ETERNITY ISLE BIOMES


Disney Isle is a truly fascinating place, full of ancient wonders. It's home to three additional biomes, with their distinct regions, but these require Mist to unlock, rather than Dreamlight. Here's what you can expect to find in each region.



GLITTERING DUNES
The ancient Glittering Dunes are a vast area of desert with little in the way of plants and little of the colorful and varied terrain. The Dunes are a wide expanse of flat ground with the remains of some ancient sandstone archways and steps. The Butterflies at the foot of a tall building in the Palace, and an owl named Lou Lou. Upon arrival at Disney Isle, you'll find yourself in Ancient's Landing - a mysterious set of ruins that appear to be very old indeed. The Docks show evidence of market activity, and are a great spot for fishing. The Clockwork is a small, enclosed area with a narrow passage a tiny beach complete with Treadwinding Table. The Quartz biomes feature views of the ocean, with more ancient ruins all in the distance - getting this area once you've used a beach post. The Ruins are all that remains of an ancient castle. Largely deserted by nature, there's a small courtyard and a staircase leading to a balcony with a magnificent view of the surrounding landscape.

BELOVED CHARACTERS

THE GOLDEN AGE

Literary classics provided strong source material for a number of Disney films. Alice in Wonderland (1951) is Disney's version of classic Lewis Carroll children's novels; Alice's Adventures in Wonderland and Through the Looking Glass, and What Alice Found There. The books had fascinated Walt Disney since childhood. In the 1920s, they had loosely inspired his part animated, part live-action Alice Comedies and since then he had bought the film rights to the novel. Disney concept artist and colour stylist Mary Blair created exuberant, fantastical production artwork that inspired the look of the film. Music and songs hold the film's sequences together and propel the story along - the film features more songs than any other Disney film at the time. One of the film's most extravagant scenes, the Mad Hatter's tea party, was initially filmed in live-action to provide an aid to animators. Vaudevillean actor Ed Wynn played the Mad Hatter and Wynn's extemporized voice track was so inspired it was used for the final film.

In 1913, Walt had seen a touring production of J.M. Barrie's stage play Peter Pan and, inspired by its combination of fantasy and swashbuckling adventure, acquired the film rights in 1939. As with Alice in Wonderland, Mary Blair created the signature production art for the film. Live-action footage was shot for the animators' reference, with the voice actors performing their roles. Meanwhile, the magic of Disney animation made the characters fly - Peter Pan even engages dastardly Captain Hook in mid-air sword fights. Tinker Bell, often represented merely as a spotlight in stage versions, became a fully realized character using actor Margaret Kerry and others, in live-action model. Released in 1953, after nearly two decades of work and thousands of drawings, Peter Pan was an immediate success and has remained a beloved Disney classic.

Literary works have remained a source of inspiration. The Sword in the Stone (1963), a whimsical adaptation of T.H. White's novel about the Arthurian legends, was the first Disney animated feature film to include songs by the Sherman Brothers, who would later work on Mary Poppins (1964), The Jungle Book (1967) and many others. The Rescuers (1977), a tale of an international rescue organisation run by mice, was based on a book series by English author Margery Sharp. Cruella DeVil nearly became the main villain in the film, but in the end the animation team created the fiery tempered, diamond-obsessed pawn shop owner Madame Medusa. Some classic tales are updated in inventive new ways: Treasure Planet (2002) is a version of Robert Louis Stevenson's 1883 novel Treasure Island set in outer space!

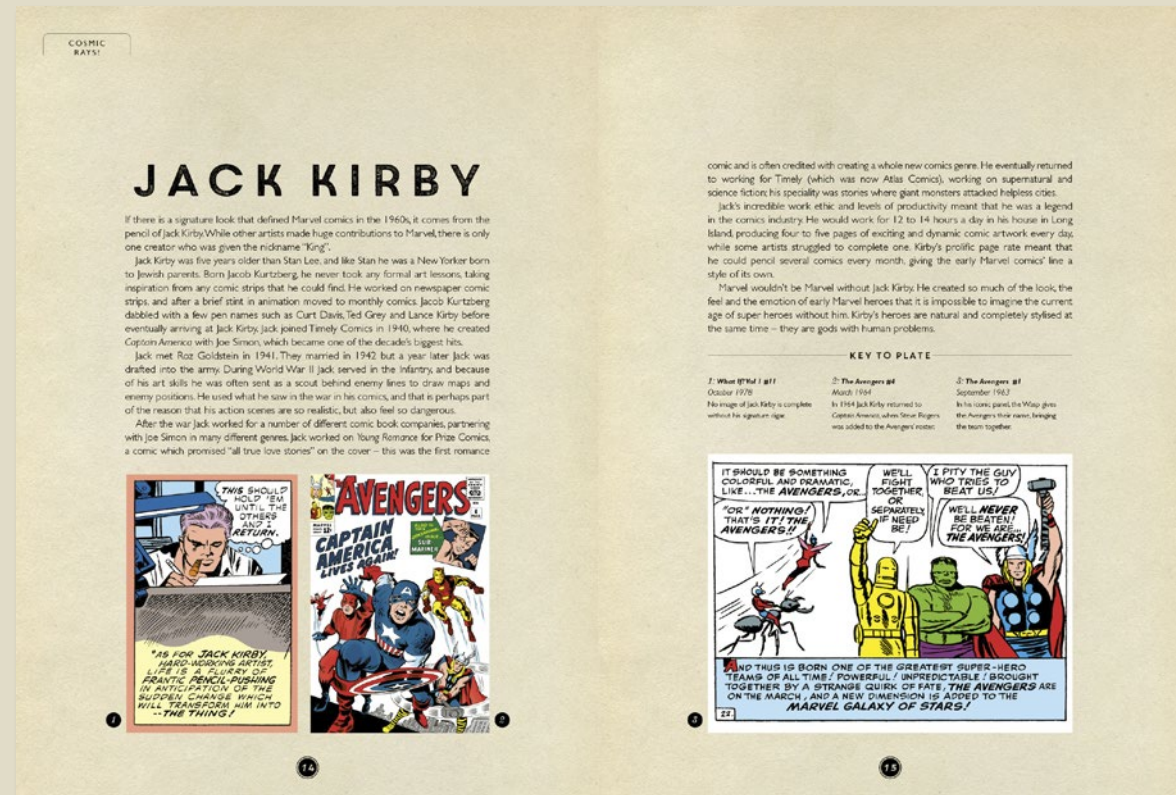

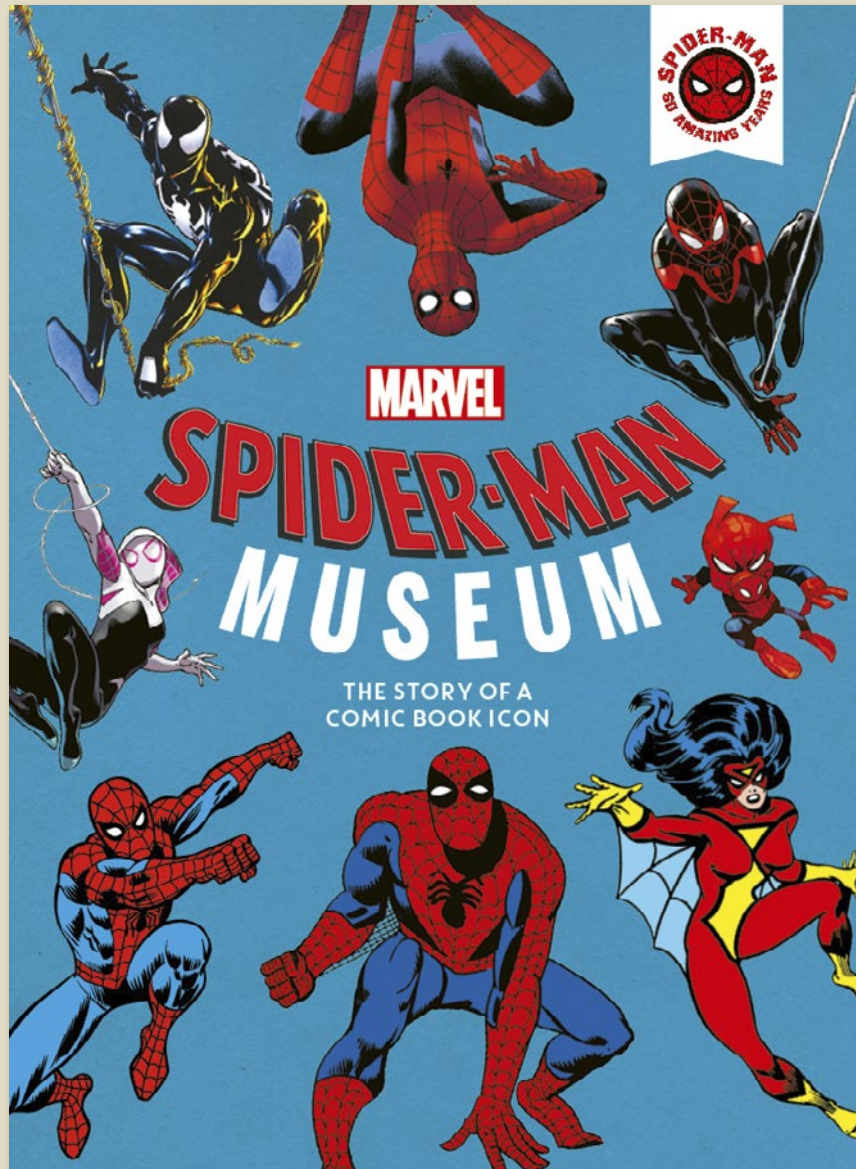

It wasn't one man, but two who were instrumental in Spider-Man's early history. Starting with *Amazing Spider-Man #1* in 1962, John Romita Sr. was responsible for shaping the look of the character and the world he lived in. His son, John Romita Jr., took over the role in 1973, continuing the legacy of his father's work. FRIENDLY NEIGHBOURHOOD SPIDER-MAN

Peter Parker got his powers when he was bitten by a radioactive spider at a science exhibition, which gave him the proportional strength, speed and endurance of a spider. He was also able to devise a formula for his webbing, a thin, glue-like substance that is strong enough to tie up his enemies and allow him to swing through New York, but which also dissolves after an hour. And his Spider-Sense, that warns of danger, allows him to stay one step ahead of his very large roster of villains.

Steve Ditko's design for the Spider-Man costume is brilliant in its simplicity and it's a testament to his work that the design has barely changed in 60 years. Spider-Man is identifiable from almost any part of his costume because of his bold and striking design, and the fact that the costume covers him completely means that readers can identify with him, as it could be anyone wearing the suit.

Spider-Man's early adventures are characterised by exciting battles with dangerous, experienced villains who contrast with Peter's youth and naivety. Spider-Man's priorities are different from other super heroes. In *Amazing Spider-Man #1* he is primarily concerned with making money to pay for medicine for Aunt May. After finding it impossible to cash a cheque for his TV appearances made out to 'Spider-Man', he tries to join the Fantastic Four before finding out that the FF do not pay a salary.

One of the reasons that Spider-Man is so relatable is that we spend so much time in the hero's head. Stan Lee said, "one of the things that has, over the years, set Spider apart from other super heroes is the fact that he so often agonises over the hand that fate has dealt him [...] The of wall-crawler is considered by many to be the Hamlet of superheroism. In fact, people always ask what made me decide to give Spider-Man so many thought balloons, as we all call them in comic-book land because it seems nobody ever used thought balloons quite that way until Aunt May's neurotic nephew made the scene. Well, the reason is quite simple, really, in novels, a reader is usually privy to the protagonist's thoughts. That's what helps make characters come alive in our imagination; it makes us feel we know them. Likewise, in stage plays, and in comics as well, we can gain great insights into the characters by their conversation. But Spider-Man, alas, is a loner. When he's out wall-crawling or web-slinging [...] he's all by himself. He has no one to talk to at such times."¹

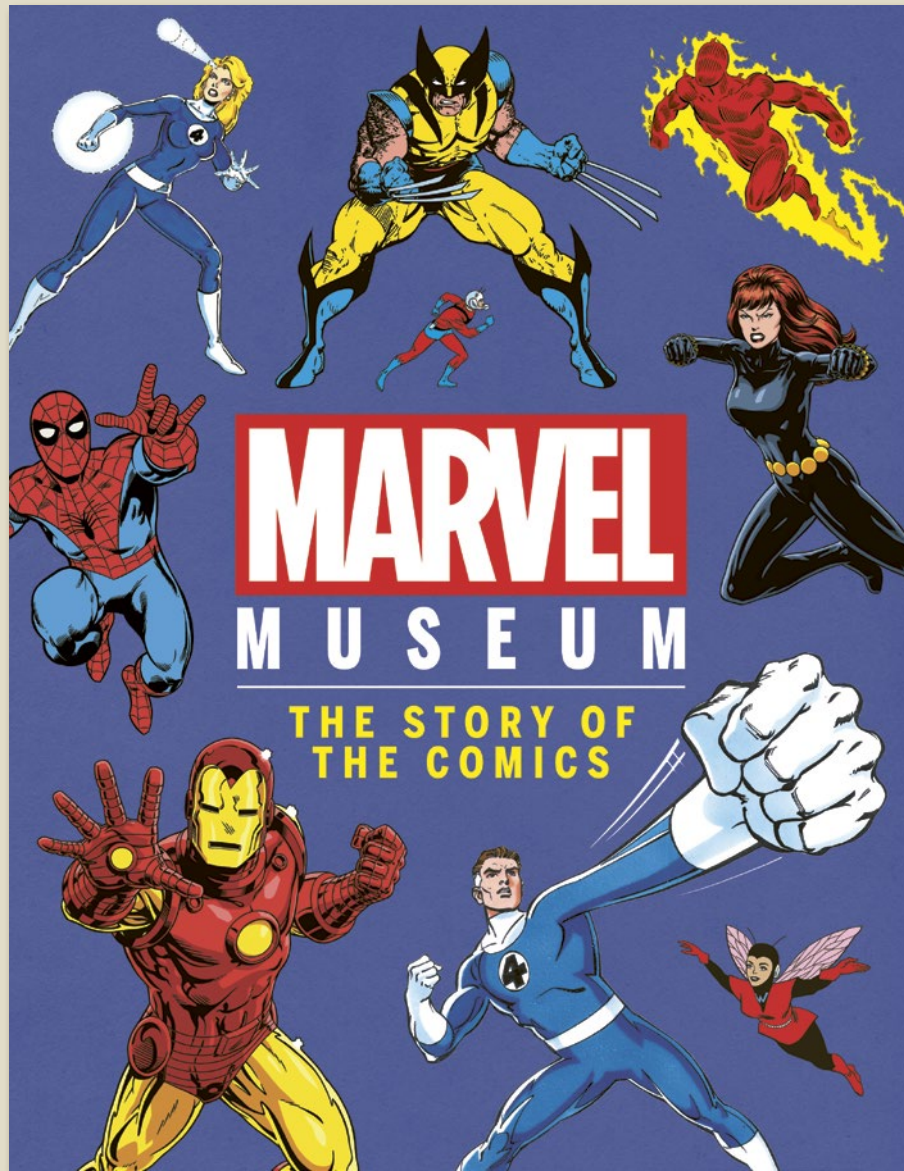

THE INFINITY STONES

The Infinity Gems (later known as the Infinity Stones) were slowly introduced to the Marvel Universe, starting with the Soul Gem in *The Thanos Quest*. Thanos discovered that the Infinity Stones are powerful artifacts older than time itself. Thanos first tried to bring the Infinity Stones together in *The Avengers Annual #7* with the express intention of destroying every single star in the galaxy, but was stopped by the Avengers, Spider-Man and the Thing. The Stones were collected and hidden in golden rings known as the Elders of the Universe, but Thanos tracked them down once again. Thanos' biggest achievement was to collect all the Infinity Gems and wield them in a specially constructed Infinity Gauntlet. With this incredible power he was able to remove half the life from the universe in the blink of an eye during *The Infinity Gauntlet* saga – despite every single Marvel hero (and cosmic being) coming together to try to stop him. Eventually, Thanos was undone because of his cruelty: he had kept the space pirate Mephisto as a disfigured jester for fun, and while Thanos was distracted Mephisto was able to take the gauntlet from him and reverse the balance of the universe. The reason that the Infinity Stones work so well as a concept is that they are a reflection of the best things about Marvel stories. The avengers have great power, they are grounded in reality, they jump between different times and spaces, they follow some of the greatest minds around and most importantly – they have fun.

JACK KIRBY

If there is a signature look that defined Marvel comics in the 1960s, it comes from Jack Kirby. While other artists made huge contributions to Marvel, there is only one creator who was given the nickname "King".

Jack Kirby was five years older than Stan Lee, and like Stan he was a New Yorker born to Jewish parents. Born Jacob Kurtzberg, he never took any formal art lessons, taking inspiration from any comic strips that he could find. He worked on newspaper comic strips, and after a brief stint in animation moved to monthly comics. Jacob Kurtzberg dabbled with a few pen names such as Curt Davis, Ted Grey and Lance Kirby before eventually arriving at Jack Kirby. Jack joined Timely Comics in 1940, where he created Captain America with Joe Simon, which became one of the decade's biggest hits.

Jack met Roz Goldstein in 1941. They married in 1942 but a year later Jack was drafted into the army. During World War II Jack served in the Infantry, and because of his art skills he was often sent as a scout behind enemy lines to draw maps and enemy positions. He used what he saw in the war in his comics, and that is perhaps part of the reason that his action scenes are so realistic, but also feel so dangerous.

After the war Jack worked for a number of different comic book companies, partnering with Joe Simon in different genres. Jack worked on *Young Romance* for Prize Comics, a comic which promised "all true love stories" on the cover – this was the first romance comic and is often credited with creating a whole new genre. He eventually returned to working for Timely (which was now Atlas Comics), working on supernatural and science fiction; his speciality was stories where giant monsters attacked helpless cities.

Jack's incredible work ethic and levels of productivity meant that he

was a legend in the comics industry. He would work for 12 to 14 hours a day in his house in Long Island, producing four to five pages of exciting and dynamic comic artwork every day, while some artists struggled to complete one. Kirby's prolific page rate meant that he could pencil several comics every month, giving the early Marvel comics' line a style of its own.

Marvel wouldn't be Marvel without Jack Kirby. He created so much of the look, the feel and the emotion of early Marvel heroes that it is impossible to imagine the current age of super heroes without him; Kirby's heroes are natural and completely stylised at the same time – they are gods with human problems.
