## What is an Insect?

The earliest insects appeared on Earth about 480 million years ago. To put this in perspective, we humans have been around for barely one million years, and the first dinosaurs appeared 230 million years ago.

Insects are part of a larger group of creatures including millipedes, centipedes, spiders, scorpions, crabs and shrimps, collectively known as the arthropods. They all have an external skeleton; a more or less rigid 'shell' with muscles attached on the inside. To grow, arthropods have to repeatedly shed their skeleton, which is a delicate business and leaves them soft and vulnerable for a short time.

Insects are the only arthropods to have three pairs of legs. Their body is divided into three segments: the head, thorax and abdomen. The head has eyes, a mouth and a pair of sensory antennae that taste the air. The legs and wings, if present, are attached to the thorax, which is often filled with muscles to move them. The abdomen contains the gut and reproductive organs. Other arthropods, including arachnids, crustaceans, millipedes and centipedes are not considered insects due to differences in leg count, antennae presence and body structures.

Nearly all insects start as eggs. Most undergo complete metamorphosis which means they completely change their physical appearance, transforming from a larva to the adult insect by way of a pupal phase (see page 68). In more primitive insects, such as mantids, grasshoppers, true bugs and stick insects, the life cycle is similar to many other arthropods – the adult female lays eggs, which hatch into 'nymphs'. These nymphs look roughly similar to the adults, other than being much smaller and with tiny wing buds rather than wings. All arthropods must shed their exoskeleton (skin) to grow, so the nymphs proceed through, typically, five to seven stages until they reach adult size. This life cycle is known as 'incomplete metamorphosis'.

**2: Stag beetle (male)**

## TRIASSIC LIFE ON LAND

### The Triassic Period

Around 251 million years ago, there was a mass extinction in which an incredible 96 per cent of all life forms died out. The Triassic period that followed saw a major growth of life on land, with both the early ancestors of mammals and dinosaurs appearing for the first time.

At the beginning of the Triassic, temperatures were warmer than they are today. There was no ice on the poles and a vast desert covered the interior of Pangaea. On higher, cooler ground, gymnosperms (plants with exposed seeds) could be found as well as coniferous forests.

The climate around the coast was now much wetter, and it was here that most life existed. There were mosses and ferns, spiders, scorpions, millipedes, centipedes and beetles. The Triassic also saw the appearance of the first grasshoppers.

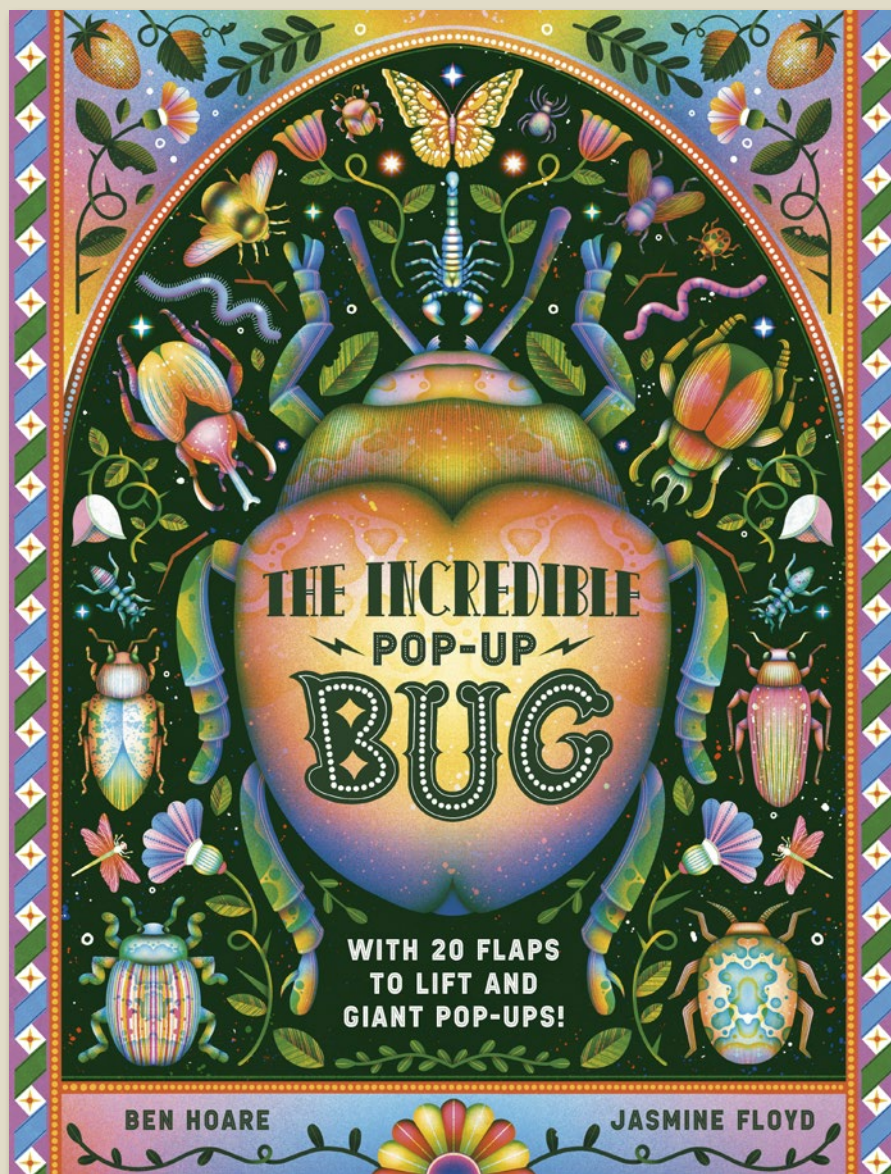
The largest life forms on land were mammal-like reptiles, known as therapsids, and the archosaurs. By the mid-Triassic, the archosaurs had branched into the first dinosaurs, and by the Late Triassic, the winged pterosaurs, the first vertebrates capable of active flight.

The earliest mammal ancestors evolved at the very end of the Triassic, from the therapsids. These were tiny shrew-like creatures that fed either on plants or insects.

- Key to plate**
- 1: *Protosuchia*  
Length 1m; Weight 600kg  
A top predator in North America. Protosuchia was an arboreal, web-footed upright leg, making a flat, rigid hunter. It had a long, thin skull, almost as long as its body. Its hindlimbs were much shorter than its forelimbs, suggesting it may have walked on two legs.
  - 2: "Furred mammal"  
Wingless 1.1m; Weight uncertain  
These mammals were all relatively small. The one discovered in 2015 and yet unnamed, had 130 teeth and four 25cm-long legs. It would have been capable of short flights and preyed on insects and by its last ancestor of mammals.
  - 3: *Bennettitales*  
These palm-like plants flourished during the Triassic. They had tough leaves and woody trunks, with short, branched stems.
  - 4: *Amecrocoelus intonsus*  
A species of conifer forests of which covered North America in the Late Triassic. Its closest relative today is the monkey puzzle tree.
  - 5: *Horseshells*  
These mobile plants were an important food source for the herbivores of the time. They evolved new forms during the Triassic. They reproduced by spores rather than seeds, and were fast-growing and resistant to underground stems.
  - 6: *Margreusodon*  
Length 1.5m; Weight 27-40kg  
An early mammal ancestor. Margreusodon still had monkey-like features, including the shape of its jaw. Its tail eggs, which were probably small and leathery, and was most likely nocturnal.

A terror seized me. The dusky houses about me stood faint and tall and dim; the trees in the park were growing black. Night, the mother of fear and mystery, was coming down.

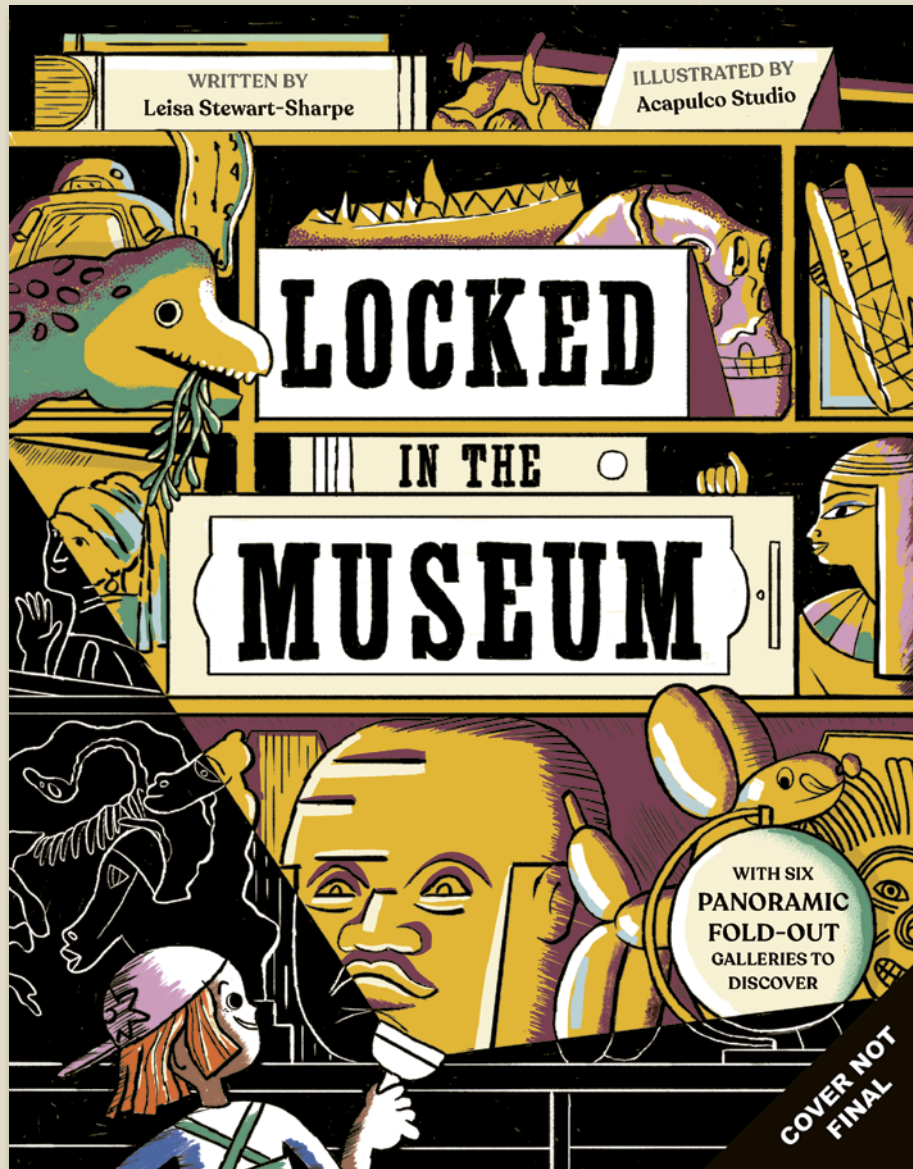

### IT'S A REPTILE! (SO WHAT / IS THAT?)

Reptiles don't have fur or feathers. Instead, their skin is covered in scales or bony plates, or both. But reptiles lay eggs, and some of them give birth to live babies. See the examples below.

**TURTLES AND TORTOISES**  
Turtles and tortoises are the only reptiles that have a shell. A turtle's shell is made of bony plates called scutes. Tortoises have a much heavier shell. Both turtles and tortoises can live for a long time.

**COLD BLOOD**  
Reptiles are cold-blooded. This means they can't generate their own heat. They have to absorb heat from the sun or their surroundings. This is why they are often found in warm places.

**LONG POWER**  
Reptiles have long, powerful tails. Some use their tails to help them move. Others use their tails to store fat for energy. Some even use their tails as a weapon.

**IT'S A BIG FAMILY!**  
Did you spot Anolis lizards and Phrynosoma, the spiny anteater?

### REPTILES HAVE BEEN AROUND FOR AGES

Reptiles have been around for a long time. Fossil evidence shows that the first reptiles appeared about 300 million years ago. Today, there are over 10,000 different species of reptiles.

**THE FIRST REPTILES**  
The first reptiles were small, four-legged animals called anapsids. They had a simple skull and no neck. They lived in the water and ate small animals.

**THE FIRST LIZARDS**  
The first lizards were small, four-legged animals called sphenodonts. They had a more complex skull and a neck. They lived on land and ate insects.

**THE FIRST SNAKES**  
The first snakes were small, legless animals called ophidians. They had a long, thin body and a forked tongue. They lived on land and ate small animals.

**THE FIRST TURTLES**  
The first turtles were small, four-legged animals called testudinates. They had a shell and a long neck. They lived in the water and ate plants and small animals.

### WHERE DO REPTILES LIVE?

Reptiles live in many different places. Some live in the water, some live on land, and some live in the air. They are found in all parts of the world.

**CORAL GATE SHARKS**  
Coral gate sharks live in the warm, shallow waters of coral reefs. They are the largest sharks in the world.

**SALTY SEA SHARKS**  
Salty sea sharks live in the open ocean. They are the largest sharks in the world.

**DEEP-SEA SHARKS**  
Deep-sea sharks live in the dark, cold waters of the deep ocean. They are the largest sharks in the world.

**CRAYFISH LIZARDS**  
Crayfish lizards live in the warm, shallow waters of coral reefs. They are the largest lizards in the world.

**SEA TURTLES**  
Sea turtles live in the open ocean. They are the largest turtles in the world.

**DESERT REPTILES**  
Desert reptiles live in hot, dry deserts. They are the largest reptiles in the world.

**SIDEWINDERS**  
Sidewinders live in the hot, dry deserts. They are the largest reptiles in the world.

**COILING SNAKES**  
Coiling snakes live in the hot, dry deserts. They are the largest snakes in the world.

### RAINFOREST REPTILES

This is Borneo, a large island in Southeast Asia, and it's a reptile paradise. From the longest snake in the world to a flying dragon, more than 250 species of reptile live happily in the steamy heat of the rainforest. It's nice and warm, there's plenty of food and there are lots of places to hide.

**Asian forest tortoise**  
The fearless Asian forest tortoise protects her eggs by piling a mound of leaves on top. If a predator comes snooping around, she'll quickly add more leaves and stand on top to guard her babies.

**Orange-headed flying dragon**  
Watch out - this Draco lizard is on the move! Thin sheets of skin between its ribs act like a parachute as it glides to the next tree. Gliding is much faster than climbing up and down.

**Spiny terrapin**  
Wise spiny terrapins stay on their guard. They may have a hard, sharp-edged shell, but that's no defence against fierce neighbourhood predators like the saltwater crocodile.

**Saltwater crocodile**  
A saltwater crocodile lurks in the shadows. Its nostrils and eyes are on top of its head, so it can stay out of view while watching for something tasty to cruise by - like a nice, crunchy spiny terrapin.

**Reticulated python**  
The world's longest snake is about to take a dip. It's a reticulated python and it can grow to a monstrous 10 metres long. Female pythons lay their eggs in hollow trees and look after them until they hatch.

**Blue coral snake**  
Beware a hungry blue coral snake! Its bright orange head and tail are a warning that it's very dangerous, with venom that can kill in minutes. Luckily, its favourite food isn't people, but other deadly snakes!

**False gharial**  
Anyone brave enough to put their head inside a false gharial's mouth would be able to count more than 80 razor-sharp, pointy teeth.

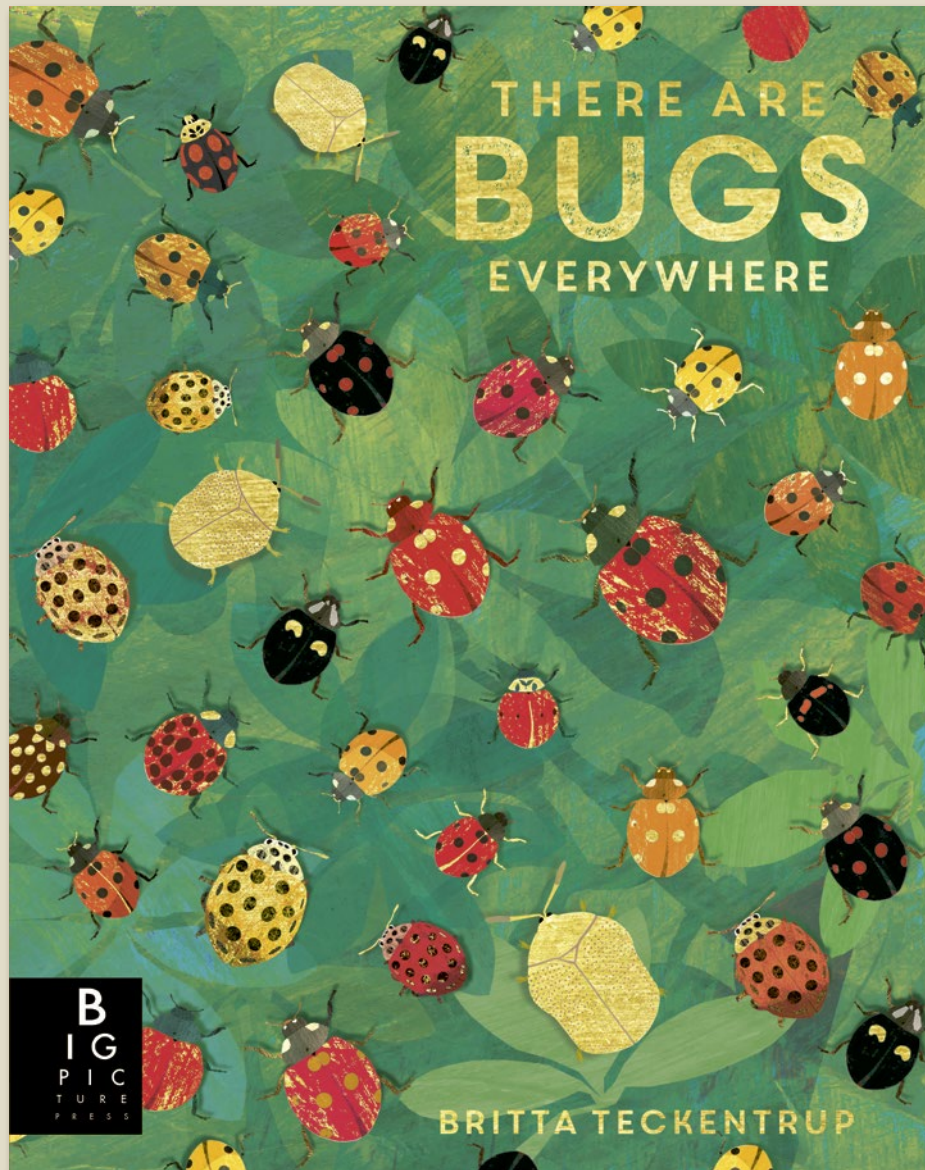
**Tokay gecko**  
A strange sound can be heard in the rainforest. It's a colourful tokay gecko, named after the male's loud call of "to-kay-to-kay". He's calling out to attract a mate.

**Saltfin lizard**  
The saltfin lizard has a miraculous talent. When it takes fright, it heads to the river and runs across the water. It doesn't sink straight away because it runs so quickly and has big, wide feet that trap air beneath them.

**CAN YOU FIND?**  
Small and dainty, the green crested lizard scuttles through the trees. Its bright green skin blends in with the background, but it turns brown when it's scared. There are six green crested lizards hiding, but how many of them are feeling frightened?

## IT'S A MAMMAL! (SO WHAT IS THAT?)

There are almost 6,000 species of mammal alive today. Mammals may look very different on the outside, but they all have **skulllets** that allow them to perform a wide range of movements. Some mammals have four legs and a tail, but others walk on two legs, fly using two wings, or have flippers and fins.

Mammals are the only animals that can fly, swim, and climb. They are also the only animals that can hibernate.

**BATS**  
Bats are the only mammals that can fly. They have wings made of skin stretched over their forelimbs.

**CATS**  
Cats are the only mammals that can retract their claws. They also have a **whisker**, which is a long, thin hair that helps them feel their way around.

**SEALS**  
Seals are the only mammals that can walk on land and swim in the water. They also have a **blubber**, which is a layer of fat that helps them stay warm.

## MAMMALS HAVE BEEN AROUND FOR AGES

Mammals have been around for a really long time. The first mammals looked like shrews, which are tiny animals with long snouts and tiny teeth. They lived about 200 million years ago. Other mammals looked like **hippos** and some of them grew much bigger than **cats**. Other mammals had long necks, long legs, and some had long tails. Some mammals had wings, and some had long hair.

**PROBOSCIDEANS**  
Proboscideans were among the earliest mammals to have long trunks. They were used for digging and eating.

**PRIMATE**  
Primates were among the earliest mammals to have large brains. They were used for climbing and eating.

**RODENT**  
Rodents were among the earliest mammals to have long tails. They were used for digging and eating.

**REPTILIAN**  
Reptilians were among the earliest mammals to have long necks. They were used for digging and eating.

**SAURIA**  
Saurians were among the earliest mammals to have long legs. They were used for digging and eating.

**TRICERATOPS**  
Triceratops were among the earliest mammals to have long horns. They were used for digging and eating.

**T-RX**  
T-Rex were among the earliest mammals to have long teeth. They were used for digging and eating.

**WALKING**  
Walking mammals were among the earliest mammals to have long legs. They were used for digging and eating.

**WINGS**  
Winged mammals were among the earliest mammals to have long wings. They were used for digging and eating.

## WHY ARE MAMMALS UNIQUE?

Mammals are a large and very successful group of animals. They have been able to spread across the world and survive in all sorts of habitats because they have some unique ways to stay warm, find their young and get food.

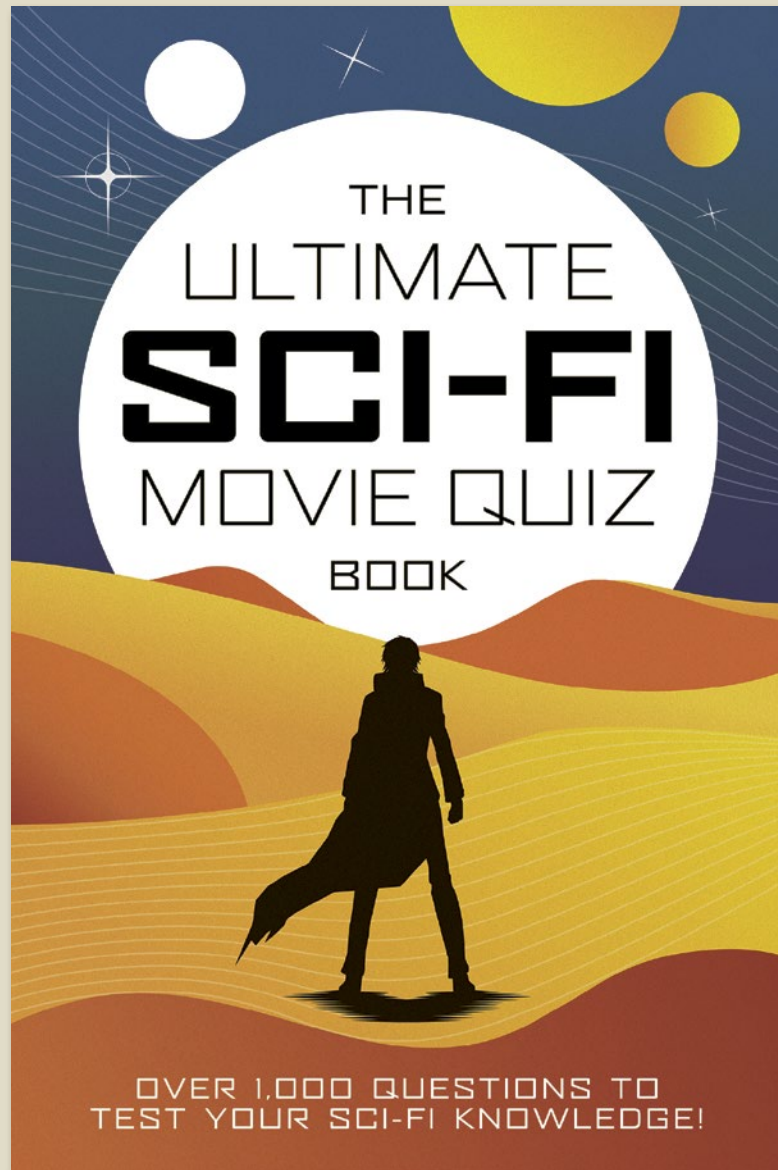
**DESERTS**  
Deserts are very dry habitats that experience extreme temperatures. **Bactrian camels** survive desert life by storing food and water as fat inside their two **humps**. They grow thick, shaggy fur for the icy winter, and shed it for the hot summer months.

**CAVES**  
Many species of bats gather together in caves in big groups called **colonies**. They rest during the day by hanging upside down from the cave ceiling and go hunting at night. Some caves can house more than five million bats!
