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EYEWEAR

Eyeglasses may seem commonplace today, but it has taken hundreds of years to develop them to where they are now, helped by a series of inventions along the way. The ancient Romans first wrote about using glass beads to read, similar to how reading glasses work today. However, it was the Arab scientist Al-Hasan Ibn al-Haytham, a man known as the 'father of modern optics', who first wrote about using convex (outwards curved) lenses to magnify an image. Eventually, Ibn al-Haytham's literature made its way to Western Europe. and translations of his work led to glass 'reading stones' becoming common. The Italians improved further on these stones to create the first eveglasses in the late 1200s.



for glasses to become lighter and more durable. The colour of lenses has changed too, creating the first purpose-built sunglasses. These work by adding cerium oxide (a type of chemical compound) into the glass to filter out harmful ultraviolet light from the sun. Sunglasses quickly became fashionable, and in 1938, it was reported that 20 million sunglasses had been sold the year before in the US. Interestingly, only a quarter of those people needed sunglasses for medical reasons. This development is an example of a product that was initially designed to benefit a few but ended up benefitting many. It is testament to the importance of innovation within the

Frida partly wore her colourful, embroidered Fehuara dresses to deguise her limp, but traditional atire was also a way of exploring her place in the history of South America.



Overhanging branches claw the roof, fog pours from between the pines, and I've not seen another person for hours.






On the 19th July, 1545 England faced an invasion. Smoke and flame erupted along the Mary Rose's larboard side as its cannors fixed at the approaching French ships; to the thousands of people wetching from the cliffs, the noise would have sounded like thunder. Then, to bring its portside guns into the action to bear as the others were reloaded, the grand old ship began to turn about_and at that crucial moment a gast of wind in it is safe, causing it to list. Water powed in through the stillopen gunports, fooding the lower cleaks.

Realising their ship was doomed, the saflors and soldiers scrambled to reach the open weather deck and leap overboard, only to be tropped by the anti-boarding netting strung overit. Seewater feared around them, sing higher and higher. From his vantage point on Southees Castle, King Henry Himadi watched the Mary Rose capitze and disappear breach the waves. Of the around 400 men nchewit, only 30 escaped with their lives.
