The Magic Fish A tale from China

The Brothers Orimm version of "Cinderella" is the one many of us are familiar with, but there are hundreds — maybe even thousands — of different versions of this sale from around the globe. This version from China was the first to be written down, over 1,000 wars ago.

Once upon a time, in a little shed outside a little house in the cave mountains of Southern China, there lived an orphan called YeTsien. She was bright-eyed, clever, kind and good at making things. YeTsien's stepmother loved her own daughter best, so YeTsien had to do all the herviest, most dangerous work, like collecting firespood from the deep forest or water from the high mountain nocks.

One day, Ye-Thien was collecting water when up from the bottom of a deep mountain pool there was a shimmering and a glittering. 
"Delicious!" they both said, wiping their mouths. They ate every morsel and threw its bones away on the rubbish heap.
