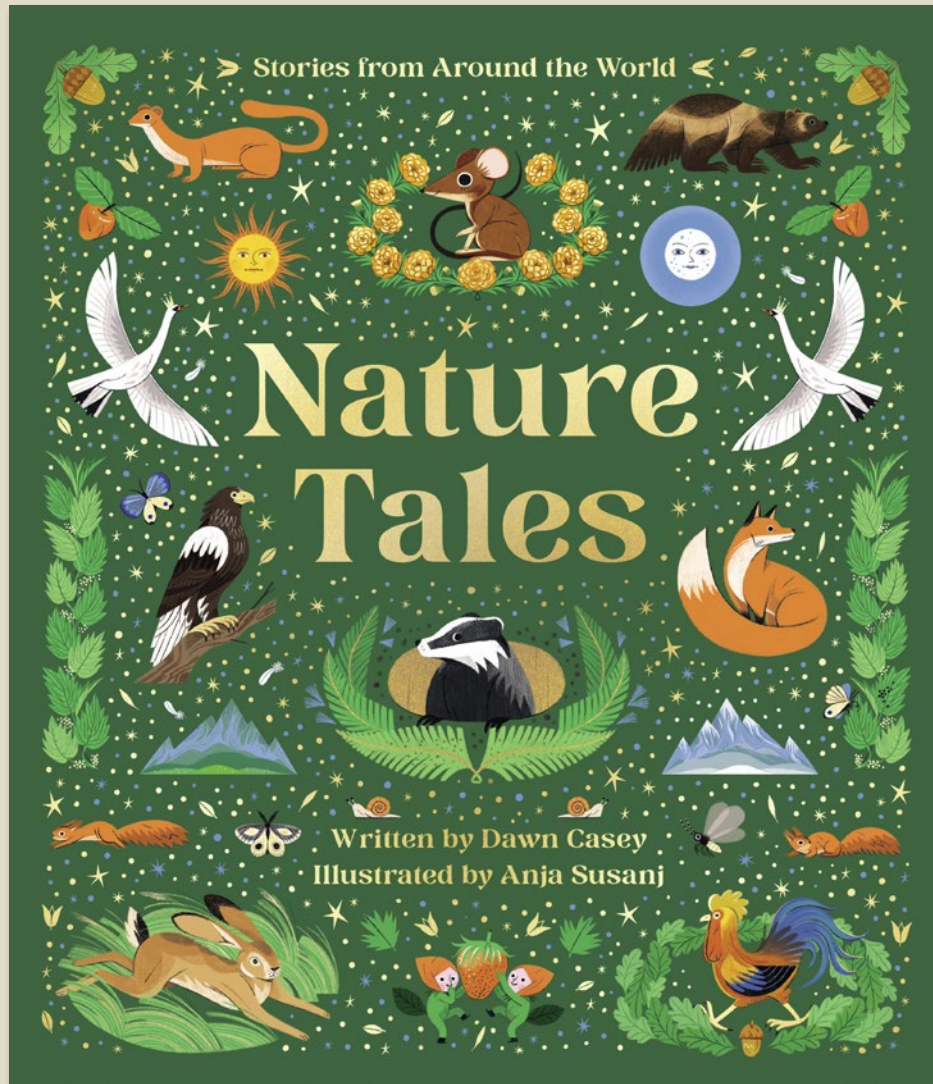
When winter was over, and white snow gave way to pink blossom, the tanuki came to the hut no more.
