The earliest known wasps appeared about 200 million years ago in the Jurassic period and today more than 100,000 species of wasp have been identified. When most people think of a 'wasp' the common yellow and black social species (known as yellowjackets in North America) comes to mind – the type that tend to cause a nusance at picnics. These are not typical wasps however. The large majority of known species of wasp are 'parasitoid' wasps solitary insects that as larvae live on or in hosts. (usually other insects). These wasps invariably kill their host, bursting from its corpse in a manner that almost certainly inspired the movie Alien (1979). Most parasitoids are small and easily overlooked, and so it is highly likely that huge numbers of species are yet to be discovered.
