1 HYPERODAPEDON (LIVED; 231—227 MYA)

This weird-looking animal is a kind of rhynchosaur

– a beaked reptile related to the dinosaurs. It had a
scaly body and moved slowly, using its beak to cut
through tough plants.

2 PISANOSAURUS (LIVED: 228-216 MYA)
This small, lightly built plant-eater weighed less
than 10 kg (22 lb). It had strong hind legs and could
run away quickly if a predator earne near. We don't
know if it was a true dinosaur or a close cousin.

S AFTOSAURUS (LIVED; 228—209 MYA) This small, slow-moving, plant-eating archosaur had a long, alender body and short arms. Four roses of thick, bony plates covered its body, providing good protection against predators.


WUSSAURUS (LIVED: 215 MYA) or 'Mouse Lizard, got its name because the first fossils discovered were tiny. We now know these were infants. It was a sauropodomorph dinosaur - a bipedial ancestor of the giant sauropods that walked on all fours.

PLATEOSAURUS (LIVED): 214—204 MYA) Platassaurus was one of the bigger dinosaurs of the Triassic and another susropodomorph. It had a small bead on a long, flexible neck, short but muscular arms with large claws on its three fingers, and powerful hind legs.

Styliosaurus (LIVED: 208–201 MYA) was one of the last sauropodomorph dimosaurs to walk on its hind legs. Its close cousins, the sauropods, all walked on four legs.







- BALD UAKARI This monkey has a short tail, and moves nimbly through the canopy using just its arms and legs. It eats fruit, nuts, leaves and some insects, and can travel up to 4.8 km (3 miles) a day.
- 3 GLDING ANT This tree-dwelling ant has evolved the ability to glide. So if it falls or gets knocked off a branch, it is able to steer itself through the air to return to the same tree. It uses its falt, wich head, hind legs and abdomen like wings to control its flightpath.
- GLDING TREE FROG This frog his fringes of skin on the outside of its limbs, and large webbed hands and feet. By speeding its hands and feet when leaping, the webbing acts as a parachute and the foot is able to glide 15 metres (39 feet) or more between branches to escape produces.
- SEADED CAPUCHIN MONKEY when climbing through the canopy, bearded capuchan monkeys rely almost entirely on their powerful hind limbs, so their arms are free to gather or earry food. They have even been observed walking up vertical tree trunks.
- BLACK SPIDER MONKEY This monkey has very long limbs and a long tail (up to 85 cm / 2.8 feet), and is an agic climber. Its tail is prehensile, meaning it can graup hold of branches, so it acts as a fill limb when the monkey is climbing or swinging through the trees.

The First Edition of Dissessor & Dissesses combined all of the bright ideas and best mechanics from the rulesets of wargarning and its homebrewed variants—as well as narrative inthinences from other media—to create a paragon of excellence in the relatively new role-playing genre.

It included three different volumes (Min & Mogic was used by players to create their characters and learn the basic mechanics of OD&D, Monsters & Treasure contained depictions of the creatures that inhabited the dungeons of the world, as well as the magical items and loot they'd drop, and The Underworld and Wildermas Adversures detailed how to design dungeons, deal with encounters and run campaigns.

Compared to the helty volumes of rules, options and possibilities that we know today, ODBO was fairly limited. It contained just three character classes – fighting-man, mage-user and direk – and only four races – human, eff, halfing and clwarf. However, the monsters numbered in the dozens, from loobolds and großs to six different deady dragons.

Although role-playing as an individual was a feature in David Wesely's Brounstein and Dave Arneson's Blockmont, it was a rare feature in a published ruleset. OD&D gave players the ability to choose their race and class, give themselves a finitastical name and even pick an alignment – lawful, neutral and chaotic — on which to base their character's actions. It was a level of escapism unmartished by any other game.

Another feature that was alien to viagoning enthusiats, and most tabletop games was the DD0— 20-bided dee, or knowledow if you work to get technical. All 2-bided de allowed for more varied outcomes than as under six skided die. Grigor had borrowed this idea from the only game that he knew used a DD0. 'Well, I don't love it,' Knight was heard saying upon the first review. 'But it will grow on me.'

The Swoosh definitely grew on Knight as the shape also bore a resemblance to the wings on the Greek goddess that Nike was named after. It would go on to become one of the most wellknown logos in the world.

While Davidson was initially paid just \$35 for her design, Knight saw her as one of the original minds behind the brand and wanted to acknowledge this. In 1983, the founder rewarded Davidson with 500 shares of Nike, as well as a golden ring

with a Swoosh-shaped diamond, which is possibly the biggest remuneration for any logo design in history.

The marking is such a part of Nike culture that every new athlete that signs with the brand is tasked to draw their own version of the Swoosh. There have been different evolutions of the Swoosh and you can see the various iterations if you look through Nike's back-catalogue of products. Designer and Nike collaborator Virgil Abloh nodded to Davidson's original Swoosh design on the cover of his book Something's Off and the marking has been reversed on signature product for eccentric players, like Dennis Rodman's Air Darwin sneaker. But the essence of the Swoosh remains in its simplicity, its elegance and the way it represents movement.
