anything Animal Boulevard has ever seen – and it could last for weeks, so they reckon!'

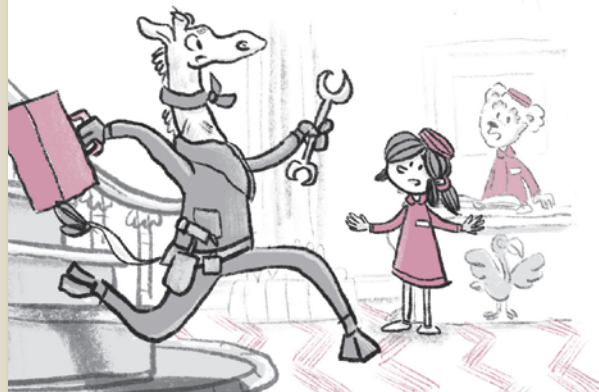
'Goodness,' said Anna. 'That does sound serious.'

Stella jabbed the air with a spanner.

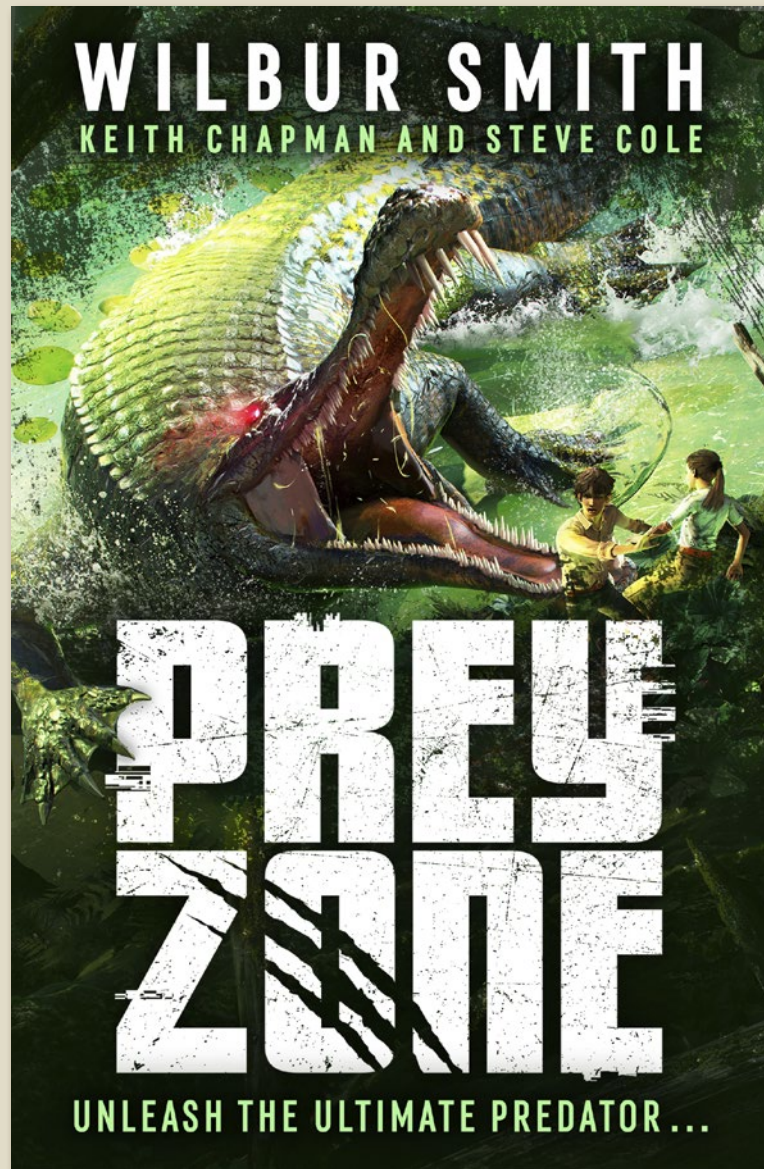
