Habitat: Coastal Waters

Coastal habitats appear where the sea meets the land. They are areas of constant change as waves, tides and currents continuously affect the landscape. Despite these challenges, life in coastal areas is the richest in the world. With rivers flooding into the sea and waves constantly eroding the land, there's a never-ending source of nutrients.

Many of the creatures that live in coastal waters, such as crabs, limpets and scallops, have hard shells which protect them from the sharp rocks and powerful currents. 
Some areas of the coast are above the water at low tide and below the water at high tide. Many animals that live in these areas – known as intertidal zones – have cement glands that allow them to anchor themselves to a rock and stay put as the tides rise and fall. Others, like starfish and octopuses, have powerful suckers on their arms which help them to grip slippery surfaces.



Sexual Reproduction

Fungi can reproduce both sexually and asexually. This is rare and caused great confusion in the past because each reproductive form would often be classed as a distinct species. Even today, scientists sometimes use DNA to identify reproductive 'pairs' of the same fungus.

Sexual reproduction in fungi can only be seen with a microscope. Two nuclei (the membrane-bound structures that contain the cell's genetic material), each with a single set of chromosomes (thread-like structures in which the DNA is packaged in the nucleus), must fuse together. It is a complex process that involves cell division and the exchange and rearrangement of genes. Living organisms including fungi do this because it ensures genetic diversity, fundamental to evolution and ultimately survival. The fusing nuclei can be from the same individual, or different ones of the same species. Once nuclei are fused, they remain in special cells from which new spore-producing structures arise. The new spores will form new fungal colonies.





Habitat: Kelp Forest

Kelp is a kind of seaweed that grows in cool coastal regions. Unlike plants on land, seaweeds have a holdfast instead of roots, which grips to the rocky seabed, ensuring the kelp is locked in place. Each holdfast has one or more stipes, or stalks, reaching up to the surface. Some types of kelp grow as tall as 45 metres, forming vast forests that tower above the seahed.

All ecosystems need a delicate balance between photosynthesising organisms (such as seaweed), herbivores and carnivores. In the kelp forest, this balance is best seen in the relationship between kelp, sea urchins and sea otters. Sea urchins graze on the kelp, making space for new plant growth. Sea otters then feed on the urchins, keeping their numbers down and ensuring they don't eat all the kelp.

Kelp forests are vulnerable to climate change as warming seas bring less of the nutrients needed for kelp growth and poor water quality reduces the light levels needed for photosynthesis, It is possible therefore that, as our ocean warms, kelp forests may move further north to cooler waters.

Frida Kahlo is one of the most recognizable artists of the twentieth century, not least because of her 143 paintings, 55 are self-portraits. "I am so often alone", she once said, "and I am the subject I know best."



Frida was born in 1907 in Coyoscin, a suburb of Mexico City, In 1925 the was nearly killed in a hornfic bus crash. She suffered multiple frectures to her spine, collarbone, ribs, pelvis, and shoulder. From that day on, Frida was in constant pain and would endure over thirty operations in her short kife. While in the hospital, Frida's father gave her some paints. Her mother made her a special easel so the could work kiping down and rigged up a mirror so she had a subject — herself. In art, Frida found her voice, a way of expressing her psychological and physical wounds. She used symbolient to describe her distress: perhaps

scissors, surrounded by her own fallen hair, or a broken heart lying at her feet. In other work she depicts herself more than once, showing different aspects of her personality. Some were shocked at the frankness with which she bared her soul; most found it exhibitating.

Oddly, during her fifetime, Frida was often talked of as the wife of the famous mural artist Diego Rivers. Today, he is remembered as Frida's husband! Their relationship was stormy and passionate. They once even divorced but remarried a year later. Everything she field and experienced was poused into her work. The terment of her broken body after the bus crash became a painting called The Broken Column, referring to her own spine. Frida partly wore her colourful, embroodered Tehuana dresses to diaguise her limp, but traditional attre was also a way of exploring, they place in the history of South America.


Her first solo exhibition, in New York, 1938, was a huge success, and the Louvre in Paris bought one of her paintings the year after. Finds was internationally famous. She became a professor at La Esmeradia school of art but by now she was so sick she had to hold classes at home. She attended the opening of her first and only solo exhibition in Mexico in her bed.

Against the advice of her doctors, Frida, who had always been politically active, attended a demonstration, weakening her beyond repair. She died in 1954, in the house in which she had been been.

"They thought I was a surrealist but I wasn't. I never painted dreams, I painted my own reality."
