist battle droids.

Clone troopers set up powerful artillery positions to blast back the Separatist advance.

Republic commanders unleash the battle droids from zip lines.

Captain Rex is the first to spot the Separatist's energy shield. He signals Trooper Commander to help destroy it with the battle droids.

The Jedi Kenobi, Skywalker, Tano, and the Clone Captain Rex and R2-D2, discuss battle tactics.

The Separatist forces are protected by an energy shield that moves as they advance, leading the Jedi Anakin Skywalker and Ahsoka Tano to mount a stealth raid.

LR-577 battle droids protect the Separatist shield generators, but the Jedi nevertheless destroy them.

Anakin Skywalker destroys the Separatist's Obi-wan Kenobi's shield.

Separatist forces on Christophsis are led by the Kothican, General Whorm Loathsom.

Obi-wan Kenobi calls for truce as Anakin and Ahsoka assault the Separatist shield generator. He slashes papers off, and the Republic are victorious.

A traitorous clone trooper, Rex, is found to be passing information to the Separatists. Commander Cody kills him on the spot.

NABOO

A small but beautiful jewel of a world, Naboo was the home planet of Queen Padmé Amidala and Senator Sheev Palpatine – who would go on to rule the galaxy as Emperor. Naboo is inhabited by the human society of the same name, and the native Gungans, an amphibious race who live in underwater cities.

THEED

The beautiful city of Theed is the capital of the Naboo. Six waterfalls cascade over the cliffs on which it perches. Nearby the Royal Palace is a lounge and a government complex.

The ancient Sith Lord Darth Maul strikes down Qui-Gon Jinn in the palace's generator complex.



Obi-Wan Kenobi avenges the death of his Master by defeating Darth Maul. The remains are cut in two and left in the depths of the facility.



Naboo is ruled by an elected King or Queen. At the time of the invasion, the Queen was Padmé Amidala, who served two terms.

BATTLE OF NABOO



Beauty hunter Cati Bane kidnaps Chancellor Palpatine during the Festival of Light, but the plot is thwarted by an undercover Obi-Wan Kenobi.



As Jedi Knight Anakin Skywalker is secretly married to Padmé Amidala.



The Battle of Naboo is fought between the Gungans and the Trade Federation's battle droids. All events but one – the desert control ship – is destroyed in orbit by Anakin Skywalker.

Droids, plants using droids as food for food and sometimes used as pack animals.



LIANORM SWAMP

Prehistoric tanks are found on Naboo and can even be used as mounts.

The Gungan Sacred Place is an ancient monument, important to the Gungans, north of the Lianorm Swamp. A treaty with the Naboo was signed here.



As Jedi Master Qui-Gon Jinn and his Padawan Obi-Wan Kenobi escape the Trade Federation and land on Naboo to save the Queen. They meet a Gungan captain, Jar Jar Binks.



PLANET CORE

Naboo's crust is porous and full of water. A large subterranean canal great distance beneath the surface, if it does not fall flat of giant sea horses such as the solo class fish, upon and inside.



The Gungans are ruled by a High Council, chaired by a Boss. At the time of the invasion, Boss Yoda is in charge.



The city of Ottoh Gungia is the underwater capital city of the Gungans. The rough bubble that it is made from are grown by the Gungans from the planet's natural plants.



Gungan warriors ride lander into battle, and are armed with sticky – long, flexible, sticky poles which can cling explosives up to 30 meters.



ANDELM IV TO UTAPAU

ANDELM IV: A remote world noted for its beetles, a source of the rare mineral dedlarite. During the Galactic Civil War a crime lord called Jaum enslaved the population, forcing them to harvest dedlarite for the Empire. His plans were foiled by the Wookiee Chewbacca and his friend Zatto.

ARKANIS: Rain falls endlessly on gloomy Arkanis, ranging from drizzle to thunderstorms. The Empire built an academy here, run by Commandant Brendol Hux, to train a generation of elite officers. It was also the site of Project Harvestar, which brought Force-sensitive children here for mysterious purposes.

BESPIN: A gas giant with no land, just layers of dense gas through which strange creatures swim. Valuable tibanna gas is collected from vast creatures called beldons and processed in the floating habitats in the upper, breathable layer of atmosphere, including the famous Cloud City.

DAGOBAH: Grand Master Yoda once described Dagobah as 'one of the purest places in the galaxy'. He first came here towards the end of the Clone Wars, drawn by a strange message from his old friend Qui-Gon Jinn, who had died many years earlier. Jinn had discovered the secret of

maintaining his identity after death and set Yoda on the path to discover it for himself. Following his failure to defeat Emperor Palpatine, Yoda exiled himself to Dagobah to meditate on the Force until a new hope could arise. It was here that he met Luke Skywalker.

D'QAR: An obscure, tree-covered planet with no intelligent life and far from the main space lanes, D'Qar is of little interest. This made it a perfect choice as a secret base for the Rebel Alliance and later the Resistance – making it a target for the First Order's Starfighter weapon.

ERIADU: A once-savage wilderness of a world, until colonists tamed it. Among the early pioneers were the Tarkin family, who formed their own militia to protect against pirates and the local wildlife. Wilhuff Tarkin grew up here and learned many harsh lessons in survival.

HOTH: The frozen world Hoth was chosen as the new headquarters of the Rebel Alliance following the Battle of Yavin. The base was discovered by an Imperial probe droid, and Darth Vader moved swiftly to invade the planet. The rebels only narrowly escaped the Echo Base's destruction.



KAMINO: This world is not on any map. As part of an elaborate plot by Darth Sidious, it was erased from the Jedi Archives, and only rediscovered when Obi-Wan Kenobi was investigating the attempted assassination of the Naboo Senator Padmé Amidala. Kenobi traced the would-be

assassin to the Wild Space planet Kamino, an endless ocean whose inhabitants had mastered the science of cloning. The Kaminoans had been paid to create a clone army for the Republic, using the DNA of the bounty hunter Jango Fett – the very assassin Kenobi was chasing.

MUSTAFAR: Lava belches from the volcanoes that cover Mustafar's surface, while swarms of droids harvest rare minerals from the molten rock. Despite the searing heat of this harsh world, it is inhabited by the native Mustafarians, who labour in the mines and factories and live in underground caverns

hollowed out by rock-eating lava flows.

Many dark deeds have taken place on Mustafar. Darth Vader betrayed and slew the Separatist Council here, ending the Clone Wars. He was then defeated and horribly maimed by Obi-Wan Kenobi.

POLU MASSA: Once a planet, Polu Massa was mysteriously shattered into an asteroid field. A scientific base here studies the disaster, and following Order 66 Yoda and Obi-Wan Kenobi found safety at the research station. It was here that Luke Skywalker and Leia Organa were born.

RYLOTH: Ryloth has seen more than its share of war. During the Clone Wars, it was a battleground between the Republic and the Separatists, as Mace Windu and his forces battled to liberate the planet. Later, freedom fighter Chass Syndulla opposed the Empire's cruel occupation.

A plot by Syndulla and his Free Ryloth group led to Emperor Palpatine and Darth Vader crash-landing on the planet after the Star Destroyer they were travelling in, the *Perilous*, was sabotaged and destroyed. However, the Lords of the Sith were able to escape the assassination attempt.

SULLUST: A barren world of volcanoes and lakes whose people live in vast underground cities. Half of all Sullustans work for the SoroSorb technology corporation. Sullustans are well known as pilots: Nien Nunb famously co-piloted the *Millennium Falcon* at the battle of Endor.

UTAPAU: Hyperwind storms batter the surface of Utapau, forcing many of the planet's inhabitants – the Utai and Pau'ans – to live in the giant sink-holes that lead down into the planet's crust. The Armani, recent settlers on Utapau, are hardy enough to dwell above ground in the grasslands.

During the Clone Wars, Utapau was an important base for the Separatists, and it was here that Obi-Wan Kenobi tracked down General Grievous and challenged him to a duel. After a fierce battle, the Jedi Master managed to tear open the cyborg's armour and destroy him using his own Master.

BATTLE OF HOTH

Darth Vader's forces discovered the rebel base on Hoth two years after the Empire's defeat at the Battle of Yavin. An overwhelming assault drove the rebels from the planet, but a fatal mistake by the Imperial Admiral Ozard meant that Vader's plan to crush the Rebellion failed.

Lines of trenches are dug into the snow, and blast cannons are set up, but the rebel weapons cannot penetrate the AT-AT's armor.

With the power generator in range, AT-ATs melt their way through the planet's shield.

Rebel troops desperately try to hold off the Imperial advance until the evacuation can be completed.

Ebba Fenn is built under the surface of the planet, to conceal it from prying eyes.

On planet, Luke Skywalker is ambushed by a vicious wampa and ends up in the hands of the Empire.

Having escaped the wampa's clutches, Luke is rescued by the spirit of Obi-Wan Kenobi, who tells him to go to the Dagobah system. Luke is then rescued by his friend Han Solo.

Once an Imperial plan, Thane Kessel now flies for the rebels and now fights against his former friend, Han Solo.

Wedge Antilles uses his superior skills to outmaneuver an AT-AT's legs, bringing it crashing to the ground.

With the rebels fleeing, Darth Vader arrives at Ebba Fenn, but is unable to prevent the Millennium Falcon from slipping away.

Rebel forces escape the planet, looking through the Imperial blockade.

RYLOTH

The homeworld of the Twi'lek species, Ryloth is a warm world with many volcanoes, jungles and valleys. The planet was the scene of decades of fierce resistance by guerrilla fighters, first against the invading Separatists, and then against the Galactic Empire.

KAMINO

This remote ocean planet is home to the Kaminoans, a race that has mastered the technology of cloning. Here the Grand Army of the Republic was created from the DNA of bounty hunter Jango Fett. The planet was deleted from the Jedi Archives by the renegade Count Dooku to conceal the secret cloning project and only rediscovered in 32 ABY by Obi-Wan Kenobi.

At the time of the Clone Wars, the Prime Minister of Kamino was Lame Duck.

32 ABY: Obi-Wan Kenobi is rescued twice, during the Battle of Kamino, by airbus.

The vast cloning facilities of Kamino could create whole armies of soldiers in a relatively short time.

32 ABY: Separatist agents decide to destroy Kamino, as water worlds like Kamino, Jedi Master Mace Tuller, believe, make short work of them.

The majestic airbus — or air whales — are native to Kamino. These powerful creatures may be used as mounts.

32 ABY: Obi-Wan Kenobi confronts Jango Fett, who is behind the assassination attempts on Padmé Amidala. The bounty hunter escapes.

32 ABY: Obi-Wan Kenobi meets Jango Fett and his clone son, Boba. He is suspicious of the Mandalorian warrior from the start.

32 ABY: General Grievous leads a Separatist armada on Kamino, hoping to destroy the Republic's supply of clone troops.



DAGOBAH

A serene swamp world, teeming with life, Dagobah was the planet chosen by the Jedi Master Yoda when he exiled himself following the triumph of Emperor Palpatine, and where Luke Skywalker trained in the ways of the Jedi. A cave on the planet strong with the dark side of the Force provided a test of his wisdom.

As Yoda is guided by the voice of Qui-Gon Jinn, Yoda reveals to Dagobah, where his old friend appears to him in the form of a mass of kiffles.

Great unknowns sleep back in the swamps of Dagobah.

The huge, naked dephts, a native to Dagobah, where it blends in with the environment thanks to its many holes.



The jabbid bird makes its nest from mud and is known for its scolding song.



Dagobathians are mostly predators which live in the murky waters of Dagobah, among other planets. A dagobathian attempted to devour R2-D2 but had to spit him out.

BESPIN

The gas giant Bepin is an important source of the rare tibanna gas, which, once refined, is used in hyperdrive systems. People live in cities floating within the thin habitable band of atmosphere surrounding the planet. One such city - Cloud City - was run by Baron Administrator Lando Calrissian and would play an important part in the Galactic Civil War.

Slack 1

The heavy hunter Behn Fort leads a carbon freeze Han Solo on to his ship, Slave I, and sets off to collect his payment from gang boss Jabba the Hutt.

Slavery ended the Imperial Fleet as it built the core of the Millennium Falcon puts in to Cloud City for hyperdrive repairs.

CLOUD CITY

The city has 192 levels. The top 50 levels are a luxury resort, while the lower levels house gas miners and their machinery and equipment.

Behn Fort tracks the Millennium Falcon to Cloud City and informs Darth Vader. The Sith Lord sets a trap for Luke Skywalker, using his friends to lure him.

At the time of the Galactic Civil War, Cloud City is run by Baron Administrator Lando Calrissian, a charismatic entrepreneur and the former owner of the Millennium Falcon.

Lando's old nemesis Leia is the computer system officer on Cloud City. His cybernetic implants enable him to interface directly with the city's network.

C-3PO opens the wrong door and is blasted by the stormtroopers who have secretly arrived with Darth Vader.

Steads of air during that in Bepin's upper atmosphere.

Ugnaughts do much of the physical labor involved with processing tibanna gas, including the carbon-freezing process that is needed to export it.

When he senses that his friends are in danger, Luke Skywalker abandons his Jedi training and rushes to Cloud City to confront Vader.

The experienced Sith Lord easily defeats the uncertain Skywalker, snapping off his right hand. He then reveals that he is Luke's father.

Luke falls from the carbon freezing chamber through a shaft and manages to cling on to its exterior at the bottom of the canyon. He calls to Leia using the Force and is rescued.

Very gas-filled creatures - up to ten kilometers long - which waste resources from the atmosphere using their long tentacles.

Luke Skywalker's severed hand and lightsaber fall down the central shaft and are caught by Leia. Later, however, the lightsaber is recovered.

UGNORGRAD

Another of Bepin's floating habitats, Ugnaught, is home to a variety of Ugnaughts.

CRAB GRASS

Crabs using creatures which float on the surface of habitats.

Chewbacca begins to put C-3PO back together. The droid eventually makes a full recovery.

LUKE SKYWALKER

BESPIN



Jedi Master Yoda is stationed on Utapau by Separatist forces. The Jedi Council send Anakin Skywalker and Obi-Wan Kenobi to investigate.

UTAPAU

The windswept planet of Utapau is distinctive for its strange terrain, pockmarked with giant sink holes into which the oceans drain, and its underground cities built from millions of animal bones. It is home to two native species, the Pau'ans and the Utai, as well as more recent arrivals the Amans.

Dactylons are giant bird-like creatures that can be used as flying mounts.

Recent arrivals on Utapau, the Amans, people live in villages on the windswept plains.

Segi arena duels must with Separatist agents on Utapau in a giant hydra crystal. Master Yoda is murdered when she discovers the plot.

While investigating Master Yoda's death, Anakin Skywalker discovers Separatist Magna-Centaurs on the planet.

Juraks are used by the Amans people to carry heavy loads. They are strong but slow.



Obi-Wan Kenobi duels General Grievous, but the Rakoth cyborg escapes and the Jedi give chase.

Kenobi's escape for his life and his rescued master on Onderon is in trouble, but the Jedi escape.

The Utai people do much of the manual labor on Utapau, under the direction of their fellow natives the Pau'ans.

General Grievous attempts to escape Obi-Wan Kenobi on his remarkable TIE fighter when he is.

The Pau'ans people live in vast sink holes about beneath the planet's surface.



Utapau's lakes and rivers drain into the sink holes, where many strange creatures live.

The sea monsters that live in Utapau's lakes can grow up to eight meters long.

Anakin Skywalker takes Separatist plot to obtain a giant hydra crystal, which can be used to create powerful weapons, destroying it instead.

MUSTAFAR

Once described as 'where Jedi go to die', the searing lava-world Mustafar is a world of ill omen. Vast refineries extract precious minerals from the volcanic core of the planet—but it is better known for its history of violence, treachery and death.

19 year: Mustafar was once home to the Black Sun crime syndicate. Their leader, Kessel Gornetz, a Felon, was killed when Darth Maul took over the organization.

20 year: In a Star Destroyer orbiting Mustafar, the Grand Inquisitor is delivered to a duel by the Jedi Kanan Jarrus. Rather than suffer the wrath of Darth Vader, the Inquisitor allows himself to fall to his death.

21 year: The Lokai, who rescue their comrade Kanan Jarrus from Grand Moff Tarkin's flagship, the *Imperial*, which is destroyed in the process.

22 year: Anakin Skywalker, now Darth Vader, dispatches the Imperial Inquisitors to the order of his son Master Darth Sidious. They ultimately end the Clone War.

Lava flow ship across the fiery surface of Mustafar. They are large enough to be used as weapons by the native Mustafarians.

Mustafar is home to numerous dangerous native creatures. They hunt in packs and are well protected by venom.

23 year: Anakin Skywalker and Ahsoka Tano rescue Prince and Princess Leia from Darth Sidious' secret facility.

24 year: Overcome with rage and jealousy, Darth Vader turns on his wife Padmé Amidala and assassinates her by burning him.

25 year: Obi-Wan Kenobi and Darth Vader duel atop the lava flows. Vader is defeated, and his body molten and burned.

26 year: Krong, the Dathomirian, is captured to keep the delicate mine materials free of outside and lava flow.
