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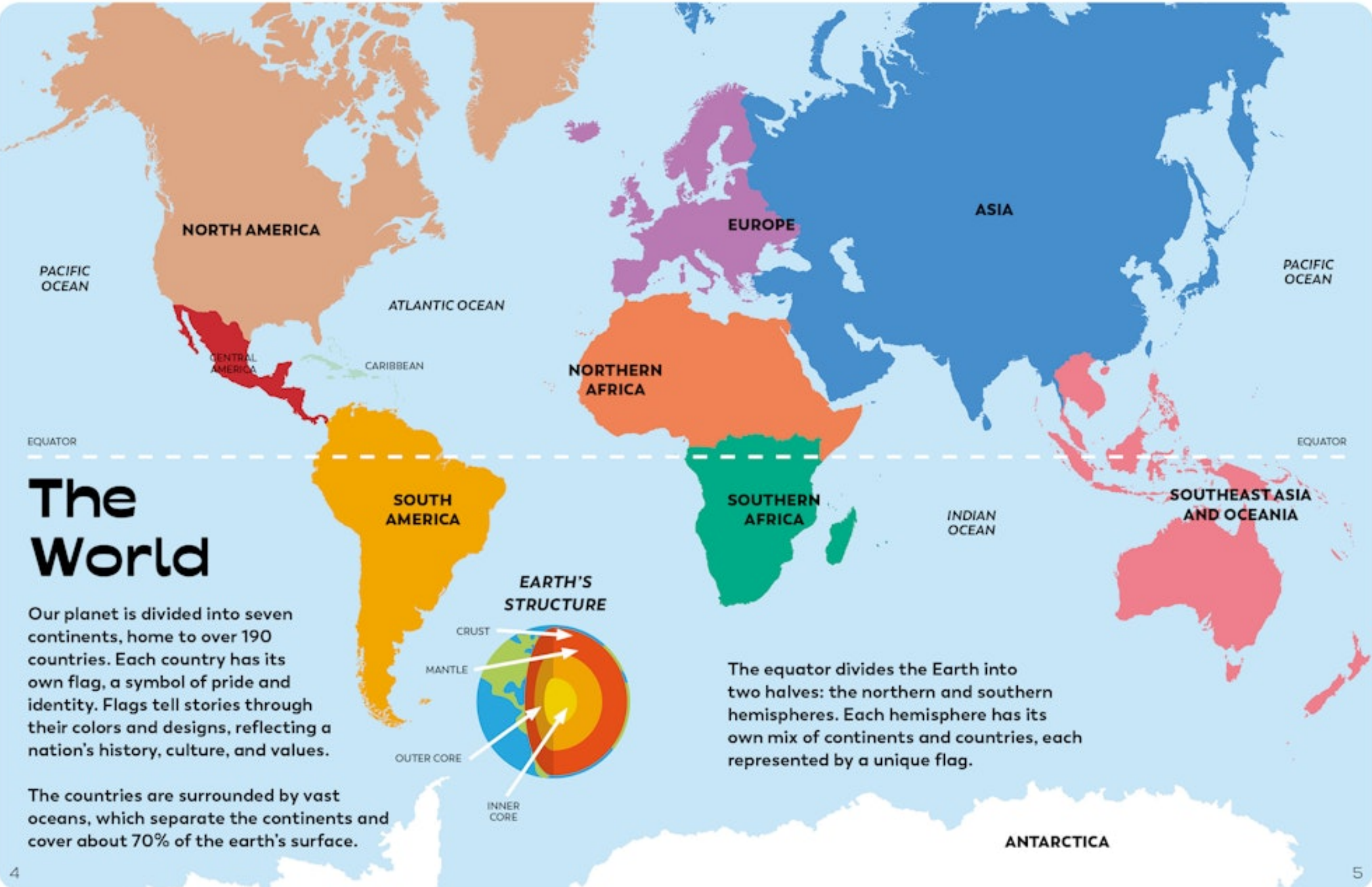
The World

Our planet is divided into seven continents, home to over 190 countries. Each country has its own flag, a symbol of pride and identity. Flags tell stories through their colors and designs, reflecting a nation's history, culture, and values.

The countries are surrounded by vast oceans, which separate the continents and cover about 70% of the earth's surface.



The equator divides the Earth into two halves: the northern and southern hemispheres. Each hemisphere has its own mix of continents and countries, each represented by a unique flag.

Europe is the world's second smallest continent. It is bordered by the Arctic Ocean to the north, the Atlantic Ocean to the west and the Mediterranean Sea to the south. There are 44 countries in Europe today, including the 27 countries in the European Union.
