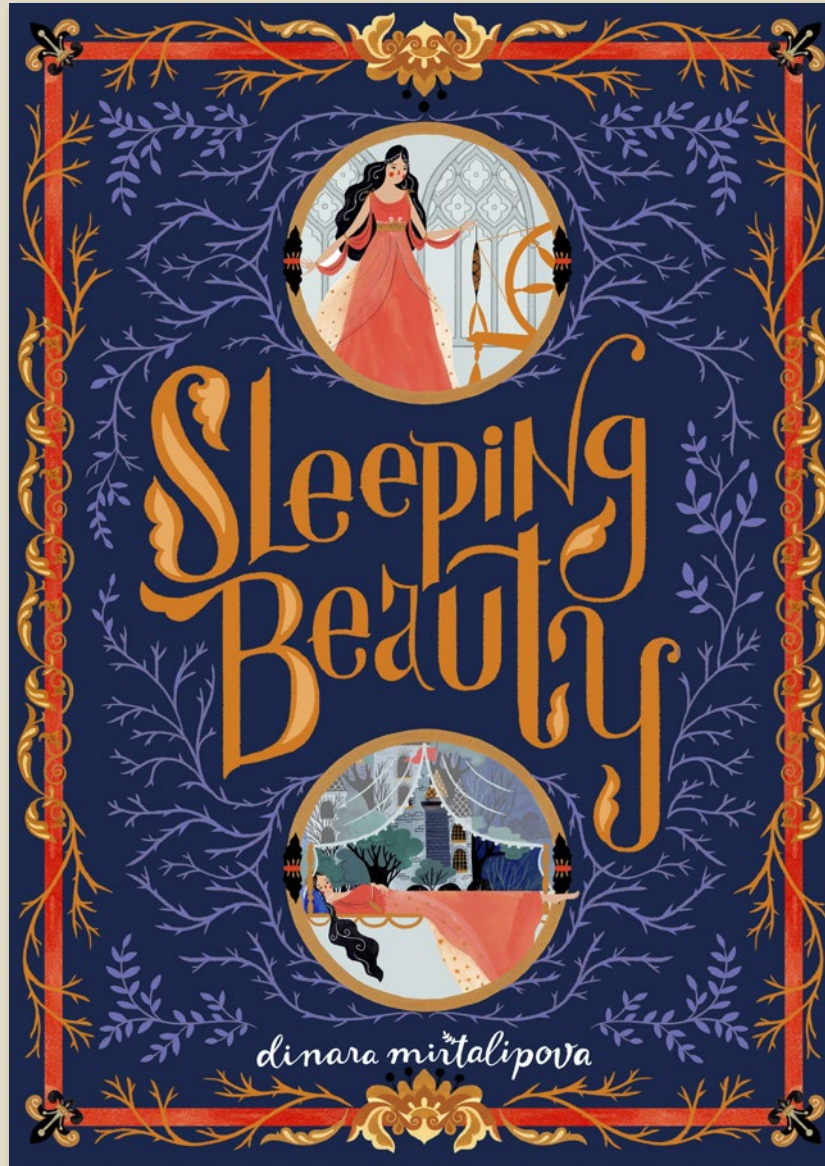
She ran even faster, past the guards, through the gardens, and away from the palace and the prince.

# Alienology

### CHAPTER II Stars and Planets

From the our Sun, we have millions of billions of stars and planets in the galaxy that surround us. There are billions of galaxies in the universe. The stars and planets are made of gas and dust. The stars are made of hydrogen and helium. The planets are made of rock and metal.

### CHAPTER III Alien Biology and Physiology

There are many different types of alien life forms. Some are simple organisms, while others are complex beings with advanced intelligence. Alien biology and physiology can be very different from Earth life.

**ALIEN'S ANATOMY** Alien anatomy can vary greatly. Some have multiple heads, while others have no heads at all. Some have multiple arms and legs.

**REPRODUCTION BY BIRTH** Many alien species reproduce by birth. The young are born from the parents and are often cared for by the parents.

**REPRODUCTION BY EGGS** Some alien species reproduce by laying eggs. The eggs are often protected by the parents until they hatch.

### CHAPTER IV Humanoid Aliens

Humanoid aliens are the most common type of alien life form. They have a similar body structure to humans, but with some differences. They are often found in space exploration programs.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION** Humanoid aliens are bipedal, have two arms and two legs, and a head with a face. They are often green or grey in color.

**EARTH HABITATS** Humanoid aliens are often found in space exploration programs. They are often found on planets like Mars and Venus.

**MISSION** Humanoid aliens are often sent to explore other planets and to establish colonies.

### CHAPTER V Technological Aliens

Many species use technology to improve their physical or mental abilities. The Cyberbrains long to extend their lifespans. They substituted their skulls for protective helmets made from a super-strong material called siliconium, which they believed would never break. However, a freak change in the atmosphere on their volcanic planet increased the temperature. Unfortunately, the Cyberbrains discovered that this caused some helmets to shatter - leaving many vulnerable brains exposed.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** Reptons in appearance, with forked tongues, body on ball, and 2000 pupils.

**EARTH HABITATS:** Wandering human body parts, Reptons have been known to infiltrate positions of power in several large corporations on Earth. They need warmth to survive, so they are most likely to be seen in the summer in large cities. They occasionally conceal themselves in swamps in subtropical zones.

**MISSION:** Long term, to conquer the Galaxy. Short-term, to steal the next spaceship.

**NOTES:** Five Repton clones are attached to each rocket ship. A mother ship is home to two hundred thousand clones. The technology of the Reptons is advanced but no longer working, since becoming clones, they've lost the capacity for original ideas.

**DENEBIAN CYBORGS**

Although they look like machines, Denebian Cyborgs are living organisms encased in mechanical shells that give them super-strength. They are not very intelligent and have never mastered the art of remodeling. When their ancestors destroyed the wildlife on their home planet, Denebian, through over-exploitation, they were forced to offer their services to other species in exchange for a new home on foreign planets.

**GENERAL DESCRIPTION:** There are many different varieties of Denebian Cyborg, but they all have mechanical exo-skeletons.

**EARTH HABITATS:** Look for these aliens in areas where machinery abounds - car scrapyards, factories or power plants. They digress themselves as machines to give assistance.

**MISSION:** To feed homes on other planets.

**NOTES:** They often work for the Group, but they will serve any race that will leave them, including the Taurians, Traders and Proboscians.

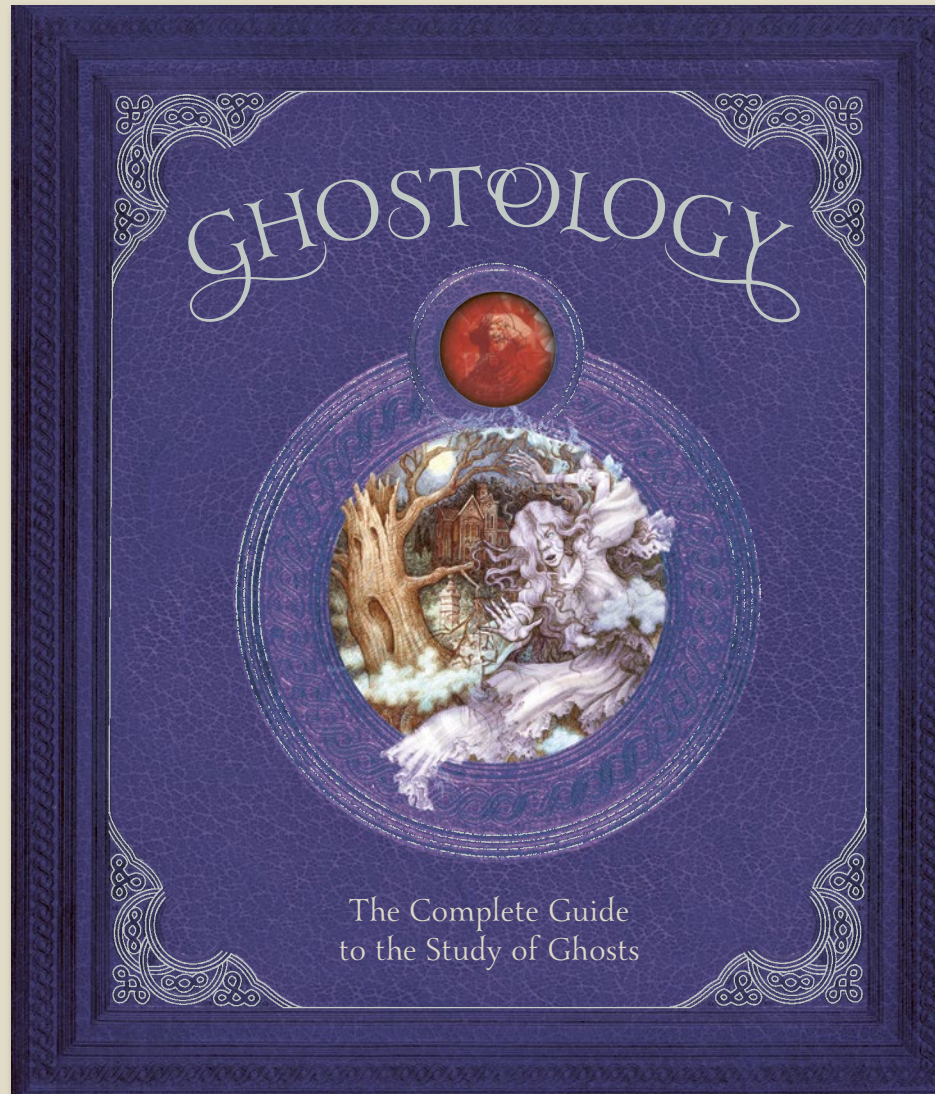
