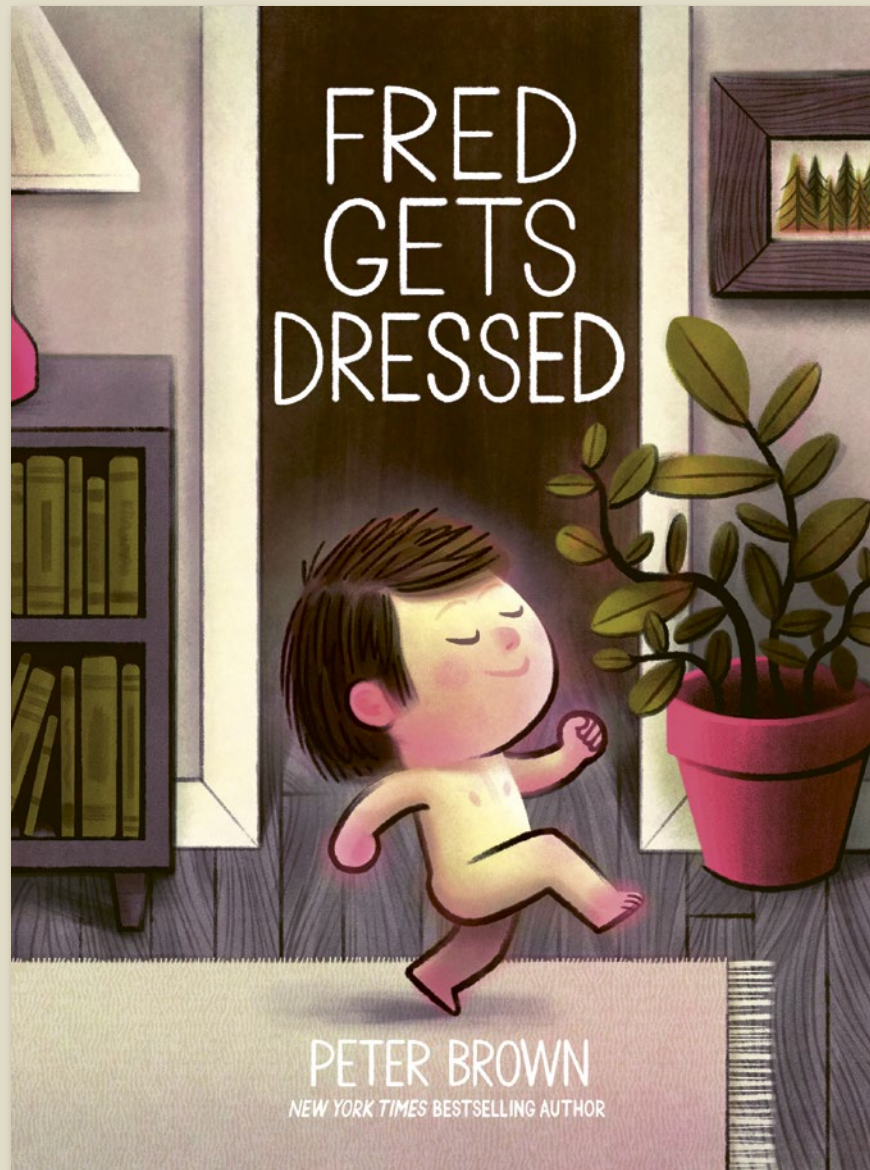
FLIGHT OF FANCY

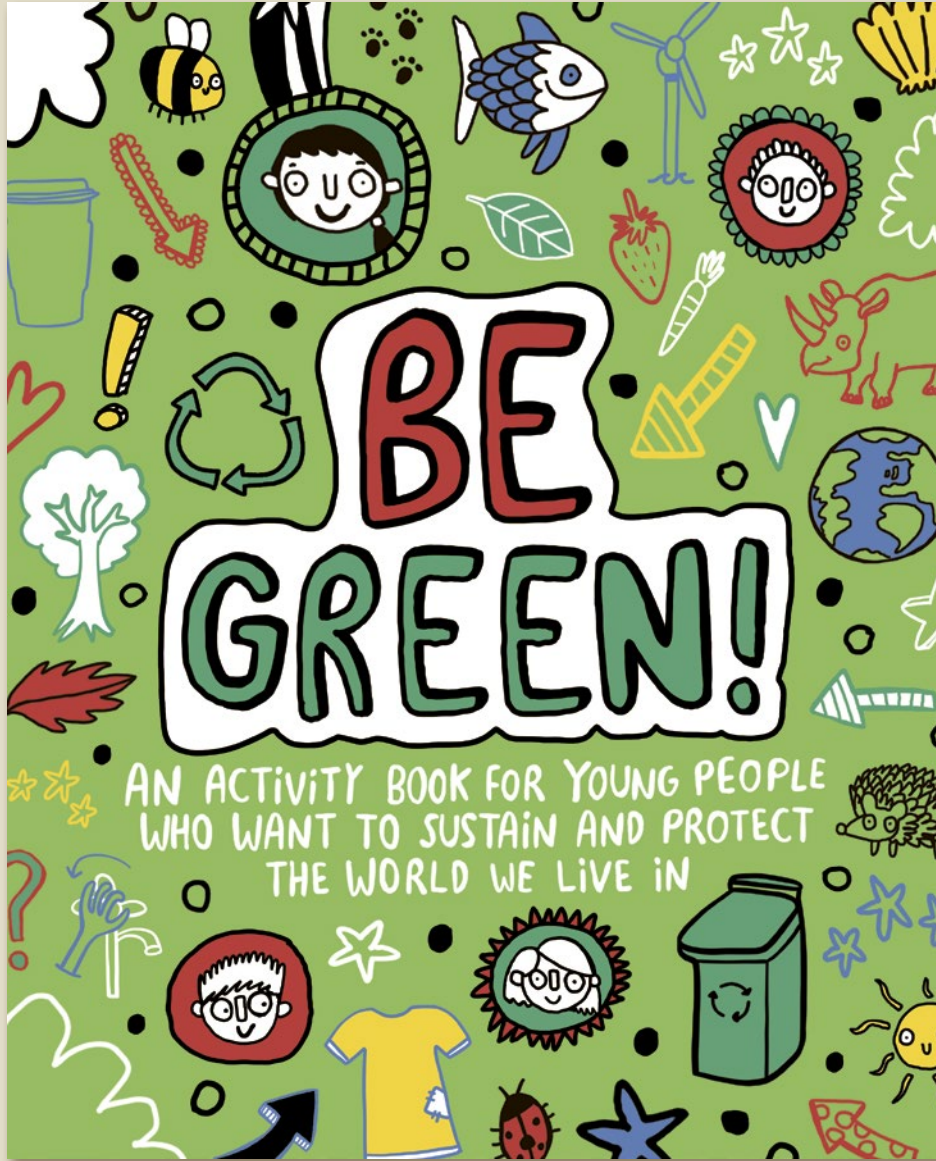
Concentrate on nothing but your breathing and try to let go of any other thoughts you may have.

anything Animal Boulevard has ever seen – and it could last for weeks, so they reckon!'

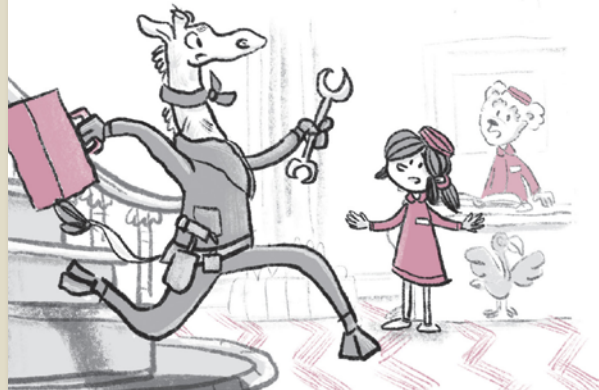
'Goodness,' said Anna. 'That does sound serious.'
