Plumbers have dreamed about Purgatory for thousands of years. They transport people and cargo faster than any other vehicle. They are a vital part of military campaigns. They help us map, explore and learn about our world. WRIGHT FLYER



On December 17th, 1903, Wilbur and Orville Wright changed the world forever. For years, they mathematically studied American brothers had shared a vision of creating a machine that could fly further and more reliably than a glider, and, unlike air or balloons, wasn't forced to fly in a particular direction by the wind. In short: the first flying vehicle that the pilot had complete control over. After years of planning and countless experiments, their vision became a history-making reality in the sandy dunes of Outer Banks, North Carolina, USA.

off. Within ten seconds as the flyer tumbled down a wooden launch rail, took off and flew close to the ground for 12 seconds. Three more flights occurred that day, the last being the longest at 59 seconds and

But this was only the beginning. News of the Wright brothers' incredible achievement spread, and soon other inventors were building on their ideas to create even more amazingly powerful machines. The first circumnavigation around the world was completed in four decades: World Cruise airplanes only 10 years later. By the 1930s, jet aircraft were soaring through the air. Today, we see aircraft in defined categories: ferry cargo, ferry out the morning news operations, and explore and breed the world - miracles of flight all elaborated by the Wright brothers.

WOOD, CANVAS AND STRING

The airplane was only a year or two away from being used soon after in combat when the First World War broke out in 1914. But over the course of the next five years, both sides realized just how useful these flying machines could be. Airplane technology advanced rapidly as each side strove to gain air superiority.

As the war progressed, both sides developed aircraft that were more manoeuvrable, could fly and gun at altitude faster, and take more damage. As technology improved, combat aircraft could be put to more uses. As well as a fighter, the British *Sigbee Camel* was also used as a 'low-land' 'branch' similar to attacking targets on the ground with bombs and machine guns.



The first bombing raids of civilian targets occurred during the First World War. Most were carried out using high-flying aircraft called Goetas (see page 25), but both sides developed bomber airplanes like Mustangs (see page 26). In the Second World War, bombers dropped bombs from under its wings and defended itself with machine guns.

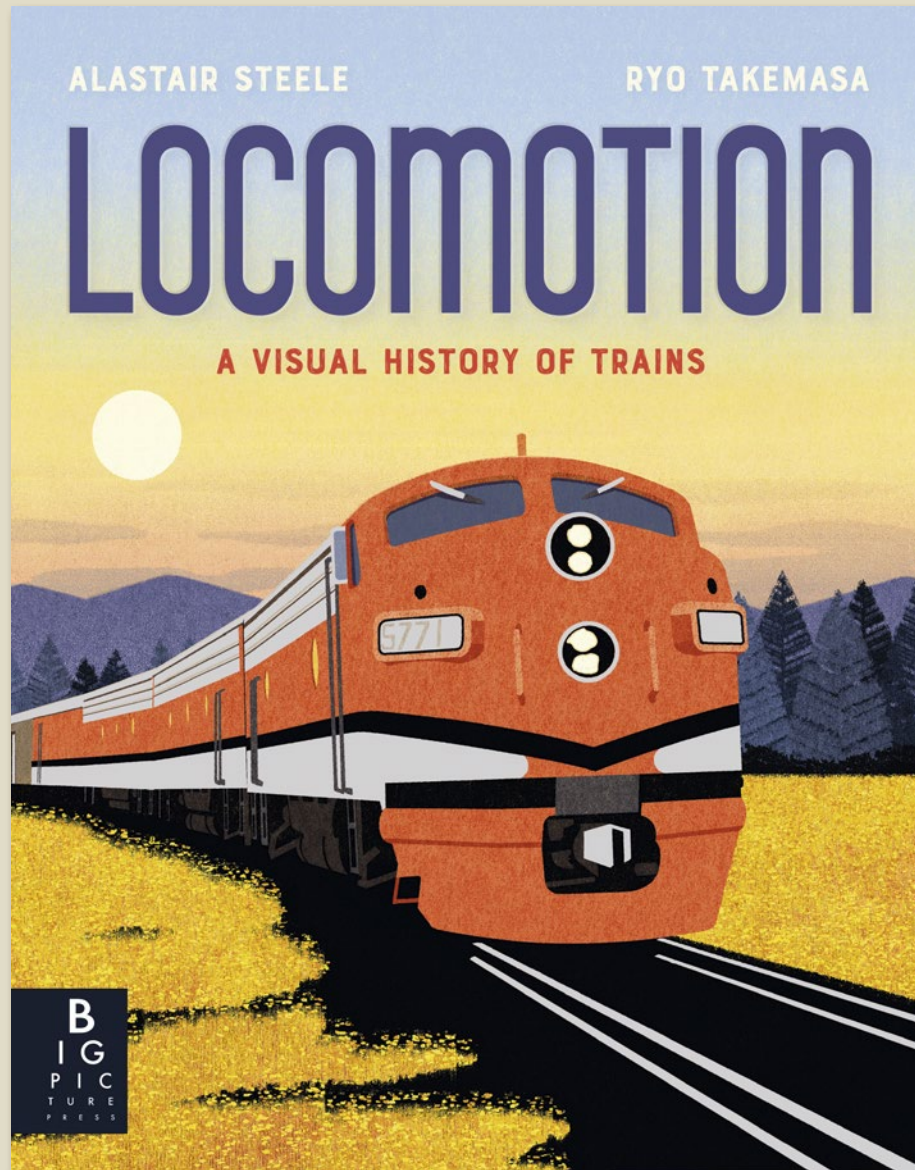
The pilots who drifted over war-torn Europe needed safer routes and skill. However, many had very little training, and the expectancy was short. Pilots who shot down more than five aircraft were called 'aces'. The Fokker D-7 triplane was flown by German ace Manfred von Richthofen - nicknamed as the Red Baron.

Locomotion

THE FIRST RAILWAYS

It is strange to think that they have only been around as we know them for about two hundred years.



At steam engines were used in British mines in the 17th century to pump water. It wasn't long before engineers tried using steam power to propel a car, and in 1802 the inventor Richard Trevithick built a very first working steam locomotive.



ELECTRIC LOCOMOTIVES

The first electric train was tested as far back as 1837. Unlike steam trains, electric locomotives do not carry fuel on-board. Instead, they are powered by electricity which can be supplied from overhead lines, a third rail or in storage such as batteries. Because electric trains can be powered by renewable energy sources, they are considered less polluting than steam or diesel trains.



The first electric passenger train was presented by Werner von Siemens at an exhibition in Berlin in 1879. Consisting of a small locomotive and three cars, it reached a speed of just 13km/h.

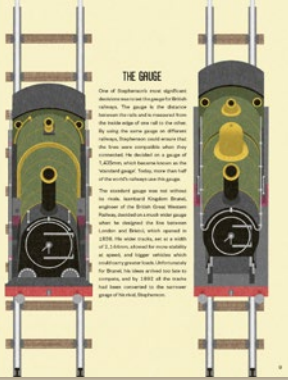


The *ETR 200* is a record-breaking electric passenger train. It is widely considered one of the first ever high-speed trains and was put into service in 1936. In 1939, it broke the speed record for trains by reaching just over 201km/h.



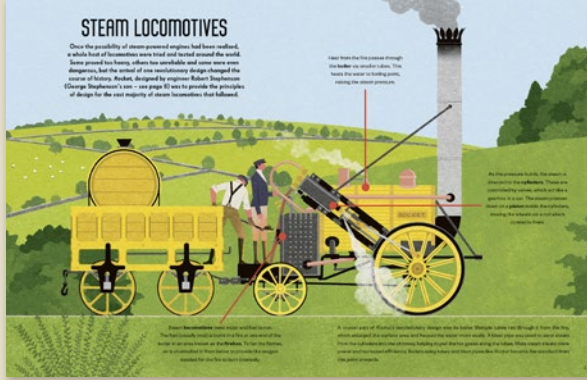
The ICE (InterCity Express) is one of Germany's most successful electric trains. The third generation ICE 3 can reach speeds of 300km/h. Since 2018, it has run on entirely **renewable energy** sources.

THE GAUGE



STEAM LOCOMOTIVES

Once the possibility of steam-powered engines had been realized, a whole host of locomotives were tried and tested around the world. Some proved too heavy, others too unreliable and some were too dangerous, but the arrival of one revolutionary design changed course of history. *Rocket*, designed by engineer Robert Stephenson and George Stephenson's son – see page 80 used to provide the prime of design for the vast majority of steam locomotives that follow.



DIESEL LOCOMOTIVES

In a diesel locomotive, the power comes from an engine that burns diesel oil. While a steam locomotive needed two people to crew it and hours to attain the right steam pressure, a diesel locomotive could simply be switched on and driven away, making them much easier and much cheaper to run. Rudolf Diesel patented his first diesel engine in 1898, but it wasn't until around 1912 that they were first used in a locomotive.



The famous DRG Class SVT 877 *Hamburg Flyer*, often referred to as the 'Flying Hamburger', was first put into service in 1933. Its smooth, rounded shape was influenced by Zeppelin **airships** allowing for minimal air resistance.

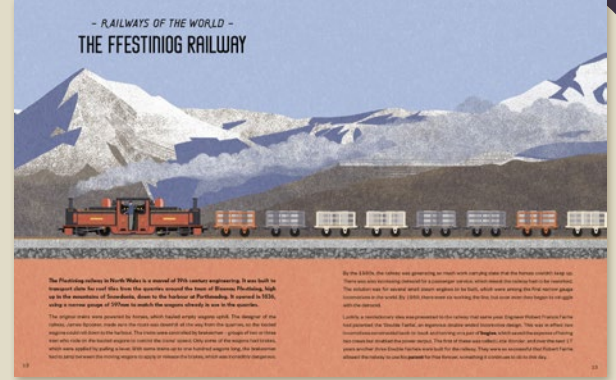


The *De10c*, built in 1956, was considered the most powerful diesel locomotive in the world at that time.

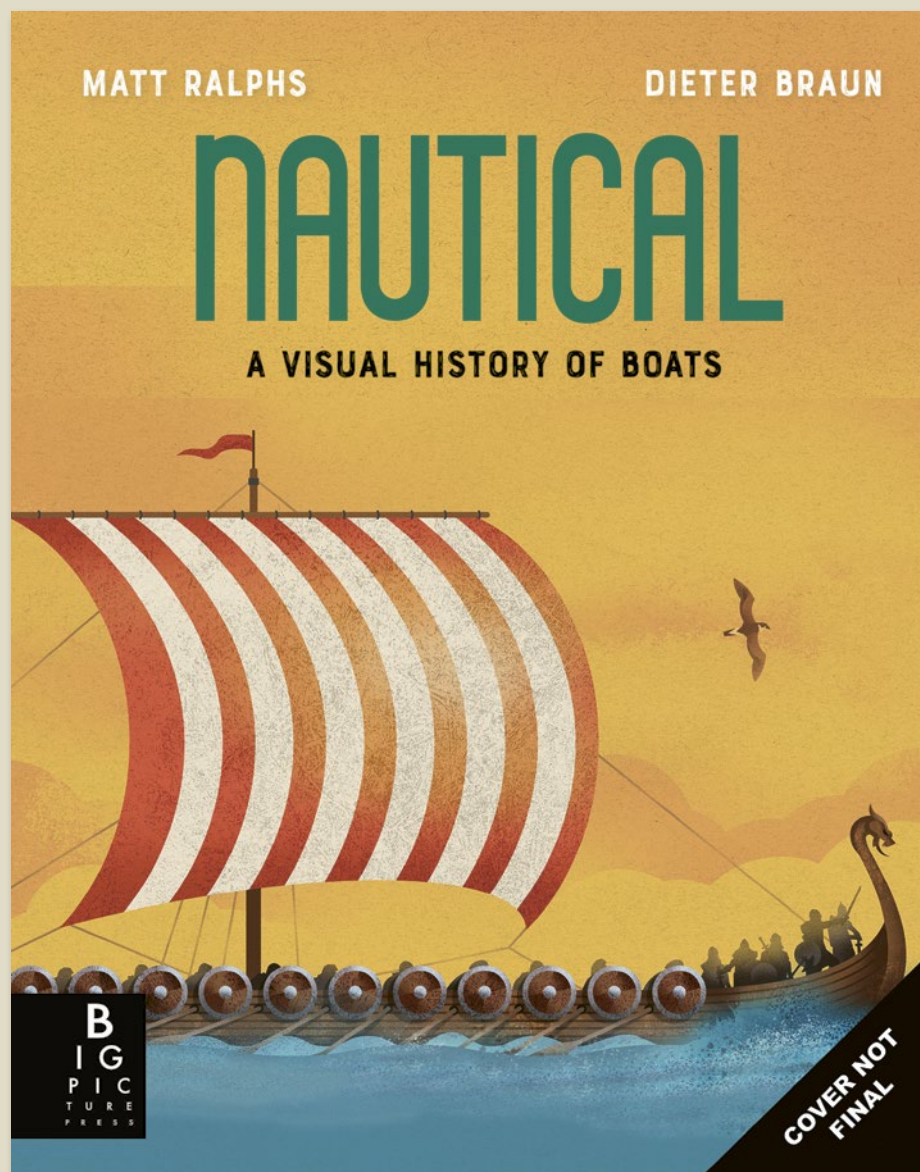


The *Intercity 125* is one of the most successful diesel trains of all time. So named because it was designed to cruise at 125 mph (about 201 km/h) when in service, it also holds the all-time speed record for diesel trains of 238 km/h, which it reached in 1987.
