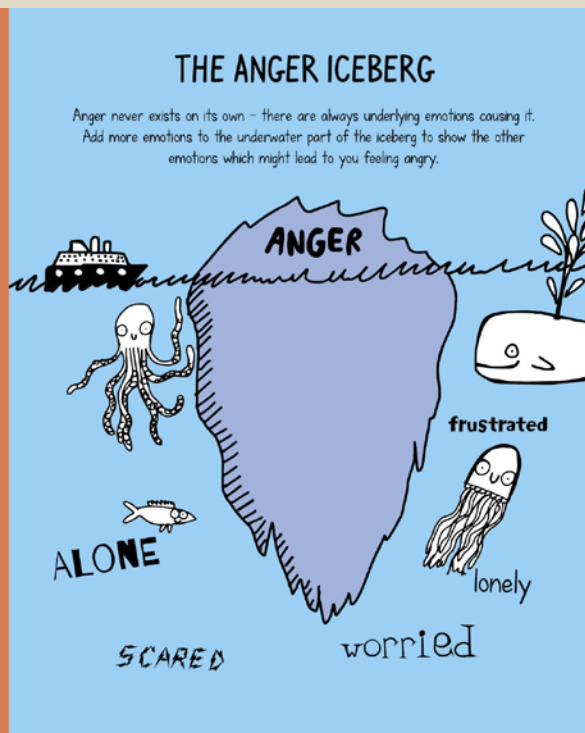
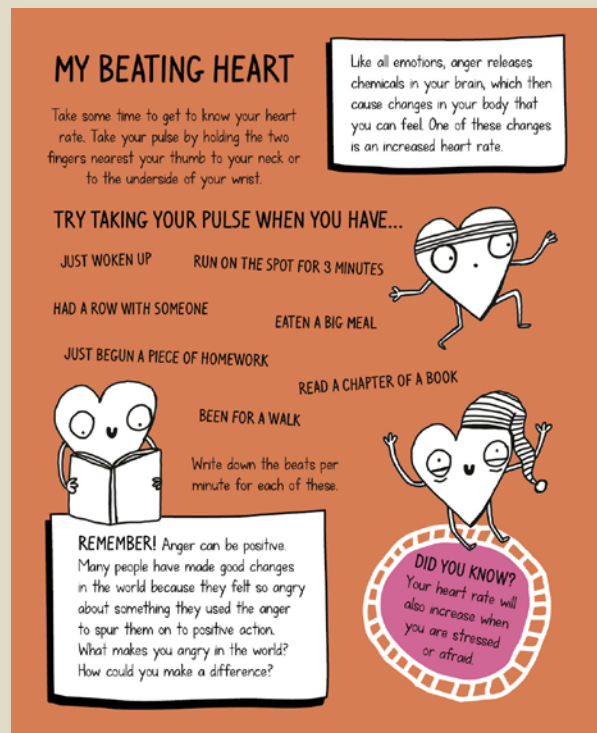

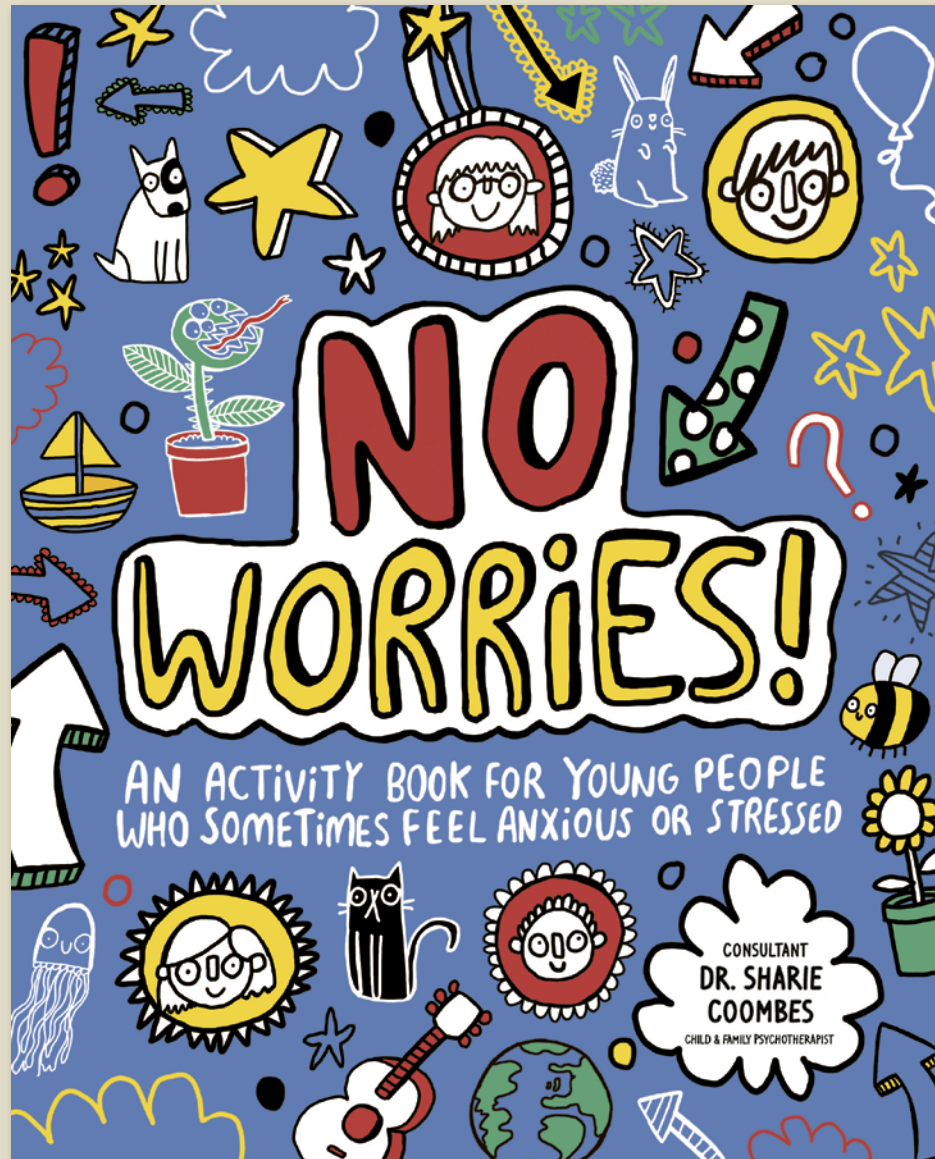

CHILD'S POSE

Bend your legs, fold your body on to your thighs and either rest your arms by your sides or extend them in front of you, whichever feels more comfortable.

Fast your feet on your ankles or above your knees and balance. Then change to your other leg.

Lie on your back and take slow breaths. Close your eyes if you want. Try to empty yourself of thoughts. If your mind wanders away, notice where it goes, then bring your attention back to your breathing.

STEP 2

Place your hand on your tummy and focus on the feeling of your stomach rising and falling with each breath. When you breathe in, quietly say 'in' to yourself, and when you breathe out, quietly say 'out' to yourself.

STEP 3

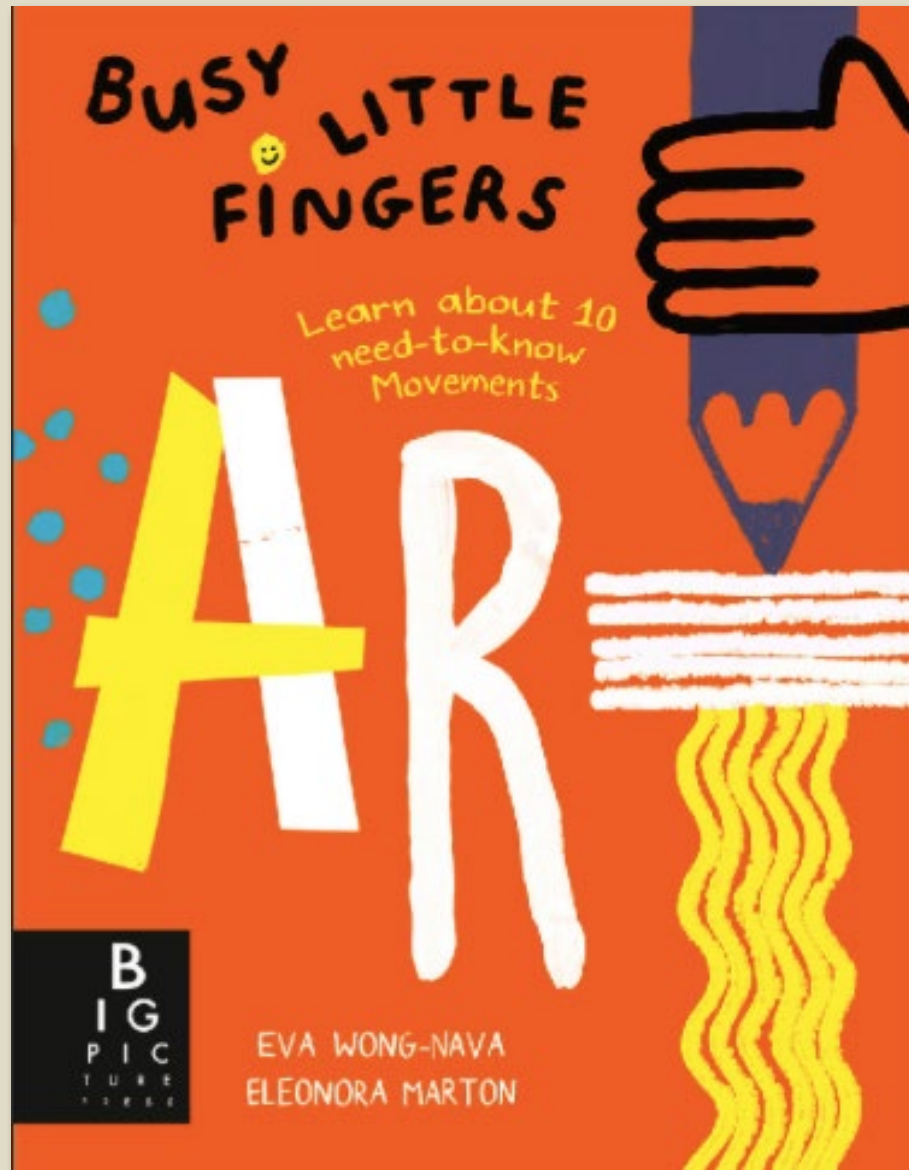
Concentrate on nothing but your breathing and try to let go of any other thoughts you may have.

When you've had lots of practice at the breathing exercise, see if you can think about a happy memory at the same time. This way, your happy memory will take up all the space in your brain, and there won't be any room for the worries.

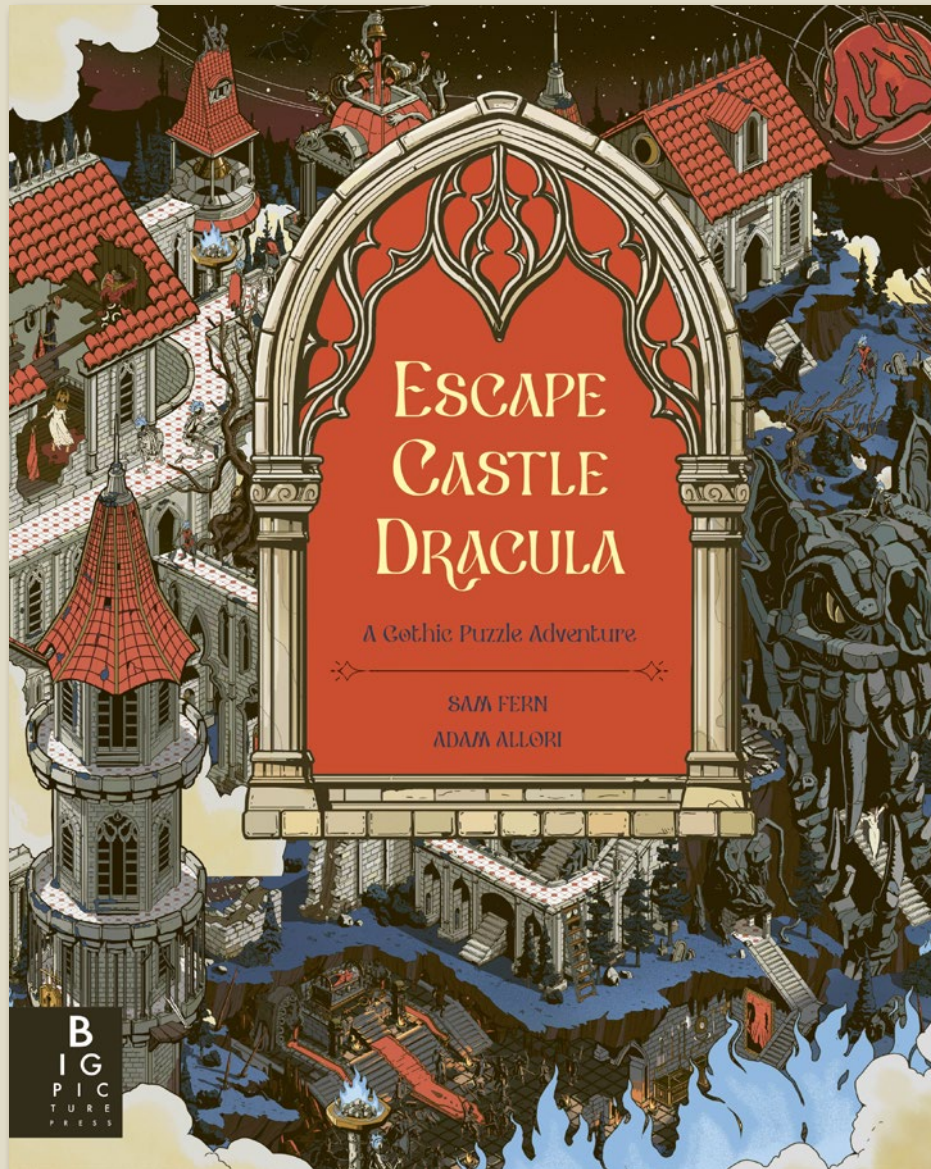
"Yeah, okay. Let's get the meteorite out of the lake," the new, relaxed go-with-the-flow Frankie replied. "So... how are we going to do that?"

Perspective

If you look at any object from different viewpoints, you will see that the part that is closest to you looks larger, and the part furthest away from you looks smaller. Drawing in perspective is a way of creating a feeling of space - of showing three dimensions on a flat surface.

It helps help you with perspective if you imagine a pencil line (the horizon line) stretching the length of the object.

The vanishing point (VP) is the place in a perspective drawing where parallel lines appear to meet. The position of the vanishing point depends on the viewer's eye level. Sometimes a line vanishing point can give you a strong added focus.

VP = vanishing point

Rats

Animals like rats make great cartoon characters. You can give them personalities and expressions just as you can with your cartoon people.

Start by drawing the body in simple shapes.

Sketch a head and neck for the body. Use the line of the body to guide the head.

Add a small circle for the eye. Use the line of the body to guide the eye.

Add a small circle for the ear. Use the line of the body to guide the ear.

Add a small circle for the tail. Use the line of the body to guide the tail.

Add a small circle for the nose. Use the line of the body to guide the nose.

Add a small circle for the mouth. Use the line of the body to guide the mouth.

Figure work

Adding clothes to a figure can help to define the character. This figure is dressed as a Victorian maid.

Start by sketching these simple shapes for the figure.

Draw an oval for the head.

Position the facial features as before.

Inside the hand shape, draw a circle and one finger going into the mouth.

Join the body and hips into one large oval.

Add a small circle for the position of the big toe. This will help you draw the shoes.

Make the legs into tube shapes.

Draw two shapes for the feet.

Sketch an oval for the head.

Add ovals for the body and hips.

Draw straight lines to connect the ovals and show the positions of the limbs.

Draw tube shapes for the arms, using your construction lines as a guide.

Draw two shapes for the feet.

Two parallel lines show the soles of the shoes.

Try drawing these hand gestures.

Sketch in the hair and add the cap.

Draw the shape of the clothes going around the body.

Sketch in the dress using curved lines.

Add details such as cuffs, buttons and a collar.

The hem of the dress covers part of the feet.

Add lines to the apron and at the bottom of the dress to show folds in the material.

Add shading to areas like this where light wouldn't reach.

Finish the head by adding the hair and eyelashes. Shade above the eyes and inside the ear.
