TRIASSIC LIFE ON LAND The Triassic Period

Around 251 million years ago, there was a mass extinction in which an incredible 96 per cent of all life forms died out. The Triassic period that followed saw a major growth of life on land, with both the early ancestors of mammals and dinosaurs appearing for the first time.

At the beginning of the Triassic, temperatures were warmer than they are today. There was no ice on the poles and a vast desert covered the interior of Pangaea. On higher, cooler ground, gymnosperms (plants with exposed seeds) could be found as well as coniferous forests.

The climate around the coast was now much wetter, and it was here that most life existed. There were mosses and ferns, spiders, scorpions, millipedes, centipedes and beetles. The Triassic also saw the appearance of the first grasshoppers.

The largest life forms on land were mammal-like reptiles known as therapsids, and the archosaurs. By the mid-Triassic, the archosaurs had branched into the first dinosaurs, and by the Late Triassic, the winged pterosaurs, the first vertebrates capable of active flight.

The earliest mammal ancestors evolved at the very end of the Triassic, from the therapsids. These were tiny shrew-like creatures that fed either on plants or insects.

1: Plesiosaurus
Length 5m, Weight 600kg.
A top predator in North America, Plesiosaurus was an inshore, semi-pelagic reptile, making a fast, agile hunter. It had a long, slender body, a small head and a long, thin tail.

2: Bennettosaurus
These palm-like plants flourished during the Triassic. They had tough, leathery leaves and woody trunks, with short, branched stems.

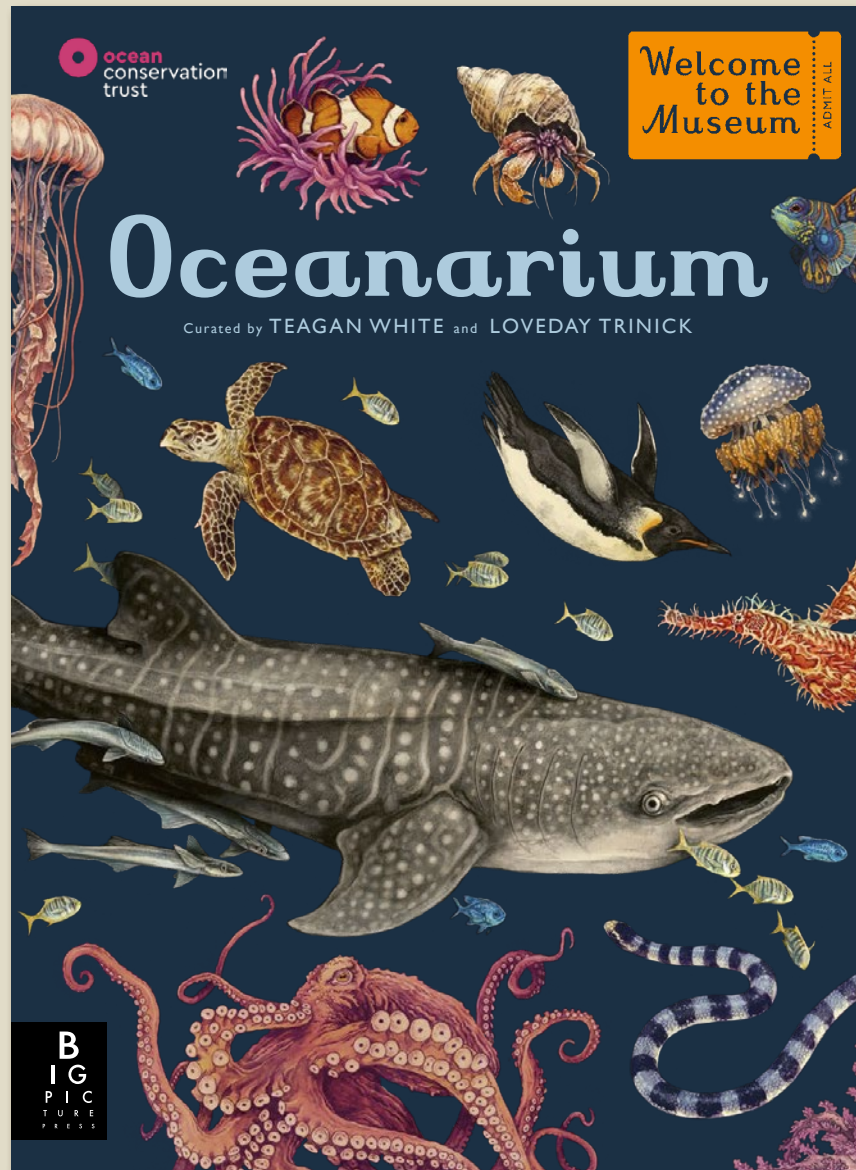
3: Arctosaurus
A species of conifer forest of which covered North America in the Late Triassic. Its closest relative today is the monkey puzzle tree.

4: 'Fanged pterosaur'
Wingspan 1.5m, Weight 100kg.
These pterosaurs were all relatively small. This one, discovered in 2015, was as yet unnamed, had 110 teeth and four 25cm-long fangs. It would have been capable of short flights and preyed on insects and tiny ancient ancestors of crocodiles.

5: Heterosaurus
These rubber-like plants were an important food source for the herbivores of the late Triassic. They reproduced by spores rather than seeds, and were fast-growing and resilient, with underground stems.

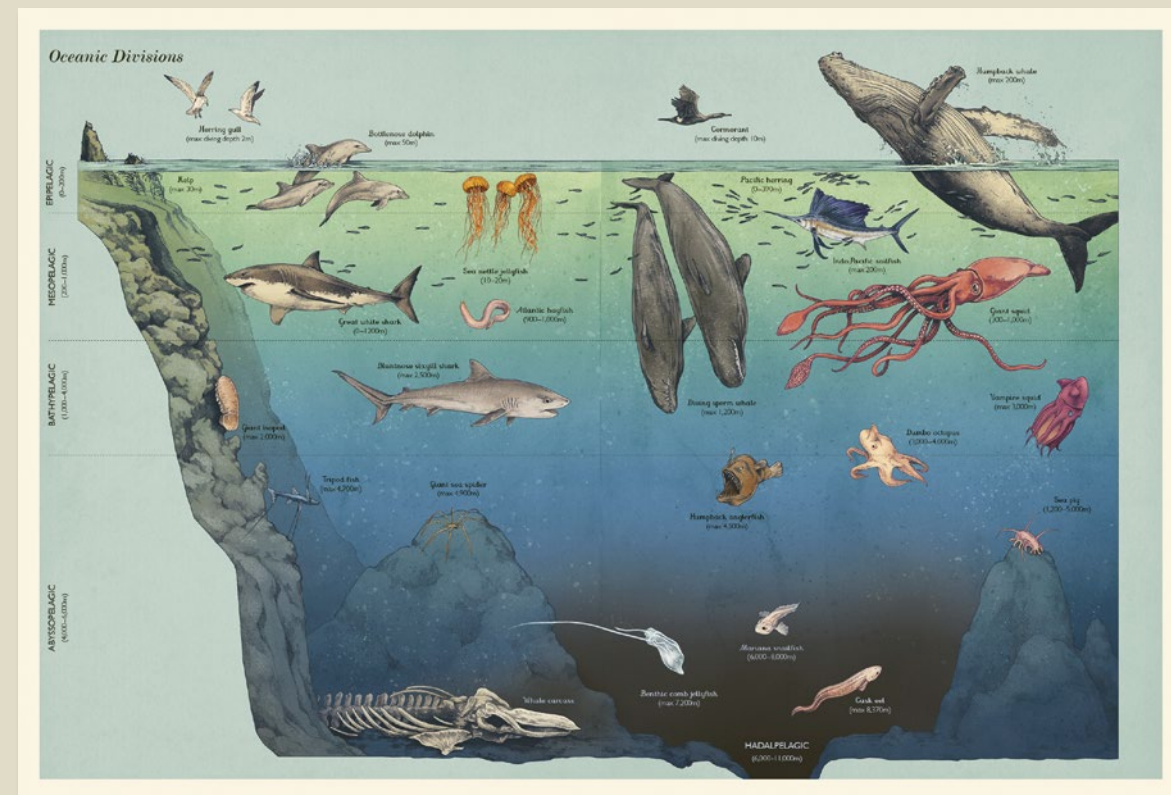
6: Megalosaurus
Length 15m, Weight 37-40kg.

Wheel

Can you imagine a world without wheels? Apart from sledges and ships, there would be no vehicles - no carts, cabs, bikes, buses, trucks, trains, cars or aeroplanes. The first wheeled vehicles were animal-drawn carts with solid wooden wheels. They were invented in Mesopotamia (modern-day Iraq) around 3500 BCE. 3500 years after the horizontal potter's wheel. These carts carried cargo to market and heavy loads, such as stone and timber for building projects. The horse-drawn chariot came next. In about 2500 BCE, chariot wheels were spoked rather than solid like a cartwheel, so they were faster and lighter. The wheel may be one of the simplest inventions, but without it our world would be completely different.



Potter's Wheel


The very first wheels were used to make pottery. The art of pottery began around 30,000 years ago. Originally, potters would shape clay into pots with their hands, but this took a long time. The Mesopotamians invented a better method in around 3500 BCE. The potter's wheel was a large stone disc balanced on a stick called an 'axle', which could be spun. By putting clay on the wheel and spinning it, the potter could shape the clay quickly into pots. We don't know for sure, but it seems likely that the potter's wheel led to the invention of the vehicle wheel.

Internet

"The world at your fingertips"

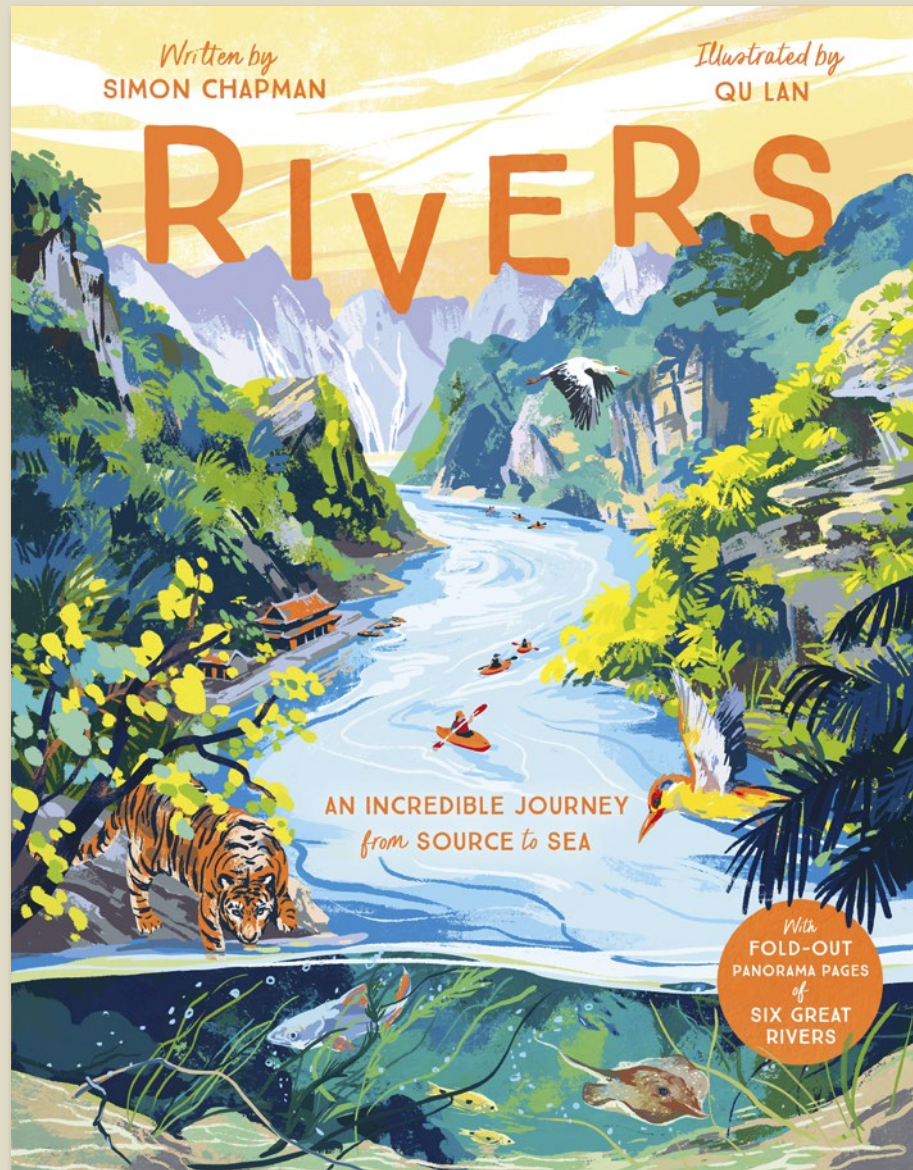
The invention of the Internet - a network of computers that 'speak' to each other - was a concentrated effort in the United States. The first computers were connected to each other in 1969, but scientists first began developing the Internet in the early 1970s during the Cold War (1947-1991), a time of heightened hostility between the USSR and the United States and when computers were the size of an entire room. The United States government wanted a communication system that couldn't be destroyed in a single attack, so they created ARPANET (Advanced Research Projects Agency Network): a series of linked computers across different locations, which allowed information to be relayed along telephone lines. The first message was sent in 1969. It was a single word: LOGIN, but only the 'L' and the 'O' got through before the network crashed. By the end of the same year four computers were connected on the ARPANET. It took years to create the 'network protocol' that allows computers to transfer data and 'speak' to each other. From the 1970s this network grew into the global Internet, which now links billions of devices. Today, whatever you want - books, food, holidays, cars - with the Internet you simply click a button and wait for it to arrive. Social media sites allow people all over the world to communicate instantly. We can consume films, television shows, music and video games, and even do our banking online.



World Wide Web

The World Wide Web (WWW) is a gateway to the Internet. It's made up of search engines like Google and Safari, the Internet addresses (also called URLs) we type in, and the websites that appear on our screens. It was invented by a British computer scientist called Tim Berners-Lee in 1989 while working at CERN, a science research laboratory in Switzerland. The WWW made the Internet accessible to everyone, not just scientists and academics.

So in this section, we're going to explore some of the most famous cities and find out what makes them so special. Some of these cities are new in Israel, but they still have big Palestinian populations, and our culture and rich history flourish in the landmarks and traditions.



Jerusalem

Jerusalem is one of the oldest cities on Earth, traces of civilization there go back 4,000 years. In that time, it has been destroyed, captured and renamed – but it has survived, and remains a very special place. One reason is that it is the holy city for the three major Abrahamic religions: Judaism, Christianity and Islam. The major landmarks for these religions – the Western Wall, the Church of the Holy Sepulchre, the Garden Tomb and the Dome of the Rock and Al-Aqsa – are all in Jerusalem.

Gaza

Gaza is a Palestinian territory that borders Egypt on one side and Israel on the other. It is made up of four main areas, the largest of which is Gaza City. It is also one of the most densely populated places on Earth. This means that there are many people living in a very small space.

Did you know?
There are about five million people living in Gaza. It is about the same size as the UK city of Belfast, which has a population of 25,000.

Most of the people in Gaza are refugees – people who fled their homes because of war. They came from other places in Palestine, like Haifa and Ramla, and even far north like the Galilee. They hoped they would be able to go back after the 1948 Arab-Israeli War, but have never been allowed to return to their homes.

Gaza was once famous for its beautiful beaches on the Mediterranean Sea and its fishing industry. However, Israel's control of the waters restricts Gaza fishermen from going far out to sea to fish, which means it's increasingly difficult to make a living as a fisherman. Unfortunately, Gaza is also geographically isolated from the rest of the country, making it almost impossible for anyone to visit or leave it.

While these things are sad, the people of Gaza are strong and hopeful, and we can learn many lessons from them about how to live life in the face of hardship. Famous artists like Mahatma (p. 50) who paints beautiful pictures, and musicians like Mohammed Assaf (p. 51) are from Gaza. On a day-to-day basis, the people of Gaza do the same activities people across the world do, like going to school, working, meeting, even singing and dancing.

Supported and empowered by their families, their faith and by each other, the people of Gaza continue to live their lives.



Jericho

People believe that Jericho is the oldest city in the world. It is also the lowest city on earth, sitting 258 meters below sea level. To understand what that means, picture yourself walking away from the beach and hiking down a valley – you would have to go down about 80 flights of stairs to reach Jericho.

Did you know?

When archaeologists explored Jericho, they found remains of early settlements going back 11,000 years!

The name of the valley it sits in is Wadi Qelt, which itself sits in the larger Jordan Valley in the West Bank.

People have always lived in Jericho, from the age of hunter-gatherers to the present day. It's also one of the first places in the world to have agriculture and probably where irrigation, the process of supplying water to plants, was invented. It is the kind of city you call an oasis, or a fertile land in a desert environment. Ein es-Sultan (or The Sultan's Spring), which produces about 1,000 gallons of water per minute, is what waters the whole area.

Jericho can get hot in the summer, but its winters are quite mild, rarely dipping below 10°C. This pleasant weather makes it a very popular place to visit for

both Palestinians and tourists. People from all over the world visit Jericho to see its rich history, and visit landmarks like Hisham's Palace, an ancient castle built over 1,200 years ago during the Umayyad Dynasty.

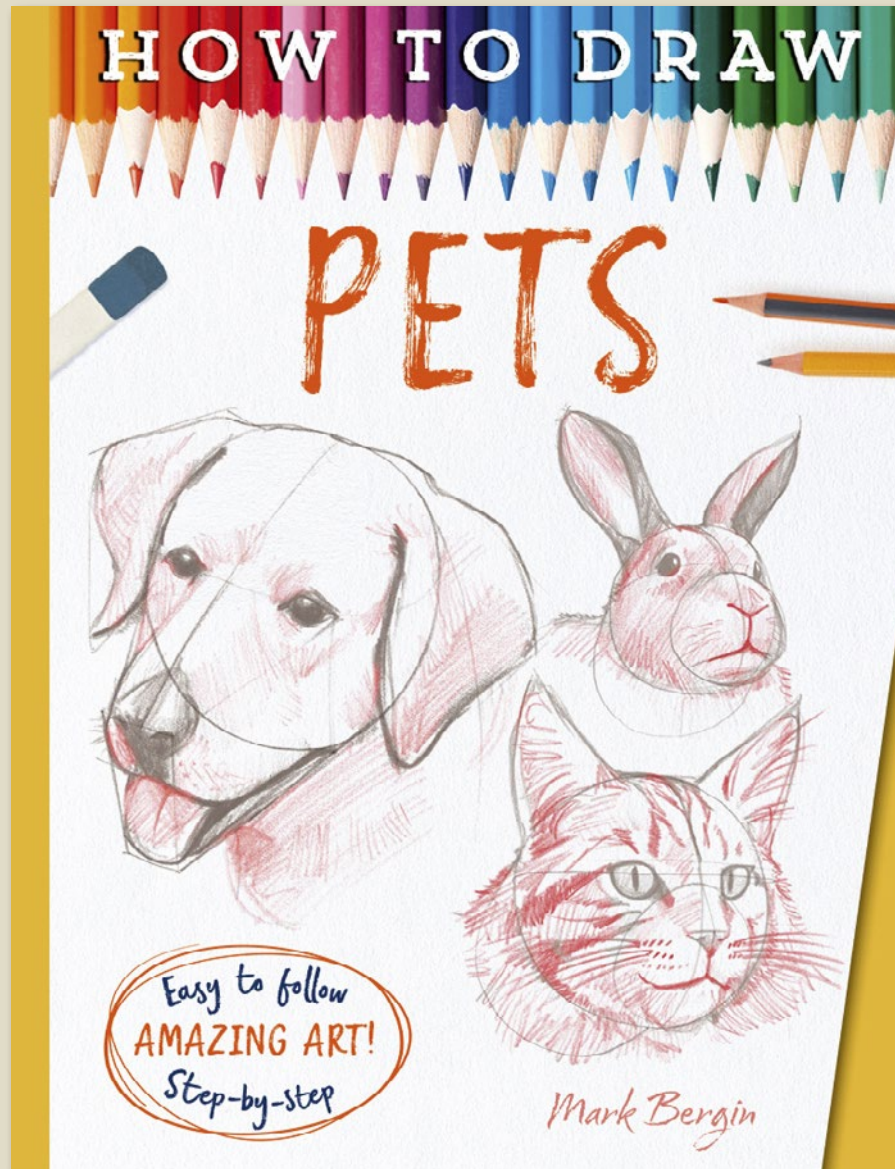
When air is heated it rises. This is what makes a hot-air balloon rise. Air spirals upwards in currents called thermals where the sun heats the air near the ground.

Colour the snakes, then cut them out to make a spiral. Gently pull the head and tail apart. Use scissors to make a hole in the nose, and attach a string. Hang the snakes over a radiator and watch them spin around!

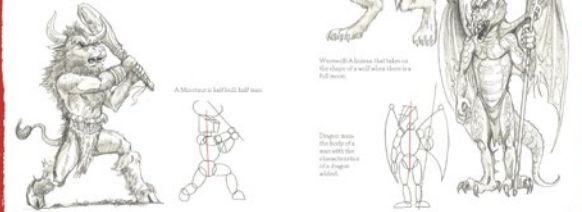

Pencil drawings can include a vast amount of detail and tone. Try experimenting with different grades of pencil to get a range of light and shade effects in your drawing.



lines down in **ink** cannot be erased, so keep your ink drawings sketchy and less rigid. Don't worry about erasing, as these lines can be lost in the drawing as it develops.

Adding light and shade to a drawing with an ink pen can be tricky. Use solid ink for the very darkest areas and cross-hatching for ordinary dark tones. Use hatching for mid-tones, and leave the white of the paper for the lightest areas.

Crisscrossing is the use of straight lines that cross each other. **Hatching** is when short parallel lines are used to create form.



Fish tips: comes in a range of sizes widths. The widest points are good for filling in large areas of flat terrain.

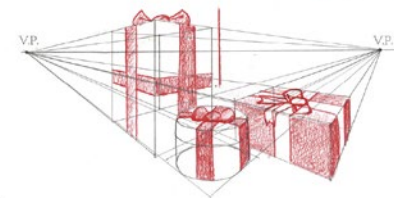
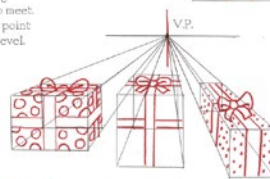


Perspective

If you look at anything from different viewpoints, you will see that the part that is closest to you looks larger, and the part furthest away from you looks smaller. Drawing in perspective is a way of creating a feeling of space - of showing three dimensions on a flat surface.



The vanishing point (VP) is the place in a perspective drawing where parallel lines appear to meet. The position of the vanishing point depends on the viewer's eye level.

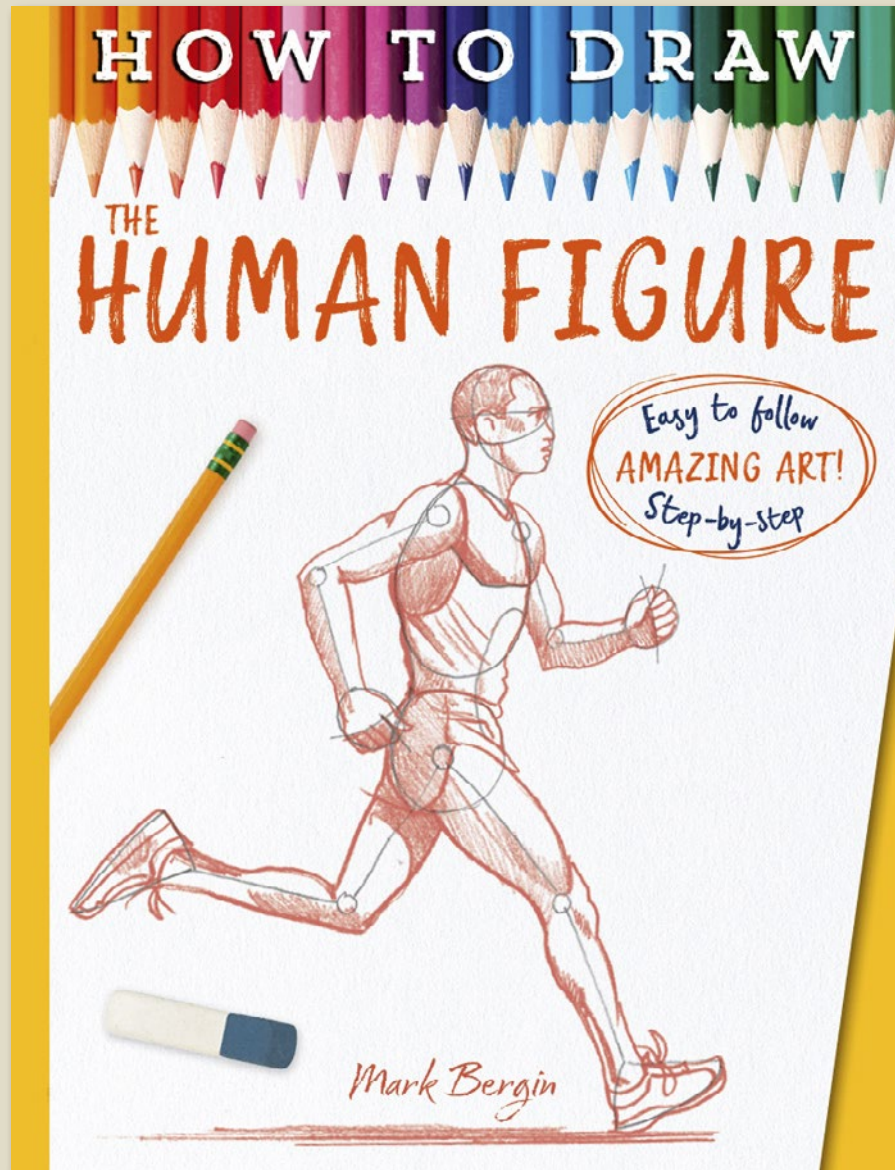


Two-point perspective uses two vanishing points: one for lines running along the length of the subject, and one on the opposite side for lines running across the width of the subject.
