Once upon a time, in a little shed outside a little house in the cave mountains of Southern China, there lived an orphan called YeTsien. She was bright-eyed, clever, kind and good at making things. YeTsien's stepmother loved her own daughter best, so YeTsien had to do all the herviest, most dangerous work, like collectine firesecod from the deep forest or water from the high mountain nocks.

One day, Ye-Thien was collecting water when up from the bottom of a deep mountain pool there was a shimmering and a glittering.
