### THE DIGESTION QUESTION

How does the food you eat turn into energy inside your body? How does it travel? The process is called digestion. Together, the parts of your body that help break down our food are called the digestive system.

**Teeth**  
The teeth cut up the food into small pieces that can be swallowed.

Food travels down here from the mouth.

### FINDING FOOD

Usually, food appears in front of you at the dinner table. But how did it make its way there? Where does food come from? Many foods go on a journey from farms to factory to finished feast. Some food comes from much closer to home too!

# Little Explorers: Weather

### THE SUN AND THE SEASONS

As weather patterns change through the year, so do different seasons. This happens because Earth orbits the sun, getting warmer when it's closer to the sun and cooler when it's further away.

**On a tilt**  
Earth's axis is tilted at an angle of 23.5 degrees. This means that it leans in a certain direction towards the sun. This tilt causes the different seasons.

**Always moving**  
Earth is always moving around the sun in a circle. It takes one year to go all the way around. During that time, part of it gets closer to the sun and part gets further away.

**North pole**

**Summer**  
When an area of the planet is tilted towards the sun, it gets more direct sunlight. This means it gets warmer. In the Northern Hemisphere, this is summer. In the Southern Hemisphere, this is winter.

**Winter**  
When an area of the planet is tilted away from the sun, it gets less direct sunlight. This means it gets cooler. In the Northern Hemisphere, this is winter. In the Southern Hemisphere, this is summer.

**Autumn**  
When an area of the planet is tilted at an angle to the sun, it gets a mix of direct and indirect sunlight. This means it gets a mix of warm and cool weather. In the Northern Hemisphere, this is autumn. In the Southern Hemisphere, this is spring.

**Spring**  
When an area of the planet is tilted at an angle to the sun, it gets a mix of direct and indirect sunlight. This means it gets a mix of warm and cool weather. In the Northern Hemisphere, this is spring. In the Southern Hemisphere, this is autumn.

**Hot and dry**  
In the summer, the sun is high in the sky. This means that the sun's rays hit the ground at a steep angle. This makes the ground get very hot. The air above the ground also gets hot. This makes the air dry.

**Sun never sets**  
In the summer, the sun is high in the sky. This means that the sun's rays hit the ground at a steep angle. This makes the ground get very hot. The air above the ground also gets hot. This makes the air dry.

### THE WATER CYCLE

Did you know that the water you drink and the rain that falls on your head are made of the same stuff? The water on our planet is recycled over and over again in a never-ending cycle.

**What's inside a cloud?**

**Evaporation**  
The sun's heat causes the water on the surface of the sea or in lakes to evaporate and rise into the air. The water vapor then condenses into tiny droplets, which form clouds.

**Condensation**  
As the water vapor rises, it cools down. This causes the water vapor to condense into tiny droplets, which form clouds.

**Precipitation**  
When the water droplets in a cloud get big enough, they fall to the ground as rain, snow, or sleet.

**Ice storms**  
If it is very cold, the water droplets in a cloud can freeze before they fall. This causes ice to form on the ground and on trees.

**Runoff**  
When it rains, the water runs down the ground and into rivers, lakes, and oceans. This is called runoff.

**Infiltration**  
Some of the water that falls on the ground soaks into the soil. This is called infiltration.

**Transpiration**  
Plants take up water from the ground and release it into the air as water vapor. This is called transpiration.

**Rainbow**  
A rainbow is formed when sunlight is refracted, or bent, by water droplets in the air.

### WHOOOSH! WIND

A gentle breeze or a strong gale - some think you can't feel the wind at all, while others think it's a powerful force that can knock you over!

**Under pressure**  
The weight of the air above us creates a pressure. The air molecules are constantly moving and bumping into each other. This creates a force that pushes down on us.

**Air on the move**  
When there is a difference in air pressure, the air will move from the high pressure area to the low pressure area. This is what creates the wind.

**Wind power**  
The wind can be used to generate electricity. Wind turbines are used to capture the energy of the wind and convert it into electricity.

### IN THE CLOUDS

On a sunny, rainy or grey day, you might see clouds in the sky. There are 10 common types of cloud, and they all mean different things for what weather we may have.

Thin, wispy clouds that are high in the sky.

**Cirrocumulus**  
Thin, white clouds that are high in the sky.

**Altostratus**  
Grey, overcast clouds that are in the middle of the sky.
